Driving directions to the walk start

From Snoqualmie Pass:

Drive east on I-90. Take Exit 80 (Roslyn/Suncadia. At the stop sign, turn LEFT on Bullfrog Road (unsigned) and CROSS over I-90. Continue on Bullfrog Road through the first, small roundabout (Suncadia entrance) to the second roundabout. At the second roundabout, take the second exit (RIGHT) on SR 903 toward Roslyn. SR 903 becomes First Street in Roslyn. Turn RIGHT on Pennsylvania Avenue and drive 1 block to a gravel parking lot on your right.

From Ellensburg:

Drive west on I-90. Take Exit 80. At the stop sign, turn RIGHT on Bullfrog Road (unsigned). Continue on Bullfrog Road through the first, small roundabout (Suncadia entrance) to the second roundabout. At the second roundabout take the second exit (RIGHT) on SR 903 toward Roslyn. SR 903 becomes First Street in Roslyn. Turn RIGHT on Pennsylvania Avenue and drive 1 block to a gravel parking lot on your right.

Gravel parking lot coordinates: N47.22358 W120.99155

Restrooms:

At various restaurants in the downtown area and at the city park.

Words-to-the-Wise and Other Info:

During cold mornings in the early spring or late fall, there may be icy patches especially where temps are below freezing at night and where the sun hasn't shone on or melted ice on walk surfaces. In April, there may still be snow patches on the rail trail. During hot summer days, carry water and bring your own shade as some portions of the walk are unshaded.

Thanks for participating in our Roslyn walk. There are walks nearby in Cle Elum, South Cle Elum and Suncadia. There are also two walks in Ellensburg.

Both 5K and 10K start with #1

1. From the gravel lot, walk to Pennsylvania Ave. Turn **RIGHT** on Pennsylvania.
2. Pennsylvania **CURVES** slightly **LEFT** and crosses the gravel Coal Mine Rail Trail (small sign on left).
3. Just after crossing the rail trail, turn **LEFT** on B Street (unsigned). *Church built 1887 and rebuilt 1932.*
4. **LEFT** on Idaho Ave. Carefully cross First St.
5. Continue on Idaho Ave. to city park at 3rd St.
6. **LEFT** on 3rd going past city park on your right.
7. At end of park just past the swing set, turn **RIGHT** onto the gravel Coal Mine Trail (*Restrooms*).
8. Continue on the trail to where an unmarked gravel drive crosses the rail trail. Turn **LEFT** on the gravel drive.
9. Turn **LEFT** on paved Horvatt Rd (unsigned). Carefully walk on the left shoulder facing traffic.
10. At stop sign at top of hill, turn **RIGHT** on S. 7th St. It turns to gravel as it ascends into the cemetery. Masonic cemetery on your right.
11. The gravel road will turn **RIGHT** and go through the middle of the cemetery.
12. **CURVE LEFT** walking downhill to paved Memorial Rd. (unsigned). Be careful as the road's gravel/dirt may be loose or slippery.
13. **LEFT** on Memorial Road past more of the cemeteries to a 3 way paved intersection. *(the kiosk on your right describes the cemeteries).*
14. **RIGHT** at the intersection and immediately turn **RIGHT** on the one lane gravel road that goes uphill (has Wrong Way/Do Not Enter sign). *(Walking W/ America's Vets qualifier on small structure on left).*
15. At the second gravel road junction, turn **LEFT**.
16. At the 4 way gravel road intersection, turn **LEFT** downhill to the paved road.
17. **LEFT** on paved Montana St. (no sign)
18. **RIGHT** at the "T" on the paved roads. (no sign)
19. **RIGHT** on W. 5th Street to the "Y" with Pennsylvania Ave. (unsigned) on the left.
20. **LEFT** on Pennsylvania up and over the little rise, and then down to 1st St (SR 903).

5K do #21 10K skip to #22

21. Go **STRAIGHT** ahead on Pennsylvania Ave. back to the gravel lot and the start point.

10K do #22 through #32

22. Turn **RIGHT** on 1st St.
(AVA Program - City Hall at 1st and Dakota.)
23. At the end of the sidewalk, there is a 35mph sign and a sign for Carek's Meat Market. Turn **LEFT** and **carefully CROSS** 1st St. onto California Ave. (no sign).
24. California Ave will **CURVE RIGHT** and become South "A" Street. (no sign).
25. At the "T", **LEFT** on South Street for 1/2 block.
26. **RIGHT** on Shaft St. You will pass N245 Rd. Look for a gravel path (unsigned) to your left at the end of a grass field where the fenceline goes away from the road. *(If you get to Carek Rd, you went too far).*
27. **LEFT** on the gravel trail (former spur rail line) which parallels the fenceline to the Coal Mine Tr.
28. **LEFT** on the Coal Mine Rail Trail (unmarked) and proceed about 2K back to Pennsylvania Ave (paved and unsigned).
29. **CROSS** Pennsylvania Ave. and continue on the gravel Coal Mine Trail as it **CURVES** to the **LEFT**.
30. **ANGLE LEFT** on paved Washington Ave. (no sign) and carefully **CROSS** North 1st St.
31. **TURN LEFT** on North 2nd St.
32. **TURN LEFT** on Pennsylvania Ave and continue **STRAIGHT** on Pennsylvania Ave back to your vehicle.

