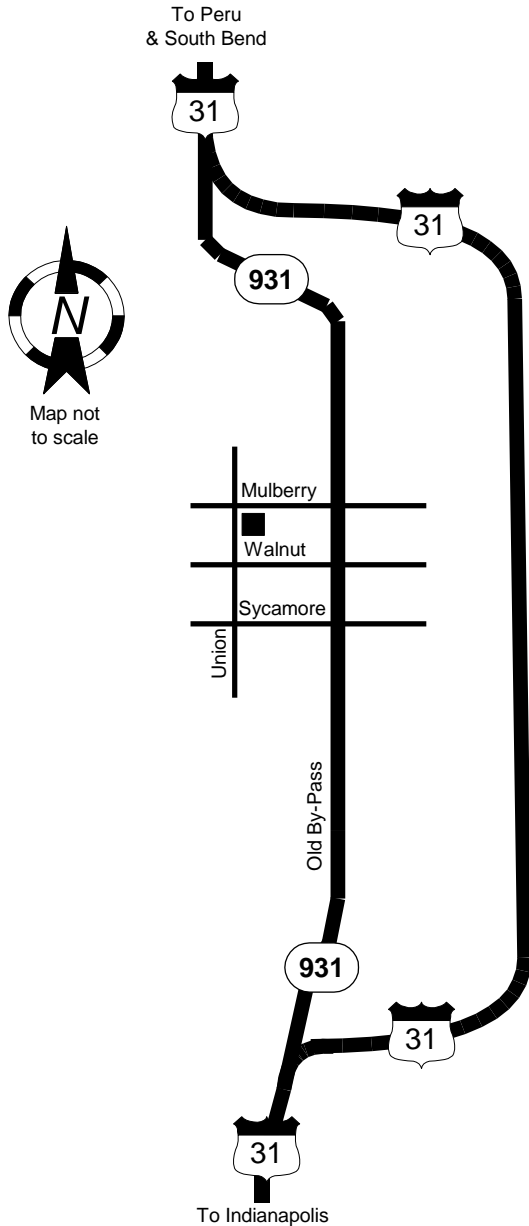


**Kokomo, Indiana Year-Round Event

**Driving Directions**

**Start point: Parking lot of Kokomo-Howard Co. Public Library, 220 N. Union St., Kokomo, IN 46901.**

Kokomo is located approximately 50 miles north of Indianapolis. Take US 31 north to Kokomo. Exit at IN 931 going north into the city. Turn left on Sycamore Street. Continue 0.8 miles to Union St. Turn right on Union Street. The library is on the right.

From the north, take US 31 south to Kokomo exit for IN 931. Follow IN 931 to Sycamore St. Turn right on Sycamore St. Continue 0.8 miles to Union St. Turn right on Union Street. The library is on the right.

Parking is in the rear behind the Library Open dawn to dusk

10K Walk Instructions

Welcome to Kokomo Indiana, and our beautiful year-round event. There are rest rooms available at the start point and along the trail

1. Exit from parking lot facing away from building turn RIGHT on Market St.
2. LEFT on Sycamore St. (Little Free Library on right)
3. RIGHT on Jay St.
4. RIGHT on Superior St. (Great Lakes special program)
5. LEFT on Purdum St.
6. CIRCLE around monument for Chief Kokomo (Mayflower spec. prog.)
7. LEFT in alley
8. LEFT on trail (crossing foot bridge)
9. RIGHT on Apperson Way to Memorial Gym (Veterans spec. prog.)
10. Turn around going back to trail and turn RIGHT on trail crossing Apperson, Union, and Main
11. BEAR LEFT on trail uphill
12. RIGHT crossing pedestrian bridge
13. LEFT at next trail (going under Washington St.)
14. RIGHT at trail split just after going under bridge
15. FOLLOW trail around staying LEFT to Restrooms on left
16. Continue on trail staying left to park drive
17. CROSS and turn RIGHT past "Willie the Whale" sculpture
18. Continue on trail under Philips St.
19. Stay on main trail to LEFT to Carter St.
20. LEFT to Westmoreland St. W
21. RIGHT on Westmoreland Dr. W
22. LEFT at Bennett St. continue to Berkley Rd. Cross to restrooms at hospital
23. Leaving hospital cross Berkley and straight on Bennett
24. RIGHT on Orchard St.
25. LEFT on Carter St. back to trail
26. LEFT on trail to Sycamore St.

27. RIGHT on Sycamore St. Cross at S. Phillips St and continue right on Sycamore passing the Seiberling Mansion
28. LEFT on Main St.
29. LEFT on Elm St. restrooms at trail head
30. LEFT on trail- Industrial Heritage Trail
31. LEFT on Mulberry St. to finish 10 Km

**WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT**  
**Be sure to log back into the OSB system to "finish/complete" your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date of the event, the distance, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)**

Welcome to Kokomo Indiana, and our beautiful year-round event. There are rest rooms available at the start point and along the trail

1. Exit from parking lot facing away from the building turn RIGHT on Market St.
2. LEFT on Sycamore St. (Little Free Library on right)
3. RIGHT on Jay St.
4. RIGHT on Superior St. (Great Lakes special program)
5. LEFT on Purdum St.
6. CIRCLE around monument for Chief Kokomo (Mayflower special prog.)
7. LEFT in alley
8. LEFT on Walk of Excellence
9. Cross foot bridge and continue past Baseball Stadium on left
10. RIGHT on Apperson to plaque for the Memorial Gym (Veterans spec. prog.)
11. Turn around going back to trail and turn RIGHT on trail crossing Apperson, Union, and Main
12. RIGHT on trail crossing pedestrian bridge to next trail on left
13. LEFT on trail and continue under Washington St.
14. RIGHT at intersection and follow around to left to RESTROOMS on left
15. CONTINUE on trail crossing a park drive
16. RIGHT, do not cross pedestrian bridge go past Willie the whale

17. RIGHT at sign where trail splits to Philips St.
18. RIGHT on Philips St.
19. CROSS and RIGHT on Sycamore St. passing the Seiberling Mansion
20. LEFT on Main St.
21. RIGHT on Mulberry St. to finish You have completed the 5K walk!
