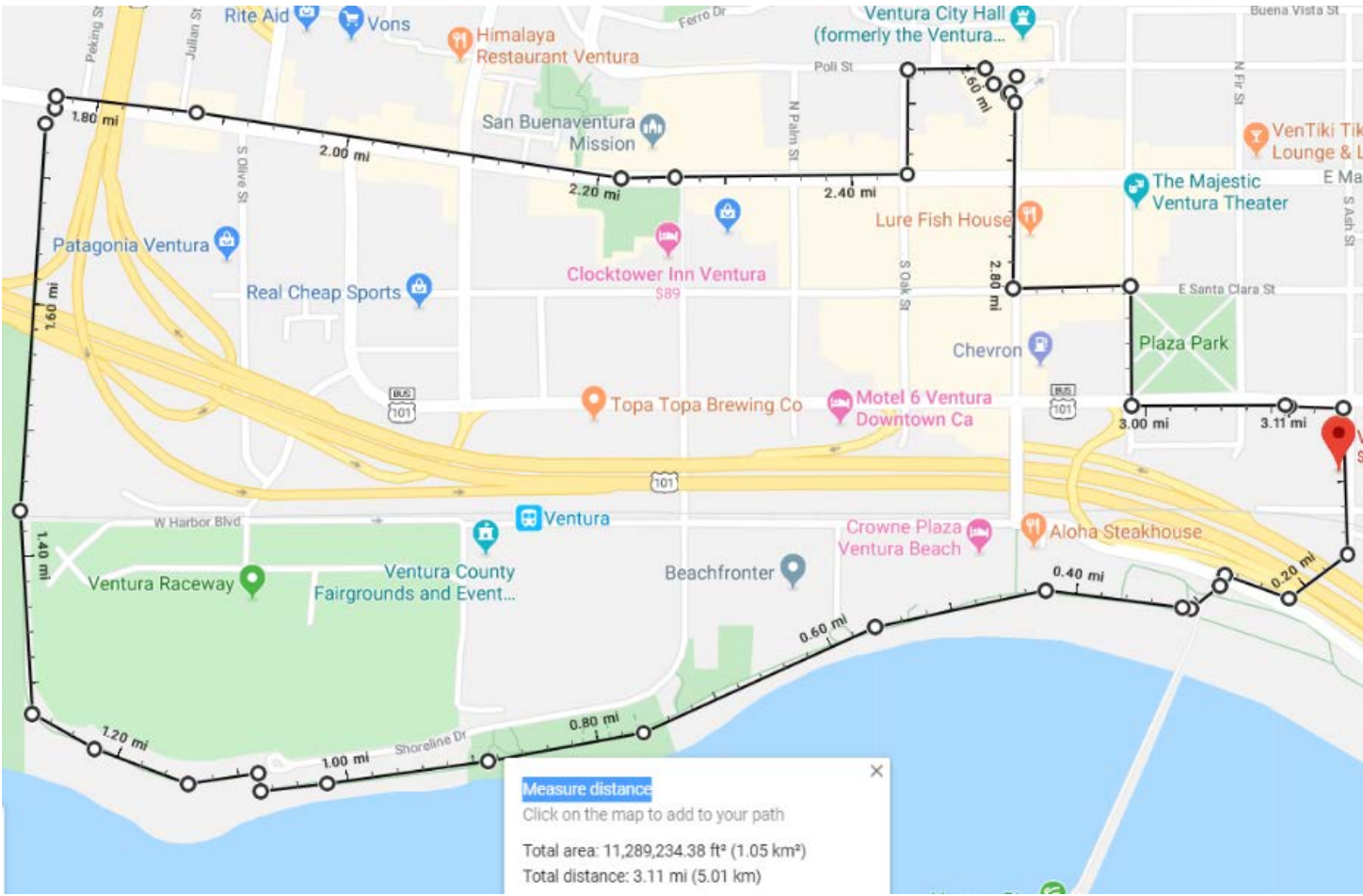

#	Direction	Km
1	Exit the Vagabond Inn to Thompson Blvd. (10 m)	0.01
2	RIGHT on Thompson Blvd for one block to Ash Street (62 m)	0.06
3	RIGHT on Ash St for three blocks, over bridge (veering right) to the crosswalk at Harbor Blvd. Cross Harbor to the Ventura Pier. (376 m)	0.44
4	RIGHT down the stairs just before the restaurant to the bike path and the Promenade. (70 m)	0.51
Note: Wheelchairs and Strollers can avoid the stairs by turning right on the sidewalk along Harbor, then left in front of the parking garage, where it joins the Promenade.		
5	RIGHT on the bike path, keeping the ocean on your right, to the Ventura River on the far side of the Ventura Fairgrounds. (2 km)	2.05
6	RIGHT along the bike path, heading north under the freeway to Main Street (790 m)	2.84
7	CROSS Main Street. RIGHT on Main Street to Oak Street. In 200 meters on your left is the Ortega Adobe. 800 meters on your left is the San Buenaventura Mission (1.09 km)	3.93
The Ortega Adobe was built in 1857 by Emigdio Ortega, whose 11 th (of 13) child, Emilio Ortega, founded the Ortega Chili Company at this site. The Ortega Adobe is the only remaining example of a "middle-class" home of the mid-1800s.		

#	Direction	Km
Mission San Buenaventura was founded in 1782, and was the last mission to be established by Father Junipero Serra.		
8	LEFT on Oak for one block to Poli Street. (140 m)	4.07
9	RIGHT on Poli St for one block to California Street. Ventura City Hall on your left. (100 m)	4.17
10	RIGHT on California to the crosswalk leading to the pedestrian island housing the statue of Father Junipero Serra, the founder of Mission San Buenaventura. Walk to the statue. (70 m)	4.24
11	Backtrack to California, and continue south for 2 blocks to Santa Clara Street. (270 m)	4.51
12	LEFT on Santa Clara for 1 block to Chestnut. Cross Chestnut. Be sure to check out the mural in the Post Office if you have time. (150 m)	4.66
13	RIGHT on Chestnut for 1 block to Thompson Ave. Cross Thompson. (150 m)	4.81
14	LEFT on Thompson for one big block to the Start/Finish at the Vagabond Inn (200 m).	5.01

For safety's sake, please walk on the **left** side of bike trails or roadways without sidewalks.

