Start Point: Grenada Pier Bait & Tackle - 1 South Beach St, Ormond Beach, FL 32174

Driving Directions: From I-95 take Exit 268 (SR40) and drive east on Granada Ave (SR40) to Beach St (approximately 4.3 miles). Turn right onto S. Beach St then turn left into the parking lot at the bait and tackle shop. Park in the parking lot to the left side of bait shop.

The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.

Welcome to Ormond Beach, Florida. "The Birthplace of Speed." Named after James Ormond, Ormond Beach is also known as Millionaires Row. We hope you take your time to enjoy historic sites, beautiful homes, and lovely parks.

1. From the Bait Shop, walk through the parking lot **bearing right towards** the brick path which circles the *Veterans Memorial*. Continue past the memorial to S. Beach St. *City Hall and Ormond Beach Library are located across S. Beach St.*
2. **TURN LEFT** for 3 blocks to the Office of the City Attorney (big sign) and *Ames Park*. *The house and the park area used to be the Ormond Beach Horticultural Society.*
3. **TURN LEFT** onto the sidewalk leading into the park. Follow the path as it meanders out to the Halifax River, and along the seawall and through the gardens and ponds.
4. Exit through the small pavilion to the parking area to reach a crosswalk for S. Beach St.
5. **TURN RIGHT and CAREFULLY CROSS** S. Beach St. toward the Timucua Indian Burial Mound. *Stop and read the historic plaque.*
6. **CONTINUE** past the Burial Mound on Mound Ave. one block to Grove St.
7. **TURN RIGHT** onto Grove St. and walk 3 blocks to the "T" intersection at Tomoka Ave.
8. **CROSS and TURN LEFT** on Tomoka Ave. for 1 block to S. Ridgewood Ave.

9. TURN RIGHT onto S. Ridgewood and continue to Granada Blvd. You will pass Ormond Elementary *on your right*. *Built in 1912, it underwent an extensive remodeling in 1986. The school has been in continuous use since first opening and is one of the oldest school buildings in Volusia County.*

10. TURN RIGHT onto Granada Blvd. and walk to S. Beach St.

11. CAREFULLY CROSS S. Beach St. at the light, and walk onto the high-rise bridge, walking across to Riverside Dr. (6K/11K SPLIT here.)

Pause at the top of the bridge for a spectacular view of the area. If you are lucky, you may see manatees or dolphins in the Halifax River.

12. [6K] TURN RIGHT onto Riverside Dr. *On your left is "The Casements," - winter home of John D. Rockefeller. Many cultural activities such as symphony concerts, choral presentations, garden parties, community theater and beautiful Christmas celebrations are now held here.*

13. TURN RIGHT at the *second* crosswalk, to the steps leading down into the garden area.

14. TURN LEFT on the sidewalk. Follow up the ramp to the stage area. Go down the steps at the back of the stage area and continue along the sidewalk with the river *on you* until you reach the sidewalk *on your left*.

15. TURN LEFT and walk out to the river and then **UNDER the bridge** to Fortunato Park.

16. BEAR LEFT onto the sidewalk and pass the boardwalk leading out to the observation pavilion. *You may walk out to the pavilion and back to look for manatees or dolphins.*

17. TURN RIGHT onto the sidewalk leading to the restrooms. *Note the exercise station to the right.* Continue past the restroom building toward the red-topped Cupola. Circle the Cupola from the original Ormond Hotel.

At one time was the largest hotel of wooden construction in the world. The Heritage Condominiums now sits on the site of the hotel.

18. Return to the park sidewalk along the water. *Restrooms available on your left.*

19. TURN RIGHT onto the sidewalk and continue in a clockwise direction, passing the playground equipment *on your left.* Continue around to John Anderson Dr.

20. TURN RIGHT along John Anderson Dr. and continue back to Granada Ave.

21. TURN RIGHT and **RE-CROSS** the Grenada Bridge.

22. At the end of the bridge, **TURN RIGHT** onto N. Beach St then walk a short distance and **TURN RIGHT** onto the path leading into the Bailey Riverbridge Gardens.

23. Walk through the gardens and past the old church *on your right* to the sidewalk leading back towards the water.

24. BEAR LEFT onto the wooden boardwalk and follow it around and **UNDER the bridge**, until returning to the Start/Finish point at the Bait shop on the other side.

