

**Instruction for UNM CAMPUS CAPER  
6 & 10km Walk, Rated 1A, Y0185  
Double Eagle Hike and Bike Club**

**Walk Start Location:** Smith's Grocery at 3701 Constitution Ave NE, Albuquerque, NM 87110.

GPS coordinates: 35.09537, -106.6034

**Restrooms** available at Smith's Grocery and Golf Course Clubhouse.

**Driving Directions:** From I-40 east or west bound take exit 160 onto Carlisle Blvd NE. From the east turn left and from the west turn right onto Carlisle Blvd NE driving south for 1 km to Smith's on the left and park away from the front door. Start the walk from the righthand door when facing the store.

**Walk Completion and Credit:** Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

"Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB."

"These maps and directions may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited."

1. From the Smith's walk **LEFT DIAGONALLY** across parking lot to traffic light. **CROSS** Carlisle Blvd with the lights.
2. **RIGHT** on Rita Dr.
3. **LEFT** on Haines Ave.
4. **LEFT** on Vassar Dr after **CAREFULLY CROSSING** Girard Blvd.
5. **STRAIGHT AHEAD** where Vassar merges with Princeton.
6. **RIGHT** on Hannett Ave.
7. **LEFT** on Princeton Dr. Walk down five homes on the **left** side and note the unique home at 1324 Princeton.
8. **REVERSE DIRECTION** to Hannett.
9. **LEFT** on Hannett.
10. **STRAIGHT AHEAD** after **CROSSING** Stanford Dr and continue through a chain-link fence and ahead on the path around the golf course. (*The route turns **right** at the end of the homes and **bears left** at Indian School, a major street, and **left** again.*)
11. **REMAIN ON THE TRAIL** closest to the fence. (*Note the Albuquerque downtown to the west and also the volcanic mounds on the west mesa. Also on the right are an exercise trail, diversion canal, and UNM campus parking.*)
12. **LEFT** when the trail reaches a group of buildings.
13. **RIGHT** after passing the Casa Esperanza Cancer Care Center. (*A short distance ahead and on the **left** is the golf course club house with restrooms, water, and vending machines.*)
14. **STRAIGHT** ahead on Yale Blvd after **CROSSING** Tucker Rd. **Continue ACROSS** Lomas Blvd at the light.
15. **RIGHT** on Las Lomas Rd.
16. **LEFT** on Redondo Rd just before University Blvd.
17. **LEFT** at the end of the parking area at Bldg 11.
18. **RIGHT DIAGONALLY** at the walkway after passing the blue sign (Anthropology, Bldg 11) on your **right**.
19. **LEFT** at the second walkway. Just before reaching the building, turn **RIGHT** passing blue sign (Scholes, Bldg 10) on your **left** and three flagpoles on **right**.
20. **CONTINUE STRAIGHT** ahead onto gravel path, following it **DIAGONALLY LEFT** across the duck pond footbridge.
21. **RIGHT** on the sidewalk around the pond.
22. **LEFT** after traveling a little less than ¼ of the way around the pond and walk toward a concrete structure with four entrances.
23. **STRAIGHT AHEAD** on the walkway passing a fountain with 12 sculpted granite pillars. (*Note the "Tribute to Mother Earth" plaque on the north rim of the fountain.*)

