

**Instructions for
Tryon Creek State Park, Y0921
Portland, OR
Multnomah County Walk
5/10 Km, rated 1B**

Walk Start Location: 11321 SW Terwilliger Blvd

GPS Coordinates: N 45.4415, W122.6754

Driving Directions: Directions: I-5 Southbound to Exit 297 (Terwilliger). Right onto Barbur Blvd., then Right again onto Terwilliger Blvd. for 2.5 miles, following signs to Tryon Creek State Park. I-5 Northbound to Exit 297 (Terwilliger). Turn Right onto Terwilliger Blvd. for 2.4 miles, following signs to Tryon Creek State Park. Park entrance will be on the right 0.75 mile beyond the round-about. Hours Open 9:00am-5:00pm, closed major holidays.

Park: Park in the parking lot at Tryon Creek State Park

Restrooms: In the Nature Center Building

Walk Completion and Credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

"Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB . "

"These maps and directions may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited. "

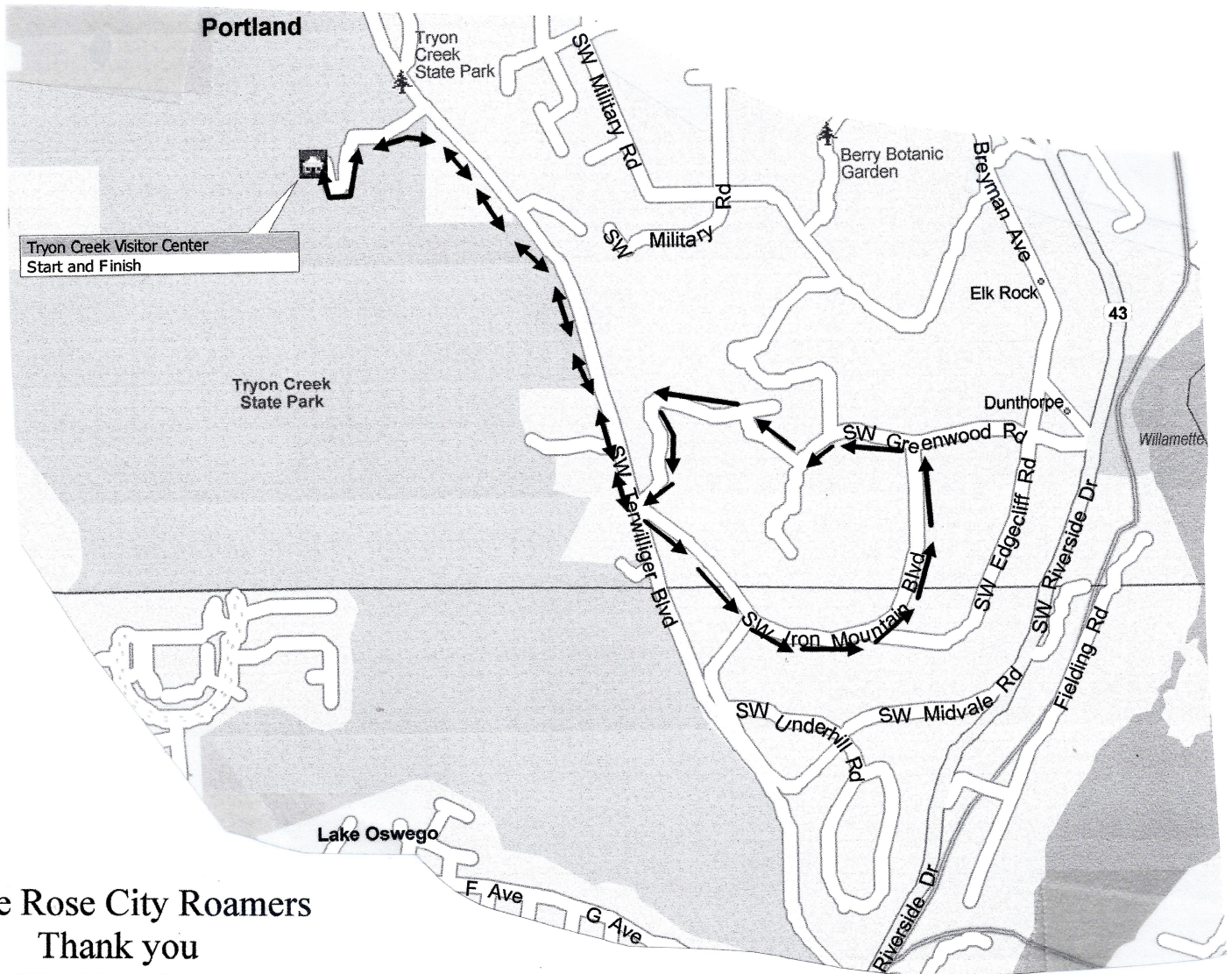

TRYON CREEK SOUTH ROUTE

5 KM – Rated 2A – YRE 921

Challenges OTSVA 2020 (Parks,) 2021 (Trails)

1. **EXIT** Tryon Creek Visitor Center and bear **RIGHT** on Entrance Rd. following it counter-clockwise through the parking lot to almost the parking lot end where there is a paved bike trail on your right.
2. **RIGHT** on paved Trail to a “Y” intersection.
3. **RIGHT** at the intersection as it turns to your right. Continue on the paved bike trail as it parallels Terwilliger Blvd. It will become the shoulder of Terwilliger Blvd. Continue until reaching Iron Mountain Blvd. on the opposite side of Terwilliger Blvd.
4. **LEFT** crossing Terwilliger Blvd. onto Iron Mountain Blvd. (continue past Glen Road and Edgecliff Road – (both on the right) to Greenwood Road.
5. **LEFT** on Greenwood Road going uphill to Mary Falling Dr.
6. **RIGHT** on Mary Falling Dr. continuing to “T”
7. **LEFT** at the “T” staying on Mary Falling then going downhill until Terwilliger Blvd.
8. **CROSS and RIGHT** on Terwilliger and follow paved bike path back the way you came to the Visitor Center.

