



The Riverside Walk

An AVA Sanctioned Year Round Event

This walk offers a 5K and a 11k option and is rated 2A. Walk goes through town past the famous Mission Inn (where President Nixon was married) and the 11 K goes up to the top of Mt. Rubidoux. You can see across the city from there. There are many restaurants and interesting shops on the Main St. Mall. Riverside is hot during summer months. Carry water and walk early in the day

Walk Registration:

Registration takes place online using that AVA Online Start Box, on my.ava.org. Follow the instructions provided to create a user account and sign the AVA waiver (one time). Instructions for payment are also included. Download the directions and print as needed. The POC does not provide event directions or accept alternate payment methods.

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Once you have physically completed the walk, please login to your Online Start Box account click on the "My Start Box" tab, then the "Finish Table" tab, then click on "Go to Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped "virtual" insert cards that you may choose to print out.

Driving Directions to Start

Riverside Community Hospital- 4445 Magnolia, Riverside, CA. From Hwy 91, exit 14th. West towards town to Magnolia. Left on Magnolia, 1 block to 1st traffic signal. Turn right to parking lot. There are restrooms in the medical center.

Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.

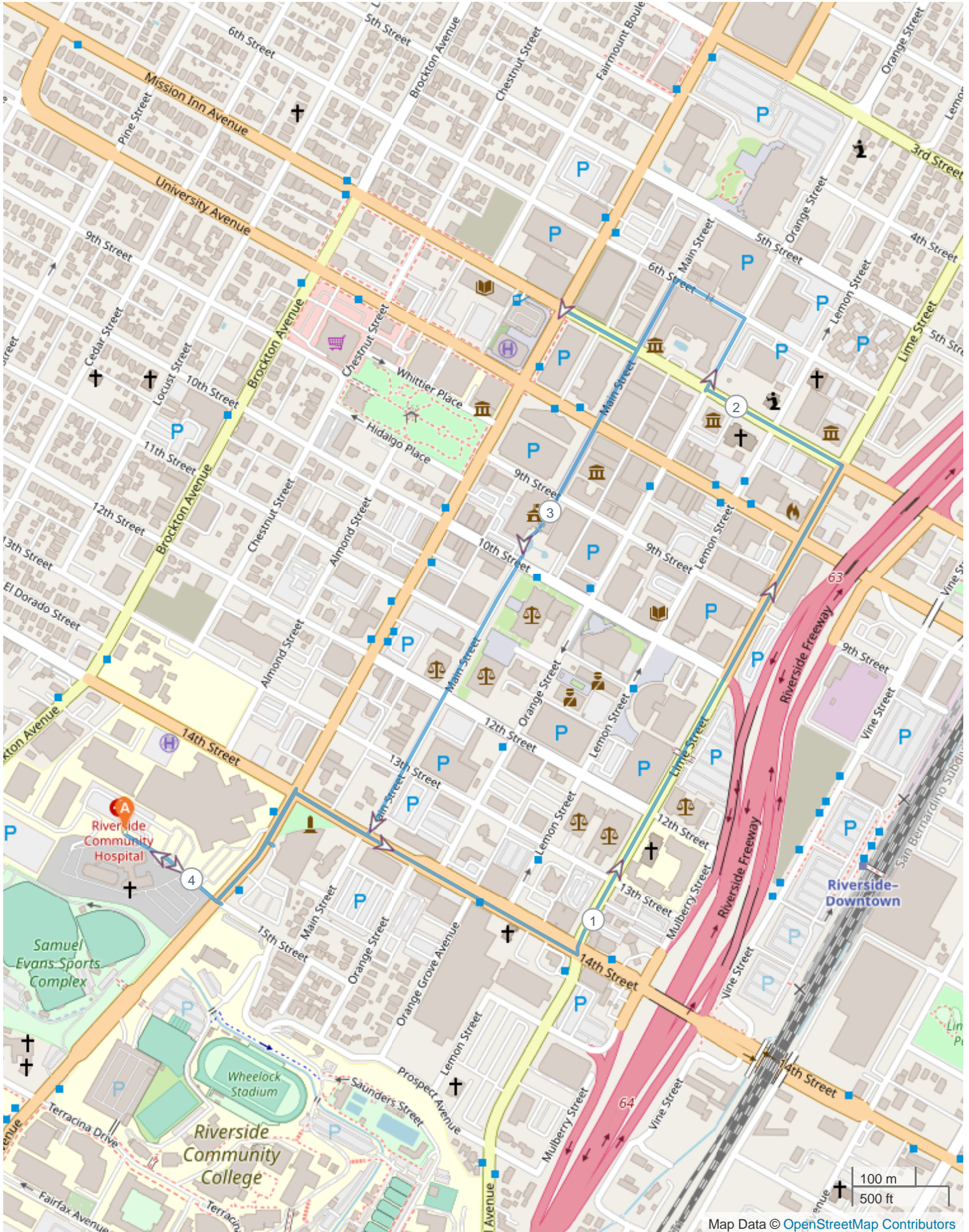

Riverside 5K

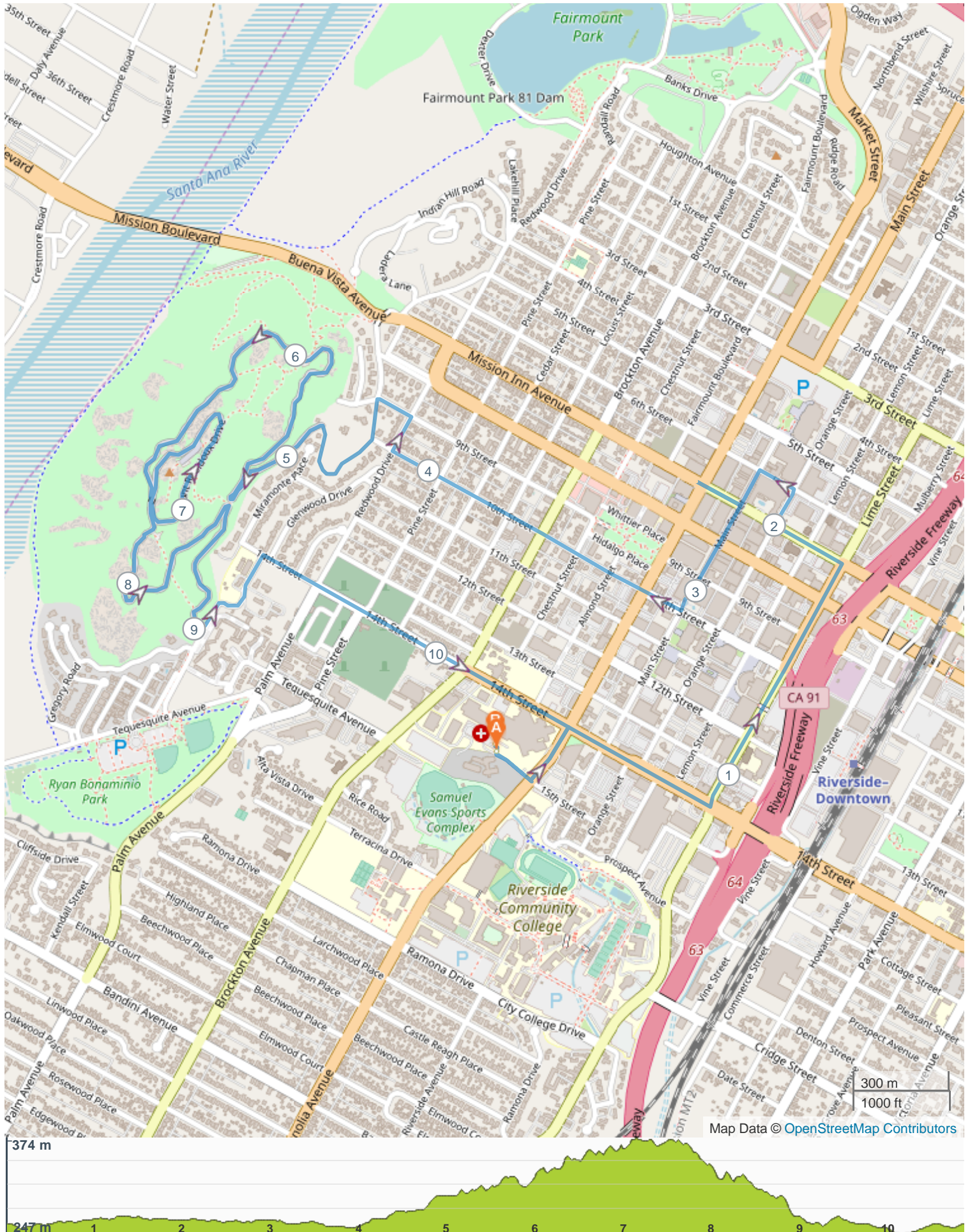

1	0.000		From the Hospital head to Magnolia
2	0.195	←	Cross Magnolia at the stop light and turn left
3	0.317	→	Just before the corner of 14th St, veer right on the sidewalk at the end of a brick bldg. Riverside Sports Hall of Fame (baseball).
