**Walk Start Location:** Juneau Cruise Ship Terminal/Visitors Center, 470 S. Franklin Street.

**GPS Coords:** 58.2965 N, 134.4011 W

**Directions:** From Cruise Ship Terminal/Visitors Center exit to S. Franklin Street. Turn left and proceed on the route. Note, cruise ship docking locations will vary but Start will be at 470 S. Franklin.

**Restrooms** available along the route in public facilities and parks.

The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB. ## **Juneau, AK State Capitol Walk**

1. **START:** Cruise ship terminal/visitor center
2. **LEFT/NORTH** on Franklin St.
3. **LEFT** at Front St.
4. **RIGHT** at Seward St.
5. **LEFT** at Third St.
6. **RIGHT** at Main St.
7. **RIGHT** at Fourth St (Capitol Bldg on left, Court House on right.)
8. **LEFT** at Franklin St.
9. **RIGHT** at Fifth St.
10. **LEFT** on Gold St. (*Cathedral of the Blessed Virgin Mary is the smallest Cathedral in the world.*)
10. **LEFT** on Sixth St to the second set of Stairs (Seward St. on left)
11. **RIGHT** upstairs to 7th
12. **RIGHT** at the top of the stairs (7th St.)
13. **LEFT** at Gold St, up the hill.
14. **RIGHT** at Eight St (very short.)
15. **LEFT** at Basin Road (no sidewalks) to the end (Perseverance Trail/gate, 1 M)
16. **TURN AROUND**, returning to Eighth St
17. **RIGHT** at Eighth St.
18. **LEFT** at Gold St.
19. **RIGHT** at Seventh St.
20. **LEFT** at Main St., downhill to Fourth St
21. **RIGHT** at Fourth St (becomes Calhoun St., AK State Bldg. on left, restrooms when open, Museum on right.)
22. **PASS** the Governor's Mansion on Calhoun St to Cope Park (on right.)
23. **RIGHT** into the Park, Gold Creek on your left (gold discovered in 1880)
24. **FOLLOW PATH** along Gold Creek (path thru parking lot) to tennis courts, restrooms. **TURN AROUND, RETURN** to Calhoun St.
25. **RIGHT** on Calhoun St, **CROSS** Gold Creek.
26. **ANGLE RIGHT** at the fork in road (Irwin St) to Evergreen Cemetery
27. **ENTER** the Cemetery, stay on **LEFT** path to Glacier Ave.
28. **LEFT** at Glacier Ave.
29. **LEFT** on 12<sup>th</sup>
30. **RIGHT** on "D" St.
31. **RIGHT** on 10<sup>th</sup> ST., crossing Glacier carefully and proceed to Egan.
32. **CROSS both 10<sup>th</sup> & Egan & LEFT** on Egan Dr a short distance.
33. **RIGHT** at W. 9<sup>th</sup> and into Mayor Bill Overstreet Park (Whale Park). Circle the Park and enjoy!
34. **LEFT** to walk on the Juneau Seawalk along the estuary and exit at Egan Dr.
35. **RIGHT** on Egan Dr, which becomes Marine Way, passing Marine Park/Hard Rock Miner statue. Marine Way merges onto Franklin St.
36. **Return** to Visitors Center/Cruise Ship

Start Point: Cruise Terminal/Visitors Center

1. **LEFT/NORTH** on S. Franklin St.
2. **LEFT** at Front St.
3. **RIGHT** at Seward St.
4. **LEFT** at Third St.
5. **RIGHT** at Main St.
6. **RIGHT** at Fourth St (Capitol Bldg. on left, Court House on right.)
7. **LEFT** at Franklin St.
8. **RIGHT** at Fifth St.
9. **LEFT** on Gold St. (the Cathedral of the Blessed Virgin Mary is the smallest Cathedral in the world.)
10. **LEFT** on Sixth St to Main.
11. **LEFT** at Main St, downhill to Fourth St.
12. **RIGHT** at Fourth St (becomes Calhoun St. AK State Bldg on left, restrooms when bldg. is open, Museum on right.)
13. **PASS** the Governor's Mansion on Calhoun St and continue as it bends left. Pass Gold Creek and sign for Cope Park.
14. **Option: Restrooms** available at Cope Park near Tennis Courts.
15. **ANGLE RIGHT** at the fork in road (Irwin St) to Evergreen Cemetery (in front of you.)
16. **ENTER** the Cemetery staying on **LEFT** path to Glacier Ave.
17. **LEFT** at Glacier Ave.
18. **LEFT** at 12<sup>th</sup> Ave.
19. **RIGHT** on "D" St.
20. **RIGHT** on 10<sup>th</sup> Ave, crossing Glacier carefully, continue to Egan
21. **CROSS** both 10<sup>th</sup> & Egan Dr
22. **LEFT** on Egan for a short distance to W 9th St.
23. **RIGHT** on W 9<sup>th</sup> St into Mayor Bill Overstreet Park (Whale Park).
24. **LEFT** from park to walk on the Juneau Seawalk along estuary and exit at Egan Dr.
25. **RIGHT** on Egan Dr, which becomes Marine Way, passing Marine Park with the Hard Rock Miner statue.
26. **CONTINUE** on Marine way as it merges with S. Franklin St.
27. **Return** to start point at Cruise Terminal/Visitor Center.
