(Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded pdf is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the pdf is downloaded. Later, any pdf fees are credited back to a walker's Event Bank when he/she submits the walk completion information as a paying for credit walker.)

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# Moses Lake Town Walk

## Driving Directions and Other Information

**Driving directions to start: Neppel Landing Park**  
**104 S. Alder St.**  
**Moses Lake, WA 98837**

**GPS Coordinates: 47.13205, -119.27910**

**Take I-90 Exit 179 (SR17)** Eastbound Left, Westbound Right on SR17.

**Continue straight** toward City Center (now Pioneer Way.) **Do NOT turn right** with SR17. At the bottom of the hill, Pioneer Way curves left becoming Broadway. **Continue** on Broadway through the light at Alder, 2 blocks to Ash. **Right** on Ash to alley on right at Neppel Landing Park. Park on left in alley.

**Restrooms:** There are no restrooms at this actual start location. There are restrooms in the Walgreens Drugs at the corner of Broadway and Alder across the street at the end of the alley. There are Restrooms seasonally on the first part of the 10k walk and all year in McCosh Park.

**Pets:** Required to be on leash. Owners must remove all animal waste.

**Climate:** Moses Lake is very hot in the summer and can be over 100 degrees. Walk early in summer, carry water and use sun screen. In the winter, residents are required to keep their sidewalks scraped. Moses Lake does not get very much snow overall, but can be very cold. Please check the weather report and wear appropriate clothing and footwear.



Neppel Landing Park Trail borders tracks of former Columbia Basin RR from Moses Lake to Connell and may still be an active spur of Burlington Northern. Neppel was the name of the first settlement on Moses Lake, which was named for Chief Moses c. 1829-1899.

1. Face the lake and turn **Right** on the paved trail to Stratford Road (unmarked.)
2. **Left** on Stratford across the lake to Knolls Vista Drive.
3. **Left** on Knolls Vista Drive to Knolls Vista School and Knolls Vista Park. (**Restrooms** in park, seasonally.) **1K** at Mattson Dr.
4. **Continue** to the end of the park as the road curves left.
5. **Right crossing street** onto the sidewalk by fire hydrant at the edge of the park and through the parking lot to Central Drive.
6. **Left** on Central to Sage Bay Dr. (next street).
7. **Left** on Sage Bay to Manzanita St.
8. **Left** on Manzanita to Edgewater Lane (**2K**).
9. **Right** on Edgewater to Larkspur St.
10. **Right** on Larkspur to Sage Bay Dr.
11. **Right** on Sage Bay to Central Dr.
12. **Right** on Central to Pine Drive at beginning of parking lot.
13. **Right** thru church parking lot/park edge sidewalk to street.
14. **Cross, jog right then left** onto North Shore Drive (**3K**) to Knolls Vista Drive.