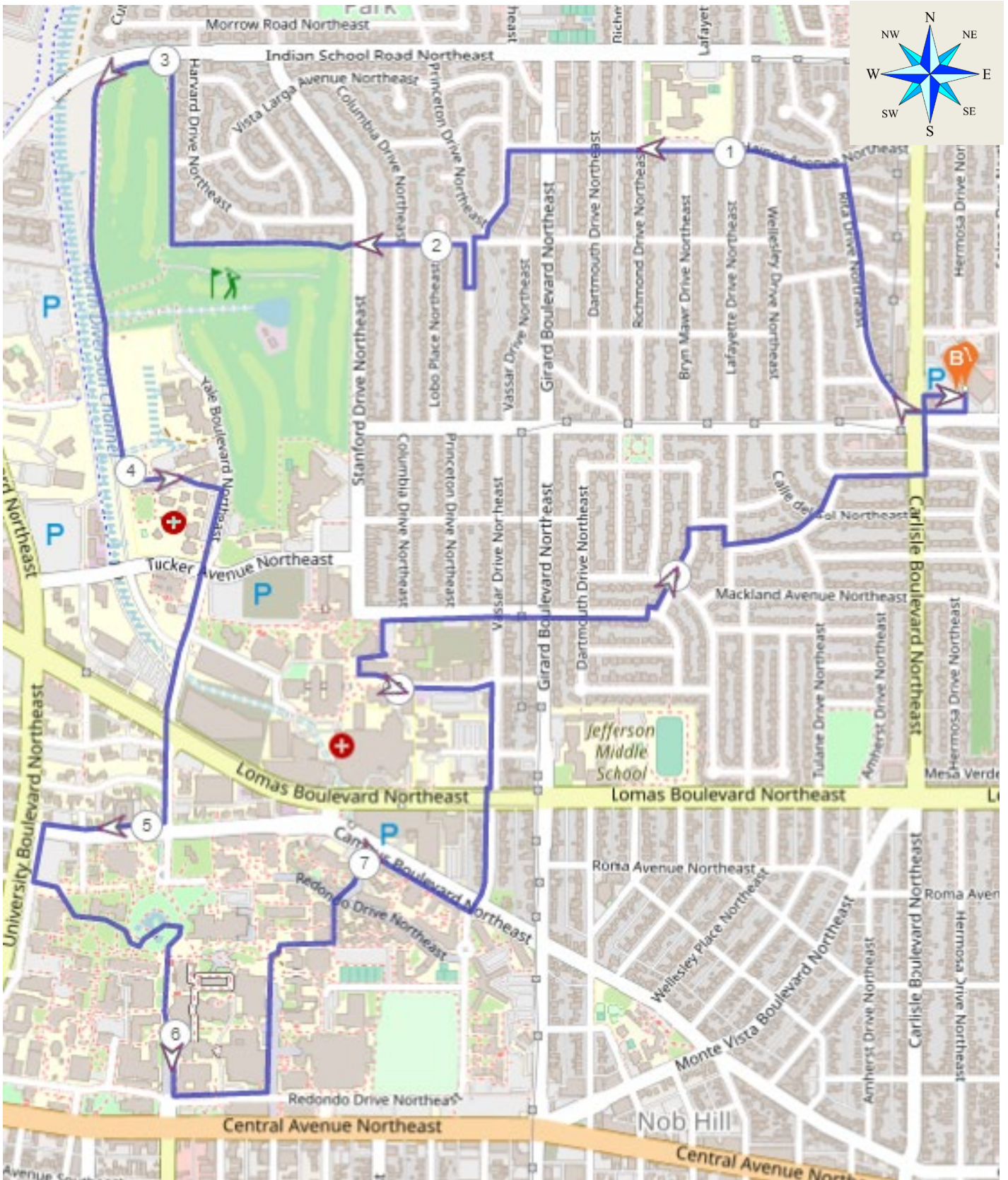
**CAUTION:** Watch for erratic golf shots as you walk around the course perimeter. Note the course signs reminding walkers to remain on the walking path and off the course. Walk to the right of the path and watch for joggers and bikers.

