DESCRIPTION

Exit 1-5 North or South at exit 55. Continue onto US-199 S/Redwood Hwy. Turn right onto Park Street. Turn right onto 7th Street. After crossing the bridge over the Rogue River, Lodge at Riverside is on the right.

PARK Parking spots away from the Lodge Entrance **Restrooms** available at Lodge and Riverside Park

Walk Completion and Credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including day the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when submitting the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

1. Exit Lodge lot to 7th St (no sign)
2. LEFT on 7th St crossing bridge.
3. Take Stairs on Left Down into Riverside Park (Restrooms In Park)
4. Walk through parking lot along roadway to Vista Drive exit. Note the Veterans Memorial on the Right hillside.
5. Right on Vista Drive to Park St.
6. LEFT on Park St. to Grants Pass Parkway
7. LEFT on Grants Pass Parkway to M St.
8. LEFT on M St. to 9th St.
9. RIGHT on 9th St to K St.
10. LEFT on K St to 6th St.
- 10k SKIP TO 15**
- 5k (Steps 11-14 shown in RED on Map)**
11. RIGHT on 6th to E St.
12. LEFT on E St. to Booth
13. LEFT on Booth to G St.
14. LEFT on G St. to 6th **(SKIP TO 28)**
15. **(10k continues here)** RIGHT on 6th St. to A St.
16. RIGHT on A St. to 8th St.
17. LEFT on 8th St to Fetzner St.
18. RIGHT on Fetzner St to 9th St.
19. LEFT on 9th St. to Memorial Ave.
20. RIGHT on Memorial Ave. into Croxton Park. Point of Interest: Who wrote the poem on large stone to the right of the tombstone carousel?
21. Leaving Croxton Park, turn RIGHT to Riddle (no sign)
22. LEFT on Riddle to 9th St.
23. RIGHT on 9th St to Savage
24. LEFT on Savage to Washington
25. LEFT on Washington (becomes 4th St.)
26. CONTINUE on 4th St. to G St.
27. LEFT on G St. to 6th St.
28. **(Both Routes)** RIGHT on 6th St. to M St.
29. LEFT on M St. to 7th St.
30. RIGHT on 7th St and back to The Lodge at Riverside.

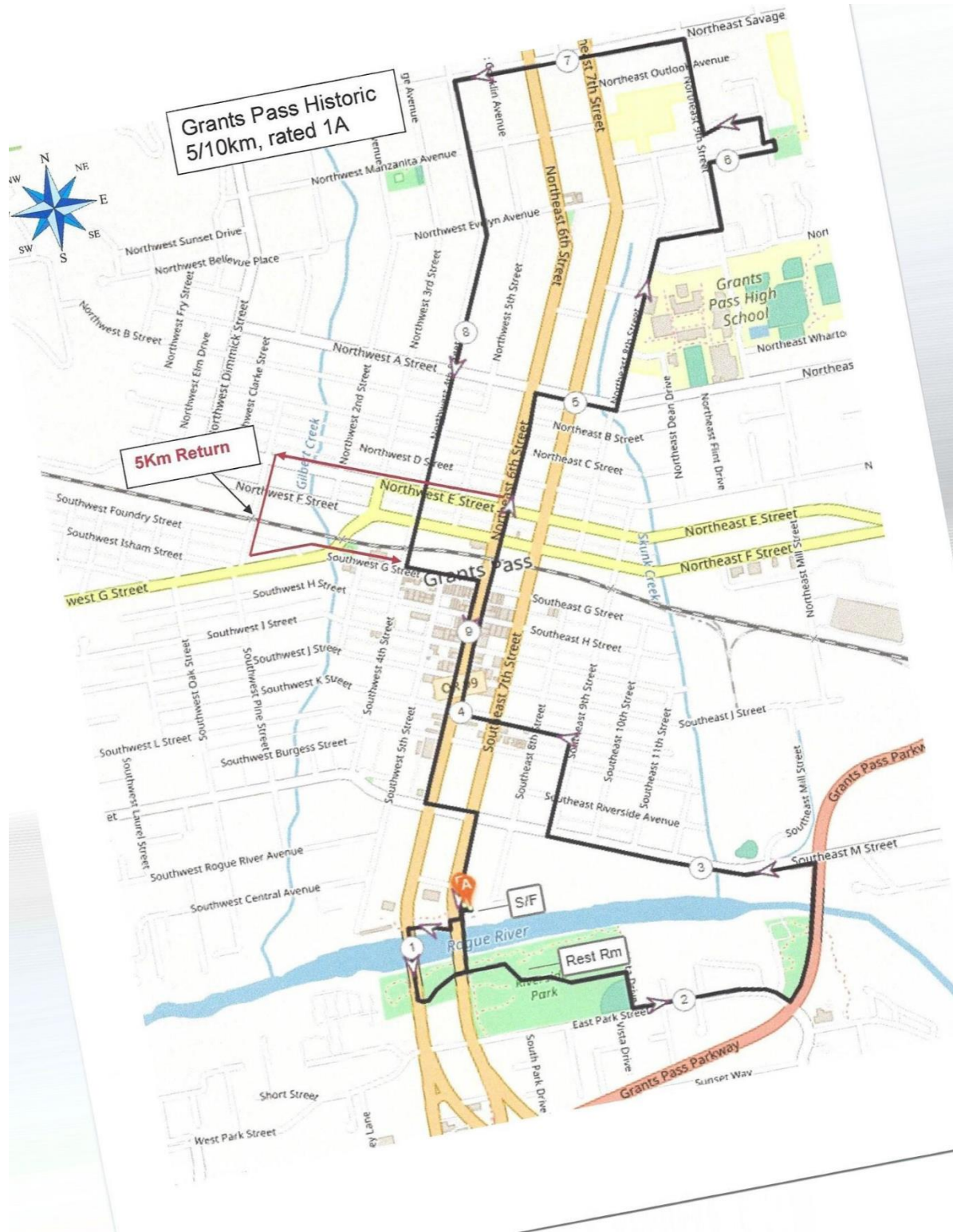
