



## Galveston Historical Walk

**Houston Happy Hikers Welcomes You to the City of Galveston, TX. The walk can be done as a 5 or 11 K.**

**Walk Registration:** Registration takes place online using AVA Online Start Box, on my.ava.org. Follow the instructions provided to create a user account and sign the AVA waiver (one time). Instructions for payment are also included. Download the directions and print as needed. The POC does not provide event directions or accept alternate payment methods.

Please use the Online Start Box (OSB) to register and complete the event. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.”

### Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Once you have physically completed the walk, please login to your Online Start Box account click on the “My Start Box” tab, then the “Finish Table” tab, then click on “Go to Finish Table” button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped” virtual” insert cards that you may choose to print out.

**Starting Point Location:** Starbucks; 102 Kempner(22<sup>nd</sup>) Street, Galveston, TX 77550

**Driving Directions:** From Houston, TX take I-45 South, to Galveston, turns into Broadway. Follow Broadway to Kempter(22<sup>nd</sup>) Street; Right on 22<sup>nd</sup> Street. Starbucks is at corner of 22<sup>nd</sup> Street and Harborside Dr.

A fee parking lot is across 22<sup>nd</sup> Street from Starbucks.

**Restrooms:** Starbucks and businesses along the route

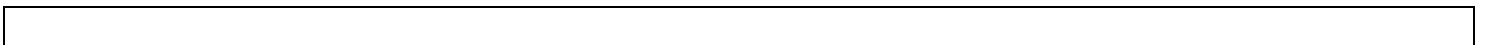
### Directions for Galveston Historical 5k

1. **EXIT** Starbucks, turn left onto 22<sup>nd</sup> St. Go four blocks.
2. **Left** on Postoffice. Go five blocks to 17<sup>th</sup> St. You will pass the Grand 1894 Opera House (2020 Postoffice). At the corner of 17<sup>th</sup> and Post Office on the right side of the street is the “Angel Cradling Bunny” sculpture (#1).
3. **PROCEED** two more blocks to 15<sup>th</sup> St. About halfway between 17<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> Sts., is “Large Pelican Holding Fish” (#9) on the right at 1609 Post Office.
4. **RIGHT** on 15<sup>th</sup> St. Go one block. At the corner of 15<sup>th</sup> and Church on the left side of the street is the “Mermaid Holding Clam Shell” (#10) sculpture.
5. **PROCEED** two more blocks.
6. **LEFT** on Ball St (Avenue H). Go one block. About half a block on the right is the “Guitar” (#7) sculpture at 1415 Ball.
7. **PROCEED** one more block on Ball. On the left is the “Two Crested Herons” (#21) sculpture at 1316 Ball, and at the corner of Ball and 13<sup>th</sup> is the “Squirrel with Acorn” (#15) and several other sculptures in the backyard (1302 Ball).
8. **LEFT** on 13<sup>th</sup> St. and continue to look for sculptures as you turn. Go one block. (NOTE: If you look behind the Mosquito Café in the parking area, you will see the “Three Pelicans and Fish” - #17 – sculpture at 628 14<sup>th</sup> St.)
9. **RIGHT** on Winnie (Avenue G). Go two blocks. As you pass Adoue Park on your right, note the sculpture of “Grandmother Reading to her Grandchildren” (#5). You will need to turn around to see the front of it. To your left just past the park is the “Monument to Galveston’s Trees” (#11) sculpture at 1028 Winnie.
10. **RIGHT** on 10<sup>th</sup> St. Go two blocks.
11. **RIGHT** on Sealy. Go four blocks. Between 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> Sts. is a beautiful sculpture of dolphins, turtles, and fish at 1212 Sealy. Also, at the corner of Sealy and 13<sup>th</sup> St is the “Hunter the Great Dane” (#6) sculpture (1228 Sealy) along the side of the house. In front of this house, is a carriage step. (NOTE: If you look further down Sealy on the left, you will see the “Tall Ship Elissa Figurehead” - #16 – sculpture at 1409 Sealy.)
12. **LEFT** on 14<sup>th</sup> St (Christopher Columbus Blvd.). Go one block. Sacred Heart Catholic Church is on the left and the Historic 1892 Bishop’s Palace is on the right.
13. **RIGHT** on Broadway past the Bishop’s Palace. Go three blocks.
14. **RIGHT** on 17<sup>th</sup> St. Go one block.
15. **RIGHT** on Sealy. Go one block. About halfway down the block on your left is the “Birds of Galveston” (#2) sculpture, which is located such that you can see all sides of the tree.
16. **LEFT** on 16<sup>th</sup> St. Go one block.
17. **LEFT** on Ball St (Avenue H). Go one block. About halfway down the block on your left is the “Toad” sculpture (#19). (NOTE: If you look further down Ball St on the left, you will see the “Geisha and Sister Angels” - #4 – sculpture at 1717 Ball.)
18. **RIGHT** on 17<sup>th</sup> St. Go one block. To the left on the corner of 17<sup>th</sup> and Winnie is the “Tin Man & Toto” (#18) sculpture (1702 Winnie St).
19. **PROCEED** one more block.
20. **LEFT** on Church St (Avenue F). Go four blocks.
21. **RIGHT** on 21<sup>st</sup> St (Moody Avenue). Go four blocks.
22. **LEFT** on the Strand. Go one block.
23. **Right** on 22<sup>nd</sup> St. Go one block to return to Starbucks.

