



## HISTORIC COROLLA 10 KM ON or OFF BEACH YEAR ROUND VOLKSWALK, YR1139

### **START/FINISH POINT: Historic Corolla Park- Rear of Currituck Maritime Museum -1140 Village Lane, Corolla, NC 27927**

Driving Directions – Historic Corolla Park is off NC-12 in Corolla, NC. Take NC-12 north from Southern Shores/Kitty Hawk at 158 bridge about 20 miles to the entrance of Historic Corolla Park (Club Dr.). Turn left on Club Drive then immediate right on Village Dr. Park at the Currituck Maritime Museum. Restrooms available.

These walking directions and maps may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

1. Exiting museum, turn left(**L**) on Village Dr. (the road you drove in).
2. Right(**R**) on Club Road (toward the Whalehead Club), keeping to the right as it crosses the canal. Immediately after crossing the canal.
3. **R** on the path leading toward the boat basin.
4. At the boat basin, **L** to follow the boardwalk around to the path at the end of the bridge.
5. Turn **R** to cross the bridge then keep turning right to return to the boat basin boardwalk.
6. **L** along the boat basin to the boat house then **L** to follow the path to Corolla Village Rd  
*(The building to the left is the Outer Banks Center for Wildlife Education admission free, as of this writing open Mo-Sa 9-4:30 including some holidays. Water, restrooms & gift shop.)*
7. **L** on Corolla Village Rd past Schoollhouse Lane and the Historic Village to Persimmon Street (across from Corolla Chapel)
8. **R** on Persimmon (not marked,) to the Highway 12.
9. **L** on the trail next to Highway 12 to Coral Lane.
10. Carefully crossing Highway 12 **R** on Coral Lane.
11. **L** on Atlantic Ave. for 3 blocks to Adriatic Ave then continue for one more block to a trail to the left.
12. **L** on this trail which leads into a small parking lot then across the parking lot to a street, Windance Ln, with no street sign here.
13. **L** on Windance Ln to Ocean Hill Blvd, a divided street to the highway
14. **R** on Ocean Hill across the highway and continue one more block to Lakeside Drive. Tennis courts are to the right approaching Lakeside Dr.

15. **R** on Lakeside following as it curves to the right to the hwy.
16. **L** on the highway trail to the entrance and parking area for the National Estuarine Reserve on the left as the highway curves to the right
17. **L** into the parking area then at the near left corner of the parking area go through the gate to the **boardwalk**, following it out and back through the nature area.
18. Return back through the parking lot and turn **L** on the highway trail and follow it all the way to the **fence** (and cattle guard in the road).

**OFF BEACH WALKERS:** Go to instruction #22 to turn on Corolla Village Drive.

19. **Pass through** the fence and continue to the crosswalk then turn **R** across the highway and again **pass through** the fence (blue Pedestrian sign) to follow the trail between the rail fences over the dunes and to the beach.



20. On the beach turn **R** and follow the beach for about 2.1 KM (1.3 mi) to the **vehicle** access point at Corolla Village Road.

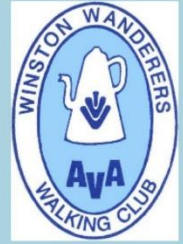
**NOTE:** Public beach access points are very poorly (or NOT) marked. There is a small sign high on the dune indicating “Corolla Village” – it will be on the right as you cross the dune. Corolla Village is (currently) the only vehicle access point on this section. Please be aware to not pass it. During the summer season there *may* be lifeguard stands nearby. During the off-season (October through April) there is likely to be vehicles entering and exiting here. **Use due caution.**



21. At Corolla Village access turn **R** to exit the beach to Corolla Village Road -
22. Then go straight ahead to cross the highway and pass the lighthouse.
23. Pass the lighthouse to the “T” intersection.
24. **L** at the “T”, pass the parking area to th Village Lane).
25. **L** on Village Lane back to Currituck Maritime Museum parking lot.
