



# Winston Wanderers welcomes you to walk with us at HISTORIC NEW BERN (Craven County) 10/6 KM WALK – Y1140

These walk directions and maps may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

We hope you enjoy your walk in North Carolina's second oldest town; established in 1710 by Baron Christopher de Graffenried, at the convergence of the Neuse and Trent Rivers. It was settled by Swiss and German immigrants and named for Bern, Switzerland. New Bern features over 150 historical landmarks, some dating from the early 18<sup>th</sup> century and with a variety of architectural periods and styles.

**START/Finish Point: Chamber of Commerce**, 316 South Front St, New Bern NC 28560 1-800-437-5767. Restrooms available and on-street parking.

**Directions:** I-95 or Raleigh: take US 70 E to New Bern. Exit 417A to E Front. After crossing bridge S Front is first street. Left on S Front for two blocks start point on right. Morehead City and beaches: Take US 70 W to New Bern. Exit right on BUS 70 to S Front (1st street left after bridge) left on S Front. After turn to S Front go two blocks to start point on right.

**WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT:** Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when they submit the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note however that the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF expires in 60 days.

1. LEAVE the Chamber of Commerce to South Front Street.

2. **LEFT** on South Front St to Craven Street (½ block)

3. **LEFT** on Craven Street to Pollock Street (1 Block)

4. **RIGHT** on Pollock Street to East Front Street (1 block)

5. **RIGHT** on East Front Street to corner of East Front and South Front Streets. Cross South Front Street.

6. **RIGHT** on South Front Street a few paces then **LEFT** on walkway that passes to the left of Riverfront Convention Center. Continue to follow

walkway along Trent River to connect to the end of Hancock Street.

7. Follow Hancock Street straight ahead to Broad Street. (3 blocks) Cross Broad Street.

8. **LEFT** on Broad Street, across Hancock, to Metcalf Street. (1 block)

9. **RIGHT** on Metcalf Street to Johnson Street (2 blocks)

10. **RIGHT** on Johnson Street

*public library is just ahead across Johnson. Available as rest/comfort stop when open. (Mon, Tue, Thu, Fri 9-9, Wed 12-6, Fri-Sat 9-6, Sun 2-6, closed Sun during Jun and Jul, also most holidays)*

11. **CONTINUE** on Johnson to Middle Street (next cross street) **CROSS** Middle Street

12. **RIGHT** on Middle St, walking on the left side of the street. *Middle Street is an interesting mix of shops and eateries housed in historic buildings. At 256 Middle St, SE corner of Middle and Pollock is the restored site of Bradham's Pharmacy, the birthplace of Pepsi Cola. The **Cow Cafe** (Maola Milk & Ice Cream Co) is on the **right** at 319 Middle Street. Open Mon-Sat from 10:00 to 9:00, this is a good place to stop for refreshment and restroom.*

13. Continue ahead on Middle Street then watch for the entrance to "Bear Plaza" approximately mid-block after crossing Pollock Street.

14. **LEFT** through Bear Plaza, noting the several carved city namesake bears, then across the parking lot to Craven Street (no street sign)

15. **LEFT** on Craven Street (cross Pollock, Broad and New Streets and pass Change Street to the right) to Johnson Street.

**(6 km option see instruction A1-2below)**

16. **RIGHT** on Johnson Street to its end at Edgerton Street. (2 blocks)

17. **LEFT** on Edgerton Street and follow **LEFT** on King Street two blocks to Craven Street.

18. **RIGHT** on Craven Street (passing the end of Middle Street to the left) to Queen Street (1 block)

19. **LEFT** on Queen Street to Johnson Street. Cross Johnson Street. (*Pass old Union Station Bldg. on right at Queen and Pasteur/Hancock Streets.*)

20. **RIGHT** across Queen Street and enter Cedar Grove Cemetery.