#	Direction	Km
1	Exit the Vagabond Inn to Thompson Blvd. (10 m)	0.01
2	RIGHT on Thompson Blvd two blocks to Kalorama Street (217 m)	0.23
3	RIGHT on Kalorama St one block to Front Street. Cross Front St. (140 m)	0.37
4	LEFT on Front Street three blocks to Thompson Blvd (360 m)	0.73
5	RIGHT on Thompson Blvd one block to Sanjon Road (170 m)	0.90
6	RIGHT on Sanjon Rd under Highway 101 to Harbor Blvd. Cross Harbor (500 m)	1.40
7	RIGHT on bike path. CONTINUE on Ventura Promenade past the Crowne Plaza and the Beachfronter Condos to the bike path at the end of Promenade Park. (1.32 km) Restrooms.	2.72
8	RIGHT on the short path to the street (Shoreline, which turns into Figueroa). (50 m)	2.77
9	CONTINUE on Figueroa under the freeway through the mall to the Ventura Mission. (620 m)	3.39
10	RIGHT on Main Street three blocks to California Street. (420 m)	3.81
11	RIGHT on California St one block to Santa Clara (140 m).	3.95
12	LEFT on Santa Clara five blocks to Laurel Street. Beautiful mural in the Post Office on your left. (700 m)	4.65
13	LEFT on Laurel two small blocks to Main Street. (130 m)	4.78
14	LEFT on Main St five blocks to California Street. (690 m)	5.47

#	Direction	Km
NOTE FOR WHEELCHAIRS AND STROLLERS: You may avoid the upcoming stairs by continuing straight on Main Street past the Albinger Archeological Museum and rejoining the map at Direction #18		
15	RIGHT on California St. to Father Serra Statue at Poli Street. (130 m)	5.60
16	LEFT on Poli St. for three blocks to the right bend of Poli St. behind the Ventura Mission. (550 m)	6.15
17	LEFT down the stairs on Valdez Alley to Main Street. Note the archeological dig on your left (130 m) Cross Main St	6.28
18	RIGHT on Main past the shopping center and the Ortega Adobe to the bike path just past the overpass, before the Ventura River Levee. (680 m)	6.96
19	LEFT on the bike path to the Ventura Promenade (10 m)	7.71
20	VEER LEFT along the Promenade past the Fairgrounds to the Crowne Plaza Hotel. (1.36 km)	9.07
21	LEFT on the California Street Mall, staying on the left of California St as you cross Harbor Blvd to Thompson Blvd (240 m)	9.31
22	RIGHT on Thompson Blvd two blocks to the Vagabond Inn Start/Finish (330 m)	9.64
