

**Instructions for
Boardman Town Walk
Y0212, 6/10 Km, rated 1A**

Walk Start Location: Boardman Marina Park, 1 West Marina Dr, Boardman OR 97818

GPS Coords: 45.84284, -119.71479

Driving Directions: Follow I-84 east to exit 164 and turn left onto N Main St. Turn left on Marine Drive and follow to Marina Park. Westbound I-84 use exit 164 and right onto N Main St to Marina Drive and left to Marina Park.

Park: parking lot on right at Marina Park.

Restrooms Public restrooms are in the park.

Walk Completion and Credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

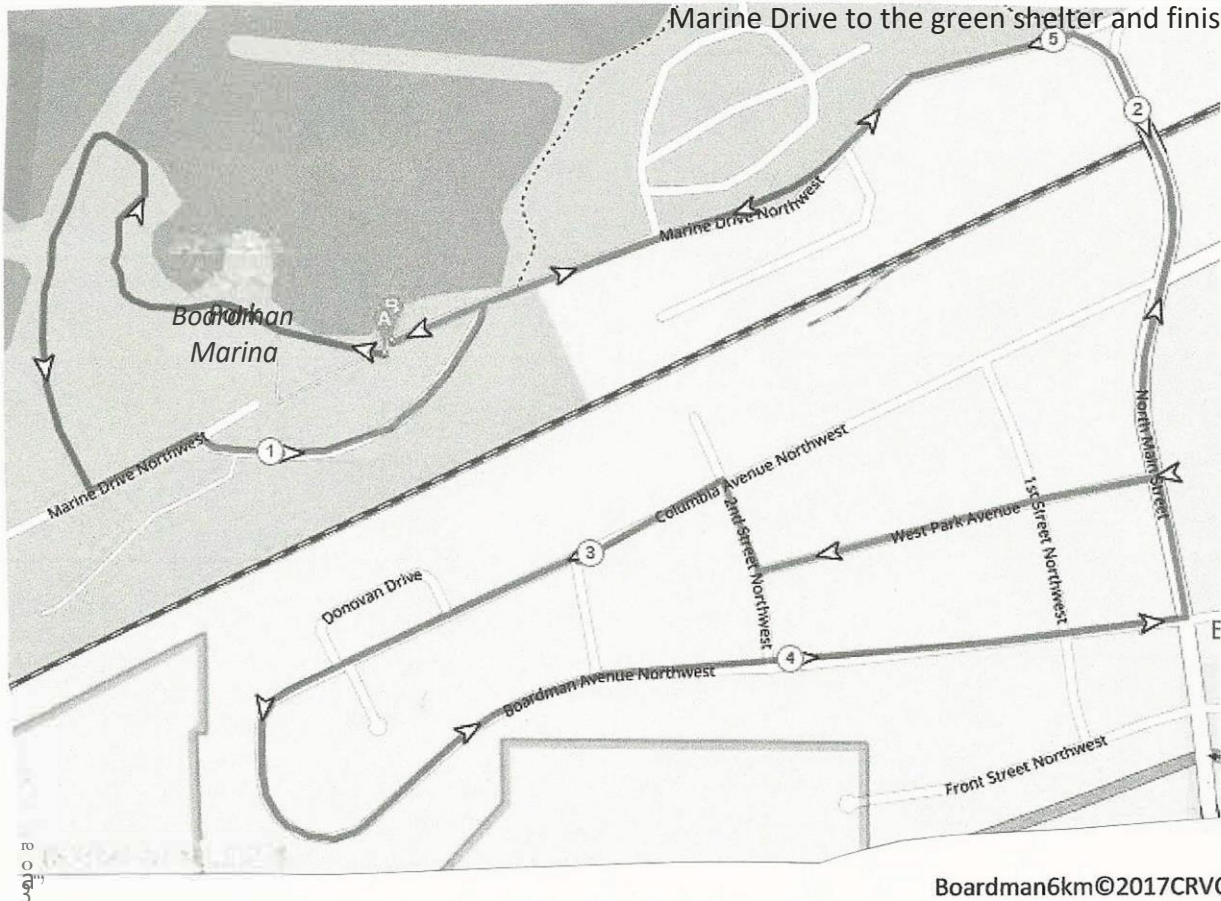

BOARDMAN 2024 YRE # 212 - 6 KM rated 1A

1. At the Boardman Marina Parking lot, WALK to green shelter with a white roof are 4 large boulders with petroglyphs on them.
2. WALK towards the river for about 20 feet to the yellow curb cut out and the paved path.
3. FOLLOW the paved path past the covered picnic pavilion on right, past the play area to the beach.
4. Follow the paved path around a gentle curve to the left. You will see the Columbia River at its widest point. *This is referred to as "Lake Umatilla".*
5. Go past the baseball fields on your left and old locust trees on your right, these trees are the only remnants of the original Boardman Community. *(The rest of the community was demolished during the construction of the John Day Dam in the 1960's)*
6. Exit the grove of trees at the asphalt highway, turn LEFT on this pavement (an original segment of the Columbia River Highway). Follow the road to the right when you get to the parking lot entrance.
7. Go past the Native American fishing site to the Stop sign at Marine Drive. (1.2K)
8. CROSS & RIGHT and walk towards the Green Fish Cleaning Station building.
9. Continue on Marine Dr.
10. WALK toward the "Y" intersection near the Railroad Overpass bridge
11. Turn RIGHT and **carefully** cross over the Railroad Overpass bridge.
12. WALK to the first street (Columbia Ave).
13. Carefully cross Columbia Ave and Turn Right to cross Main Street.
14. LEFT on Main St to walk past the Sandpiper Apts.
15. After passing the apartments there is a gravel parking lot. Turn RIGHT to walk through the gravel parking lot to NW 1st St. You will walk past a Water Tower on your left. (If you gotten to the Banner Bank you have went too far).
16. CROSS 1st St. at crosswalk on the left & continue straight on NW Park Ave. (Restrooms on your left.)
17. At Stop Sign (NW 2nd St), turn RIGHT for 1 block.
18. LEFT on NW Columbia Ave.
19. Continue on NW Columbia Ave as it curves around to the left and becomes NW Boardman Ave. (past Sagebrush Apartments on right)
20. Continue on NW Boardman Ave to Main St. (At NW Boardman & 1st St NW is Post Office)
21. Turn LEFT on Main St to Railroad Overpass Bridge.
22. At the "Y" intersection, LEFT to walk back on Marine Drive to the green shelter and finish.



BOARDMAN 2024 YRE 212 10 KM

1. At the Boardman Marina Parking lot, WALK to green shelter with a white roof are 4 large boulders with petroglyphs on them.
2. WALK towards the river for about 20 feet to the yellow curb cut out and the paved path.
3. Follow the paved path past the covered picnic pavilion on right, past the play area to the beach.
4. Follow the paved path around a gentle curve to the left. You will see the Columbia River at its widest point. *This is referred to as "Lake Umatilla".*
