

# HISTORIC EAST NASHVILLE WALK

## The Tuck-a-See Wanderers Welcomes you to The Historic East Nashville Walk An AVA Year Round Event

East Nashville is home to beautifully restored Victorian and Craftsman homes, picturesque shopping, and eclectic dining. The walk is a 5K or 10K city walk.

### START POINT:

Edgefield Baptist Church, 700 Russell St., Nashville, TN 37206

### DIRECTIONS TO START:

From I-24 East or West take Exit 49, Shelby Ave., Nissan Stadium. Turn Right onto Shelby Ave. Turn Left on 7th Ave. Seventh Ave ends and turns right onto Russell St. The Church is at South 7<sup>th</sup> St. and Russell St. Parking is available on Russell St. across from the church.

### Walk Registration:

Registration takes place online using the AVA Online Start Box (OSB) on my.ava.org. Follow the instructions provided to create a user account and sign the AVA Waiver (one time). Instructions for payment are also included. Download the directions and print as needed. A fee of \$2 is deducted from the user's Event Bank for the downloaded PDF directions. The \$2 PDF fee is credited back to the user's Event Bank when the walk completion information is submitted. Note that the \$2 "coupon" for the downloaded PDF expires in 60 days. The POC does not provide event directions or accept alternate payment methods.

### Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Once you have physically completed the walk, login to your Online Start Box account on the "My Start Box" tab, then the "Finish Table" tab, then click on "Go To Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped "Virtual" insert cards that you may choose to print. The OSB system will then deduct the \$3 walking fee from the user's Event Bank. (The \$2 PDF fee will be credited back to the user's Event Bank as long as the event is finished within the 60 days from registration.)

restaurants along the route.

### Walk Directions:

1. Facing Edgefield Baptist Church go RIGHT to S 7<sup>th</sup> St.
2. LEFT on S 7<sup>th</sup> St.
3. CROSS Fatherland St.
  - a. At Fatherland St and 7<sup>th</sup> St the Sky Blue Café was once H.G.Hill Grocery.
4. CROSS Boscobel St.
5. LEFT on Shelby Ave.
6. CROSS S 8<sup>th</sup> St.
7. LEFT on S 9<sup>th</sup> St.
8. LEFT on Boscobel St. **(1 K)**
9. RIGHT on S 8<sup>th</sup> St.
10. RIGHT on Fatherland St.
11. CROSS S 9<sup>th</sup>, Prospect, and S 10<sup>th</sup> Sts.
12. RIGHT on S 11<sup>th</sup> St. **(2 K)**
  - a. Wax Nashville at the corner of Fatherland and S 11<sup>th</sup> St occupies a corner space of what was an H.G. Hill Grocery.
13. CROSS Lillian St.
  - a. Craftsman bungalow at 316 S 11<sup>th</sup> St. circa 1925 was built for William "Buck" and Victoria Green. Buck Green played trap drums initially for a traveling circus, the in area theaters. House renovated 2012.
14. CROSS Boscobel Sts.
15. LEFT on Shelby Ave.
  - a. See the Shelby Ave Baptist Church on Right. The Edgefield Church (Start Point) is the mother church for Shelby church.
16. CROSS S 12<sup>th</sup>, S 13<sup>th</sup>, S 14<sup>th</sup>, and S 15<sup>th</sup> Sts.
  - a. See unusual home on right at Shelby and 15<sup>th</sup> St. Note corrugated siding and rain barrel.
17. CROSS S 16<sup>th</sup> St. **(3 K)**
18. CROSS S 17<sup>th</sup> and S 18<sup>th</sup> Sts.
19. LEFT on 19<sup>th</sup> St.
20. CROSS Boscobel and Lillian Sts. Passing Shelby Park on your right.
21. LEFT on Fatherland St.
22. CROSS S 18<sup>th</sup> and S 17<sup>th</sup> Sts.
  - a. See 1628 Fatherland St former H.G.Hill Store (17<sup>th</sup> and Fatherland). **(4 K)**  
H.G.Hill operated a number of neighborhood grocery stores generally located on the right side of the street as one would leave town. Bus riders would step off the bus and onto the H.G.Hill property to buy their daily groceries on their way home from work. This store opened in 1926 and remained opened for 70 years until 1996. In January 2013 it was purchased for Olive and Sinclair Chocolate Co.
23. CROSS S 16<sup>th</sup> and S 15<sup>th</sup> Sts.
24. RIGHT on 14<sup>th</sup> St. (Restroom at 4-Way Market)
25. RIGHT on Russell St. There are no sidewalks on a section of this street. Please walk on the left facing traffic. **(5 K)**
26. CROSS S 15<sup>th</sup> and S 16<sup>th</sup> Sts.
27. LEFT on S 17<sup>th</sup> St. (5.3 K)

