DRIVING DIRECTIONS**

Start Point Address:
Auntie's Bookstore
402 W. Main Ave.
Spokane, WA 99201

Directions from I-90:

Exit 281 (Division Street)
Eastbound exit right and then left on Division (under I-90)
Westbound exit right and then right on Division.
North to W. Riverside Avenue.
Left on W. Riverside.
Right on Washington Street to W. Main.
Aunties' is on left.

Parking in the area of Auntie's:

On Street Parking: Meters have a maximum of 2 hours

Off Street Parking: There is a large parking lot to the north of Auntie's (fee is dependent on number of hours)

NOTE: There is a physical start box at this location.

NOTE: Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. DO NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. LCVA only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.

ESVA Challenge Programs: 39 Counties (Spokane), All Clubs (LCVA), Strolling Along the River, Front Line Heroes (Medical Office, Restaurant), That's Entertainment (Sports Venue: Arena, Cultural: Book Store), Tell Me A Story

When using the map for the last 3K the Riverside listed is the area of Spokane not the street. The street is Main as listed in the directions.

1. **EXIT** Auntie's Book Store to Washington (Water and Restrooms available in Aunties, ask for RR code)
2. **LEFT** on Washington to Spokane Falls Blvd
3. **LEFT** on Spokane Falls Blvd to Post (City Hall)
4. **RIGHT** on Post passing City Hall and across the newly reopened Post Street Bridge
5. **LEFT** at end of Bridge (1K) and follow the Centennial Trail under the Monroe Street Bridge
6. **STAY** on trail through Kendall Yards past the Nest over the Maple Street Bridge (2K at Elm)
7. **PASS** the Viewpoint at Nettleton and Ohio to the split in the trail (3K)
8. **LEFT** down the trail to and across the Sandifur Bridge
9. **STAY LEFT** on South Gorge Trail between the River and the Parking Lot
10. **CONTINUE** on asphalt trail (4K) heading back toward downtown to Elm Street (5K)
11. **LEFT** on Elm and continue on trail to Cedar (RR) Available at Grover Field
12. **RIGHT** on Cedar 1 block to Main
13. **LEFT** on Main passing the Spokane Club (6K) to new metal walkway
14. **LEFT** on Metal Walkway to go under the Monroe Street Bridge
15. **STAY** on walkway past City Hall to Post and cross (RR in Riverfront Sq)
16. **STAY ON** Spokane Falls Blvd to Washington
17. **RIGHT** on Washington to Aunties (7K) 10K Walkers continue to Main (next intersection)
18. **LEFT** on Main one block to Bernard
19. **LEFT** on Bernard to Spokane Falls Blvd and cross
20. **LEFT** a very short distance to passageway through the Performing Arts Bldg
21. **RIGHT** through passageway to Astronaut Statue
22. **RIGHT** on trail to Wooden Bridge
23. **LEFT** crossing the bridge to trail on north side of river
24. **STAY RIGHT** on paths to bridge over river near dam
25. **CROSS** bridge to trail
26. **LEFT** on trail following the river passing the pavilion (8K)
27. **RIGHT** on trail toward Butterfly Sculpture
28. **LEFT** to exit park on Mallon
29. **STRAIGHT** on Mallon passing the Flour Mill to the walkway just past the building
30. **LEFT** through parking lot and on to the trail as it turns right to corner
31. **LEFT** on trail down across both foot bridges to first trail

32. **LEFT** on trail and up the stairs to
Howard Street Bridge
33. **RIGHT** on Howard Street to the
Water Feature/Splash Pad (9K)
34. **LEFT** in plaza to pass the Looft
Carousel and the Garbage Goat
35. **STAY** on trail passing the Red Wagon
36. **ANGLE RIGHT** out of the park to
Washington and Spokane Falls Blvd
37. **CROSS** Spokane Falls Blvd and
continue on Washington to S/F at
Aunties Book Store

There is a PSB at this location. Use either the OSB or PSB but do not comingle. The Lilac City Volkssport Association and Auntie's Book Store hope you enjoyed your experience and will come again.
