**Start Point Address:
Caboose Park
Dayton, WA 99328**

From the West:

Stay on US 12 to Dayton.

US 12 becomes Main in Dayton

Left on 1st Street to Alley

Right into Alley to Park.

From the east:

Stay on US 12 to Dayton

US 12 becomes Main in Dayton

Pass the Weinhard to 1st Street

Right on 1st to Alley

Right into Alley to Park.

Park in the alley between the Hotel and Caboose Park/Historic Depot

Public restroom is located between the park and the hotel. (Directions start here)

Bridges and sidewalks could be wet or icy please take into consideration weather conditions when selecting to do this walk.

1. **Depart Start Point in Caboose Park**
RIGHT in Alley one block to N. 2nd Street (No Sign)
2. **LEFT** on N. 2nd Street to E. Patit St.
(2nd and Commercial is the Dayton Historical Depot built in 1881. Oldest in Washington. Restored in 1981)
3. **RIGHT** on E. Patit Street to N. 3rd St.
(312 E. Patit is the Andrew Nilsson Home built in 1885)
4. **LEFT** on N. 3rd Street to E. Dayton Ave (507 N. 3rd Street is the Dexter Home built in 1905)
5. **LEFT** on E. Dayton Avenue to N. 1st Street (1K)
6. **LEFT** on N. 1st Street to E. Washington Ave (504 N. 1st is the Mill House, 410 N. 1st is the Boldman Home, 303 N. 1st, all built in 1880)
7. **LEFT** on E. Washington Avenue to N. 4th Street (203 and 205 E. Washington Street built in 1905, 221 E. Washington was the Brining Memorial Hospital built in 1935 (now offices), 303 E. Washington is Broughton Home built in 1885)
8. **RIGHT** on N. 4th Street to Main Street and **CROSS** (303 N. 3rd is the Baker Home built in 1884, 3rd and Main is the Columbia County Courthouse built in 1886-7 and restored in 1991-2)
9. **RIGHT** on Main Street to Restroom Bldg and Touchet River Trail (No Sign) (2K at Main and 1st)
DO NOT CROSS THE RIVER
10. **LEFT** on Touchet River Trail (10K Walkers skip to step 13)
11. **5K Walkers Left on road through the park to 2nd Street**
12. **LEFT** on 2nd Street to Clay and **resume instructions at step 19)**
13. **CONTINUE** on trail until it intersects with N. Fork Touchet River Road (5.3K)
14. **LEFT** on N. Fork Touchet River Road (becomes 4th Street) to Clay Street (8.0 K) (218 S. 4th St. NP Depot 1898)
15. **LEFT** on Clay to 3rd Street
16. **LEFT** on 3rd Street to School Bus Street (9.0 K)
17. **RIGHT** on School Bus Street to 2nd Street (Bathrooms in the Park)
18. **RIGHT** on 2nd Street to Clay St (410 S. 2nd built in 1892, 314 S. 2nd built in 1871 enlarged in 1898, 212 S. 2nd built in 1891, 203 S. 2nd Community Bible Church built in 1892-3)
19. **LEFT** on Clay St to 1st Street
20. **RIGHT** on 1st Commercial
21. **RIGHT** on Commercial and enter Caboose Park near the Depot to Start/Finish (10K)
