

**Instructions for
River and Town, Y-1292
Rainier, OR
5/10 Km, rated 2A**

Walk Start Location: Cornerstone Café at 102 East A St, Rainier, OR 97048.

GPS Coords: 46.08978, -122.93546

Driving Directions: Drive east or west on Hwy 30 to Rainier and turn toward the Columbia River at the city hall. Go 1 block to the start point.

Park: Park in the public parking lot on East A Street, across the street from the Cornerstone Café

Restrooms: Steps 8 and 16 of Loop 1.

Walk Completion and Credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

"Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB."

"These maps and directions may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited."

LOOP 1 – Rainier River Walk

1. Facing the entrance door of the Cornerstone Café, turn **RIGHT**, then **LEFT** on 1st St.
2. **LEFT** on East C St.
3. **LEFT** on East 4th St.
4. **LEFT** on East B St.
5. **RIGHT** on East 1st St.
6. **RIGHT** on East A St.
7. **TURN AROUND** at East 5th St staying on East A St.
8. **RIGHT** at the public parking lot with the Restrooms at 3rd St.
9. Walk towards the shelter near the river and turn **LEFT** on the sidewalk by the shelter (picnic tables & gazebo.)
10. The path turns into an asphalt path by the Eagles Bldg. **RIGHT** to stay on asphalt path.
11. At the end of the asphalt path turn **LEFT** onto gravel trail.
12. **RIGHT** on West A St (unmarked) and walk across the small bridge.
13. At the end of the bridge, turn **RIGHT** onto asphalt path (Rainier Park).
14. **RIGHT** at the first turn towards the river (across from the Baseball Fields.)
15. **RIGHT** on gravel path (Tennis courts on the left).
16. Gravel becomes sidewalk continue past the boat ramp. (*Restrooms in the parking lot.*)
17. Veer **RIGHT** on the sidewalk to continue past the Senior Housing.
18. Veer **RIGHT** to continue on the sidewalk past the condos.
19. At the end of the last condo and the end of the sidewalk continue on the sandy path along the river.
20. **LEFT** at the fence.
21. **LEFT** on the first path which will continue and become West A St.
22. **LEFT** on Chinook Dr.
23. **RIGHT** on King Dr.

24. **RIGHT** on Coho Terrace.

25. **LEFT** on West A St.

26. Remain on West A St, past the Skatepark & Blue Star Veterans Memorial.

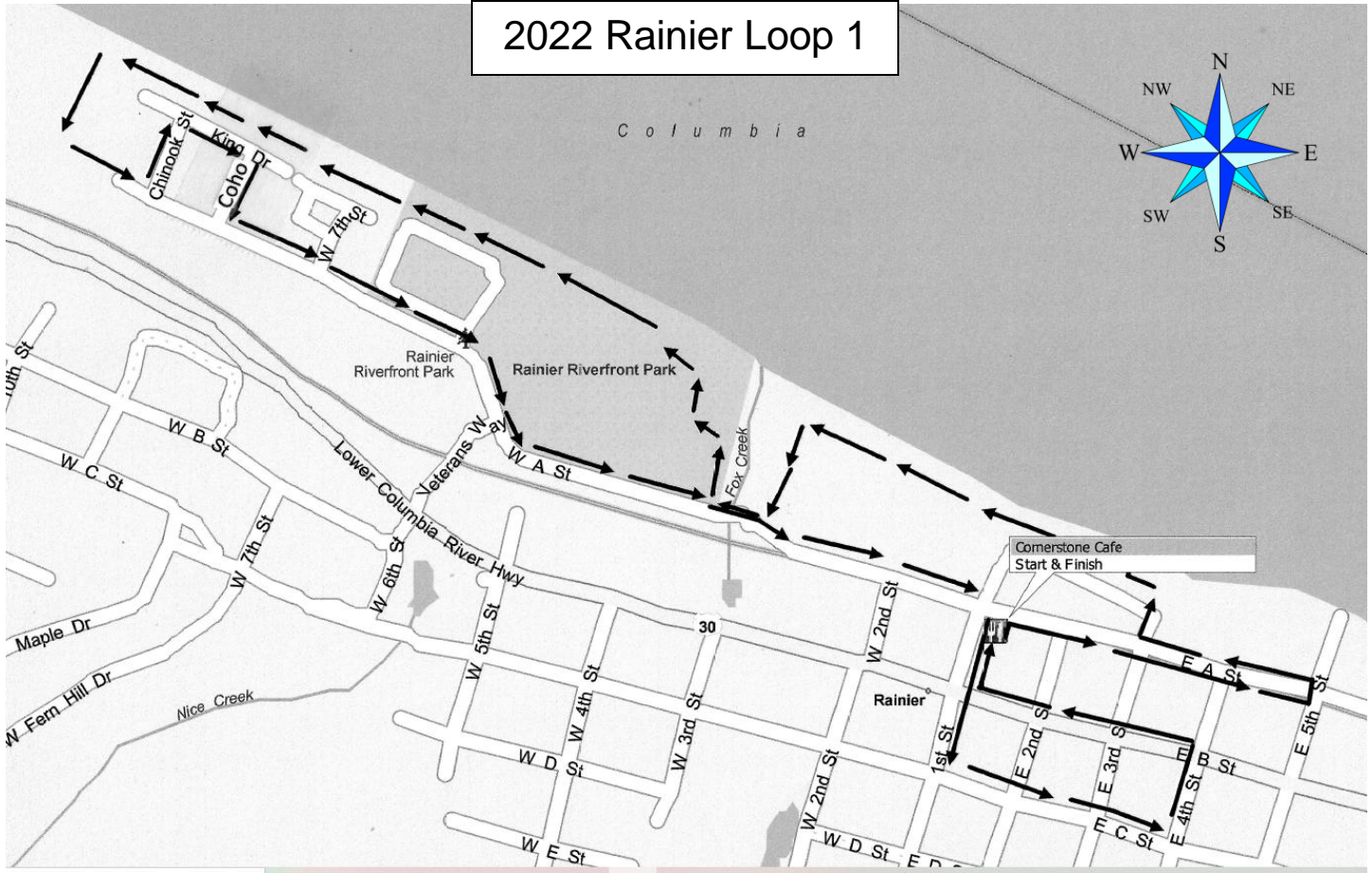
27. Remain on West A St all the way back to the Cornerstone Café at the corner of East A St and East First St.

LOOP 2 – Rainier Town Walk

1. Facing the Cornerstone Café, turn **RIGHT** to West 1st St.
2. **LEFT** on West 1st St.
3. **CROSS** B St at the light and **CROSS** West 1st St.
4. **CONTINUE** on West B St (Hwy 30) past City Hall to the City of Rainier sign.
5. **LEFT** on walkway by the sign.
6. Walk up the hill on West B St curving **LEFT** onto West 13th St.
7. **LEFT** on West C St (at first intersection.)
8. **CROSS** the bridge that was built in 1911 continuing on West C St.
9. **CONTINUE** uphill passing West 3rd St to East 3rd St. (***West changes to East at 1st St.*)
10. **RIGHT** on East 3rd St.
11. **LEFT** on East D St.
12. **LEFT** on East 8th St.
13. **LEFT** on East C St.
14. **LEFT** on East 4th St.
15. **RIGHT** on East D St.
16. **RIGHT** on East 2nd St.
17. **LEFT** on East C St.
18. **RIGHT** on West 1st St.
19. **CROSS** West B St at the traffic light and walk back to the Cornerstone Café to finish.
