This walk offers a 5K and a 10K option and is rated 1A. Trail goes through historic Corona, featuring some lovely parks and interesting neighborhoods. Corona can be very hot, carry water and walk early

Registration takes place online using that AVA Online Start Box, on my.ava.org. Follow the instructions provided to create a user account and sign the AVA waiver (one time). Instructions for payment are also included. Download the directions and print as needed. The POC does not provide event directions or accept alternate payment methods.

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Once you have physically completed the walk, please login to your Online Start Box account, click on the "My Start Box" tab, then the "Finish Table" tab, then click on "Go to Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped "virtual" insert cards that you may choose to print out.

Corona Regional Medical Center-800 S main, 92882. From Hwy 91 Eastbound, turn right on Main. Go approx 6 blocks to 8th. Right on 8th to the hospital. From 91 Westbound, exit on Main St. Right on Main to 8th. Restrooms in hospital and parks along route

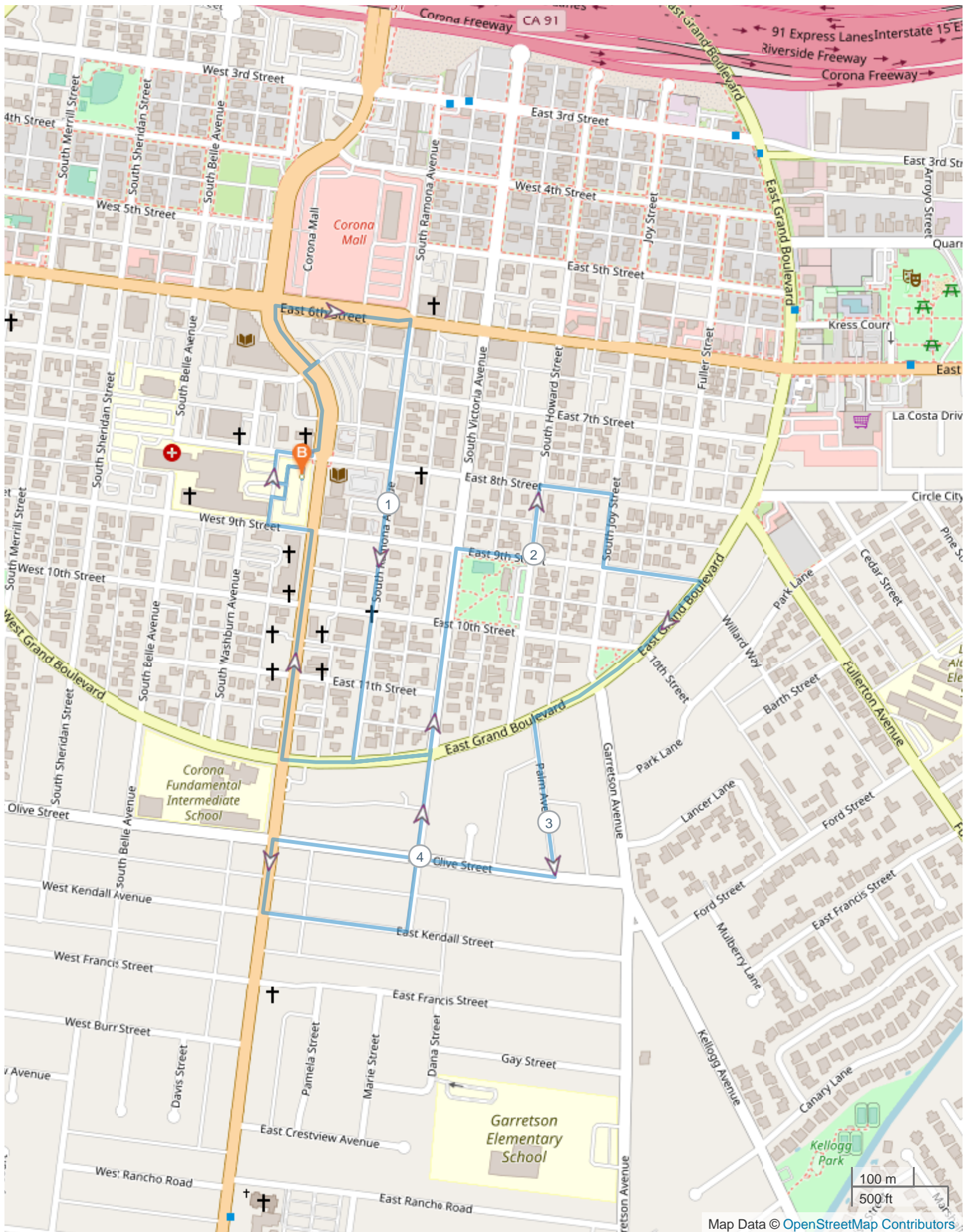

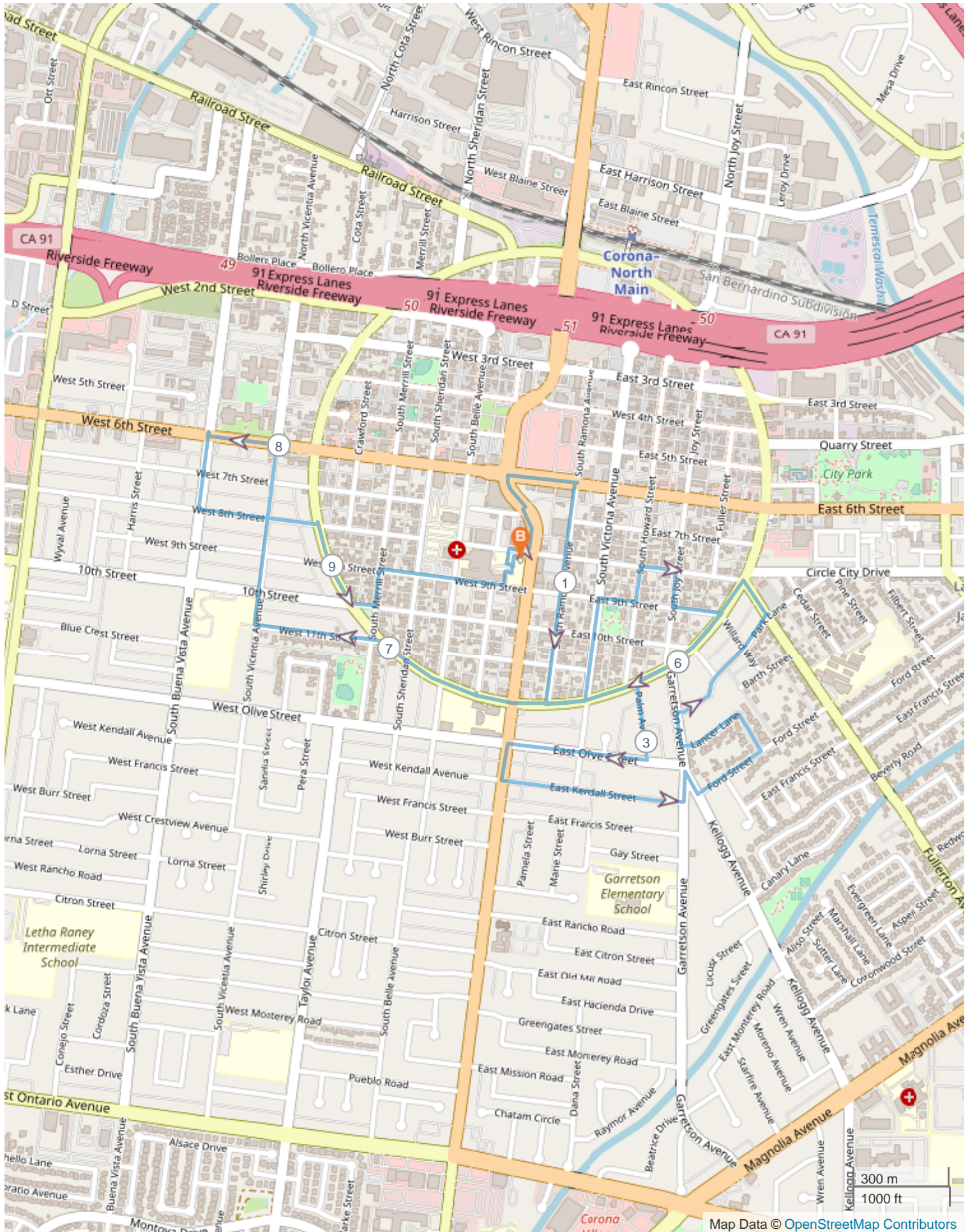

1	0.000		Start at the Corona Regional Medical Center
2	0.192	←	At 8th and Main is the First Babtist Church (1938)
3	0.211	←	Turn left onto South Main Street to the first signal (Stan Reynolds Pkwy). Turn right crossing Main and then left continuing north on Main. Large marble building across Main is the Corona Library
4	0.499	→	Turn right onto East 6th Street to Ramona. Landmark Bldg on NE corner (1929)
5	0.713	→	Turn right onto South Ramona Avenue for 6 blocks to Grand Blvd. Note the First Congregational Church (1911) and the Methodist Church (1887) Also note the residences at 1022 (built 1893), 1111(built 1902), 1116(built in 1900), and 1124 (built in 18999)
6	1.413	←	Turn left onto East Grand Boulevard 1 block to Victoria
