

**Instructions for
Steilacoom Historic Town Walk, Y-0635
Steilacoom, WA
5 & 10 Km, rated 2B**

Walk Start Location: Chevron Station at 3025 Steilacoom Blvd SW, Steilacoom, WA 98388.
GPS Coordinates: 47.17708, -122.757534.

Driving Directions: From I-5: Exit 129 (So. 72nd St.). Southbound--Get in right lane on off-ramp following So. 74th St. Westbound. Turn right onto So. 74th St. and follow it for 2.1. miles. After crossing Lakewood Dr. W., So. 74th St. becomes Custer Rd. W. Follow Custer Rd. W. for 1.3 miles merging into right lane. Stay in right lane as it turns right onto 88th St. W. After the first traffic signal, 88th merges into Steilacoom Blvd. SW. Follow Steilacoom Blvd. for 2 miles to Sentinel/Far West Dr. SW. Chevron Station is on the right. Park in a stall away from the station entrance if possible. Northbound--Get in left lane at end of off-ramp and turn left onto So. 72nd St. After crossing over I-5, So. 72nd St. becomes So. 74th St. Follow directions above to start point.

Parking: Use parking spots away from the station or on side street.

Restrooms: available in Chevron Station, Sunny Side Beach Park, and at the ferry terminal.

Walk Completion and Credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that a person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a "paying for credit" participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

"Please use either the Online Start box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB or signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB."

1. Leave Chevron Station and head toward street (Steilacoom Blvd)
2. **TURN RIGHT** onto Steilacoom Blvd.
3. **TURN RIGHT** onto Ira Light St. (In a block, street JOGS Right)
4. **TURN LEFT** onto Manitoba St. (Walking through Manitoba Park)
5. **TURN LEFT** onto Leschi Dr.
6. **TURN RIGHT** onto Puget Dr., turning **RIGHT** and downhill.
7. **TURN LEFT** onto Hewitt Dr. (Unmarked, past eagle sculpture, going downhill land turning **LEFT**.)
8. **TURN RIGHT** onto Tatoosh Pl. to end of cul-de-sac.
9. **ENTER** gravel trail between two houses, marked as "Public Trail".
10. At end of trail, follow asphalt road down to bottom of hill.
11. **5K WALKERS ONLY—ANGLE LEFT** onto unmarked street (Lafayette St.) and **continue to Step #18**.
12. **10K WALKERS**, use crosswalk and **CROSS** unmarked Lafayette St.
13. **TURN RIGHT** onto Lafayette St.
14. When sidewalk ends, **ANGLE LEFT** onto wide trail crossing railroad tracks into Sunny Side Beach Park.
15. Once in park, **TURN RIGHT** following paved trail to far end of park.
(RESTROOMS on Right—Seasonally)
16. At end of park, **TURN AROUND** and retrace your steps back through park, crossing back over railroad tracks and back to crosswalk.
17. **CROSS & RIGHT** onto Lafayette St.
18. **5K WALKERS ONLY—TURN LEFT** onto Main St. for 1 block then **TURN LEFT** onto Rainier St. and **continue to Step #34**.
19. **10K WALKERS—TURN RIGHT** onto Main St. crossing Lafayette St.
20. **TURN LEFT** onto Commercial St.
21. **TURN LEFT** onto Wilkes St.
22. **TURN RIGHT** back onto Lafayette St.
23. **TURN RIGHT** onto Union Ave.
24. Continue down towards Ferry Terminal.
(RESTROOMS in Terminal)
25. At railroad crossing, **TURN AROUND** and go back up Union Ave. on **RIGHT** side of street.
26. **TURN RIGHT** onto Martin St.
27. **TURN LEFT** onto 2nd St.
28. **TURN RIGHT** onto Champion St.
29. **TURN LEFT** onto 1st St.
30. **TURN LEFT** onto Gove St.
31. **TURN LEFT** onto 5th St.
32. **TURN RIGHT** onto Martin St to Union St.
33. Carefully cross Union St at Crosswalk to Rainier
34. Continue on **LEFT** side of Rainier St. passing Steilacoom Museum and Historic Home.
35. When road ends, **TURN RIGHT** onto Puyallup St. (unmarked)
36. In one block, **TURN LEFT** onto Steilacoom Blvd., walking on **LEFT** side of street.
37. Follow Steilacoom Blvd. up a long, gradual hill.
38. Street curves right and ends up at the Chevron Station to finish your walk.

BE SURE TO WRITE THE WALK NUMBER (0635) ON YOUR ENVELOPE BEFORE MAILING.

THINGS TO SEE

After Step #5, you will be starting down a series of hills. The large body of water is Puget Sound. Across the water are a series of islands. The one directly across with the large buildings is McNeil Island. The buildings were once a Federal Prison, now the facility is operated by the State. The island to the left is Anderson Island and to the far right is Fox Island. On a clear day, you can see the Olympic Mountains in the background.

At Step #24, the ferry serves Anderson and Ketron Islands. This ferry is operated by Pierce County, where most other ferries are operated by the State of Washington.

Before you turn at Step #29, you can walk onto the footbridge across the street for another viewpoint. There was once a marina below. The Island across a short stretch of water is Ketron Island also served by the Steilacoom Ferry.
