Note: There is a traditional start box inside the EDC.' If you have initiated registration in OSB for this event, please stay with the OSB process. Do not double register at the physical start box. Complete the event by logging back into OSB as stated in walk instructions

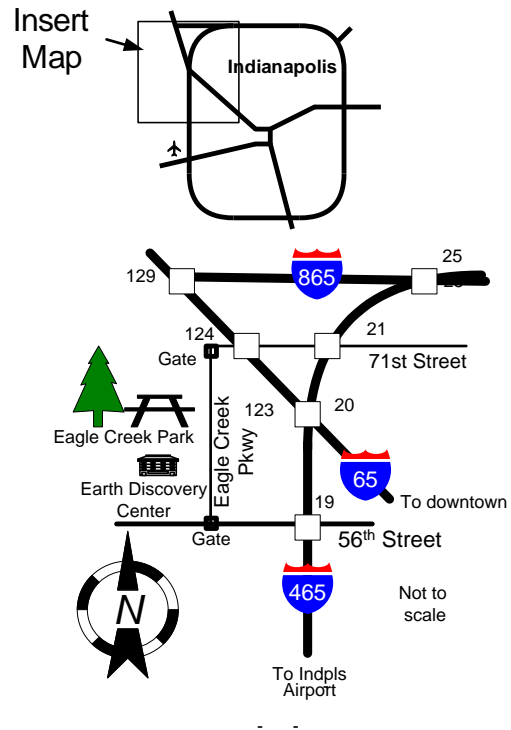
The start point is the parking lot of the Earth Discovery Center (EDC), 5901 Delong Rd. Indianapolis, IN 46254, **Park admission (\$5 or \$6 per car) is charged at the 56th Street or 71st Street gates.** The park is open 7 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. EDC is open: 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. (M-Sat) and 1 to 5 p.m. (Sun) -rest rooms and drinking fountain available. The EDC is closed for most holidays, and open half days before Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's

Eagle Creek Park is located on the northwest side of Indianapolis and can be reached from I-65 or I-465. The start point is located on the southern side of the park near the 56th Street gate.

From I-465, exit at 56th Street (Exit 19) going west. Right at the gate entrance and pay the park fee. Continue into the park on Eagle Creek Parkway to Walnut Point Road. Left then another quick left to Delong Road going down the hill to the EDC parking lot

Welcome to Indianapolis, and our beautiful year-round event. There are rest rooms available at the start point and stations along the trail

10 K trail

1. Start at the Earth Discovery Center (EDC)
2. Cross street and turn left at the RED Trail marker going north
3. Continue on the RED trail past the Marina and go left staying on the Red Trail to the coffer dam (the narrow land bridge that goes out on the lake).
4. After going past the 3 K mark you will leave the coffer dam and go up the hill toward the 71st Street gate.
5. Turn right at asphalt path with barrel on the side. This path leads to the Ornithology Center
6. After passing the Ornithology Center (water, rest rooms) and bird cages the path continues and becomes the Edesess Trail and follows the ridge line with beautiful views of the lake
7. Turn left at the Blue trail at the end of the Edesess Trail, as you start to descend the hill. Follow a short distance to Lilly Lake.
8. Turn right on to RED Trail, just past the lake
9. Follow the RED trail back to the EDC

11 K trail

1. Start at the Earth Discovery Center (EDC)
2. Cross street and turn left or right at the RED Trail marker going north or south
3. Follow the RED trail back to the EDC

5 K trail

1. Start at the Earth Discovery Center (EDC)
2. Cross street and turn left at the RED Trail marker going north

3. Continue on the RED trail past the Marina to the Edesess Trail
4. Take the Edesess Trail (straight ahead) which splits from the Red Trail and follows a rail fence up the hill
5. Continue to the Ornithology Center to the large redwood log display
6. Turn around at the big log and retrace your steps back to the EDC

WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT

Be sure to log back into the OSB system to “finish/complete” your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant’s Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date of the event, the distance, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user’s Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user’s Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