7	1.535	←	Turn left onto South Victoria Avenue to 9th St
8	1.860	→	Turn right onto East 9th Street to Howard Street
9	1.978	←	Turn left onto South Howard Street to 8th St
10	2.106	→	Turn right onto East 8th Street to Joy St. The Joy Street Market on NW corner is attached to a home built in 1900. The market was completed in 1937
11	2.221	→	Turn right onto South Joy Street to 9th
12	2.336	←	Turn left onto East 9th Street to Grand Blvd
13	2.493	↘	Turn sharp right onto East Grand Boulevard. Cross Joy and then Grand using the crosswalk. Continue on Grand
14	2.838	←	Turn left onto Palm Avenue to Olive
15	3.089	↘	Turn sharp right onto East Olive Street to Main Street
16	3.535	←	Turn left onto South Main Street to Kendall Street
17	3.650	←	Turn left onto East Kendall Street
18	3.879	←	Turn left onto South Victoria Avenue
19	4.173	→	Turn right onto East Grand Boulevard
20	4.405	→	Turn right onto South Main Street

2	0.211	←	Turn left onto South Main Street to the first signal (Stan Reynolds Pkwy). Turn right at the signal, crossing Main Street, then left again continuing north on Main. The large marble building across Main is the Coronal Library)
3	0.470	→	Turn right onto East 6th Street to Ramona. Landmark building on NE corner (1929)
4	0.693	←	Turn left onto South Ramona Avenue 6 blocks to Grand Blvd. Note the First Congregational Church (1911) and the Methodist Church (1887). Also note the residences at 1022(built 1893), 111 (built 1902), 1116 (built in 1900) and 1124 (built 1899)
5	1.393	←	Turn left onto East Grand Boulevard to Victoria
6	1.515	←	Turn left onto South Victoria Avenue to 9th Street
7	1.841	→	Turn right onto East 9th Street to Howard
8	1.958	←	Turn left onto South Howard Street to 8th
9	2.073	→	Turn right onto East 8th Street to Joy. The Joy Street Market on NW corner is attached to a home built around 1900. The market was completed in 1937