15. **Right** on Knolls Vista to Stratford Road. (**4K**)
16. **Right** on Stratford Rd to Neppel Landing Park. (**Restrooms** in the Walgreens across the street.)
17. **Right** on the trail into the park.
18. **Continue** keeping the lake on right to a kiosk on left and an uphill paved trail. (**5K**)
19. **Left** on trail uphill, and turn **Right** through the basalt columns at the top and out to Broadway. American Legion Post 209 to right.
20. **Cross** Broadway in the crosswalk on the **left** side of Dogwood and Broadway.
21. **Turn right** and cross Dogwood.
22. **Left** on Dogwood to Third Ave. Carl T. Ahlers Park on right.
23. **Cross** Third Ave and turn right on Third passing Frontier Middle School to Elm St at the end of the school.
24. **Left** on Elm and follow sidewalk as it curves onto Fourth Ave.
25. **Continue** on Fourth keeping on the left side as it turns into Columbia to “A” St. (**6K**)
26. **Left** at “A” St. to Rose St. just before McCosh Park. **If you do not want a Little Free Library, skip #27.**
27. **Right** on Rose 3 houses to the Little Free Library on right and return to “A” St, cross and right.
28. **Left** into the parking lot of McCosh Park across from Emanuel Lutheran.
29. **Right** onto the asphalt path at the right corner of the tennis courts.
30. **Continue** on the path past the picnic shelter, tot lot and **restrooms (seasonal).**
31. **Continue** on the path to the Peace Memorial (**Veterans Memorial**) and Centennial Theatre. Farmers market open Saturdays Mid June – Mid October.
32. **Continue** in the same direction on the asphalt path keeping the lake on your right toward the rectangular building. (old Swedberg pool house.)
33. **Continue** on path to right of the pool house.
34. **Left** at the end of the pool house.
35. **Follow** along the fence on the path, then **Right (Restroom seasonally)** to the parking lot and **Left** to the crosswalk by the bike art. Playground built by and named Rotary Playground.
36. **Right straight** through the parking lot to W. Fifth Ave. (**7K**)
37. **Straight** ahead on the right side of Fifth crossing Ash to Division.
38. **Cross** Division at crosswalk and turn **right** onto Division.
39. **Left** on Seventh Ave to S. Alder St.
40. **Right** on S. Alder St. to the Japanese Peace Gardens. Walk through the park if open. (**Restrooms seasonally**) (**8K**)
41. **Return** on S. Alder to E. Fifth Ave.
42. **Cross Fifth turn Right** and continue on Fifth past the police station to Civic Center Park and library. **Restrooms in library when open. 911 Memorial further down 5<sup>th</sup>.**
43. **Left** to library and **Left** on sidewalk to Drought Tolerant Garden sign. Take path on left of sign.
44. **Continue** on the path past the **restrooms** (open seasonally) to the Civic Center. (**City Hall**)