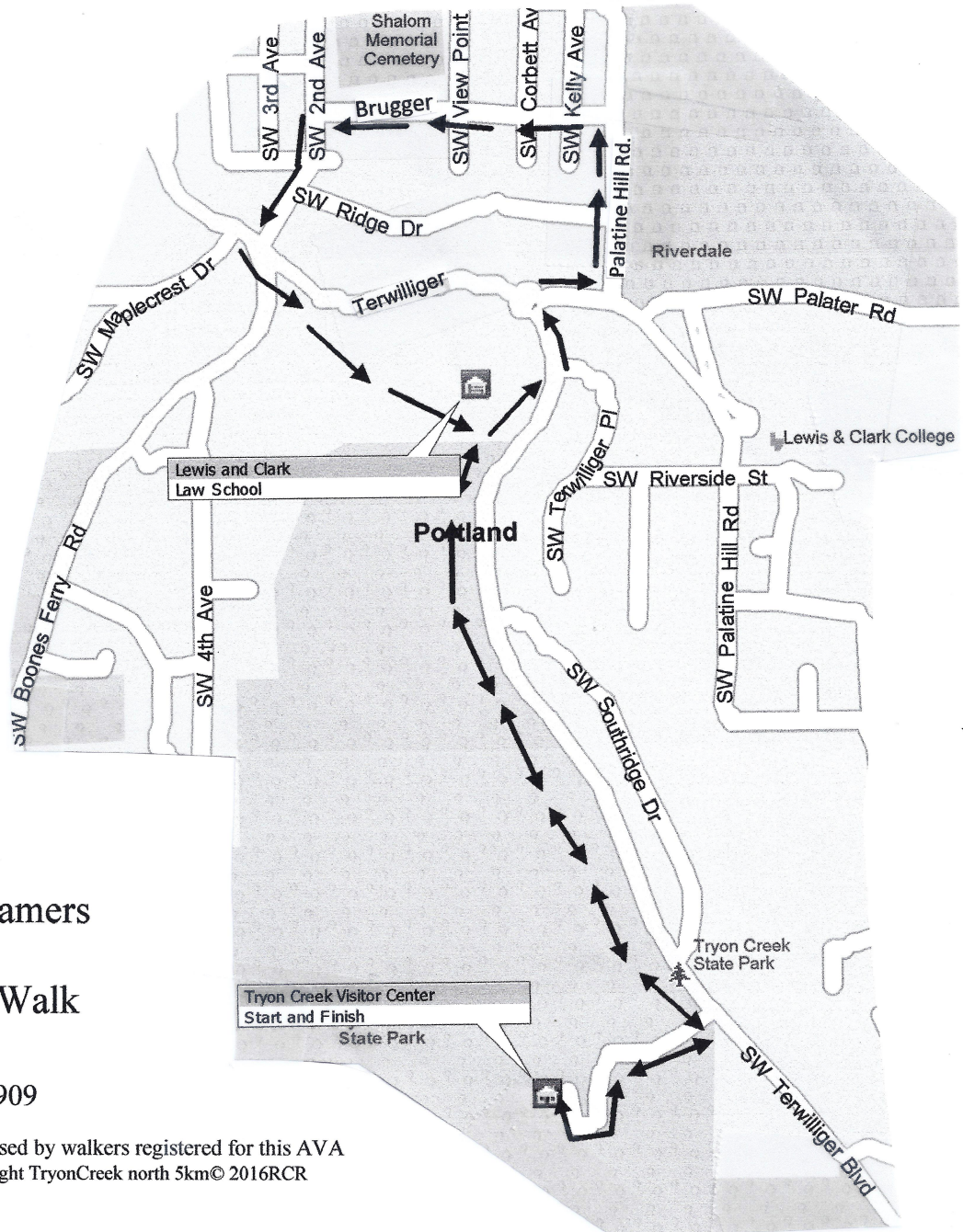

TRYON CREEK NORTH ROUTE

5 KM – Rated 2A – YRE 921

Challenges OTSVA 2020 (Parks,) 2021 (Trails)

1. **EXIT** Tryon Creek Visitor Center and bear **RIGHT** on Entrance Rd. following it counter-clockwise through the parking lot to almost the parking lot end where there is a paved bike trail on your right.
2. **RIGHT** on paved Trail to a “Y” intersection.
3. **LEFT** at the intersection crossing the entrance road to the visitor center. Continue on the paved bike trail as it parallels Terwilliger Blvd on your right to a “Y” with pavement on both trails. A large building (part of Lewis and Clark Law school) will be in the center of the “Y”.
4. **RIGHT** on the paved trail to Terwilliger Blvd.
5. **CROSS** and **LEFT** on Terwilliger to Traffic circle
6. **CROSS** the first two lanes that are straight ahead and then **RIGHT** on Palater Rd. for a block to Palatine Hill Rd.
7. **LEFT** on Palatine Hill Rd. to Brugger St.
8. **LEFT** on Brugger St to 2nd Av.
9. **LEFT** on 2nd Av. to Terwilliger.
10. **CROSS** Terwilliger and then **LEFT** crossing Boones Ferry Rd. entering paved bike path.
11. **CONTINUE** on bike path to “Y” intersection at Lewis and Clark Law School.
12. **RIGHT** on the paved trail and continue until passing the entrance road to the Visitor Center.
13. **RIGHT** at the next paved trail returning to the Visitor Center and finish
