The New Braunfels Marsch-und Wandergruppe  
Welcomes you to  
The Don Flick 5k and 11k Memorial Walk

An AVA Sanctioned Year Round Event through  
Downtown New Braunfels and surrounding  
Residential Areas and Parks



The 5k walk proceeds through downtown New Braunfels and the surrounding residential areas, while the 11k adds Landa Park to the route. The routes are rated 1B. The walk start/end point is the front of the Faust Hotel, located at 240 S. Seguin Avenue, New Braunfels TX 78130.

### **Walk Registration:**

Registration takes place online using the AVA Online Start Box, located at [my.ava.org](http://my.ava.org). Follow the instructions provided to create a user account and sign the AVA waiver. Instructions for payment are also included. Download the directions and print as needed. The POC does not provide event directions or accept alternate payment methods.

### **Walk Completion and Walk Credit:**

Once you have physically completed the walk, please login into your Online Start Box account by clicking on the "My Start Box" tab, the "Finish Table" tab, then click on the "Go to Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as selecting the applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped "virtual" insert cards that you may choose to print out.

### **Directions and Parking:**

From North or South on I-35, take Exit 187 to Seguin Avenue. Go west on Seguin Avenue toward downtown New Braunfels, about 0.9 miles, to Coll Street. Turn left onto Coll Street, then turn right onto Castell Avenue.

From TX Hwy 46 (Boerne, Bulverde, etc.), cross Loop 337 on the NW edge of New Braunfels. Hwy 46 becomes North Walnut within the city limits. Follow Walnut Avenue (Business 46) for 2 miles to the light at West San Antonio Street. Go 0.7 miles to the light at Castell Avenue (one block before the Main Plaza), and turn right.

Due to construction at the Faust Hotel, we recommend not using their parking lot while the hotel is closed. Free parking can be found at the corner of Coll and Castell (300 S. Castell Ave), or across from the Civic/ Convention Center on Coll Street. A "Pay to Park" lot can be found on S. Castell across from Krause's Cafe & Biergarten.

**5K ROUTE DIRECTIONS**

1. Exit the Faust Hotel and turn RIGHT on S. Seguin Ave.
  - Faust Hotel (Built in 1929, Originally the Traveler's Hotel)
2. STRAIGHT on S. Seguin Ave to Butcher St.
  - First Protestant Church (Built in 1875)
  - NB Civil/Convention Center
  - Statue of Prince Carl of Solms
3. RIGHT on Butcher St to S. Castell Ave.
  - Faust Brewing Company
4. RIGHT on S. Castell Avenue to W. Coll St.
5. LEFT on W. Coll St to S. Academy Ave
  - \*\* Watch for trains; carefully cross the tracks
6. LEFT on S. Academy Ave to Sophienburg Museum
  - American Legion Post 179
  - Sophienburg Museum
7. RIGHT into and through the museum grounds to Magazine Ave
8. RIGHT on Magazine Ave to W. Cross St.
9. LEFT on W. Cross St to S. Santa Clara Ave
  - First Baptist Church
  - St. Paul Lutheran Church
10. RIGHT on S. Santa Clara Ave to W. San Antonio St.
  - McKenna Children's Museum
11. RIGHT on W. San Antonio St to Hill Ave
  - First United Methodist Church
  - Downtown Social/Pour Haus
  - New Braunfels Railroad Museum (Built in 1907)
  - Brauntex Theater (Built in 1942)
  - "The Art of Entertainment" Mural
  - "Connecting New Braunfels to the World" Mural

  - Henne Hardware (Oldest in Texas, since 1857)
12. RIGHT on Hill Ave to alleyway before Fire Department Museum
  - Fire Department Museum
13. LEFT on alleyway to S. Castell Ave
  - NB Art League Mural (Dali, Kahlo, Picasso)
  - "Spass und Gemütlichkeit" Mural
14. LEFT on S. Castell Ave to W. Mill St
  - "City of a Prince" Mural (side of antique store)
  - Gebhardt's Chili Powder Mural (side of Phoenix Saloon)
  - \*\* Carefully cross W. San Antonio St
  - Myron's Steakhouse (old Palace Theater)
  - Two Tarts Bakery
  - McAdoo's Restaurant (old Post Office, built in 1915)
  - Hermann Seele "The Soul of New Braunfels" Tiled Mural
15. RIGHT on W. Mill St to N. Seguin Ave.
  - Got Toys
  - New Braunfels Brewing Company
16. RIGHT on N. Seguin Ave to Main Plaza
  - Comal County Courthouse (Built in 1898)
17. RIGHT on Main Plaza, carefully crossing W. San Antonio St and S. Seguin Ave
  - Main Plaza Bandshell
  - "The Legacy of Our Journey" Mural (behind UPS)
  - Eiband & Fischer Store (original burned in 1947)
  - WWI and Civil War Soldier Statues (Main Plaza)
18. RIGHT on S. Seguin Ave, with road on your right, to W. Garden St.
  - Naegelin's Bakery (Oldest in Texas; since 1868)
  - "Lindheimer - Father of Texas Botany" Mural
  - Celebrations Formalwear (old Greyhound Bus Station)
  - Elks Lodge
19. LEFT on E. Garden St to Comal Ave.
20. RIGHT on Comal Ave to Lindheimer Haus
  - Lindheimer Haus (Built in 1852)
21. TURN AROUND on Comal Ave, and proceed to E. Coll St.
22. LEFT on E. Coll St to S. Seguin Ave and carefully cross to return to the Faust Hotel.