**45. Left** on path at Civic Center continuing between buildings with Civic Center on your right to the end of that building. (9K)  
Civic Center has Museum and Art Center

**46. Right** on sidewalk to round-about at Balsam.  
(unmarked).  
Municipal Court & Veterans Memorial in next building

**47. Cross** Balsam at the crosswalk at E. Fourth Ave.  
**Continue on** the right side of Fourth to S. Alder St at the end of the community garden.

**48. Right** on Alder to E. Third Ave.

**49. Left** crossing Alder. **Right** crossing Third.

**50. Left** on Third to Beech.

Clock tower in round-about. Post Office at Beech.

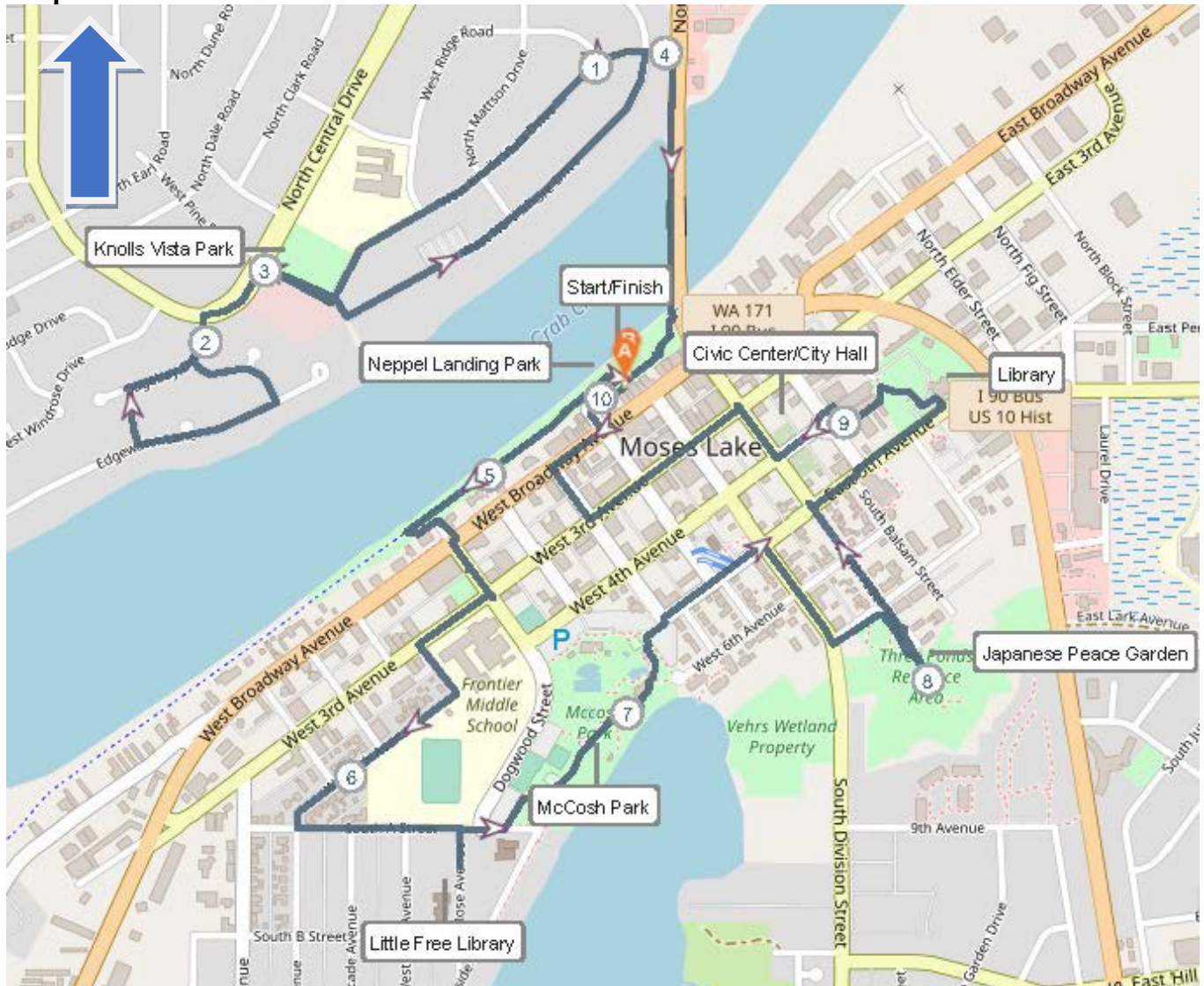
**51. Right** on Beech to Broadway.

