Reminder: OSB registered users should be sure to log back in to the OSB system after doing the event, to “finish/complete” your online registration, by entering your participation date, distance, and any special programs.

10K – rated 1A: This walk features the beautiful campus of the University of Washington. The route travels the Burke Gilman Trail to the Campus, and returns through the UW Medical campus, the Northlake area, and along Lake Union.

Restrooms available at Gasworks Park, one block south of start location, and at various buildings on the UW campus.

Driving Directions:

From I-5 north or southbound, take exit 169/NE 45th Street. Turn west onto NE 45th to Meridian Avenue North. Turn left onto Meridian and proceed downhill on Meridian. Fisheries Supply faces N 34th Street at the SW corner of Meridian and 34th. Turn onto 34th for the best on-street parking. Do not park in the store lot.

THESE DIRECTIONS FOR AVA REGISTERED WALKERS ONLY

- 1) Exit Fisheries Supply and turn **RIGHT** to end of parking lot (Meridian Street).
- 2) Turn **LEFT** up Meridian to 34th.
- 3) Turn **RIGHT** to cross Meridian and continue on 34th as it curves to the left and becomes N. Pacific.
- 4) At Latona Ave NE, where pedestrian and bike paths merge, cross Latona and move to right on the Burke Gilman Trail. (1.1K). Continue on BGT until first stop sign on the trail (with twinkling red lights, no less!). This is Brooklyn Ave NE. (2K)
- 5) Turn **LEFT** onto Brooklyn for one block to NE 40th Street.
- 6) Turn **RIGHT** crossing Brooklyn and continue on NE 40th to University Way.
- 7) Cross University Way and turn **LEFT** to cross 40th. Continue up University Way to NE 43rd Street. (Post Office)
- 8) Turn **RIGHT** onto NE 43rd, cross 15th NE with light and continue up ramp/stairs and along Stevens Way to Memorial Way.
- 9) At Memorial Way (2.9K) turn **RIGHT**; follow Memorial Way past Parrington Hall and angle **RIGHT** and then **LEFT** as Memorial Way becomes George Washington Lane.
- 11) Pass statue of Washington on your left and continue downhill to Grant Lane. Turn **LEFT** on Grant for one block to W Stevens Way (Crosswalk and stop sign).
- 12) Turn **RIGHT** to cross and continue on Stevens Way. Follow Stevens Way around the campus, passing Architecture Hall, Guthrie, Botany greenhouses (*with Herb Garden across Stevens Way*), Anderson Hall (4K), Mechanical Engineering, the HUB (restrooms), Hall Health and Padelford.
- 13) Cross Pend Oreille Road and continue on E Stevens Way by Whitman Court to NE Skagit Lane (sign across street). Turn **LEFT** to cross Stevens Way in the crosswalk and continue a few steps along Stevens Way.
- 14) At the Y, angle **LEFT** on walkway towards Music Building. (5K)
- 15) Descend the stairs and follow the brick walkway through the Quad and down the stairs/ramp into Red Square.
- 16) Pass the Broken Obelisk on right and Suzzalo Library on left and continue down the stairs/ramp towards Drumheller Fountain (aka Frosh Pond).
- 17) Circle to the left around the fountain and just short of halfway around turn **LEFT** on the walkway down Rainier Vista (the mountain is dead ahead on a clear day).
- 18) Cross Steven Way and continue to the pedestrian overpass over Montlake Avenue. Turn **LEFT** onto the overpass (6K), cross over Montlake, and follow the ramp to the **RIGHT** down to Montlake.
- 19) Cross Walla Walla Lane with light and walk towards Montlake Bridge. Just before bridge turn **LEFT** (Yellow vehicle barricade) onto gravel road/path and walk for 150 meters.
- 20) Execute a **RIGHT** hairpin turn off the trail onto another trail and follow to stairway down to canal. (NB: Use handrail on stairs.)
- 21) Turn **RIGHT** onto walkway and continue beneath bridge to end of walkway.

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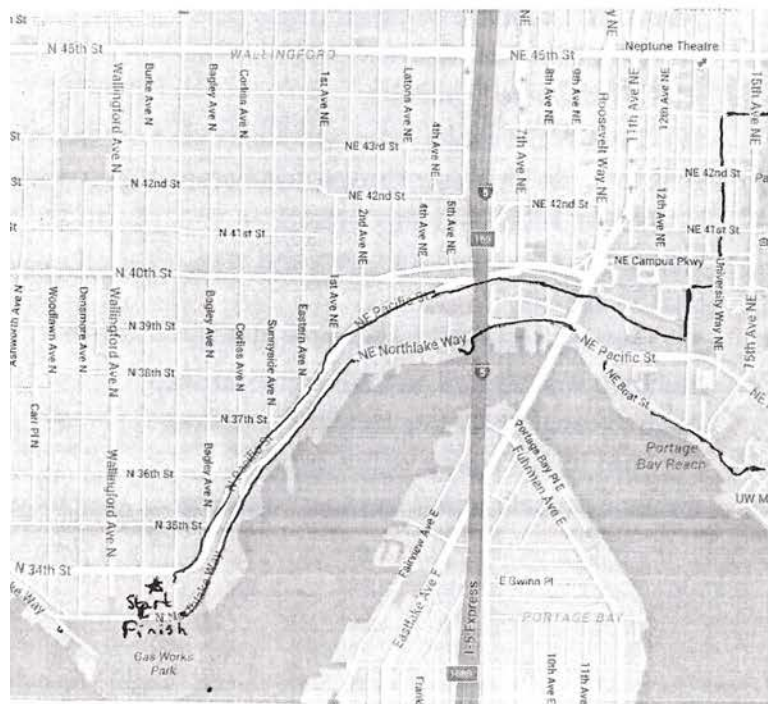
- 22) Turn **RIGHT** up the stairs, cross the grass & lot (b'ball hoop) and walk a few steps up the ramp to a sidewalk on left.
- 23) Turn **LEFT** onto the sidewalk and follow it along Columbia Road (7K @ Ferry Place).
- 24) Continue on Columbia Road as it passes parking shack and curves to left around a "tree island" and passes Jensen Boatworks. Columbia becomes Boat Street. Continue on Boat to its intersection with 15th NE.
- 25) At intersection take a half **LEFT** to remain on Boat Street and walk along Boat (passing Agua Verde & UWPD) to end of Boat and intersection with NE Pacific
- 26) Turn **LEFT** onto Pacific. (8K) Cross Eastlake Place NE and continue on unpaved path beneath bridge. At 7th NE move left to sidewalk. Continue along Northlake Way.
- 27) As you approach the I-5 bridge overhead (before flashing light), turn **LEFT** into a small park on the Ship Canal. Follow the path around and out of the park back to Northlake Way.

- 28) Turn **LEFT** onto Northlake Way (passing Ivar's Salmon House) to 4th Ave NE.
- 29) Turn **RIGHT** to cross Northlake Way in the crosswalk and then immediately **LEFT** to continue on Northlake Way.
- 30) Continue on the walkway as it curves to the left, passing marinas (9K), N 36th, and Corliss Ave N.
- 31) Where the walkway merges with the Burke Gilman Trail (Cheshiahud Loop sign), cross the wider bike path to the narrower pedestrian path and turn **LEFT** onto the BGT.
- 32) Continue on the BGT to Burke Avenue North. Turn **RIGHT** on Burke uphill for one half block. Turn into parking lot to Fisheries Supply and the finish.