4	0.518	→	Follow the sidewalk out onto 14th St and turn right
5	0.937	↙	Turn sharp left onto Lime to Mission Inn Ave
6	1.807	←	Turn left onto Mission Inn Avenue to Orange. You will pass the Unitarian Church and the Congregational Church. You can get a Golden Heritage stamp at eh Museum on the Corner of Orange and Mission Inn Ave
7	2.051	→	Turn right onto Orange Street to 6th
8	2.184	←	Turn left onto 6th Street to Main St.
9	2.309	→	Turn left onto Main Street to Mission Inn Ave. (Bakery on left)
10	2.439	→	Turn right onto Mission Inn Avenue to Market St. (Fox Theater)
11	2.571		Turn left onto crossing Market Street then make a u turn and head back toward Main St
12	2.713	→	Turn right onto Main Street through Mall to 10th. Courthouse on corner of 10th & Main erected in 1903, Veteran Memorial on the corner north of the Court house, Rose Garden, next to the Courthouse
13	3.587	→	Turn right onto 14th Street to Market
14	3.719	←	Turn left onto Market Street
15	4.126		Return to the Start point

1	0.000		Start at hospital and head to Magnolia Ave. Cross Magnolia at stop light
2	0.151	←	Turn left onto Magnolia Avenue
3	0.283	→	Go almost to corner veering right on the sidewalk at the end of a brick bldg. Riverside Sports Hall of Fame (baseball). Follow the sidewalk out to 14th St
4	0.444	→	Turn right onto 14th Street to Lime
5	0.879	↙	Turn sharp left onto Lime St to Mission Inn Ave
6	1.749	←	Turn left onto Mission Inn Avenue to Orange. You may get a Golden Heritage Stamp at the Museum (corner of Orange and Mission Inn Ave)
7	2.015	→	Turn right onto Orange Street to 6th St
8	2.141	←	Turn left onto 6th Street to Main St
9	2.266	←	Turn left onto Main Street to Mission Inn Avenue. (Bakery on the left)
10	2.391	→	Turn right onto Mission Inn Avenue to Market St. (Fox theater)
