



# Tualatin – Brown’s Ferry

Stamp # Y0798

10 km (6 and 4km Loops)

This walk is comprised of two (2) loops, 6 and 4km. Both are rated 2B. We have included a modification to the longer loop in case of muddy weather. This only comes into play on Loop 1 for the long straightaway along the river. Loop 1 also has a 1k option to **Labyrinth Challenge**. See “Labyrinth Challenge Option”, page 5, of this instruction set, for details.

**START LOCATION:** Atfalati Park, corner of SW 65<sup>th</sup> Ave and Sagert St., Tualatin, OR 97062.

**GPS Coordinates:** 45.37535, -122.74433

**DRIVING TO WALK START:** I-5 North or South, take Exit 289. North turns right and South turns left onto SW Nyberg Street. Continue as it bends right and becomes SW 65<sup>th</sup> Ave. Just after the crest of the hill, turn right onto SW Sagert St., then immediate left into Atfalati Park parking area.

**RESTROOMS:** We recommend stopping elsewhere before starting the walk. During most of the year, restrooms are open in the parks on each loop of the walk.

**Walk Completion and Credit:** Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant’s Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user’s Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user’s Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

"Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB."

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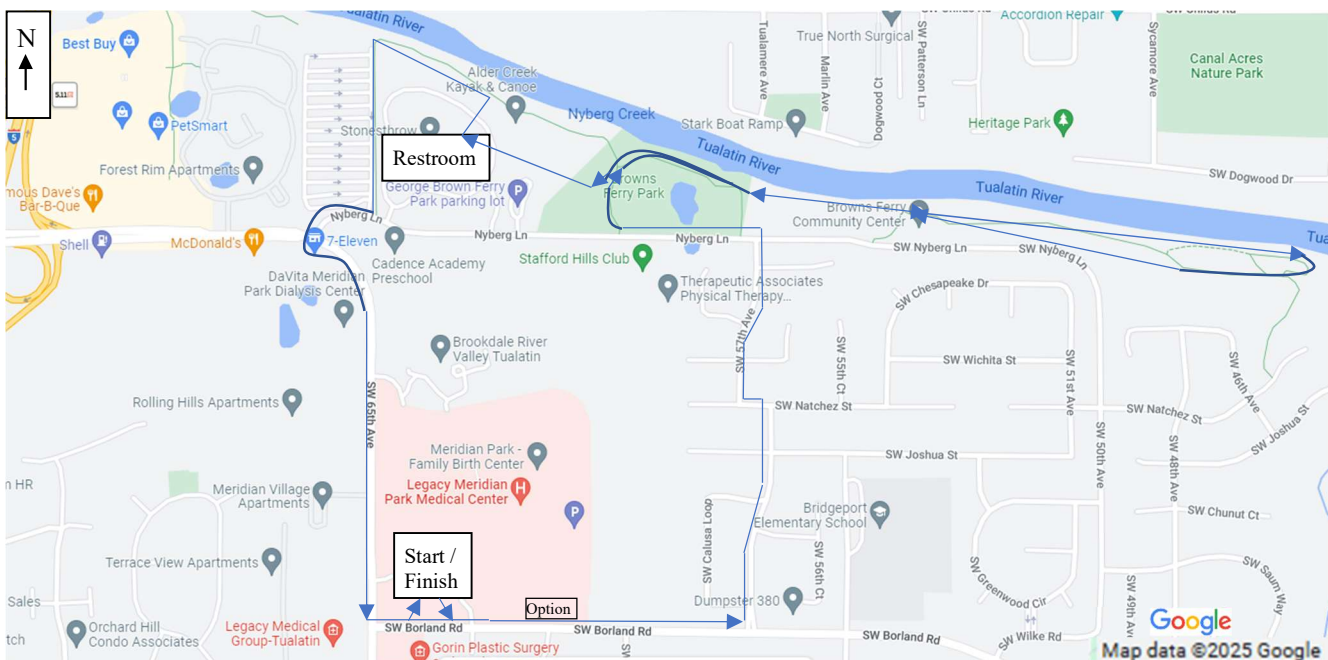

**Tualatin - Brown's Ferry Walk – Loop 1, Brown's Ferry Park – 6.1K (long)**  
**YRE #0798 Rated 2B**

Restrooms at 4K.

1. At the Borland Road/65<sup>th</sup> Ave. corner of the hospital parking lot, FACE Borland Road with 65<sup>th</sup> Ave. on your right and turn LEFT onto Borland Road.
2. OPTION: Sixty meters past the Emergency entrance: See Labyrinth Challenge option sheet.
3. LEFT on 57<sup>th</sup> Ave
4. CROSS and LEFT on Natchez St.
5. RIGHT on 57<sup>th</sup> again and continue downhill
6. CROSS Nyberg Ln., then turn LEFT and pass the park pond on right
7. RIGHT at first cement path after the pond
8. RIGHT on gravel path, pass 2 pair of park benches, keep pond on right and cross bridge
9. STRAIGHT at dirt path into woods keeping river on left
10. STAY to left at “Y” and cross (left) wooden bridge
11. LEFT at “Y” keeping bench on left
12. LEFT onto sidewalk keeping covered deck on left. LEFT in 40 yards, QUICK RIGHT onto dirt path
13. LEFT at cement path and cross bridge
14. CROSS road to river and SLIGHT LEFT on dirt path at “Protected Natural Area” sign
15. Continue STRAIGHT on gravel path at “Y”
16. First RIGHT at next gravel path
17. RIGHT and stay on cement path