**52. Right** on Broadway to Alder.

**53. Left**, crossing Broadway at the light, to Neppel Landing Park and left into alley to your car.

1. Face the lake and turn **left** on the paved trail
2. **Continue** on the trail keeping the lake on your right past the kiosk to the paved trail on left.  
*Former train station site. Trail follows active BNSF spur.*
3. **Left** on this trail uphill, and **turn Right** through the basalt columns at the top and out to Broadway. *American Legion Post 209 to right.*
4. **Cross** Broadway in the crosswalk on the **left** side of Dogwood and Broadway.
5. **Turn right** and cross Dogwood.
6. **Left** on Dogwood St to W. Third Ave.  
*Carl T. Ahlers Park on right.*
7. **Cross** W. Third Ave and **Right** passing Frontier Middle School to S. Elm St at the end of the school.
8. **Left** on Elm and follow sidewalk as it curves onto Fourth Ave.(1K)
9. **Continue** on Fourth keeping on the left side as it turns into Columbia to S. A St.
10. **Left** on “A” St to Rose St before McCosh Park. **If you don’t want a Little Free Library, go to 12.**
11. **Right** on Rose 3 houses to Little Free Library on right and return to “A” St, **Cross and Right**.
12. **Left** into the parking lot of McCosh Park across from Emanuel Lutheran.
13. **Right** onto the asphalt path at the right corner of the tennis courts.
14. **Continue** on the path past the picnic shelter, tot lot and **restrooms (seasonal)**. (2K)
15. **Continue** on the path to the Peace Memorial and Centennial Theatre.  
*Farmers market open Saturdays Mid June – Mid October.*
16. **Continue** in the same direction on the asphalt path keeping the lake on your right toward the rectangular building (old Swedberg pool house.)
17. **Continue** on path to right of the pool house.
18. **Left** at the end of the pool house. (**Restrooms seasonally**.)
19. **Follow** along the fence on path then **Right** to parking lot and **Left** to crosswalk by the bike art.  
*Playground built by and named Rotary Playground.*
20. **Right straight** through the parking lot to W. Fifth Ave.
21. **Straight** ahead on the right side of Fifth, crossing Ash to Division.
22. **Cross** Division at crosswalk and turn **right** onto Division to E. Seventh Ave.
23. **Left** on Seventh to S. Alder St.
24. **Right** on Alder to the Japanese Peace Gardens. Walk through the park if open. (**Restrooms seasonally**) (3K)
25. **Return** on S. Alder to E. Fifth Ave.
26. **Cross and Right** on Fifth past the police station to Civic Center Park and library. (**Restrooms when open**.) **911 Memorial a little further on 5<sup>th</sup>.**
27. **Left** to library entrance and **Left** on sidewalk to the Drought Tolerant Garden sign. Take the path to the left of the sign.
28. **Continue** on the path past the **restrooms** (open seasonally) to the Civic Center. (4K)
29. **Left** on path at Civic Center continuing between buildings with Civic Center on your right to the end of that building.  
*Civic Center has City Hall & Museum and Art Center*
30. **Right** on sidewalk to round-about at S. Balsam (unmarked.)  
*Municipal Court in next building . Veterans Memorial.*
31. **Cross** Balsam in crosswalk onto E Fourth Ave.
32. **Continue on** the right side of Fourth to S. Alder St. *community garden on your right (and left).*
33. **Right** on Alder to E. Third Ave.
34. **Left** crossing Alder. **Right** crossing Third.
35. **Left** on Third to Beech.  
*Statue of Liberty metal sculpture on SE corner of 3<sup>rd</sup> and Ash. Clock tower in round-about. Post Office across street.*
36. **Right** on Beech to Broadway.
37. **Right** on Broadway to Ash
38. **Left**, crossing Broadway at the light, and continue on Ash to the alley and your car.

## Driving Directions and Other Information

**Driving directions to start: Grant County International Airport**  
**7810 Andrews St. NE**  
**Moses Lake, WA 98837**

**GPS Coordinates: 47.21101, -119.31692**

**Take I-90 Exit 179 (SR17)** Eastbound Left, Westbound Right on SR17.

**Stay in right lane** to light where SR17 turns right. **Right** on SR17 continuing nearly 5 miles to the light at Patton Blvd NE. **Right** on Patton 2 miles all the way down to the entrance to the parking lot on left just before the terminal building. **Left** into the parking lot and park in the Day Use area. Free parking.

**From the 10k/5k Town Walk Parking area:** Drive out of the alley and turn **Right** on Alder through the light to E. 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. **Right** on 3<sup>rd</sup>. **Right** on Ash. **Right** on Broadway, keeping in the **left lane** to the light. **Left** on Alder/Stratford Rd to SR17 overpass. **Left** onto SR17 to light at Patton. Continue as above.

**Restrooms:** Restrooms are available in the terminal building, and in building #1800 noted in the directions.

**Pets:** Dogs are allowed, but not in buildings. Required to be on leash. Owners must remove all animal waste.

**Climate:** Moses Lake is very hot in the summer and can be over 100 degrees. Walk early in summer, carry water and use sun screen. In the winter, residents are required to keep their sidewalks scraped. Moses Lake does not get very much snow overall, but can be very cold. Please check the weather report and wear appropriate clothing and footwear.