 Trail Map**

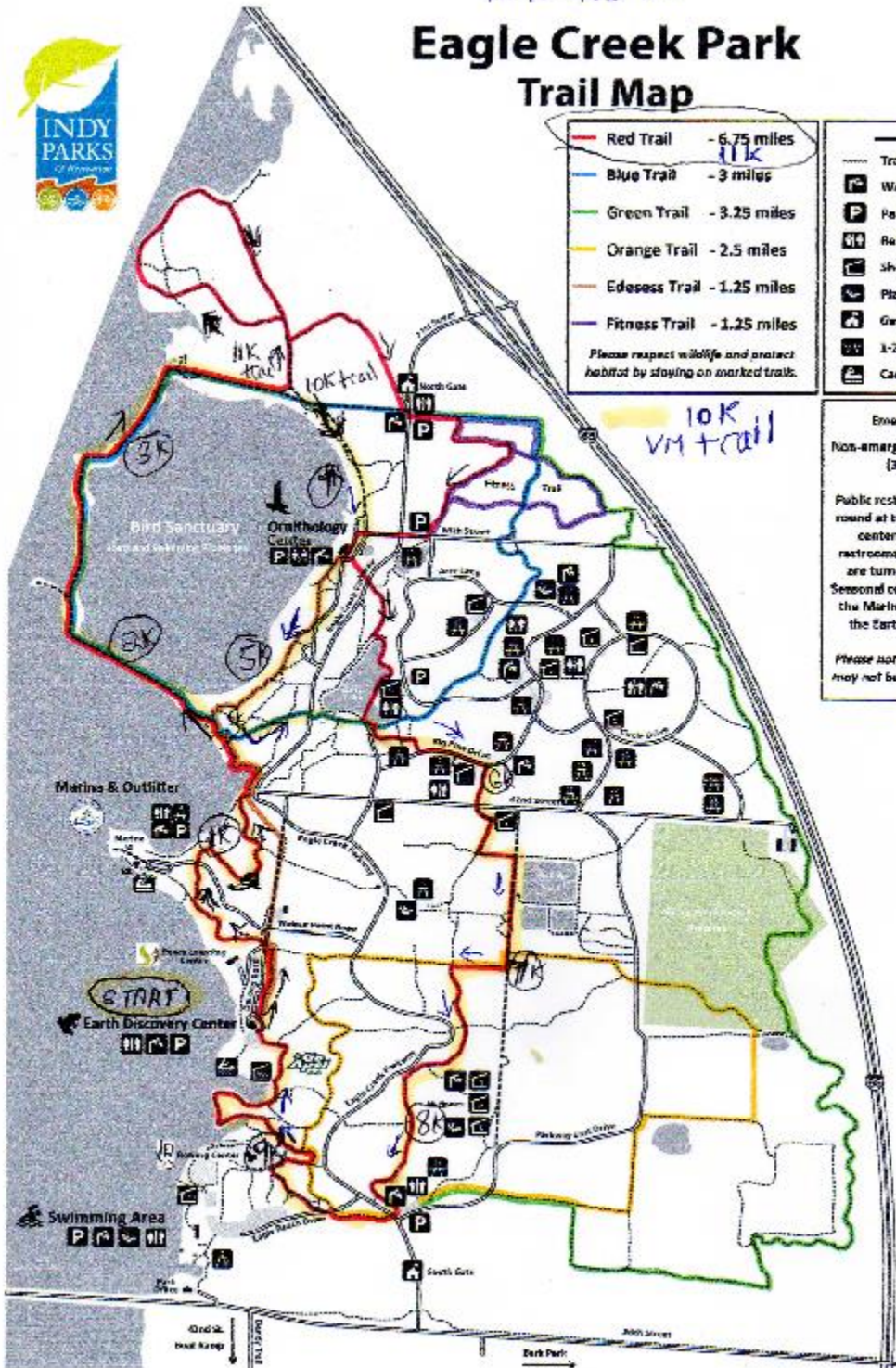
