

Instructions for
Salish Ponds, Y-1489
5 & 10 Km, rated 1B

Walk Start Location: Fred Meyer Store at 22855 NE Park Lane, Wood Village, OR 97060.

GPS Coords: 45.53004, -122.42867

Driving Directions: From I-84 east or west bound, take Exit 14 from the freeway. From the west, turn right on 207th to NE Halsey St, turn left to 223rd Ave. Turn right to Park Ln. Turn left with signal at Park Ln, and follow the drive to the Fred Meyer Store. Use the second entrance, just past the drive thru pharmacy. From the east, exit the freeway at Exit 14 and turn left on 207th and follow directions above. You can take bus #12 Sandy to Troutdale and get off at Wood Village Shopping Center.

Park: Store parking area away from the store.

Restrooms available at start, Salish Ponds and Target store.

Walk Completion and Credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

"Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB."

"These maps and directions may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited."

AVA Challenges: Walking USA A-Z. Walk Oregon Challenges: Nature, Roses, Statues, Unique, Yogurt, Zeroes, Zone. Other challenges mentioned in the instructions.ESVA: Front Line Heros: Sustenance Providers, Essential Services, Medical Services.

1. From the front door of the Wood Village Fred Meyer Store (**Spas & salons – Great Clips**), turn right and follow the sidewalk as it curves and goes out Park Lane to 223rd Avenue. Cross 223rd at Park Lane with the signal light and turn left on 223rd to Glisan Street.
2. Turn right on Glisan Street to NE Market Drive and the entrance to Fairview Village. Turn right on Market Drive into Fairview Village.
3. Continue on NE Market Drive past NE Clear Creek Way. **1K** at 844 NE Market Drive.
4. Turn right on NE Clear Creek Way (Streets in New Fairview make loops!!) and cross the street. Just beyond 810 NE Clear Creek Way, turn left on paved path over the little bridge to the end of the path. Make a sharp right turn to circle the cul-de-sac. Go completely around the cul-de-sac Fettzer Park and past 924 NE Pacific Drive.
5. Continue on NE Pacific Drive which becomes NE Park Lane. Veer right –take sidewalk through park Stone Park and turn left at the water fountain.

6. Cross NE Multnomah, stay on Park Lane to NE Chinook Way.
 7. Turn right on NE Chinook Way to NE Charles Ct. Pvt. **2K** at 1380 Charles St. Pvt.
 8. Circle the cul-de-sac, and exit back onto NE Chinook Way. Turn left and follow the sidewalk back to NE Market Drive at NE Chinook Way.
 9. Cross NE Market Drive (Icicle Park) and turn right. Follow the sidewalk around to the corner of NE Market Dr.
 10. Cross Village. Continue on NE Market Drive past the shops on the left. Post is on the right of NE Market Drive. Turn left on NE Park Lane. Cross the street.
 11. Follow NE Park Lane toward the Fairview Community Park. Be sure to stop a minute to appreciate the Roger A. Vonderharr Pavilion in the Fairview Community Park. **3K** at 1307 NE Park Lane.
 12. Go left on NE Park Lane to the little path that leads to the Alex Brown Bridge and to Salish Ponds Wetlands Park. Follow the designated trail. Follow the “Trail to Ponds” sign, over a small wooden bridge, past the back side of Target on your right.
 13. Continue on the trail under the NE 207th Avenue overpass.
- Note: Following heavy rains, the portion of the trail to the ponds just beyond the northwest corner of Target may have standing water. You may get around that by returning to the Target parking lot. Walk to Halsey Street, turn left and continue to 207th Avenue. Cross 207th and turn left, and take the path around a barrier gate to the right of the sidewalk. This road will take you down hill to the bridge just to the right (west) of the overpass. Turn right to cross the bridge and return to the trail. 4K as you approach second curve after wooden bridge.***
14. At the “Y” in the trail, go right, circling the Pond counterclockwise.