Grant County International Airport used to be **Larson Airforce Base**. The whole area is called the Larson Community. **No pets in buildings.**

**USE THE MAP!! Sidewalk directions can be confusing.**

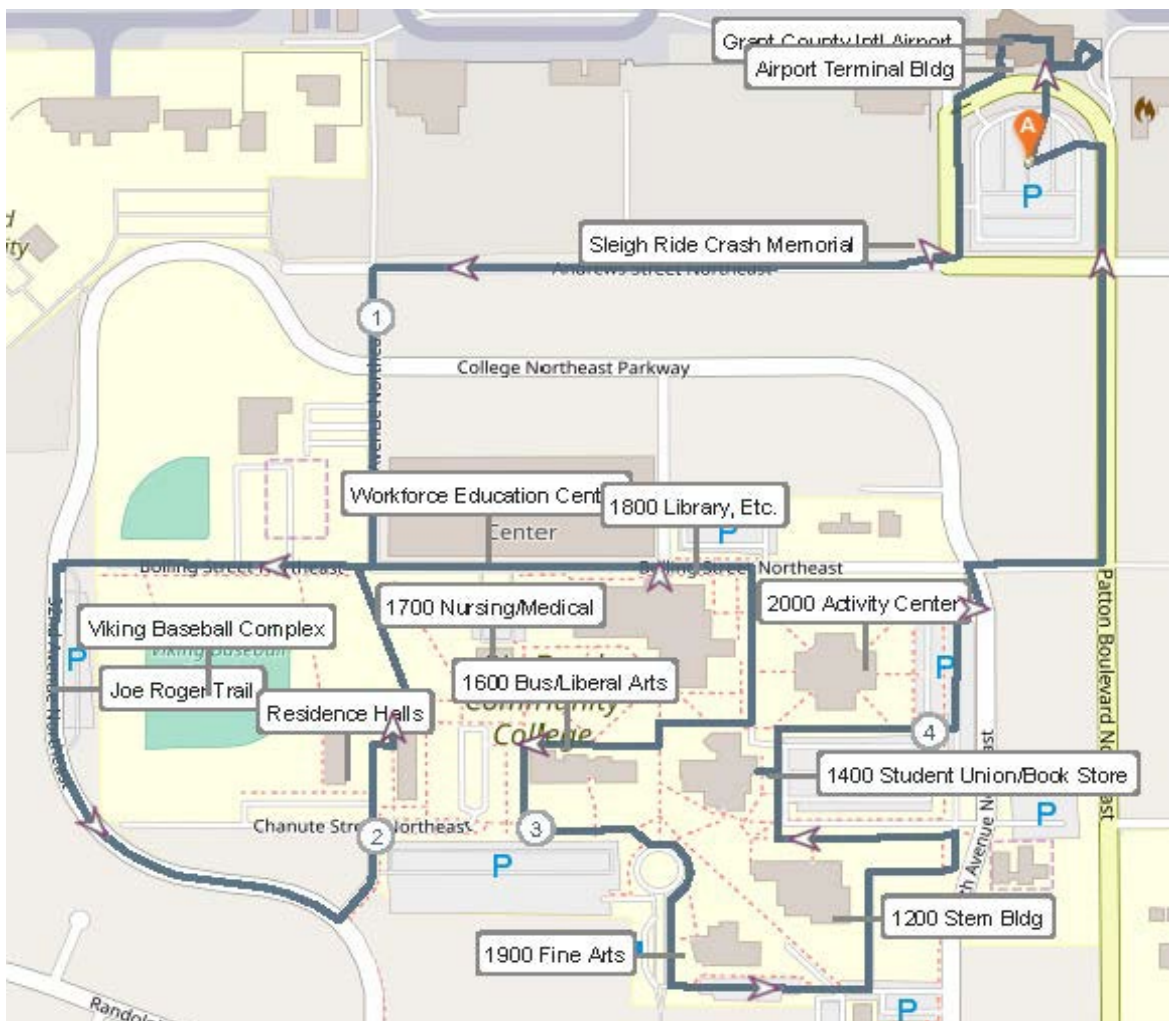
1. **Face terminal bldg.** and cross the road toward the Departures Door.
2. **Right** before door to basalt columns memorial and walk around the circle back to the front Departures door. Enter the terminal.  
(hours 6:30AM to 5:30PM everyday) Restrooms inside.
3. **Left** walking through the terminal. You can look out any area to view the air field.  
**At present the airfield houses Boeing 737 Max planes that couldn't be delivered or sold because of lack of FAA safety approval.**
4. **Left** out the next door (Arrivals) and **Right** on the sidewalk to next street (unmarked.)
5. **Left** with parking lot on left to the next corner (Andrews St NE)
6. **Right** crossing street to the Sleigh Ride plane crash memorial on the corner.  
**You can read about the crash on the memorial.**
7. **Cross** and **Right** on Andrews on the sidewalk, continuing after the sidewalk ends facing traffic to 30<sup>th</sup> Ave NE. **(1K)**
8. **Left** on 30<sup>th</sup> on left side, crossing College Northeast Parkway to Bolling St NE.  
**You are on the campus of Big Bend Community College home of the Vikings.**
9. **Cross** and **Right** on Bolling passing the Word Services/Central Receiving building and Softball field on right and Baseball field on the left to the street end.
10. **Pass** through the barrier keeping the parking lot on your left to the street (College Parkway NE) and the Joe Roger Trail (sidewalk.)
11. **Left** on the Joe Roger Trail, passing by the enclosed UAS Flight Lab as it curves to Chanute St NE. **(2K)**
12. **Left** on Chanute continuing straight toward and between the Viking Residence Hall on the left and the Phillips Residence Hall on the right to the end just before the picnic tables.
13. **Right** on the sidewalk to Phillips Hall and **Left** on the sidewalk to the "T"; then **Right** to the #1700 Bldg (Health/Tech Dept.)
14. **Left** on the diagonal path just before the #1700 Bldg to the street (Bolling St NE)
