Eugene, Oregon; Lane County
10k/5k, rated 2B; Y1203

Walk Start Location: Valley River Inn, 1000 Valley River Way, Eugene, OR.

Driving Directions: From 1-5 take exit 194B (West 1-105, West 126, Eugene): take Exit 1 (second exit, Delta Hwy, Santa Clara, Junction City), stay in right lane and take the first exit to Valley River Center. Keep going right, then get into left lane as you go on the overpass. Turn left onto Valley River Way, follow to its end. Valley River Inn is on the left.

GPS Coordinates: 44.06558, -123.10291

Park: In lot, near the river.

Restrooms: At Valley River Inn and in park (if open).

Walk Completion and Credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including that the event was walked, the distance walked and the selection of applicable special programs that a person is participating in. (A fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when they submit the event completion info as a payment for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days).

Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances and any special programs using the OSB.

These maps and directions may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

Roses and History 10k/5k walk Rated 2B © 2021

1. Exit Valley River Inn, Left through parking toward Willamette River.
2. Walk down steps in wall to bike path.
3. Right on path toward the first bridge.
4. Left to cross the Greenway Bridge.
5. Left at the intersection. **(1k)**
6. Stay Left at the intersection at the sign board and restrooms.
7. Right at the intersection before Rose Garden, restroom building on the left.
8. Left on first trail into Rose Garden. **(2k)**
9. Bear Left entering garden, walk clock-wise around garden. **Note: 200 year old cherry tree planted in 1847 by city founder Eugene Skinner.**
10. Right at Pergola passing tables.
11. Right on brick walkway under arbor.
12. Right at third path then left to return to the river trail. **5k Left; skip to step #27**
13. Right on bike path walking under the Hwy. overpass to first path on right.
14. Right on path and continue as it goes along Washington Street, to 3rd Avenue.
15. Left on 3rd for some distance, until you reach Skinner Butte sign and steps on the left. **Note: Historic McMurphy-Johnson house Up on the left and Historic Train Station off to the right.**
16. Left up the steps and trail until reaching Summit Road. **(4k)**
17. Left a **short distance** on Summit Road, then **Right** on Summit Loop Road.
18. Continue up road as it circles up to the top and cross parking area to the view point. **Note: The veterans memorial.**
19. Right on sidewalk from view point past flagpole and through yellow posts. Continue up path to 1851 Historic Stone. **(5k)**
20. Left on path at stone, follow arrows to River-Play, River-Bank trail system.
21. Right at arrow to river path system toward Campbell Senior Center walking between two large trees, stay on path until reaching the street.
22. At street, carefully cross and go right on sidewalk to Senior Center. **(6k)**
23. Right at Senior Center parking to left in passing front of Center then left on sidewalk to the brick Courtyard and "Dixie's bench".
24. Left out of Courtyard to river path.
25. Left, after about 1k and passing the parking are, go left up the walkway to the playground and restrooms.
26. Return to river path.
27. Left on river path to the Greenway bridge.
28. Right to cross the bridge.
29. Right on River Path to Valley River Inn and finish



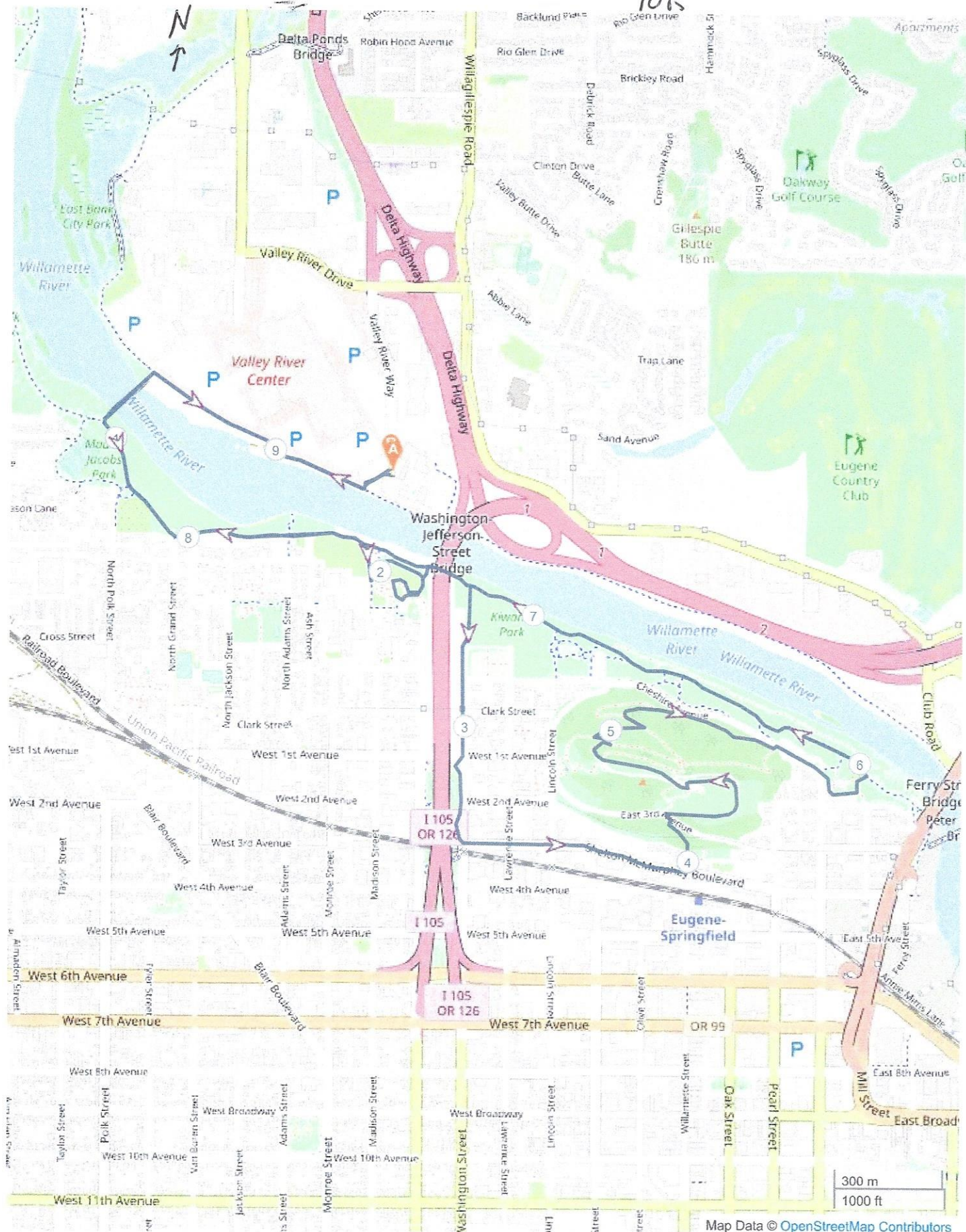
