In case of Emergency: Dial 911

Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match. For example, if you register using the OSB, do not complete your event by using the PSB (nor sign the PSB log sheet). The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.

Be sure to log back into the OSB system to 'finish/complete' your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date of the event, the distance, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.) Also note that an event registration expires after 30 days, but if your registrations lapses, you may re-register without cost.

Physical Start Box/Start Point: Best Western Plus InnTowner Madison - 2424 University Avenue, Madison, Wisconsin 53726

Driving to the Start Box/Start Point: Request the Box at the Reception counter. From the Beltline (US-12/18) exit on Midvale Blvd. Go north on Midvale to University Ave. (approx. 2.5 miles). Go east (right) on University continuing on University Ave, bearing right at Campus Drive/University Ave. split. Turn left on Highland. The Inn Towner will be on the right. 1-800-258-8321 (reservations only, 10% room discount for walkers).

Restrooms, food, and drinks available at the start point.

Exit Best Western Plus InnTowner lobby. Turn

1. **L** to University Av. Turn
2. **R** on University Av to Highland Av at the lights. Turn
3. **L** on Highland Av, crossing University Av. Continue straight on Highland Av. Cross and immediately turn
4. **L** on Kendall Av. Cross Chestnut St and Walnut St. Cross and turn
5. **R** on Allen St. Cross and turn
6. **L** on Chamberlain Av. Cross Bascom Pl. (*You are now in the University Heights Historic District. When it was developed, it became a choice location for professors and university administrators.*) Cross and turn
7. **R** on Forest St. (*The land and the English-style brick Olin House to the left, behind the metal fence, is the official residence of the University of Wisconsin-Madison chancellor.*) By a fire hydrant, cross Bascom St and continue on Prospect Av to Van Hise Av.

(On the right-hand corner, at 106, is the Harold C. Bradley House. This was designed in the office of Chicago architect Louis Sullivan and is on the NRHP. This is one of the masterpieces of Prairie School design and one of Madison's most important architectural landmarks. Best known for his pioneering skyscraper designs, this is one of Sullivan's last works, and one of his very rare residential

designs. He was the mentor of Wisconsin native architect Frank Lloyd Wright.) [1K] Turn

8. **L** on Van Hise, crossing Prospect Av. Immediately turn
9. **L** on Prospect Av. Continue on Prospect Av as it curves right. You will get a better view of the UW chancellor's residence across the street. Cross Roby Rd and veer left.

(At 137, note plaque at base of tree for the Prairie-style Edward C. Elliott House. As you veer right on Ely Pl, note plaque for the Eugene A. Gilmore House, designed by Frank Lloyd Wright.)

Continue going right on Ely Pl. (*The first house on the left, 115, was the first home built on the crown of University Heights in 1894. The last house on the left on this block, 101, is a superb example of an international-style house.*) Prior to Summit Av, turn

10. **L** and go down steps, crossing Ely Pl. Veer
11. **L** on Summit Av. (*Note plaque on ground at corner for the international-style house.*) Cross Spooner St. Cross Lathrop St to Breese Ter. **CAREFULLY** cross Breese Ter in the crosswalk. Turn
12. **R** on Breese Ter. At a break in the metal fence, turn
13. **L** at the Ho-Chunk Nation Plaza overhead sign. Continue straight on the concrete, with Camp Randall Stadium on the right. (*Note stones on left by a parking*

ramp high-lighting Rose Bowl championships.) [2K] Pass the Stephen M. Bennett Student-Athlete Performance Center as you walk on a pedestrian mall.

At the corner of the building, continue straight. Prior to walking under a stone arch, note informational sign on right. (*The arch was dedicated in 1912 to honor Wisconsin's Civil War soldiers.*) Continue to Randall Av. (*If in need of restrooms, cross Randall Av and turn left to Union South, the last building on this block. The main entrance is near corner of Randall Av and Campus Drive.*) Turn

14. R on Randall Av for a few steps and turn

15. R onto a concrete path into Camp Randall Memorial Park. (*This area is a small part of what was a Civil War military training camp through which some 70,000 Wisconsinites and nearly 4,000 Confederate prisoners of war would pass. It was also used as a training facility during World War I.*) At intersection, turn

16. L and note historical marker on the left and a wooden Civil War guardhouse on the right. At Monroe St (no sign) turn

17. R on Monroe St. *Note the 600-pound bronze Fighting Wisconsin Badger statue near the stadium. The sandstone UW Field House on the right has been the site of numerous sporting and community events.*) Turn