28. CROSS Russell St.
29. LEFT on Holly St. for a short “jog” to rejoin S 17<sup>th</sup> St.
30. RIGHT on S 17<sup>th</sup> St.
  - a. *See Lockeland Elementary School on right.*
31. CROSS Woodland St.
32. LEFT on Forest Ave.
33. RIGHT on N 16<sup>th</sup> St. **(6 K)**
34. CROSS Garland Ave, Ordway Pl. and McEwen Ave.
35. LEFT on Stratton Ave.
36. CROSS N 15<sup>th</sup> St.
  - a. *See 1423 Stratton Ave., Warsham-Gillespie-Nixon House. This 2 story Folk Victorian was built in 1899 and was renovated in 2006 and 2011.*
  - b. *See 1422 Stratton Ave., Spain Booker-Porter House. This 1 story Folk Victorian house was originally occupied in 1898 by the Spains. Albert Bushrad “A Bush”, his wife, Mary Louise “Lulu”, and their son Bernett “Bernie”. Mr. Spain was born in Nashville, kept books for a living, and served as an elected Justice of the Peace with an office on Nashville’s Public Square.*
37. LEFT on N 14<sup>th</sup> St. **(7 K)**
38. CROSS Calvin Ave., Ordway Pl., Garland Ave, and Forrest Ave.
39. LEFT on Woodland St. (Restroom at 4-Stop Market)
  - a. *See Lipstick Lounge on corner of N 14<sup>th</sup> St.*
40. CROSS S 15<sup>th</sup> St.
  - a. *See 1520 Woodland St., a former H.G. Hill Grocery.*
41. RIGHT on S 16<sup>th</sup> St.
  - a. *See Top O’Woodland B&B on corner of S 16<sup>th</sup> St.*
42. RIGHT on Holly St. **(8 K)**
  - a. *See old Fire Hall on corner of S 16<sup>th</sup> St and Holly St.*
  - b. *See 1515 Holly St. The James and Eugenia Lester House is a Tudor Revival house built in 1928 for James and Eugenia Lester. Mr. James was a police officer. Renovated 2004-2005.*
43. CROSS S 15<sup>th</sup> and S 14<sup>th</sup> Sts.
44. LEFT on S 13<sup>th</sup> St.
  - a. *See East End United Methodist Church on the corner of S 13<sup>th</sup> St and Holly St.*
45. RIGHT on Russell St.
46. CROSS S 12<sup>th</sup> St.
47. RIGHT on S 11<sup>th</sup> St
48. CROSS Holly St.
49. LEFT on Woodland St. Note: This is a 5 street intersection known as Five Points. Woodland is the first street on your left. **(9 K)**
50. LEFT on S 10<sup>th</sup> St.
51. RIGHT on Russell St.
52. CROSS S 9<sup>th</sup> and S 8<sup>th</sup> Sts.
53. ARRIVE at Edgefield Baptist Church, 700 Russell St.

