Modesto Historic Year-round Walk #167

5K & 10K Walks

Start Point: Starbucks, 800 Oakdale Rd., Modesto, CA 95355

Special Programs: Bridges, City Parks, Points of Reference, Post Offices, Walk the USA St x St. County: Stanislaus

1. Exit Starbucks and turn left to the corner of Oakdale Rd. and Scenic Dr.
2. Cross Scenic Dr. at the signal light and continue straight ahead. (Oakdale Rd. changes its name to El Vista Ave.)
3. Follow El Vista Ave. and cross the bridge over Dry Creek. At the end of the bridge, turn left on the trail, down a small hill, then follow the trail left under the bridge. Continue on this trail into East La Loma Park.
4. Follow this paved trail along Dry Creek. The creek will be on the right. Continue on this trail a good distance until you come to restrooms on the right.

5K WALKERS – Turn around and return on the trail the way you came to the childrens playground on the right – **Continue with #20.**

10 K WALKERS CONTINUE:

5. Pass the restrooms and on the right is a footbridge to Moose Park. Cross the bridge to Morton Blvd. Keep left and cross Morton Blvd. to Rue De Yoe.
6. Follow Rue De Yoe straight ahead to La Loma Blvd.

7. Turn right on LaLoma. Cross Burney & H Streets.
8. Cross over 19th at H St. and continue to Downey Ave. Left on Downey to J St. (use caution when crossing I St.)
9. At Downey & J St. Note the sculpture tribute to George Lucas' American Graffiti. Turn right and cross Downey at McHenry Ave. to the other side and turn left on Downey. Downey changes its name to Needham St.
10. Follow Needham to Sycamore (restrooms and water in park by swimming pool). Turn right at Sycamore one block, and return to Needham Street. Note very tall Australian Bunya-Bunya tree on corner.
11. Cross Needham at the crosswalk to 15th St. and follow 15th St. to J Street. Turn right on J St. to the Historic State Theatre at 1307 J St. (Mural across street.)
12. Continue on J St. to 12th St. and turn left. You will pass the Modesto Post Office at 12th & I St.
13. Left on I St. to the McHenry Museum at 1402 I St. The Modesto Stanislaus Library is across the Street.
14. Follow I Street to 14th St. Right on 14th St. to G St. Cross G Street to the other side and turn left. (A & W has been at this location since 1957.)
15. Continue on G St. to 18th St. Cross 18th St. & Burney St. continuing around the roundabout to La Loma.
16. Cross La Loma to the other side and turn right. Follow La Loma across the bridge to the Park.
17. Make a left at the gate into the park and bear right toward the restrooms. With the restrooms on your left follow the paved pathway toward the drinking fountain. Dry Creek is on your left.
18. Continue on the paved pathway straight ahead to a footbridge on the left. Left over the footbridge and turn right on the paved pathway. Now dry creek will be on the right.
19. Follow the paved pathway, passing by a tan building on left (City of Modesto, Thousand Oaks Station.) Continue on the paved pathway through the park to the children's playground on the right.

Modesto Walk # 167 P.2

5K Walkers continue here:

- 20. Turn right on path toward the restrooms. Follow left along the sidewalk passing by the restrooms and turn right up the hill to Edgebrook Dr.
- 21. Left on Edgebrook Dr. to El Vista Ave.
- 22. Left on El Vista, cross the bridge and El Vista becomes Oakdale Rd.

- 23. Continue on El Vista to Scenic Dr. and turn right at the stoplight on Scenic Dr. crossing Oakdale Rd. Left on Oakdale Rd. back to Starbucks.

Thank you for doing our walk, and our thanks to Starbucks for keeping our walk box. Starbucks is a wonderful place for lunch or a drink.
