**RICHLAND, WA. 6K and 10K SEASONAL WALKS Y1012
CENTRAL WASHINGTON SUN STRIDERS - RATED 1A**

DRIVING DIRECTIONS to COLUMBIA POINT PARK walk start

46.15'47.89"N 119.14'47.92"W

1. From I-82, take exit 102 (I-182 toward Richland/Pasco).
2. Take Exit 5B off I-182. You will loop around to George Washington Way.
3. Turn **RIGHT** at the first stop light on Columbia Point Drive.
4. Follow Columbia Point Drive to the end (past the golf course and residential area).
5. Park on the left just before the turnaround at the river. (*restrooms at boat launch and turnaround point*)

WALK INSTRUCTIONS

1. Facing the river at the turnaround, turn **LEFT** on the asphalt path. The river will be on your right.
2. Follow the pathway around the park keeping the water on your right. **CROSS** in front of the boat launch (*Restrooms on your left*) and continue on the path past the marina. The water will still be on your right.
3. At 2K is a gazebo at the Riverfront Hotel.
4. **CONTINUE** on trail past Hampton Inn into Howard Amon Park.
5. After the boat dock on the right (3K), is a bench on your left with a plaque embedded in concrete that is dedicated to **Monica Watts**. (*6K walkers turn around here and return to the parking lot and your vehicle*).
6. **10K walkers CROSS** the boat launch at Howard Amon Park. Stay on the trail that is between the boat launch parking lot and the river.
7. **PROCEED** uphill, following the trail along the dike.
8. At 4K is a gray house on the left with a white screened-in porch.
9. The trail **PROCEEDS** into Leslie Groves Park.
10. At 5K are restrooms *where the path splits, bikes on upper trail, walkers on lower trail*. Turn **AROUND** and return on the Riverfront Trail to the parking lot and your car.

Thanks for walking our Richland walk. There are also OSB walks in Kennewick and Pasco.

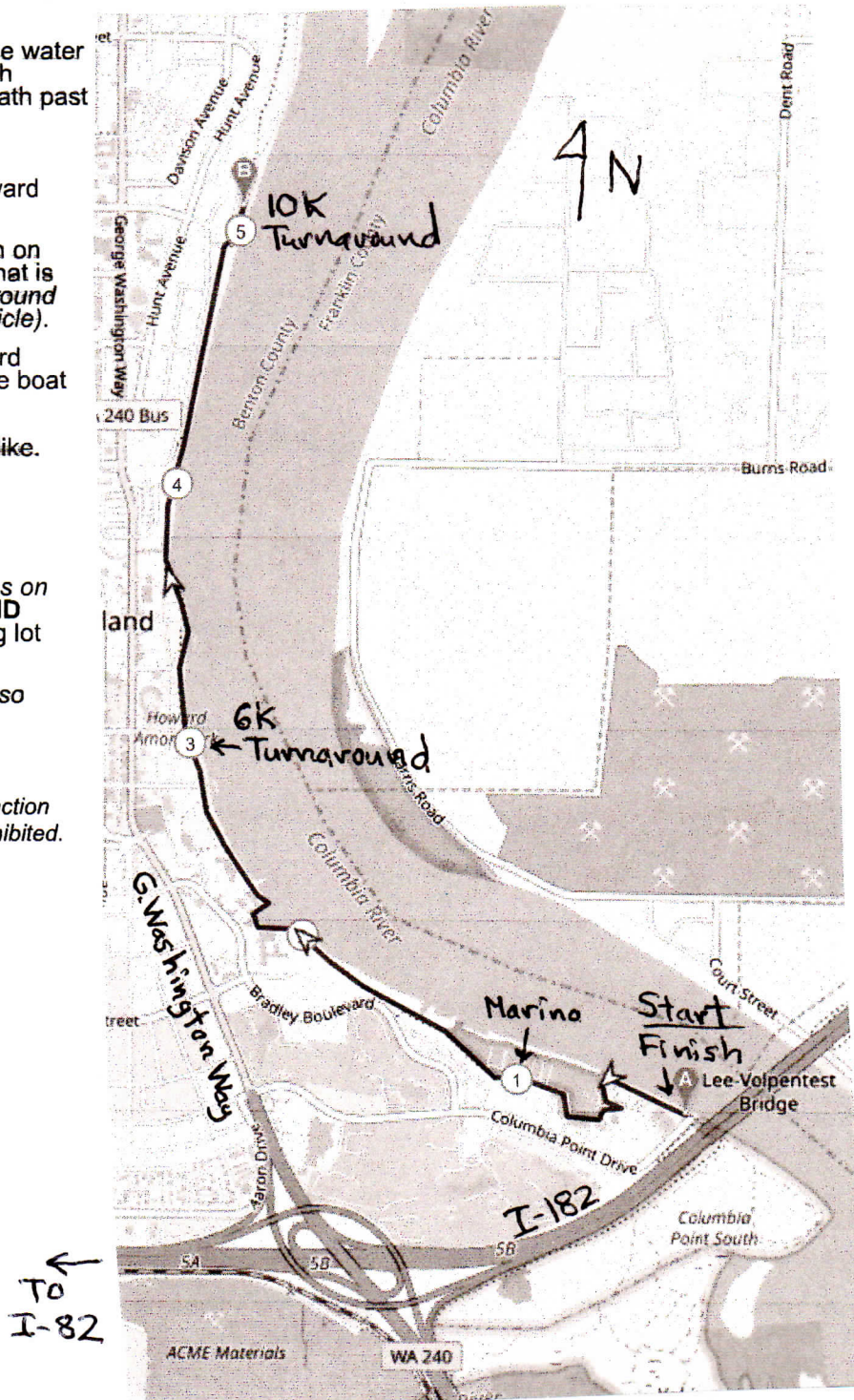

The walk directions and map may only be used in conjunction with a signed AVA athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

Be sure to log back into the OSB system (my.ava.org) to finish/complete your online registration after doing the walk. The OSB system does not deduct any walking fee from a walker's event bank until they have submitted walk completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that walker is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded pdf is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the pdf is downloaded. Later, any pdf fees are credited back to a walker's Event Bank when he/she submits the walk completion info as a paying for credit walker.) The \$2 "coupon" for the downloaded pdf expires in 60 days.