21. Follow the oyster shell surfaced path ahead to and half-around the Confederate Memorial statue and continue as the path turns to the **left**. Shortly after the left turn pass a cross path that is shell covered to the left and grass to the right. Continue another short distance to a wide grass cross path.

22. Turn **LEFT** on the wide grass path (after making the turn pass between family plots for Street on the right and Hawk on the left.) Follow the grass

path as it narrows and passes the Cedar Grove Fountain and on to "T" at a shell-surfaced path just past 2 tall obelisk-type monuments on the left for family Duffy.

23. **LEFT** to the shell-surfaced cross path on which you entered the cemetery. **RIGHT**, again passing half-around the Confederate memorial and exiting the cemetery across Queen Street.

24. **RIGHT** on Queen Street to George Street. Notice Police Department at corner of George & Queen St.'s

25. **LEFT** on George Street to Pollock Street in front of Tryon Palace. *Tryon Visitor Center and Ticket Office is to the right at the corner of George and Pollock Streets.*

*You are welcome and encouraged to watch the approximately 15-minute film continuously running in the VC auditorium. Restrooms and water are also available inside the Visitor Center. (M-Sa 9-5 and Sun 1 -5.)*

26. **RIGHT** on Pollock passing the end of Eden Street to the left. Just past Eden Street enter the Mary Kistler Stoney Flower Garden to the **right**. Cross from the Stoney Flower Garden into the Gertrude S. Carraway Garden then exit back to Pollock Street directly across from the end of Eden Street.

27. **Cross** Pollock Street and go straight ahead on Eden Street following to the left as it passes between the back side of Tryon Palace and the Trent River to become Metcalf Street and continue ahead to Pollock Street.

28. **RIGHT** on Pollock Street to Middle Street. (2 blocks)

29. **LEFT** on Middle Street to Broad Street. (1 block)

30. **LEFT** on Broad Street to Hancock Street. Look for the New Bern Fire Department on the right. (1 block)

31. **RIGHT** across Broad Street on Hancock Street past the **Firemen's Museum** to New Street. (1 block)

The **New Bern Academy Museum** is to the left across New Street.

32. **RIGHT** on New Street to and across Craven Street. **LEFT** on Craven St. a short distance to Change Street.

33. **RIGHT** on Change Street to and across East Front Street.

34. **RIGHT** on East Front for one short block to Linden Street. Across from Linden Street move to the **LEFT** to Walk along the sea wall along the Neuse River.

35. **(6 km option rejoins the 10 km route here)**

At the end of the sea wall walkway bear right up the steps or ramp to the sidewalk and continue left along East Front Street.

36. Immediately after the Courtyard by Marriot hotel turn **LEFT** on the driveway toward the boat launch ramp and into Union Point Park.

37. Bear **RIGHT** to again follow the sea wall walkway around Union Point Park. *This is the confluence of the Neuse and Trent Rivers.*

38. Pass through an underpass to exit Union Point Park. Turn **RIGHT** to Front Street. Turn **LEFT** on South Front Street and return to **Chamber of Commerce**, the start/finish point.

**OPTIONAL 6KM ROUTE** (Does not pass Tryon Palace or Cedar Grove Cemetery)

A1-1. Follow 10km route through **instruction No. 15**.

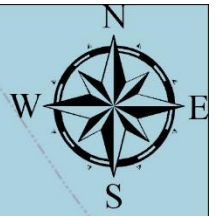
A1-2. After turning right on Johnson Street (at step 16) go one block and **turn RIGHT** on East Front Street

A1-3. Follow East Front Street 2 short blocks to the end of Linden Street.

A1-4. Move to the left to walk along the Seawall.

A1-5. Resume with 10km **instruction NO. 34** to finish the walk.

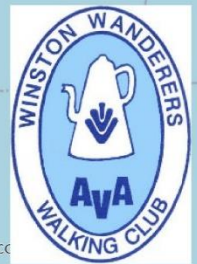
# Historic New Bern 10/6 KM Walk AVA UK 1140
