After your walk, be sure to log back into the OSB system to complete your online registration. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date of the event, the distance, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.). Also note that an event registration expires after 30 days, but if your registrations lapses, you may re-register without cost.

DESCRIPTION:

Two Ocean Lake hike takes you through meadows and regenerating forests. There are magnificent and frequent views of the Teton Range and Grand Teton. This is a well-maintained trail, and has little shade. Bring water, sunscreen, sunglasses, and rain gear. Summer days are generally warm and sunny but afternoon thunderstorms often develop quickly. A hat, binoculars and camera are useful, too. Starting elevation about 6900 feet. Elevation gain about 240 feet.

NOTE: These maps and directions may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

Within Grand Teton dial 911 for emergencies. If you're traveling somewhere without phone reception, you must be prepared to self-rescue and to be self-sufficient. Many areas of Grand Teton National Park have poor or little cell coverage.

GPS Coordinates: 43.90127,-110.50155

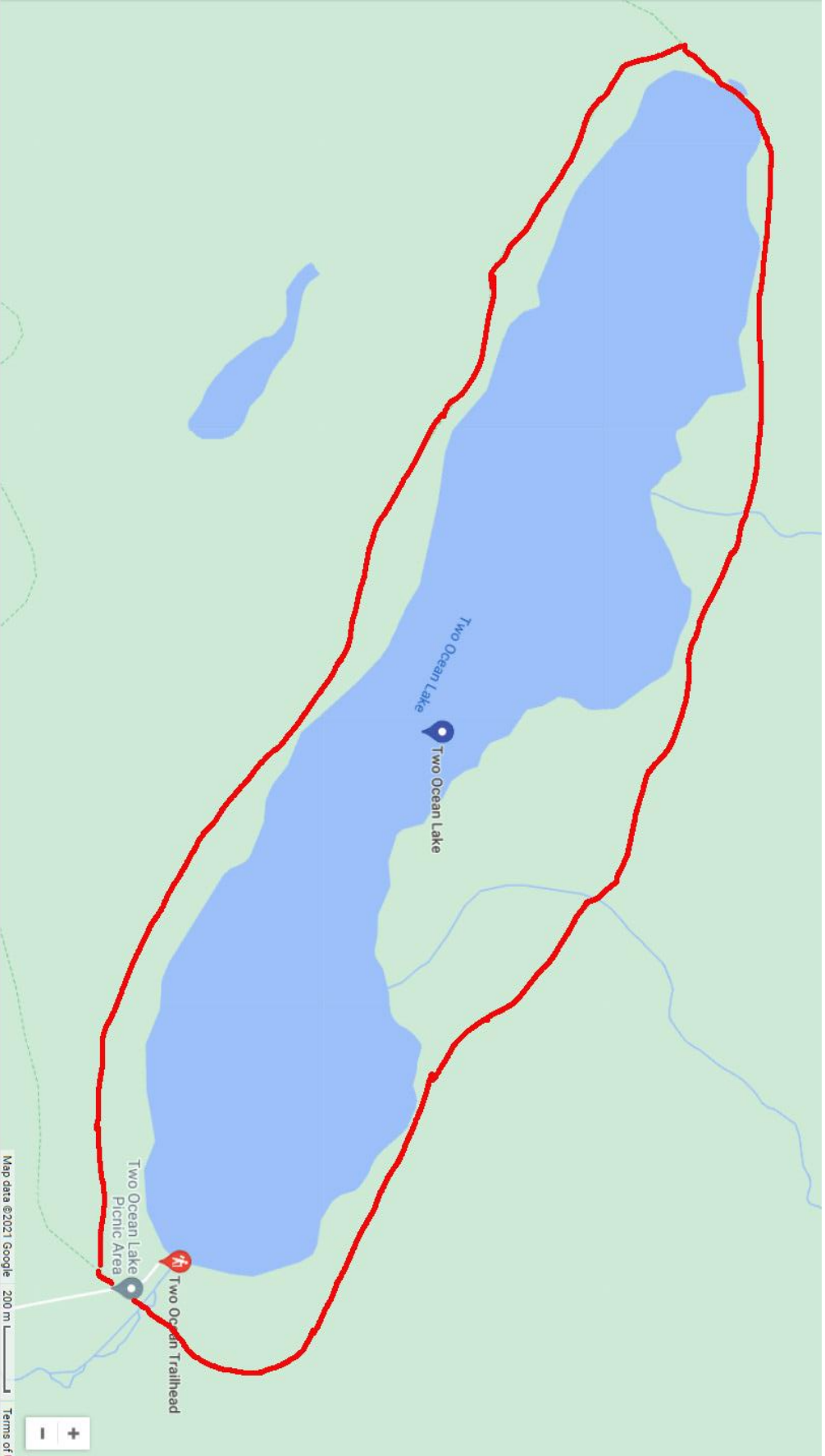
To reach the trailhead turn onto Pacific Creek Road, located roughly 0.9 miles north of Moran Junction. After driving roughly 2 miles, turn left onto Two Ocean Road and drive another 2.4 miles to the end of the gravel road at the lake and the Two Ocean Lake Trailhead.

There is a pit toilet at the trailhead.

Please carry food and water on this hike.

Hiking Directions

Leaving from the Two Ocean Lake Trailhead, hikers can circumnavigate the lakeshore in either a clockwise or counter-clockwise direction. The Two Ocean Lake Trail circles the entire lake in a loop to return to the Two Ocean Lake Trailhead. You will enjoy views of the Teton Range. In early to mid-summer, wildflowers populate the area, brightening up the landscape and making for stunning views. Don't forget the bug spray! Due to the wet, marshy nature of the landscape, Two Ocean Lake is a popular area for mosquitos.