10	2.189	→	Turn right onto South Joy Street to 9th
11	2.318	→	Turn right onto East 9th Street
12	2.474	↘	Turn sharp right onto East Grand Boulevard. Cross Joy, then Grand using crosswalk. Continue on Grand to Palm
13	2.820	←	Turn left onto Palm Avenue to Olive
14	3.070	↘	Turn sharp right onto East Olive Street to Main
15	3.516	←	Turn left onto South Main Street to Kendall
16	3.632	←	Turn left onto East Kendall Street to Garretson
17	4.206	→	Turn right onto Garretson Avenue
18	4.312	↘	Turn sharp right onto Kellogg Avenue
19	4.395	←	Turn left onto Ford Street to Lancer
20	4.636	←	Turn left onto Lancer Lane curving back to Garretson
21	4.983	→	Turn right onto Garretson Avenue to Park
22	5.089	→	Turn right onto Park Lane to Fullerton
23	5.536	←	Turn left on to Fullerton Avenue to Grand (signal on corner)
24	5.671	↙	Turn sharp left onto East Grand Boulevard . There are too many great old homes on grand to note-just enjoy.
25	6.649		Cross Main and continue to Washburn. About 1/2 block from Washburn there is a plaque surrounded by red brick near the sidewalk, This was the start point of the famous road race around the circle (Grand Blvd) Races were held here in 1913, 1914, & 1916
26	7.026	↖	Keep left onto West 11th Street
27	7.427	→	Turn right onto South Vicentia Avenue to 6th. Jefferson School is the oldest standing school building in Corona that is still in use. It was built in 1927

28	8.007	←	Turn left onto West 6th Street to Buena Vista. The Civic Center building (across the street) was once Corona High School from 1923 to 1961., The City of Corona now has offices there
29	8.226	←	Turn left onto South Buena Vista Avenue to 8th
30	8.480	←	Turn left onto West 8th Street
31	8.858	→	Turn right onto West Grand Boulevard to 10th
32	9.137	←	Turn left onto 10th Street
33	9.220	←	Turn left onto South Merrill Street
34	9.342	→	Turn right onto West 9th Street several blocks , the hospital will be on your left
35	9.890		FINISH