**NOTE: Walk includes some of the Tree Carvings created from the damage to the Oak Trees during Hurricane Ike. You may have to stray a block from the route to completely see the Tree carvings and is an option if you choose.**

15. \*Squirrel with Acorn, Dolphin Moray Eel & Dorado, Owl, and Wildlife Totem Pole – 1302 Ball
16. Tall Ship Elissa Figurehead – 1409 Sealy Avenue
17. Three Pelicans and Fish – 628 14<sup>th</sup> St (Behind Mosquito Café)
18. \*Tin Man and Toto – 1702 Winnie St
19. \*Toad – 1615 Ball St
20. Train Engineer – 225 25<sup>th</sup> St
21. \*Two Crested Herons – 1316 Ball St
22. Where Have All the Flowers Gone – 1016 Church St
23. Yellow Lab – 1820 Winnie St

24. **EXIT** Starbucks, turn left onto 22<sup>nd</sup> St. Go four blocks.
25. **Left** on Postoffice. Go five blocks to 17<sup>th</sup> St. You will pass the Grand 1894 Opera House (2020 Postoffice). At the corner of 17<sup>th</sup> and Post Office on the right side of the street is the “Angel Cradling Bunny” sculpture (#1).
26. **PROCEED** two more blocks to 15<sup>th</sup> St. About halfway between 17<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> Sts., is “Large Pelican Holding Fish” (#9) on the right at 1609 Post Office.
27. **RIGHT** on 15<sup>th</sup> St. Go one block. At the corner of 15<sup>th</sup> and Church on the left side of the street is the “Mermaid Holding Clam Shell” (#10) sculpture.
28. **RIGHT** on Church St (Avenue F). Go two blocks. Halfway between 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> on the right is the “Pelican Sitting on Piling” (#12) sculpture at 1618 Church St.
29. **LEFT** on 17<sup>th</sup> St. Go one block. To the right on the corner of 17<sup>th</sup> and Winnie is the “Tin Man & Toto” (#18) sculpture (1702 Winnie St).
30. **PROCEED** one more block on 17<sup>th</sup> St.
31. **RIGHT** on Ball St (Avenue H). Go one block. About halfway on the left, is the “Geisha and Sister Angels” (#4) sculpture at 1717 Ball.
32. **LEFT** on 18<sup>th</sup> St. Go one block.
33. **LEFT** on Sealy Avenue. Go two blocks. About halfway between 17<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> Sts on the left is the “Birds of Galveston” (#2) sculpture, which is located such that you can see all sides of the tree.
34. **LEFT** on 16<sup>th</sup> St. Go one block. (NOTE: If you look down Ball to the left – opposite direction that you will turn – you will see the “Toad” - #19 – sculpture at 1615 Ball St.)
35. **RIGHT** on Ball St (Avenue H). Go two blocks. About halfway between 15<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> Sts. on the right is the “Guitar” (#7) sculpture at 1415 Ball.
36. **PROCEED** one more block on Ball. On the left is the “Two Crested Herons” (#21) sculpture at 1316 Ball, and at the corner of Ball and 13<sup>th</sup> is the “Squirrel with Acorn” (#15) and several other sculptures in the backyard (1302 Ball).
37. **LEFT** on 13<sup>th</sup> St. and continue to look for sculptures as you turn. Go one block. Between Ball (Avenue H) and Winnie (Avenue G), look for the pelican and alligator carving on your left at 709 13<sup>th</sup> St. (NOTE: If you look behind the Mosquito Café in the parking area, you will see the “Three Pelicans and Fish” - #17 – sculpture at 628 14<sup>th</sup> St.)
38. **PROCEED** five more blocks on 13<sup>th</sup> St.
39. **RIGHT** on Strand St. Go two blocks to 11<sup>th</sup> St.