18. R on Little St. Cross Breese Ter and continue straight on Regent St. Cross

Lathrop St. [3K] Cross Spooner St (*to the right is Randall School, which is Madison's oldest school in continuous operation*) and immediately turn

19. L crossing Regent St. Continue on Spooner St for one block. Cross and turn

20. R on Rowley Av. Turn

21. L on Commonwealth Av. Cross Prospect Av. Cross Allen St and immediately turn

22. R and cross Commonwealth Av. Immediately turn

23. L on Commonwealth Av. Turn

24. R on Rugby Row. Cross Vista Rd. [4K] Turn

25. R on Virginia Ter. Cross Eton Ridge, Hollister Av, and Rowley Av, to Regent St. Turn

26. L on Regent St. At the overhead All Way Stop, turn

27. R and **CAREFULLY** cross Regent St in the first crosswalk. Continue straight on Highland Av with playing fields for West High School on both sides of the street. Cross Van Hise Av, Joss Ct, Chamberlain Av, and Kendall Av, to University Av. Cross University Av back to the start/finish.

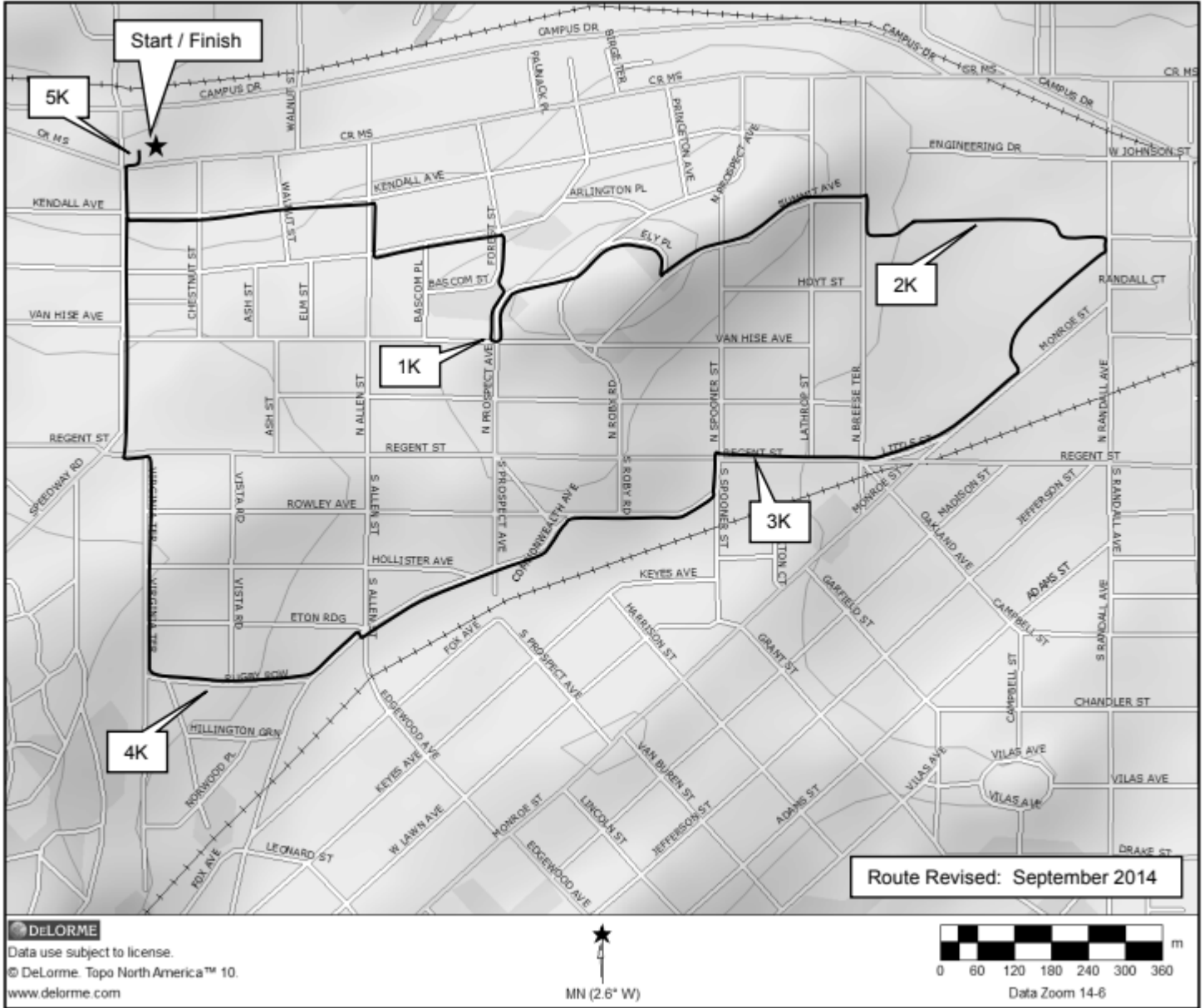

Exit Best Western Plus InnTowner lobby. Turn

1. **L** to University Av. Turn
2. **R** on University Av to Highland Av at the lights. Turn
3. **L** on Highland Av, crossing University Av. Continue straight on Highland Av. Cross and turn
4. **L** on Kendall Av. Cross Chestnut St and Walnut St. Cross and turn
5. **R** on Allen St. Cross and turn
6. **L** on Chamberlain Av. Cross Bascom Pl. (*You are now in the University Heights Historic District. When it was developed, it became a choice location for professors and university administrators.*) Cross and turn
7. **R** on Forest St. (*The land and the English-style brick Olin House to the left, behind the metal fence, is the official residence of the University of Wisconsin-Madison chancellor.*) By a fire hydrant, cross Bascom St and continue on Prospect Av to Van Hise Av.

(On the right-hand corner, at 106, is the Harold C. Bradley House. This was designed in the office of Chicago architect Louis Sullivan and is on the NRHP. This is one of the masterpieces of Prairie School design and one of Madison's most important architectural landmarks. 8. **L** on Van Hise, crossing Prospect Av. Immediately turn
9. **L** on Prospect Av. Continue on Prospect Av as it curves right. You will get a better view of the UW chancellor's residence across the street. Cross Roby Rd and veer left.

(At 137, note plaque at base of tree for the Prairie-style Edward C. Elliott House. As you veer right on Ely Pl, note plaque for the Eugene A. Gilmore House, designed by Frank Lloyd Wright.)