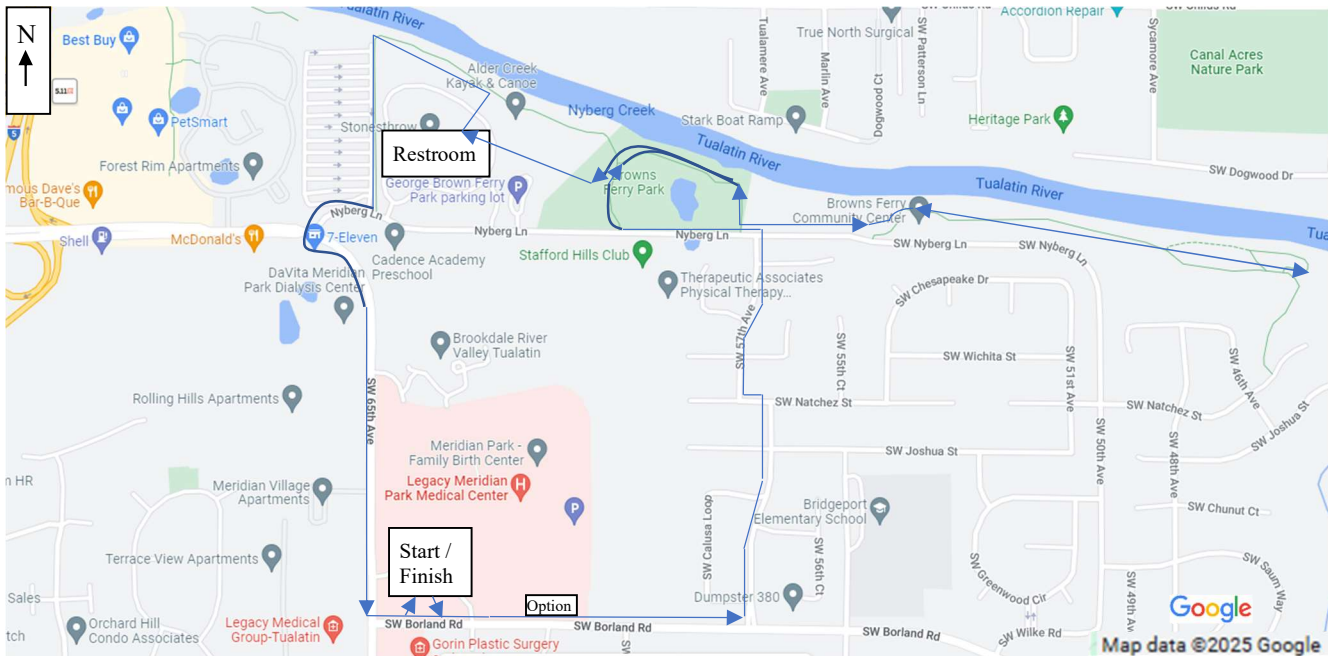
18. RIGHT just past covered deck onto dirt path
19. STRAIGHT at “T” onto gravel path keeping river and bench on right
20. Cross bridge, and immediate RIGHT onto dirt path (turn before the other bridge ahead on left)
21. CONTINUE STRAIGHT onto gravel path.
22. Cross bridge and pass the pond on left
23. LEFT on cement path, then first RIGHT onto gravel path
24. RIGHT at T and cross bridge. Continue to restrooms at the Brown's Ferry parking area
25. CONTINUE on cement path past restrooms as it bends to the right to the boathouse and old barn
26. LEFT after the boathouse onto the boardwalk
27. LEFT at first ‘T’, following path under power lines to Nyberg Lane (unmarked).
28. RIGHT at end of trail at Nyberg Lane (unmarked)
29. CROSS 65<sup>th</sup> Ave./ Nyberg Street at light
30. LEFT on 65<sup>th</sup> crossing entrance to 7-Eleven at light
31. At the top of the hill at traffic light;
  - a. those continuing with the 4.1k (short) route, continue STRAIGHT on 65th at light, go to instruction #3 on 4.1k (short) route and ignore the remaining instructions on this page – **OR** -
  - b. Those finishing, LEFT and CROSS 65th onto Borland at light.
32. LEFT into hospital parking lot to start/finish.