40. **CROSS** 11<sup>th</sup> St and follow the walkway to UTMB and Old Red (the large reddish building on the left).
41. **RETURN** to Strand St and continue one block.
42. **LEFT** on 12<sup>th</sup> St. Go five blocks.
43. **LEFT** on Winnie (Avenue G). Go three blocks. As you pass Adoue Park on your right, note the sculpture of “Grandmother Reading to her Grandchildren” (#5). You will need to turn around to see the front of it. To your left just past the park is the “Monument to Galveston’s Trees” (#11) sculpture at 1028 Winnie.
44. **RIGHT** on 8<sup>th</sup> St. Go one block.
45. **RIGHT** on Ball (Avenue H). Go one block. At the intersection of Ball and 9<sup>th</sup> St, look to your right. Along the fence facing 9<sup>th</sup> St is the “Small Dolphin” (#14) sculpture and facing Ball St is the “Pod of Dolphins & Mermaids” (#13) sculpture.
46. **LEFT** on 9<sup>th</sup> St. Go one block.
47. **RIGHT** on Sealy. Go five blocks. Between 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> Sts. is a beautiful sculpture of dolphins, turtles, and fish at 1212 Sealy. Also, at the corner of Sealy and 13<sup>th</sup> St is the “Hunter the Great Dane” (#6) sculpture (1228 Sealy) along the side of the house. In front of this house, is a carriage step. (NOTE: If you look further down Sealy on the left, you will see the “Tall Ship Elissa Figurehead” - #16 – sculpture at 1409 Sealy.)
48. **LEFT** on 14<sup>th</sup> St (Christopher Columbus Blvd.). Go one block. Sacred Heart Catholic Church is on the left and the Historic 1892 Bishop’s Palace is on the right.
49. **CROSS** Broadway carefully. The light is very short and may require two cycles to cross.
50. **PROCEED** on 14<sup>th</sup> St for seven more blocks.
51. **CROSS** Seawall Blvd carefully.
52. **RIGHT** on Seawall Blvd. Go six blocks.
53. **PROCEED** on Seawall for two more blocks. On the Seawall, there is a marker for the site of The Balinese Room Pier, and a few blocks away, you will see Galveston Island Historic Pleasure Pier.
54. **CROSS** Seawall Blvd at 23<sup>rd</sup> St.
55. **PROCEED** on 23<sup>rd</sup> St for one block.
56. **RIGHT** on Bernardo De Galvez Avenue (Avenue P). Go two blocks.

57. **LEFT** on Moody Avenue (21<sup>st</sup> St). Go nine blocks. On your right between Avenue M ½ and Avenue M is The Bryan Museum.
58. **CROSS** Broadway carefully. The light is very short and may require two cycles to cross.
59. **LEFT** on Broadway. Go four blocks. Between 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> Sts is 1859 Ashton Villa, and at the corner of Broadway and 25<sup>th</sup> St is the Open Gates Conference Center. In the intersection of Broadway and 25<sup>th</sup> St is The Texas Heroes Monument dedicated to the heroes of the Texas Revolution.
60. **RIGHT** on 25<sup>th</sup> St (Rosenberg St). Go one block. In front of the old Galveston Fire Station on the left is the “Dalmatian” (#3) sculpture.
61. **PROCEED** on 25<sup>th</sup> St (Rosenberg St) for six more blocks. (NOTE: if you look to your left in the parking lot just past Mechanic St, you will see the “Train Engineer” - #20 – sculpture at 225 25<sup>th</sup> St.)
62. **RIGHT** on Mechanic St. Go two blocks. You will pass through the Powell Arch built for Mardi Gras and walk past the historic Tremont Hotel on the left.
63. **LEFT** on 23<sup>rd</sup> St. Go one block.
64. **RIGHT** on Strand. Go one block.
65. **LEFT** on 22<sup>nd</sup> St. Go one block to return to Starbucks
