## Herman (Herm) Husbands Memorial Walk

*This walk honors the life and service of Herm Husbands (1933-2023), Coronado Beachcombers President over 20 years and driving force that kept this popular walk alive. Herm served as the Pacific Region Director 2001-2005. He was also a retired Air Force Colonel.*

**Special Programs:** Par for the Course, Rails-to-Trails [Bayshore Bikeway | TrailLink](#), Walking with America's Veterans

**Start Point:** Museum of History and Art, 1100 Orange Avenue, Coronado CA 92118. Museum hours 10-4 Tuesday – Sunday, Closed Monday. For most current hours of operation, exhibition details, and more information about the museum visit [Coronadohistory.org](#).

**Directions to start:** From I-5 (N or S) take Coronado-San Diego Bridge (State Hwy 75) across bay to Coronado. Follow main artery from bridge, becomes Third St. Turn left at light onto Orange Ave. Follow Orange to intersection of Orange and Park Pl. Free 2hr street parking or as posted on signs and curb markings. Strictly enforced and ticketed electronically (\$60). May find free unlimited parking on side streets or north of 10<sup>th</sup> St along Orange Ave.

**OPTIONAL Directions to start via Flagship Ferry:** (Note this option is for the 12K route only.) Forget about parking and take the Ferry! Fare is \$7 each way and serves Coronado from two locations in San Diego. [Broadway Pier route](#) and [Convention Center Route](#). Follow links for schedule and more information. When you arrive at the Coronado Ferry Landing begin walk directions at step 28. If 12K is too much, after step 35 go to step 21 to return directly to ferry landing for 7K.

*We sincerely hope you enjoy your walk in this beautiful city. The Museum has graciously welcomed walkers for 20+ years. Take time to visit their exhibits before or after your walk and thank them for supporting this event. The staff is happy to answer any questions about local history. The OSB system does not deduct any walking fee from a walker's Event Bank until they have submitted walk completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that walker is participating in. (NOTE: The \$2 fee for event PDF Download is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the pdf is downloaded. This prepaid fee is applied against the credit fee(s) at the OSB "Finish Table" when you submit the walk completion info. However, the \$2 "coupon" for the downloaded PDF expires 60 days from download.)

☺ = *Special Program identifier*

*Observe all traffic signals; cross at crosswalks.  
Restroom at start and along route (see map)*

1. **Exit** Museum and **Turn Left** on Orange Ave
2. **Circle Left** in front of Restaurant onto Park Place to Star Park Circle
3. Carefully Cross Star Park Circle to enter Star Park and proceed to flagpole.

☺ **Walk with America's Veterans – Star Park Memorial (1<sup>st</sup> qualifier)** **NOTE:** This event has multiple qualifiers for this special program. You may only use one qualifier per day/paid walk in the same book. Include date of walk with qualifier in book entry.

4. **Turn left** to exit park and carefully cross Star Park Circle to Lomas Ave
5. **Continue** on Lomas Ave to Orange Ave
6. **Turn right** on Orange Ave and continue past Hotel del Coronado
7. **Turn right** at Avenida del Sol
8. Near end of street **turn Right** and follow sidewalk to beach side of Hotel del Coronado
9. Walk along path with beach on left and hotel annex on right
10. **Turn Left** at first available path to beach and lifeguard stand, **then right** keeping ocean on left

## **DOGS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON BEACH**

***IF walking dog or do not want to walk in sand stay on sidewalk with hotel on right and beach on left. Proceed past the Hotel del Coronado until you reach Ocean Blvd. Skip to step 13.***

11. **Turn right** at brown lifeguard tower toward restrooms and Ocean Blvd
12. **Turn left** on Ocean Blvd. keep beach on left.
13. **Continue** on Ocean Blvd to **turn right** in front of the East Gate of North Island Naval Air Station and walk to historical marker
14. **Turn right** at marker with the beach and Ocean Blvd now on your right and Sunset Park on left

15. **Continue** on sidewalk to Alameda Blvd
16. **Turn left** on Alameda Blvd for three blocks
17. **Turn right** on Olive Ave
18. **Turn right** on Tenth St, continue to Orange Ave
19. **5KM walkers:** **Turn right** to finish at the Coronado Historical Museum
20. **12KM walkers:** **Turn left** on Orange Ave
21. Continue to Eighth Street and **turn right** to cross Orange Ave using crosswalk/lights
22. **Turn left** and continue on right sidewalk of Orange Ave
23. Pass Spreckels Park – Restroom at end of park on Sixth Street
- ☺ **Walk with America's Veterans – VFW Post 2422, 557 Orange Ave (2<sup>nd</sup> qualifier)**
24. **Carefully cross** First St and enter Centennial Park passing the Coronado Ferry Ticket Booth
25. Follow path through park past gazebo
26. ☺ **Walk with America's Veterans – Birthplace of Naval Aviation Plaque on left (3<sup>rd</sup> qualifier)**
27. Continue to T, turn right toward Ferry Landing
- ☺ **Rails to Trails – Bayshore Bikeway begins at Ferry Landing and follows bayside path**
28. **Continue** on path always keeping water on left, passing Oakwood Apts and Marriot Resort
29. **Continue** on the bayside path through Tidelands Park (restroom in park) and under the San Diego-Coronado Bridge
30. After crossing under bridge **follow** bike path with golf course on your left
- ☺ **Par for the Course – Coronado Golf Course**
31. At Glorietta Blvd **turn left** on walk/bike lane
32. **Continue** on Glorietta Blvd as it veers right and then curves to left
33. After the Tennis Center, **turn right** on Tenth Street
34. **Turn left** on B Ave
35. **Turn right** on Orange Ave to finish at the Coronado Historical Museum