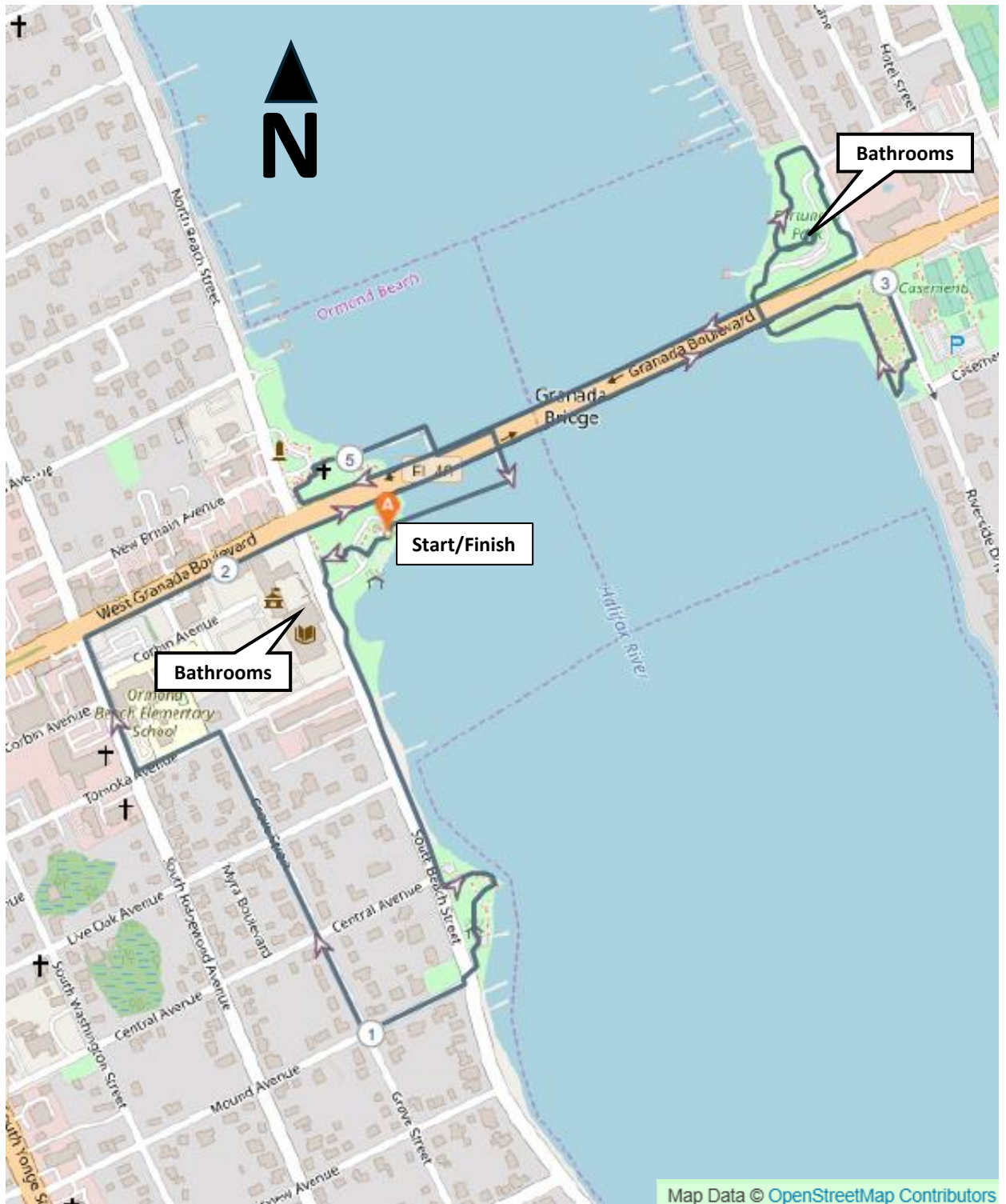

4. Exit through the small pavilion to the parking area to reach a crosswalk for S. Beach St.
5. **TURN RIGHT and CAREFULLY CROSS** S. Beach St. toward the Timucua Indian Burial Mound. *Stop and read the historic plaque.*
6. **CONTINUE** past the Burial Mound on Mound Ave. one block to Grove St.
7. **TURN RIGHT** onto Grove St. and walk 3 blocks to the “T” intersection at Tomoka Ave.
8. **CROSS and TURN LEFT** on Tomoka Ave. for 1 block to S. Ridgewood Ave.
9. **TURN RIGHT** onto S. Ridgewood and continue to Granada Blvd. You will pass Ormond Elementary

on your right. Built in 1912, it underwent an extensive remodeling in 1986. The school has been in continuous use since first opening and is one of the oldest school buildings in Volusia County.