Continue going right on Ely Pl. (*The first house on the left, 115, was the first home built on the crown of University Heights in 1894. The last house on the left on this block, 101, is a superb example of an international-style house.*) Prior to Summit Av, turn

10. **L** and go down steps, crossing Ely Pl. Veer
11. **L** on Summit Av. (*Note plaque on ground at corner for the international-style house.*) Cross Spooner St. Cross Lathrop St to Breese Ter. **CAREFULLY** cross Breese Ter in the crosswalk. Turn
12. **R** on Breese Ter. At a break in the metal fence, turn
13. **L** at the Ho-Chunk Nation Plaza overhead sign. Continue straight on the concrete, with Camp Randall Stadium on the right. (*Note stones on left by a parking ramp high-lighting Rose Bowl championships.*) [2K] Pass the Stephen M. Bennett Student-Athlete Performance Center as you walk on a pedestrian mall.

At the corner of the building, continue straight. Prior to walking under a stone arch, note informational sign on right. (*The arch was dedicated in 1912 to honor Wisconsin's Civil War soldiers.*) Continue to Randall Av. (*If in need of restrooms, cross Randall Av and turn left to Union South, the last building on this block. The main entrance is near intersection of Randall Av and Campus Drive.*) Turn

14. **R** on Randall Av for a few steps and turn
15. **R** onto a concrete path into Camp Randall Memorial Park. (*This area is a small part of what was a Civil War military training camp through which some 70,000 Wisconsinites and nearly 4,000 Confederate prisoners of war would pass. It was also used as a training facility during World War I.*) At intersection, turn
16. **L** and note historical marker on the left and a wooden Civil War guardhouse on the right. At Monroe St (no sign) turn
17. **R** on Monroe St. (*Note the 600-pound bronze Fighting Wisconsin Badger statue near the stadium. The sandstone UW Field House on the right has been the site of numerous sporting and community events.*) Turn
18. **R** on Little St. Cross Breese Ter and continue straight on Regent St. Cross Lathrop St. **[3K]** Cross Spooner St (*to the right is Randall School, which is Madison's oldest school in continuous operation*) and immediately turn
19. **L** crossing Regent St. Continue on Spooner St for one block. Cross and turn
20. **R** on Rowley Av. Turn
21. **L** on Commonwealth Av for a short distance and then turn
22. **L** on a concrete path opposite Harrison St. Cross a bridge. At the end of the path, turn
23. **R** on a ramp down to the South West Bike Path. Turn
24. **L** on this bike path. Pass the exits for Prospect Av and pass under the Edgewood