**11K ROUTE DIRECTIONS**

1. Start at the Faust Hotel and turn RIGHT on S. Seguin Ave.
  - Faust Hotel (Built in 1929, Originally the Traveler's Hotel)
2. STRAIGHT on S. Seguin Ave to Butcher St.
  - First Protestant Church (Built in 1875)
  - NB Civil/Convention Center
  - Statue of Prince Carl of Solms
3. RIGHT on Butcher St to S. Castell Ave.
  - Faust Brewing Company
4. RIGHT on S. Castell Avenue to W. Coll St.
5. LEFT on W. Coll St to S. Academy Ave
  - \*\* Watch for trains; carefully cross the tracks
6. LEFT on S. Academy Ave to Sophienburg Museum
  - American Legion Post 179
  - Sophienburg Museum
7. RIGHT into and through the museum grounds to Magazine Ave
8. RIGHT on Magazine Ave to W. Cross St.
9. LEFT on W. Cross St to S. Santa Clara Ave
  - First Baptist Church
  - St. Paul Lutheran Church
10. RIGHT on S. Santa Clara Ave to W. San Antonio St.
  - McKenna Children's Museum
11. RIGHT on W. San Antonio St to Hill Ave
  - First United Methodist Church
  - Downtown Social/Pour Haus
  - New Braunfels Railroad Museum (Built in 1907)
  - Brauntex Theater (Built in 1942)
  - "The Art of Entertainment" Mural
  - "Connecting New Braunfels to the World" Mural

12. RIGHT on Hill Ave to alleyway before Fire Department Museum
  - Fire Department Museum
13. LEFT on alleyway to S. Castell Ave
  - NB Art League Mural (Dali, Kahlo, Picasso)
  - "Spass und Gemütlichkeit" Mural
14. LEFT on S. Castell Ave to W. Mill St
  - "City of a Prince" Mural (side of antique store)
  - Gebhardt's Chili Powder Mural (side of Phoenix Saloon)
  - \*\* Carefully cross W. San Antonio St
  - Myron's Steakhouse (old Palace Theater)
  - Two Tarts Bakery
  - McAdoo's Restaurant (old Post Office, built in 1915)
  - Hermann Seele "The Soul of New Braunfels" Tiled Mural
15. RIGHT on W. Mill St to N. Seguin Ave.
  - Got Toys
  - New Braunfels Brewing Company
16. LEFT on N. Seguin Ave. curving to the left to Landa St.
  - Sts Peter & Paul Thrift Store and School
17. CONTINUE on Landa Street, under the Railroad Bridge, to Linda Park Drive
  - Wursthfest Main Gate
  - Maibaum (with history of New Braunfels)
18. RIGHT on Landa Park Dr., passing Elizabeth Ave. and Golf Course Road, to a "City of New Braunfels" Park Sign
  - "Lure of the Springs" Mural
  - Fachwerk Memorial
  - Aquatic Center and Pool
  - Miniature Railway Station
19. At the Park Sign, turn RIGHT onto a wide pinkish stone sidewalk
  - Founders Oak Tree
  - Early Settlers Memorial
20. RIGHT, then LEFT, following the shoreline trail and railroad track to a wood and metal bridge; watch for the park train
21. CROSS the bridge and turn RIGHT onto the path.
22. Follow shoreline path to the gazebo at the water's edge

**11K ROUTE DIRECTIONS CONTINUED**

23. Continue past the gazebo around the edge of the park, paralleling the springs flowing on your right. Continue for about 100 yards to the intersection of Gazebo Circle and Landa Park Dr.

24. Carefully CROSS the Landa Park Drive

- Comal Springs; shortest river in Texas at 2.5 miles
- Panther Canyon Nature Trails; 51 acre wilderness

25. LEFT on the path, following Landa Park Drive

26. CROSS the green metal bridge and continue around the edge of Landa Park; Fredericksburg Road is the park boundary on your right.

27. Continue RIGHT on the walk and cross Playground Drive.

28. Walk through the left parking area, with the railroad tracks on your right.

29. Follow the cement sidewalk as it bears to the left. Pass the playground and restrooms (to your left). Continue past the pavilion on the edge of the Comal River running along Landa Park Drive.