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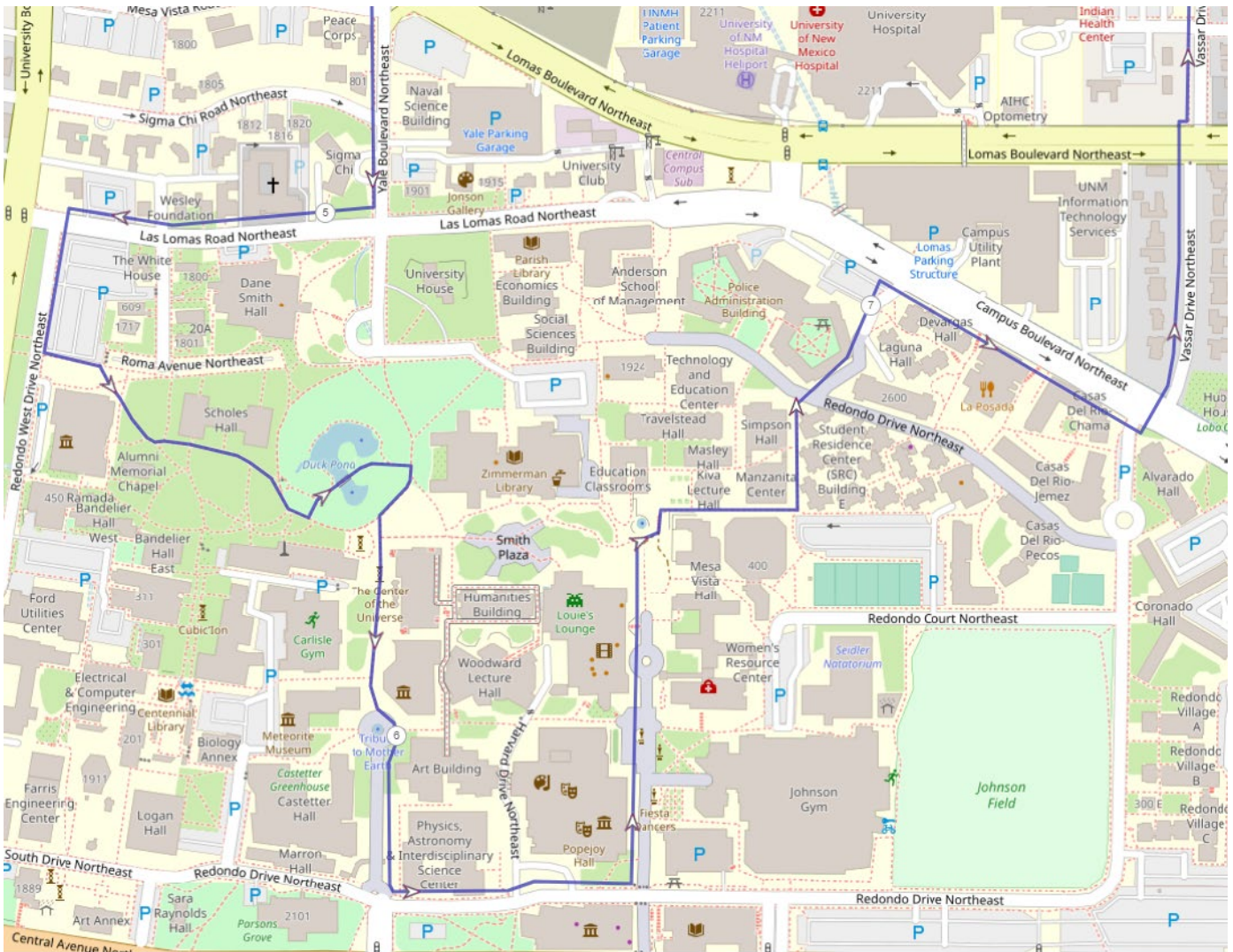
24. **LEFT** at Redondo Rd.
25. **LEFT** at the Center for Fine Arts on the campus main concourse. (*On your **right** is a parking structure and on the **left** is Popejoy Hall, used for concerts, plays, etc. Behind you is the student bookstore if you're looking for some gifts and across Central Blvd is the Frontier Restaurant, a favorite hangout for students and others looking for great Mexican-American Food.*)
26. **CONTINUE STRAIGHT** ahead along the concourse past several sculptures and the newly renovated Student Union on the **left**. (*Food and restrooms available.*)
27. **RIGHT** after descending stairs at the end of the concourse and passing the Kiva Lecture Hall.
28. **LEFT** at the end of Manzanita Hall, Bldg 70.
29. **RIGHT** on the broad walkway after passing the College of Education, Bldg 64.
30. **LEFT** after the blue sign (Santa Clara, Bldg 61), passing Bldgs 74 and 75 on your **left**, then **DOWN** the stairs. **CROSS** the street.
31. **RIGHT** on Campus Blvd.
32. **LEFT** at Vassar 4 blocks.
33. **CROSS** Lomas Blvd using **EXTREME CAUTION**. (If traffic is heavy, walk **right** to Girard and **cross** at the light, **then return** to Vassar. Note the unique old Indian Hospital building on your **left** at Revere Pl.)
34. **LEFT** at Frontier Ave and walk along the College of Nursing and College of Pharmacy, Bldg 228.
35. **RIGHT DIAGONALY** at the end of the building and walk between Health Science Library (Bldg 234) and Health Science and Services (Bldg 266).
36. **RIGHT** on sidewalk around Bldg 266 and continue **RIGHT** along Marble Ave.

15. **RIGHT** on Stanford and **CONTINUE LEFT** around corner to Marble Ave.
16. **CONTINUE** to Summit after **CROSSING** Girard
17. **LEFT** on Summit Dr.
18. **RIGHT** on Mountain Rd.
19. **RIGHT** on Lafayette Dr.
20. **LEFT** on Hastings Dr.
21. **RIGHT** on Calle del Rancho.
22. **LEFT** on Carlisle Blvd.
23. **RIGHT DIAGONALLY** across parking lot to Smith's and your car.

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