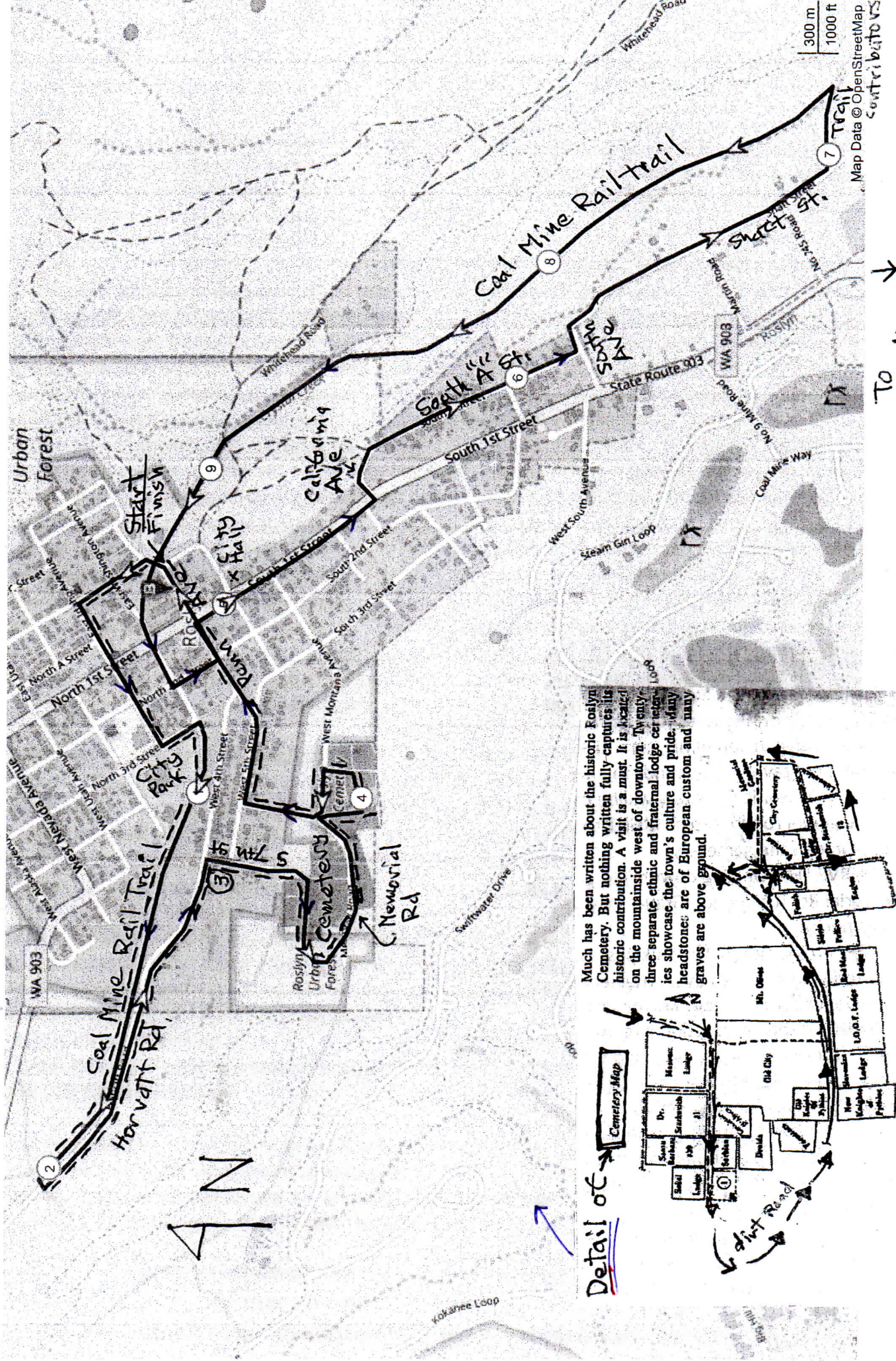
These walking directions and maps may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.

Be sure to log back into the OSB system (my.ava.org) to finish/complete your online registration after doing the walk. The OSB system does not deduct any walking fee from a walker's Event Bank until they have submitted walk completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that walker is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded pdf is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the pdf is downloaded. Later, any pdf fees are credited back to a walker's Event Bank when he/she submits the walk completion info as a paying for credit walker.) The \$2 "coupon" for the downloaded pdf expires in 60 days.