15. **Right** on sidewalk crossing driveway and continuing with #3700 Workforce Education Center on left to the #1800 bldg Library and Grant County Advanced Technologies Education Center, cafeteria and other offices on right. **Open weekdays. Restrooms**
16. **Continue** on past #1800 to a sidewalk on right next to a parking lot.
17. **Right** on this sidewalk with parking lot on left to the tan #1400 Building.
18. **Right** on wide sidewalk before #1400 to a "T"
19. **Left** then **Right** on path passing the Business and Liberal Arts Bldg #1600 to the next sidewalk by the light pole before the parking lot.
20. **Left** on sidewalk with #1600 now on left to the sidewalk at end of #1600. **(3K)**
21. **Left** in front of the #1600 bldg to a "Y".
22. **Right** at the "Y" and **Left** following the sidewalk around the traffic circle to the small Japanese/American Garden.
23. **Continue** around the traffic circle to the sidewalk at the street (28<sup>th</sup> Ave NE.)
24. **Left** on 28<sup>th</sup> with the Fine Arts bldg on left.

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25. **Left** on sidewalk behind Fine Arts bldg. **crossing** a small road and continuing **straight** along a parking lot to 2<sup>nd</sup> small road on left.
26. **Left** on this small road passing the #1200 STEM Center on left.
27. **Right** on next sidewalk to parking lot by street.
28. **Left** on sidewalk at parking lot up to the street corner of College Parkway NE and Chanute street (unmarked).
29. **Left** on sidewalk next to Chanute to the next sidewalk on right.
30. **Right** on this sidewalk with #1400 Student Center/Administration/Book Store on left. **Bookstore and Restrooms inside Open 8:30 – 4:30 M-Th; 8:30 – 1:30 F.**

31. **Continue straight** crossing street to sidewalk.
32. **Right** on sidewalk with sunken #2000 Peter D. DeVries Activity Center/gym on left to sidewalk next to street (College Pkwy E) **(4K)**
33. **Left** on sidewalk at College Pkwy to corner at Bolling St E.
34. **Cross** Bolling and **Right crossing** College Pkwy, continuing on left side of Bolling to Patton Blvd NE.
35. **Left** on Patton crossing Andrews to the terminal parking lot and the **Finish**.