15. Continue circling the pond on the gravel trail as you walk along the fence beside Glisan Street. **5K** about 50 feet before curving left around end of pond.
16. Continue circling pond back to the "Y". Bear right to return on the same path to the little bridge just before Fairview Parkway overpass.
17. At the bridge, bear left and follow the blacktop road uphill to the barrier gate. Pass around the end of the barrier and go to the sidewalk on your right. Turn left and continue on Fairview Parkway to Halsey Street.
18. With the signal lights, cross Halsey Street, turn right and cross Fairview Parkway. **6K** at corner after crossing 207th Avenue.
19. Continue on Halsey Street to 213th Avenue. Cross NE 213th.
20. Stay on 213th to the end of the street and Cleone Park. Turn right and go through the park, bearing right at first inter-section.
21. Exit park and turn right on cul-de-sac (214th Avenue--unmarked) to San Rafael. Cross San Rafael and turn right.
22. Turn left on the path to the right of 21328 San Rafael to NE Hancock St. Turn left on NE Hancock Street which turns into Cedar Street. **7K @ 730 NE Hancock.**
23. Turn left on 4th and then right on Main.
24. Right on 1st Street, past Handy Park.
NOTE: The jail house and memorial to the Handy Family. The jail house was in the original City Hall.
25. Right on Cedar Street to 4th Street. Small brick building on 1st and Cedar is the old Fairview Post Office. **8K** at 135 Cedar Street.
26. Left on 3rd Street to Harrison Street. Left on Harrison Street, across the street at the old City Hall (large white building at 300 Harrison, now the Fairview Community Center), to 2nd Street.
27. Right on 2nd Street to Fairview Avenue (223rd Avenue). Left on Lincoln to Fairview Ave. Right on Fairview Avenue/223rd Str. Continue on 223rd to Park Lane. **9K** prior to 40 Mile Speed sign.
28. Turn left at the Park Lane signal light to return to the sidewalk leading to Fred Meyer Store and the FINISH POINT.