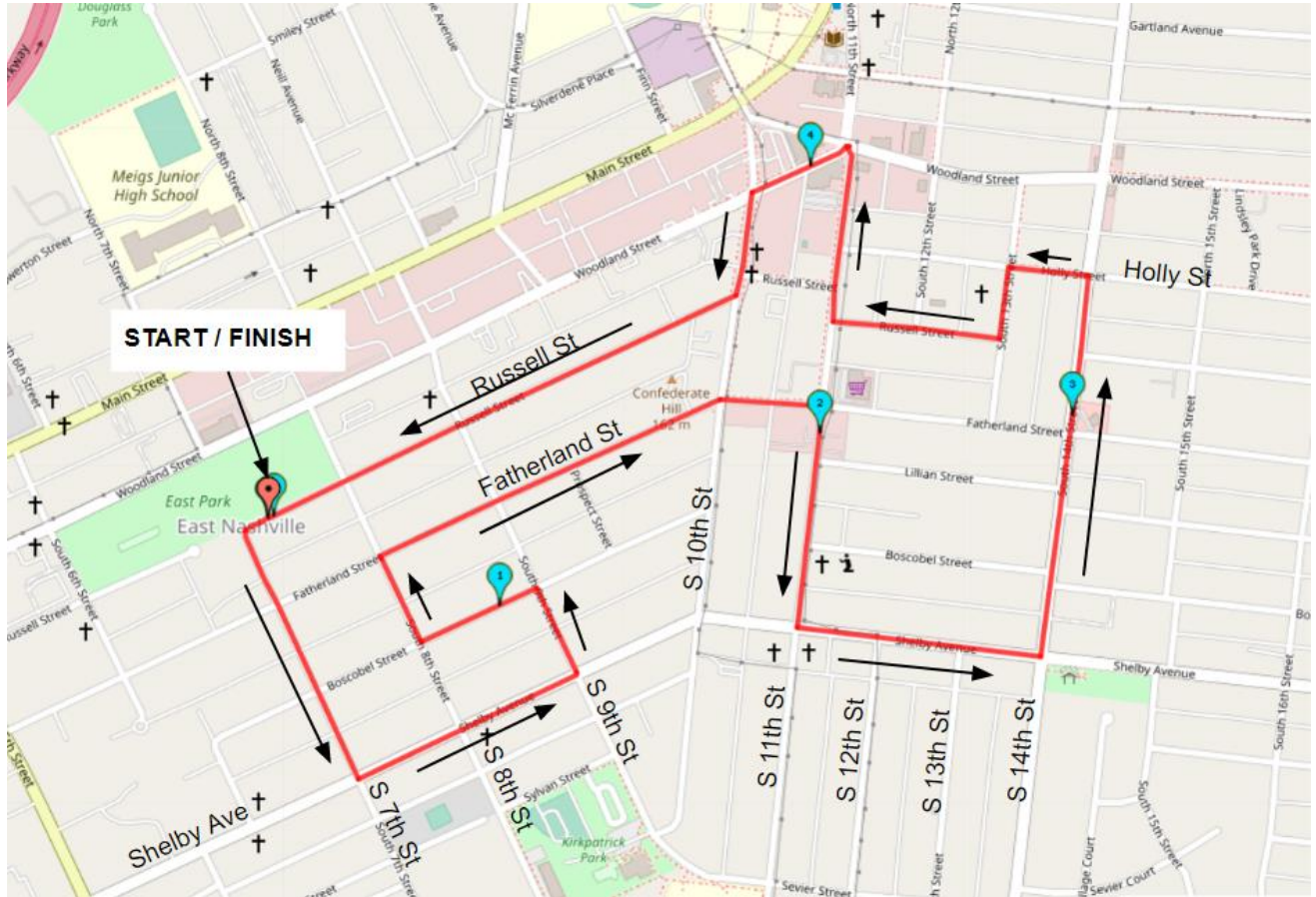
1. Facing Edgefield Baptist Church go RIGHT to S 7<sup>th</sup> St.
2. LEFT on S 7<sup>th</sup> St.
3. CROSS Fatherland St.
  - a. At Fatherland St and 7<sup>th</sup> St the Sky Blue Café was once H.G.Hill Grocery.
4. CROSS Boscobel St.
5. LEFT on Shelby Ave.
6. CROSS S 8<sup>th</sup> St.
7. LEFT on S 9<sup>th</sup> St.
8. LEFT on Boscobel St. (1 K)
9. RIGHT on S 8<sup>th</sup> St.
10. RIGHT on Fatherland St.
11. CROSS S 9<sup>th</sup>, Prospect, and S 10<sup>th</sup> Sts.
12. RIGHT on S 11<sup>th</sup> St. (2 K)
  - a. Wax Nashville at the corner of Fatherland and S 11<sup>th</sup> St occupies a

corner space of what once was once an H.G.Hill Grocery.

13. CROSS Lillian St.
  - a. Craftsman bungalow at 316 S 11<sup>th</sup> St. circa 1925 was built for William "Buck" and Victoria Green. Buck Green played trap drums initially for a traveling circus, the in area theaters. House renovated 2012.
14. CROSS Boscobel St.
15. LEFT on Shelby Ave.
  - a. See the Shelby Ave Baptist Church on Right. The Edgefield Church (Start Point) is the mother church for Shelby church.
16. CROSS S 12<sup>th</sup> and S 13<sup>th</sup> Sts.
17. LEFT on S 14<sup>th</sup> St.
  - a. Shelby Walk Park on corner of Shelby Ave and S 14<sup>th</sup> St.
18. CROSS Boscobel, Lillian, Fatherland (Restrooms at 4 Way Market) (3 K), and Russell Sts.
19. LEFT on Holly St.
20. LEFT on S 13<sup>th</sup> St.
  - a. See East End United Methodist Church
21. RIGHT on Russell St.
22. CROSS S 12<sup>th</sup> St.
23. RIGHT on S 11<sup>th</sup> St
24. CROSS Holly St.
25. LEFT on Woodland St. (4 K) Note: This is a 5 street intersection known as Five Points. Woodland is the first street on your left.
26. LEFT on S 10<sup>th</sup> St.
27. RIGHT on Russell St.
28. CROSS S 9<sup>th</sup> and S 8<sup>th</sup> Sts.
29. ARRIVE at Edgefield Baptist Church, 700 Russell St.