30. CROSS the metal bridge to Landa Park Drive, and carefully cross the street.

31. RIGHT on Landa Park Drive, passing Golf Course Road, to Elizabeth Avenue.

32. LEFT on Elizabeth Avenue to Hinman Island Drive

- Wurstfest Hall; "Fenster Inst Wurstfest" Mural
- Circle Arts Theater
- Landa Park Golf Course

33. RIGHT on Hinman Island Drive and carefully cross the railroad tracks, to a concrete sidewalk about 200 yards ahead.

34. RIGHT on the sidewalk, and proceed to the riverbank.

35. LEFT, and follow the walkway to the wooden bridge.

36. CROSS the wooden bridge, and climb the stairs to take the ramp to the Archway

37. ENTER the Archway and head towards the tennis courts.

38. LEFT at the park road (before the courts) and follow to the exit

- Prince Solms Park
- Veterans' Memorial Obelisk (on your right)

39. RIGHT on to Liberty St to E. San Antonio St.

40. LEFT on E. San Antonio St to S. Union Ave.

41. RIGHT on S. Union Ave to E. Lincoln St.

- Schlitterbahn Water Park

42. RIGHT on E. Lincoln St to Comal Ave

43. LEFT on Comal Ave to 491 Comal St

- Ferdinand Lindheimer Home and Museum

44. TURN AROUND and proceed on Comal St to E. San Antonio St.

45. LEFT on E. San Antonio St to the Main Plaza

46. RIGHT at the crosswalk, crossing E. San Antonio, then LEFT, going around the Plaza to S. Seguin Ave.

- WWI Memorial
- Comal County Courthouse
- Main Plaza Bandshell

47. RIGHT on S. Seguin Avenue, returning to the Faust Hotel

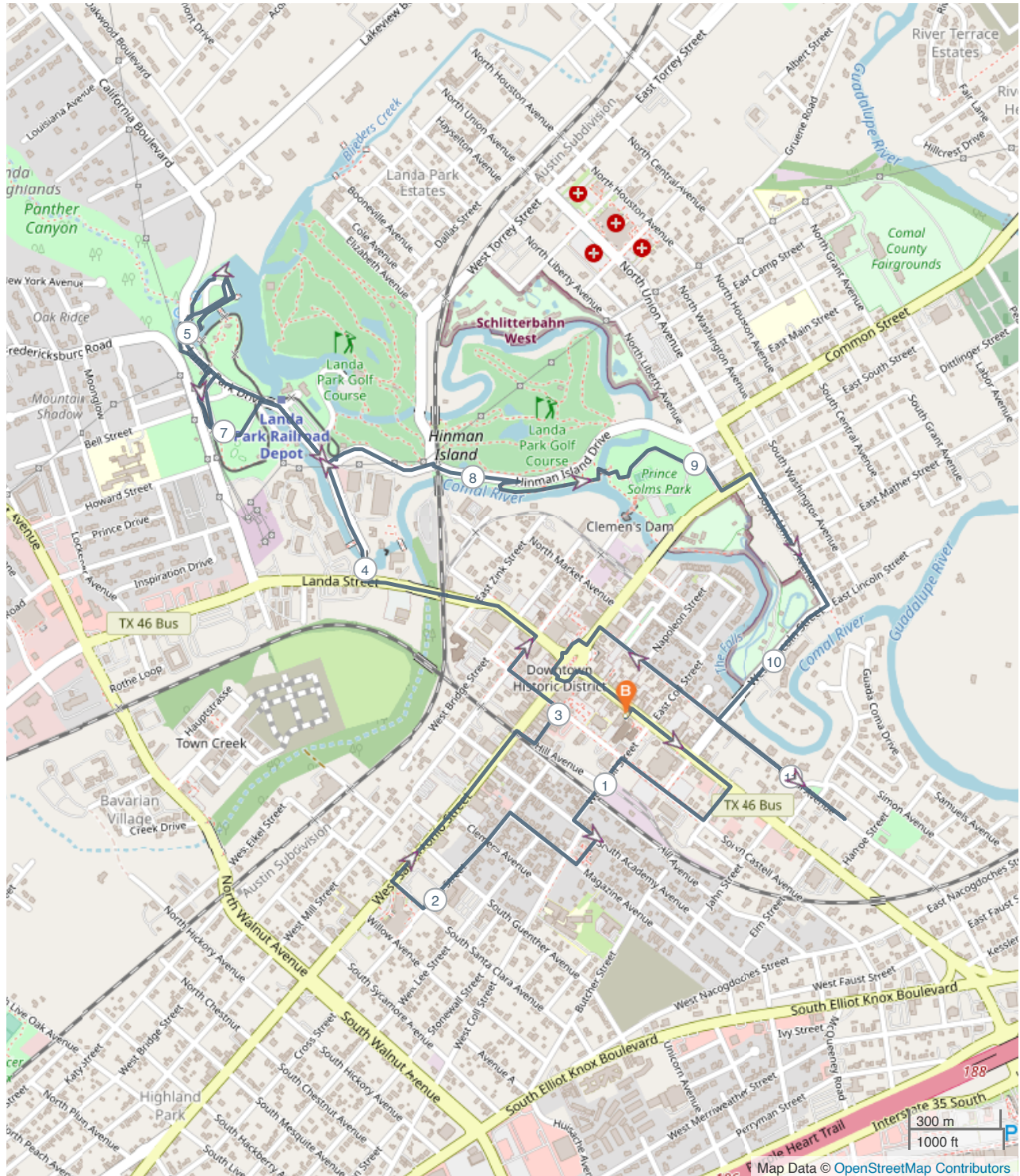
