

Instructions for
Butler Creek, Y-0595
5 & 10 Km, rated 2B

Walk Start Location: Highland Safeway at 1001 SW Highland Dr, Gresham, OR 97080.

GPS Coords: 45.48924, -122.47677

Driving Directions: Going either east or west on I-84, take Exit 13(181st Ave).Go south on 181st. When you cross Stark St 181st becomes 182nd. When you pass Centennial High School get into the right lane. Cross Powell Blvd and turn into the Safeway parking lot on the right. From I-205 traveling south, take exit 19 (Division St).Left on Division to 182nd Ave. Right on 182nd Ave to Powell Blvd. When you pass Centennial High School get into the right lane. Cross Powell Blvd and turn right into the Safeway parking lot. From I-205 traveling north take the Powell/Division St exit. Right on Powell to 182nd Ave. Right into the Safeway parking lot. You can take Bus #9 Powell/Gresham and get off at Powell and Highland Drive and walk to Safeway.

Park: Please park in the outlying area of the lot.

Restrooms: Safeway and along Springwater Trail.

Walk Completion and Credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

"Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB."

"These maps and directions may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited."

2022 Butler Creek Walk**

Y0595 10K RATED 2-B

Butler Creek Greenway Trail, along scenic Butler Creek, is a soft-surfaced trail initially constructed in 1987 by volunteers.

1. Go out the south door of Safeway, near the Deli Dept.
2. Turn right, taking the sidewalk to 11th St.
3. Turn left on 11th St, and walk to Highland Dr.
4. Cross Highland Dr. at the light and turn right on Highland Dr., crossing 11th St.
5. Walk 10-15' to take the sidewalk to the left, before the "Brake Team" sign. You will pass DEQ, walking the sidewalk along the cyclone fence to the Springwater Trail
6. Turn left on Springwater Trail, passing Paesano Park (**Gazebo**) at Cedarville on the right, Linnemann Station (the green building with a public restroom) on the left and Cedarville Inn ahead on the left.
7. Cross Pleasant View Dr. to continue on Springwater Trail. **1 K at the green pipe over Johnson Creek** Continue past the green shelter with a bench.
8. Turn right at the next trail across from the bench on the left.
9. Bear left at the Y in this trail.
10. Bear left to take the bridge (Pedestrian **Bridges**) up to 14th St.
11. Cross 14th St. at the crosswalk to take the path between two posts. **2 K at the posts**
12. Continue through the forested trail to Binford Lake Parkway.
13. Cross Binford Lake Parkway to continue the trail to the right, to pass Binford Lake on the left. Turn right at the end of the bridge.
14. Continue, crossing another bridge and passing a bench on the right.
15. Cross the bridge, with a cyclone fence on your left, to enter Butler Creek Park. **3 K at the park**
16. Bear right onto the paved path into the park. (**Park , Playground**) Continue around the path, bearing left as you continue through the park.
17. Turn right at the drinking fountain to exit the park at 27th Dr. and cross 27th Dr.
18. Turn left to walk a few feet to the paved path that goes between the homes on your left and the lake on your right.
19. This path is paved, then gravel, then grass. It does not look like a public access at first, but you will see city parks signs that indicate no swimming, etc.
20. Continue walking to the street at the end of the paved path to your right. Turn right at the 25 MPH sign, walking to Mawcrest St. Cross Mawcrest St.
21. Cross Willow Parkway. Turn right on Willow Parkway, walking to Battaglia Pl.
22. Cross Battaglia Pl. and turn left on 31st St.
23. Turn left on Binford Ave. **4K at 33rd St**
24. Continue to Butler Creek Rd.
25. Turn left on the sidewalk to the school . Walk to the end of the sidewalk, with the three yellow striped reflector signs.
26. Turn around, to walk back to the cyclone fence along the edge of the school grounds.
27. Turn right at the end of the cyclone fence to enter the sidewalk along the driveway.
28. Turn left at the end of the cyclone fence, entering the paved area with the school building on the right of school.