Av bridge. **[4K]** Follow the bike path across Commonwealth Av and immediately turn

25. **L** on the sidewalk along Commonwealth Av. Turn
26. **R** on Fox Av for a short distance and turn
27. **R** on a concrete path, going into a tunnel under the bike path. Upon coming to a street, walk on the right side. At an intersection, turn
28. **R** and shortly after a fire hydrant, turn
29. **L** and cross Norwood Pl. Continue straight on Hillington Way, with Hillington Green Park on the right. Turn
30. **L** on Rugby Row. Turn
31. **R** on Virginia Ter. Cross Eton Ridge, Hollister Av, and Rowley Av, to Regent St. **[5K]** Turn
32. **L** on Regent St. Veer
33. **L** on Speedway Rd. Take the first sidewalk on the left towards the Forest Hill Cemetery office building. (*Note map of cemetery on back of route map. The office was built in 1908 as a shelter and waiting room for street car customers when Forest Hill was the end of the street car line. In those days, it was fashionable to come to the cemetery for a picnic.*)

Walk on the right side of the office. Follow the road, walking on the left side. (*Forest Hill was established in 1858. It contains the graves of many persons who have played significant roles in the history of the city, the state, and the nation. At the first intersection, note the receiving vault on the left, which was used to store bodies until the spring thaw. On the right is the Catlin Chapel.*)

Continuing straight on the main road, on the left is Union Soldiers Lot. (*This contains the graves of Civil War soldiers, along with eight children who died while living at the Soldiers' Orphans Home in Madison. It is a national cemetery.*)

Just past the mausoleum is Confederate Rest. (*This is the northernmost Confederate*

Cemetery in the U.S.) Continue on the road, and at next intersection, veer

- 34.** L with Section 21 on the right. Pass Sections 23, 24, 25, 20, and 15. At Section 14, veer
- 35.** R right and stay on left side of road. Pass Sections 20, 19, and 12. There will be a flag pole in a grassy triangle – continue to the right of that, with Section 35 on the left, which is a Veterans' Section.

(Veterans' graves are clustered around three effigy mounds in the Forest Hill Cemetery Indian Mound Group. There is also a veterans memorial with a flag pole.) [6K] Turn

- 36.** R between Sections 12 and 38. Go between Sections 11 and 36, pass Section 10, and go between Sections 40 and 50. At Sections 44 and 42, continue straight on an asphalt path. At Speedway Rd turn
- 37.** L with Glenway Golf Course on the left. *(This is city-owned and there are seasonal restrooms in the clubhouse and there is a gas station across the street.)* Cross Glenway St at the lights and immediately turn
- 38.** R crossing Mineral Point Rd. Immediately turn
- 39.** R and cross Glenway St. Immediately turn
- 40.** L on Glenway St. Cross Hammersley Av, [7K] Ross St, and Hillcrest Dr. Cross Zwerg Dr and immediately turn
- 41.** L crossing Glenway St. Take the short asphalt path and walk on the right of the playground into Reservoir Park. Go up the grassy hill towards a tower. Walk through the basketball court to Larkin St. Cross Larkin St and walk on Plymouth Cir.

This is the Sunset Hills development, a dense collection of Modern homes mostly built between 1953 and 1965. Deed restrictions required that the houses respect the topography, be constructed of a mixture of

masonry, wood, and other materials, be of "contemporary or modern design", and be designed by an architect. Many of the fronts feature small windows as the larger windows are in the back overlooking their back yards. Many also have flat roofs.)

Pass Alden Dr and Priscilla Ln. Cross Larkin St and turn

- 42.** R on Larkin St. [8K] Shortly after passing Priscilla Ln on the right and after crossing a driveway, turn
- 43.** L on a grassy path into a wooded area of Reservoir Park. Stay on path to the left, going uphill. The dirt trail may be slippery when wet. *(At the top of the hill, the open area to the right is on top of a 6,000,000 gallon reservoir, nicknamed "The Rez". This is Madison Water Utility's oldest operating facility.)*

Walk on the woodchip trail (slippery when wet) and take steps down to the street, with a pumping station on the right. Cross and turn

- 44.** L on Glenway St. Cross Ridge Rd to Regent St. Carefully cross Regent St and immediately turn
- 45.** R on Regent St. Cross Franklin Av. At Farley Av *(to the right is Resurrection Catholic Cemetery. Chris Farley, Madison native, actor, and comedian, is entombed in the main mausoleum),* turn
- 46.** L on Farley Av. Cross [9K] Mason St, Van Hise Av, and Chamberlain Av, to Kendall Av. Turn
- 47.** R on Kendall Av. Cross Grand Av to Highland Av. Turn
- 48.** L on Highland Av to University Av. Turn
- 49.** R crossing Highland Av and immediately turn
- 50.** L crossing University Av back to the start/finish.