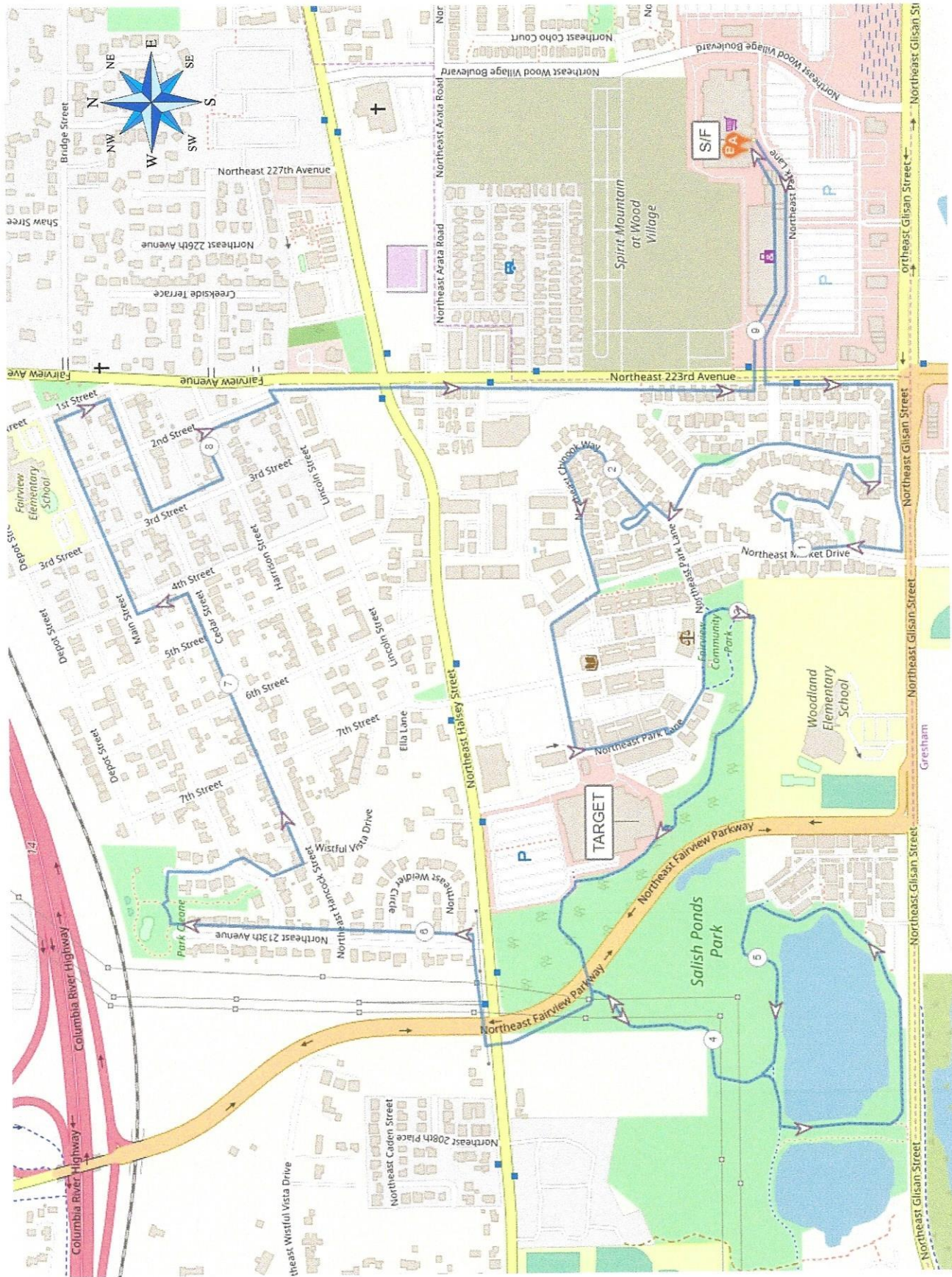

AVA Challenges: Walking USA – A-Z; Walk Oregon Challenges: Nature, Roses, Statues, Spas & Salons, Unique, Yogurt, Zeroes. ESVA: Front Line Heros: Sustenance Provider, Essential Services, Medical Facility.

1. From the front door of the Wood Village Fred Meyer Store turn right and follow the sidewalk as it curves and goes out Park Lane to 223rd Avenue. Cross 223rd at Park Lane with the signal light and proceed straight ahead into Fairview Village on Park Lane until you come to Park Lane.
2. At stop sign, Park Lane curves right. Stay on Park Lane. Cross stone bridge and continue straight ahead to Fairview Community Park.
3. Turn left and enter park on the little path that leads to the Alex Brown Bridge and to Salish Ponds Wetlands Park. Follow the designated trail. Follow the "Trail to Ponds" sign (**IK**), over a small wooden bridge, past the back side of Target on your right.
4. Continue on the trail under the NE 207th Avenue overpass.

Note: Following heavy rains, the portion of the trail to the ponds just beyond the northwest corner of Target may have standing water. You may get around that by returning to the Target parking lot. Walk to Halsey St., turn left and continue to 207th Avenue. Cross 207th and turn left, and take the path around a barrier gate to the right of the sidewalk. This road will take you down hill to the

bridge just to the right (west) of the overpass. Turn right to cross the bridge and return to the trail.

5. At the "Y" in the trail, go left, circling the pond clockwise. (**2K** at Porta Potty)
6. Continue circling the pond on the gravel trail as you walk along the fence beside Glisan Street.
7. Continue circling pond back to the "Y" keep bearing right. (**3k** when passing Porta Potty again). After the Porta Potty turn left to return on the same path to the little bridge just before the 207th Avenue overpass.
8. Continue on the path past the back side of Target on your left. Cross the small wooden bridge and past the "Trail to Ponds" sign (**4K**)
9. Re-cross the Alex Brown Bridge and exit Fairview Community Park.
10. Turn right on Park Lane, cross Market Place and stay on Park Lane as it curves right.
11. When Park Lane intersects Pacific Drive, cross Park Lane and turn left. It is now Park Avenue. Continue on Park Avenue to 223rd Avenue. Cross 223rd Avenue with signal light and proceed through parking lot to the finish point at Fred Meyer.