**Addendum: Use instead of standard Loop 1 walk instructions if trail is muddy**

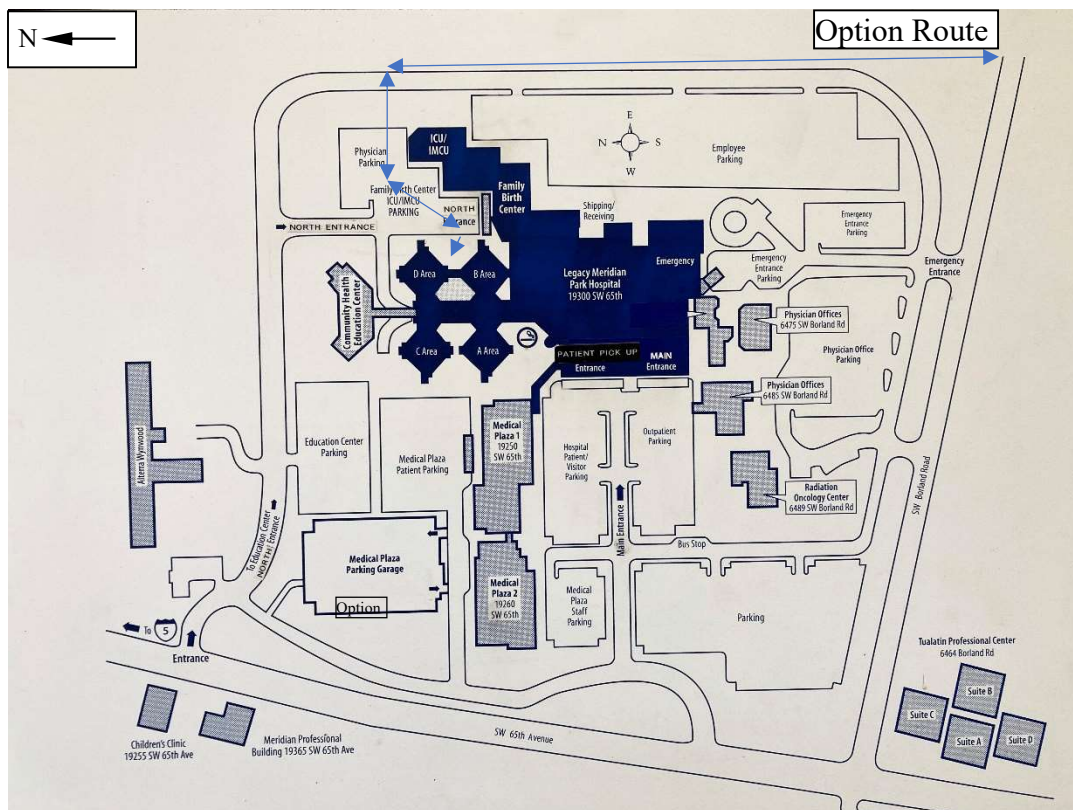

RIGHT on 57<sup>th</sup> again and continue downhill</li> <li>6. CROSS Nyberg Ln., then turn LEFT and pass the park pond on right</li> <li>7. RIGHT at first cement path after the pond</li> <li>8. RIGHT on gravel path, pass 2 pair of park benches, keep pond on right and cross bridge</li> <li>9. RIGHT continuing on gravel (not dirt) path to Nyberg</li> <li>10. LEFT on Nyberg to Brown's Ferry Community Center sign, and LEFT on cement path</li> <li>11. Follow cement path until it ends in asphalt</li> <li>12. TURN AROUND at steep uphill near cyclone fence and retrace steps back to the Community Center</li> <li>13. LEFT just past covered deck, continuing on cement path to Nyberg and turn RIGHT</li> <li>14. RIGHT onto second gravel path (wooden post)</li> </ol> | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>15. LEFT at "T", continuing on gravel (not dirt) path keeping river on right</li> <li>16. Cross bridge and pass the pond on left</li> <li>17. LEFT on cement path, then first RIGHT onto gravel path</li> <li>18. RIGHT at T and cross bridge. Continue to restrooms at the Brown's Ferry parking area</li> <li>19. CONTINUE on cement path past restrooms as it bends to the right to the boathouse and old barn</li> <li>20. LEFT after the boathouse onto the boardwalk</li> <li>21. LEFT at first 'T', following path under power lines to Nyberg Lane (unmarked).</li> <li>22. 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## Tualatin - Brown's Ferry Walk – Loop 1 Labyrinth 1k Option at Meridian Park Hospital

1. From Loop 1, instruction #2:
2. Sixty meters past the Borland Road Emergency Entrance, turn LEFT onto chip path near corner of black cyclone fence.
3. Keep LEFT on main path (both tree stumps to your right) and onto the paved road.
4. STRAIGHT on road, past Shipping/Receiving to last building on your left.
5. LEFT after building (at "K" parking lot). LEFT to hospital "NORTH ENTRANCE". Facing the North Entrance, locate the path through shrubbery to your right, a few meters from the fire plug.
6. RIGHT on this path to the Labyrinth.
7. Return to the walk route the way you arrived: That is;
8. Return on the path from the labyrinth to the North Entrance, then back across the "K" parking lot keeping the building on your right.
9. At the end of the building, RIGHT onto the road past Shipping/Receiving and toward the Emergency entrance.
10. As the road bends sharply right, go STRAIGHT INSTEAD onto the chip path and return to Borland Road.
11. LEFT onto Borland to continue the walk route to instruction #3.