5. Go past the baseball fields on your left and old locust trees on your right, these trees are the only remnants of the original Boardman Community. *(The rest of the community was demolished during the construction of the John Day Dam in the 1960's)*
6. Exit the groove of trees at the asphalt highway, turn LEFT on this pavement (an original segment of the Columbia River Highway). Follow the road to the right when you get to the parking lot entrance.
7. Go past the Native American fishing site to the Stop sign at Marine Drive. (1.2K)
8. Turn RIGHT and walk towards the Green Fish Cleaning Station building.
9. Turn LEFT onto the paved path just before the Green Fish Station building.
10. Walking past the RV Park on your right and the Marina on your left, follow the path walking next to the Columbia River.
11. Continue on the paved path, leaving the campground/RV park. At the white short wooden bridge continue on the path. (2K) passing through the groves of Cottonwood and Russian Olive trees.
12. You will be walking along the river at Sailboard Beach to the Captain Al James Barge Tugboat.
13. Continue on the paved path going past the tugboat and curving to the left. Walking past the Veterans' Memorial on your left. (3K)
14. Walk on the paved path into the parking lot, past the 1st building (River Front Center) and walk towards the River Lodge (2nd building).
15. Just before the 2nd building is a paved path. Follow the paved path to walk behind Riverfront Lodge and next to the river.
16. LEFT at the 1st paved path on the left. Do not continue straight.
17. Stay on paved path, passing a bench and continue on to walk past the picnic shelter.
18. Take the cement path to the right to the restrooms. At the restrooms turn to walk towards the parking lot. (3.9K)
19. At the parking lot WALK towards the entrance road to the White Gate.
20. CONTINUE straight on entrance road and Turn RIGHT on Tidewater Way to stop sign. Turn LEFT on Port Way.
21. RIGHT at the crosswalk and cross to the paved path next to the tugboat, LEFT on the paved path going towards the tugboat.
22. Stay on the paved pathway walking past the tugboat (You have been on this path before.)
23. WALK towards Sailboard Beach.
24. At Sailboard Beach, turn LEFT to walk towards Marine Drive, walking past the rocks. (5.4K)
25. Carefully cross Marine Drive and Turn RIGHT.
26. Walk towards the "Y" intersection near the Railroad overpass bridge.
27. Turn LEFT and **carefully** cross over the Railroad Overpass bridge.
28. WALK to the first street (Columbia Ave).
29. Carefully cross Columbia Ave and Turn Right to cross Main Street.
30. Turn LEFT on Main St to walk past the Sandpiper Apartments.
31. After passing the apartments there is a gravel parking lot. Turn RIGHT to walk through the gravel parking lot to NW 1st St. You will walk past a Water Tower on your left. (If you gotten to the Banner Bank you have went too far). (6.1K)
32. CROSS 1st Street using the crosswalk on the left and continue straight on NW Park Ave. (Restrooms a short distance on your left.)
33. At Stop Sign (NW 2nd St) Turn RIGHT for 1 block.
34. Turn LEFT on NW Columbia Ave.
35. Continue on NW Columbia Ave as it curves around to the LEFT and becomes NW Boardman Ave. (past Sagebrush Apartments on right)
36. Continue on NW Boardman Ave to Main St. (At NW Boardman & 1st St NW is Post Office) (8K)
37. Turn LEFT on Main St to Railroad Overpass Bridge.
38. At the "Y" intersection, LEFT to walk back on Marine Drive to the Green Shelter with the Petroglyph's (FINISH).