11	2.528	↓	At Market, cross Mission Inn Ave and turn around to head back toward Main St
12	2.703	→	Turn right onto Main Street through the Mall to 10th. Courthouse on corner of 10th& Main erected in 1903, Veteran Memorial on the corner north of the Courthouse, Rose Garden next to the Courthouse
13	3.087	→	Turn right onto 10th Street, crossing Market & Brocton, to Redwood.
14	4.121	→	Turn right onto Redwood Drive to 9th
15	4.243	←	Turn left onto 9th Street. Walk on the left side of the street to the entrance to Mt. Rubidoux Park. Enter through the gates on the left. Trail open regardless of sign
16	4.372	←	Enter through the gates on the left. Trail open regardless of sign onto Mount Rubidoux Drive. You will be on a paved road all the way up and down the mountain
17	5.230	→	Continue up the road. At the huge rock where the trail divides, stay to the right making a sharp right turn. Go up the hill on the 'up' road
18	6.824		Continue up the road and go under the Ben Lewis Bridge
19	7.252		'Peace Tower'. Check Point: What are the two words on the rock arch?
20	7.444	↗	Continue around until you get to the amphitheater which is used for Easter Sunrise Services. You might enjoy the view from this point or climb up to the 'Cross'
21	7.726	↖	Then continue down the road over the wooden bridge and down again
22	8.534	↘	You will get to a place where you almost meet the 'up' road, but make a sharp turn (around the rock to the right and continue down to street (Glenwood)
23	9.065	←	Turn left onto Glenwood Drive to 14th
24	9.385	→	Turn right onto 14th Street. Stay left facing traffic. On your left is the Evergreen Cemetery. There you will find the grave of Frank Miller, founder of the Mission Inn
25	10.483	→	Turn right onto Magnolia Avenue and head back to hospital
26	10.855		Finish at start point