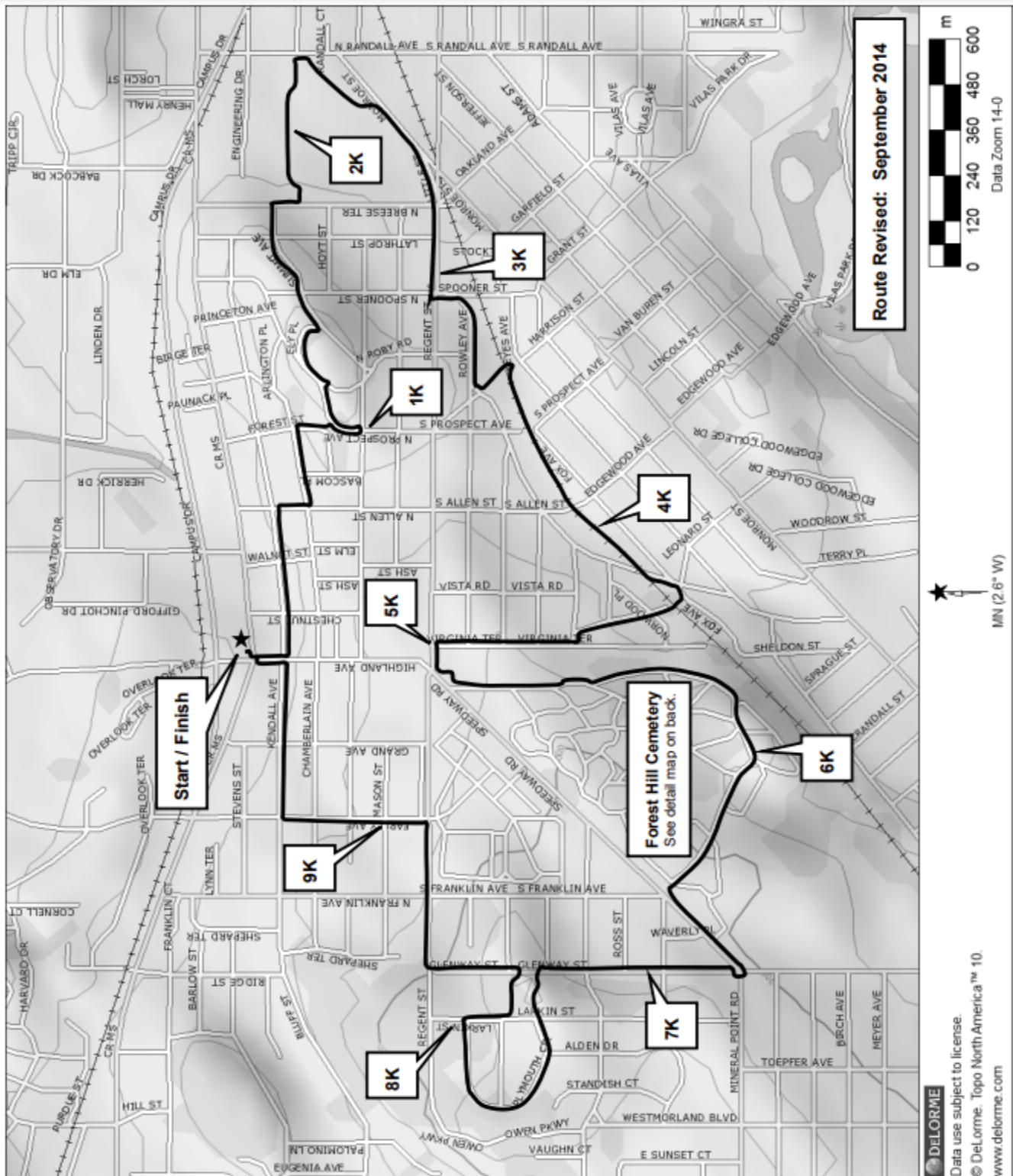