29. Circle around the building to the back of the school.
30. Turn around at the corner of the building, after passing the red fire hydrant and take the 1st sidewalk to the right.
31. Turn right at the steps, curving toward Binford Way. Turn right on Binford Way, which will become Binford Ave. **5K at 31st St.**
32. Turn right on 31st St.
33. Turn right on Willow Parkway and cross Mawrcrest. Then turn left to cross Willow Parkway.
34. Turn right, walk to the house addressed "2323", then, take the paved path to the left, into the grassy path, with the houses on the right and the creek on the left. Remember this is a public access, even though it does not look like it at first.
35. At the end of the path, cross the street, which is 27th Dr. and turn left to enter Butler Creek Park.
36. Turn left at the drinking fountain and continue left, then bear right in the curved path out of the park.
37. Enter the trail at the first bench, with the cyclone fence on the right.
38. Turn left at the Y to cross the bridge.
6 K at the bench on the trail
39. Continue on the trail, to Binford Lake Parkway, while passing Binford Lake on the right.
40. Cross the Binford Lake Parkway at the crosswalk, continuing on the gravel path.
41. Continue through the forested trail to 14th St. and pass through the two posts to cross the crosswalk on 14th and cross the bridge. **7K at the end of the bridge**
42. Bear right at the Y in the trail at the end of the bridge and follow the path to the next Y on the gravel path.
43. Bear right at this Y and turn left onto Springwater Trail and continue past the green shelter with the bench.
44. Cross Pleasant View Dr., to continue on Springwater Trail. **8 K at Pleasant View Dr.**
45. Pass Linnemann Station and pass Paesano Park at Cedarville.
46. Continue on Springwater Trail, under the viaduct, passing the sign on left, "Early Inhabitants of Johnson Creek."
47. Continue past the next sign on left, "Johnson Creek History" and cross the bridge, continuing to the green shelter. **9K at the shelter.**
48. Turn around to retrace your steps, walking under the viaduct.
49. Take an immediate left turn at the path to walk along the cyclone fence near DEQ.
50. Exit the path onto the sidewalk along Highland Dr. and cross 11th St. at the light.
51. Turn left to cross Highland Dr. at the light.
52. Walk up 11th St. to enter the sidewalk to the Safeway south entry and the Start Point.

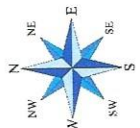

Butler Creek Greenway Trail, along scenic Butler Creek, is a soft-surfaced trail initially constructed in 1987 by volunteers.

1. Go out the south door of Safeway, near the Deli Dept.
2. Turn right, taking the sidewalk to 11th St.
3. Turn left on 11th St, and walk to Highland Dr.
4. Cross Highland Dr. at the light.
5. Turn right on Highland Dr., crossing 11th St.
6. Walk 10-15' to take the sidewalk to the left, before the "Brake Team" sign. You will pass DEQ, walking the sidewalk along the cyclone fence.
7. Follow the trail to Springwater Trail.
8. Turn left on Springwater Trail passing Paesano Park (**Gazebo**) at Cedarville on the right, Linnemann Station (the green building with a public restroom) on the left and Cedarville Inn ahead on the left.
9. Cross Pleasant View Dr. to continue on Springwater Trail. **1 K at the green pipe over Johnson Creek**
10. Continue past the green shelter with a bench.
11. Turn right at the next trail across from the bench on the left.
12. Bear left at the Y in this trail.
13. Bear left to take the bridge (**Pedestrian Bridges** up to 14th St.
14. Cross 14th St. at the crosswalk to take the path between two posts. **2 K at the posts**
15. Continue through the forested trail to Binford Lake Parkway.
16. Cross Binford Lake Parkway, at the crosswalk, to see Binford Lake
17. Turn around, cross Binford Lake Parkway at the crosswalk, continuing on the gravel path.
18. Continue through the forested trail to 14th St.
19. Pass through the two posts to cross the crosswalk on 14th. **3 K at the bridge**
20. Cross the bridge.
21. Bear right at the end of the bridge.
22. Follow the path to the Y on the gravel path.
23. Bear left at this Y.
24. Turn left onto Springwater Trail.
25. Cross Pleasant View Dr., to continue on Springwater Trail. **4 K at Pleasant View Dr.**
26. Pass Linnemann Station (the green building with a public restroom) and pass Paesano Park at Cedarville.
27. Turn right at the sidewalk, before the viaduct, to walk along the cyclone fence near DEQ.
28. Exit the path onto the sidewalk along Highland Dr.
29. Cross 11th St. at the light.
30. Turn left to cross Highland Dr. at the light.
31. Walk up 11th St. to enter the sidewalk to the Safeway south entry and the Start Point.