10. TURN RIGHT onto Granada Blvd. and walk to S. Beach St.

11. CAREFULLY CROSS S. Beach St. at the light, and walk onto the high-rise bridge, walking across to Riverside Dr. (6K/11K SPLIT here.)

Pause at the top of the bridge for a spectacular view of the area. If you are lucky, you may see manatees or dolphins in the Halifax River.

12. [11K] Continue STRAIGHT to S. Halifax Ave. *On your right is “The Casements,” - winter home of John D. Rockefeller. Many cultural activities such as symphony concerts, choral presentations, garden parties, community theater and beautiful Christmas celebrations are now held here.*

13. CAREFULLY CROSS S. Halifax, then **TURN RIGHT** and walk a short distance passing the *Ormond Memorial Art Museum*.

14. TURN LEFT at the peacock fountain into the *Ormond Memorial Gardens*. Look to the right and view the lovely waterfall – *built by a former HW club member!* Follow main path passing the WWI, Korean War and Vietnam War memorials, to the Labrinth pavilion.

15. Continue through the gardens (multiple paths) passing the turtle pond and bearing right to exit on the east side onto Seton Trail.

16. TURN LEFT and return to Granada Blvd.

17. TURN RIGHT on Granada Blvd. Continue to the traffic light at S. Atlantic Ave. (FL A1A), passing the *historic WPA police/fire station at 160 E. Granada*

18. CAREFULLY CROSS A1A using the pedestrian signal and crosswalk, and continue to the ocean.
Restrooms located on the left just before you enter the beach.

ALTERNATE ROUTE

If tides or weather conditions do not permit, OR you do not wish to walk on the beach, you may TURN RIGHT onto S. Atlantic Ave. and walk South to Rockefeller Dr., then **TURN RIGHT** and continue to **Step #21**.

19. TURN RIGHT on the beach and walk south about 8/10 of a mile to the Rockefeller Dr. vehicle exit ramp. [There is a small vertical sign at the Rockefeller exit ramp, *just before* a yellow four-story motel.]

20. TURN RIGHT to exit the beach and continue to A1A (S. Atlantic Ave.) **CAREFULLY CROSS** S. Atlantic Ave. (A1A) at the pedestrian signal.

21. CONTINUE on Rockefeller Dr. for 4 blocks to Halifax Dr.

22. TURN RIGHT on S. Halifax for 1 long block to at crosswalk at Fluhart Dr.

23. TURN LEFT on Fluhart, then walk 2 blocks to Riverside Dr.

24. At the traffic pylons, CAREFULLY CROSS Fluhart Dr. and **TURN RIGHT** on Riverside Dr.

25. Riverside Dr. is a narrow one-way street. Walk on the *LEFT facing traffic. Enjoy the beautiful overhanging branches of the live oak trees and the lovely homes of the "rich and famous."*

26. At Casement Dr., take the sidewalk *on the left* until you reach the second set of steps *on your left*. leading to the Rockefeller Gardens.

27. Go down the steps and **TURN LEFT** toward the stage area. Follow the sidewalk going up the ramp to the stage area, down the at the rear and toward the pool.

28. TURN RIGHT along the river and walk the length of the park until to the sidewalk *on your left*.

29. TURN LEFT and walk out to the river and then **UNDER the bridge** to Fortunato Park.

30. BEAR LEFT onto the sidewalk and pass the boardwalk leading out to the observation pavilion. *You may walk out to the pavilion and back to look for manatees or dolphins.*

31. TURN RIGHT onto the sidewalk leading to the restrooms. *Note the exercise station to the right.* Continue past the restroom building toward the red-topped Cupola. Circle the Cupola from the original Ormond Hotel.

32. Return to the park sidewalk along the water. *Restrooms available on your left.*

37. Walk through the gardens and past the old church *on your right* to the sidewalk leading back towards the water.

38. BEAR LEFT onto the wooden boardwalk and follow it around and **UNDER the bridge**, until returning to the Start/Finish point at the Bait shop on the other side.
