START POINT: Historic Edenton Visitor Center 108 North Broad St, Edenton, NC 27932

Directions: From US-17, take exit 227 (NC-32) towards Edenton. If you are coming from the west, turn right at end of exit ramp. If coming from the east, turn left at end of exit ramp. Continue on NC-32 for .5 mile to N. Broad St. Turn Right on N. Broad St. for 1/2 mile, start point is on left at corner of E. Gale St (Parking is around back of Visitors Center)

WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participants Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when they submit the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note however that the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF expires in 60 days.

1. From the Visitor Center – (Rest Rooms Available), exit down special needs ramp continuing straight toward the right back corner of the parking area and exit to the brick walkway to Church St. passing the James Iredell House, ca. 1773, on the left.

2. **RIGHT** on Church St. across Broad St. and turn **RIGHT** on Broad St. to Carteret St. *St Paul's Episcopal Church and Cemetery (early 18th century) is to the left. Also pass St Anne's Catholic Church and Cemetery also on the left at 207 N. Broad St.*

3. **LEFT** on Carteret 1 block to Granville St. cross and then **LEFT** on Granville 4 blocks to Queen St.

4. **10 Km –RIGHT** on Queen St. cross Moseley St. and continue to Dickenson St. (next street to left after crossing bridge.)

5 Km - LEFT on Queen St. to McMullen Ave.- **go to Step No. 9**

5. CAREFULLY cross Queen St. to turn **LEFT** on Dickinson to Queen Anne Dr.

6. **LEFT** on Queen Anne Dr. following clockwise as Queen Anne curves right to become Miles Brown St. **RIGHT** for 1 block to return to Queen Anne Dr. **RIGHT** on Queen Anne Dr. back to Dickinson St.

7. **LEFT** on Dickinson to and again CAREFULLY cross Queen St.

8. **RIGHT** on Queen St. to its end at McMullen Ave.

Note the historical marker about the “Edenton Tea Party” (American Revolution) on Queen near Broad. Later cross the tracks of the Chesapeake & Albermarle/Norfolk Southern Railroad.

9. **RIGHT** on McMullen and continue as it curves to the **RIGHT** to become King St. to Oakum St. and E. Water.

10. **RIGHT** on Oakum St. 1 block to Eden St. then **LEFT** 1 block to Court St.

11. **LEFT** on Court St. toward the 1767 Courthouse. Approaching the courthouse turn **RIGHT** up a couple of steps to pass between the courthouse and the replica stocks and historic jail then follow to the left around the courthouse to King St.

12. **10 km- LEFT** on King St. passing in front of the courthouse and continue on King St. to Oakum St./ E. Water St.

13. **5 km - CROSS King St** to Colonial Avenue – **go to Step # 17b.**

14. **RIGHT** on Oakum St./E.Water St. as it curves to the **RIGHT** to Water St.

15. **Cross** Water St. to the park. (Do not cross the bridge). Cross the park to follow the seawall to the right and soon return to Water Street passing by Williamson Monument on right.

16. Cross Water Street then turn **LEFT** to walk on the right side of Water Street to Court Street

17. **RIGHT** on Court Street to King, **LEFT** on King passing the courthouse and **LEFT** on Colonial Ave (no sign, circling the Courthouse Green)

*(17 b) After turning **LEFT** on Colonial Ave watch to the right for the colonial teapot mounted on the end of an upturned cannon barrel that marks the home site of the Edenton Tea Party (American Revolution).*

This marker is in the fence line of an open lot. If vehicles are parked along the street the teapot may be obscured behind them.

18. **RIGHT** on Water St to Broad St then **LEFT** on Broad St to the Barker House (1782).

19. **10 km** Turn **RIGHT** into the park to the left of the playground. Water and restrooms are in the buildings adjacent to the playground.

5 km Turn **AROUND** and take Broad Street to Gale St. and visitor center.

20. Continue through the park curving to the **RIGHT** toward a small street (Dock Street, looks more like a parking lot) then out to Water Street. **LEFT** on Water St to curve **RIGHT** onto Granville for 1 block.

21. **LEFT** on Blount. Across South Moseley, Blount St becomes Pembroke Circle and circles to the right to become Eden St. as it crosses Moseley.

22. Continue straight on Eden St to Broad St then **RIGHT** on Broad St to Water St. On Broad St between King and Water Sts pass the 1758 vintage Cupola House and Gardens

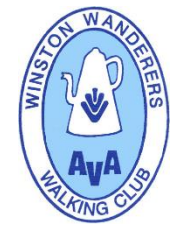
23. At Water Street turn **LEFT** across Broad Street, then **LEFT** on Broad St. to Gale St. **RIGHT** on Gale St. to the Visitor Center.
