This walk is composed of a 5km and 10km routes. The walk is rated 2A and is along town, campus and park sidewalks. The walk includes University of Montevallo campus, which has listed 28 buildings listed on National Register of Historic places. The buildings are dated from 1820s, 1850s to the present. The walk also includes a 40 acre's park with "Tingles" forest of faces. The tingle trees, murals, sculptures and fire hydrants are created by local artists.

Special Programs: Town Halls/City Halls, Walking with America's Veterans, Step to the Beat, and Par for the Course

Walk Registration:

Registration takes place online using that AVA Online Start Box, on my.ava.org. Follow the instructions provided to create a user account and sign the AVA waiver (one time). Instructions for payment are also included. Download the directions and print as needed. The POC does not provide event directions or accept alternate payment methods. **REMINDER:** Be sure to log back into the OSB system to 'finish/complete' your online registration after doing the event.

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Once you have physically completed the walk, please login to your Online Start Box account click on the "My Start Box" tab, then the "Finish Table" tab, then click on "Go to Finish Table" button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped "virtual" insert cards that you may choose to print out.

Driving Directions to Start/Finish Point:

The address to Start/Finish Point is 845 Valley St., Montevallo, AL Take Exit 228 from I-65. Take AL Hwy 25 S though Calera. Right on Hwy 155 N. (Middle Street) Cross Hwy 119 continue on Middle Street. Right on Valley to 845 Valley St. Walk starts facing the Global Community Outreach/Office of Veterans and Military Affairs building. Park on street or back of the bank's parking lot. Please do not park close to bank building. Restrooms are not available at start point. Restrooms available at local fast food restaurants and parks.

Montevallo, AL 10KM- 845 Valley St.

1. **FACE** the Global Community Outreach/Veterans and Military Affairs' building
2. LEFT on Valley St.
3. RIGHT on Middle St.
3. RIGHT on Oak St.
4. CROSS North Boundary St.-- Center for the Arts located on the corner
5. LEFT and CROSS Oak and go through gate onto red brick sidewalk, passing Palmer Hall.
6. Just before the sculpture of two hands (Centennial Plaza), RIGHT onto Highland St. Continue on Highland St. and exit the campus thru the brick & iron gateway.
7. RIGHT on Plowman St.
8. LEFT on Oak St.
9. Take next LEFT on Wadsworth St (no street sign),
10. RIGHT onto Highland St.
11. LEFT on Moody.
12. LEFT on Nabors. CROSS Plowman St, Continue on Nabor merge onto King St.
- 13.. At end, curve LEFT onto King. Just after this turn, Bloch intersects to the right. Cross King to Bloch and go thru the **smaller gateway (left of large gateway)** onto the brick path which leads to the front of King House.
14. WALK to King House front door. After viewing King House, turn around and go LEFT, taking the 2nd LEFT path to the intersection of Bloch St. and King-Harman St. RIGHT on King-Harman St. Pass Harmon Hall.
15. RIGHT on the sidewalk at the end of Harman Hall. Before the end of the sidewalk, go LEFT across the grass to the small cemetery inside the stone wall. This is the King family cemetery.
16. Leave the cemetery-Retrace steps and RETURN to King-Harman St and go RIGHT.

17. CROSS College Dr, to the brick walk, right of the driveway and follow it to U of M President's home-the Flowerhill House.

18. When the sidewalk ends at the brick driveway, take the driveway in a counter-clockwise direction pass front of house.

19. RETURN to brick walkway and Go RIGHT on walkway and return to College Dr

20. CROSS and turn RIGHT on College Dr.

21. Continue on College Dr. Pass the Student Activity Building on the right and Peck Hall on the left.

22. Just past Peck Hall, turn LEFT into parking lot before the next building.

23. At the dumpsters, go RIGHT on the sidewalk. At the end of sidewalk, go LEFT onto the brick **walkway** to pass Bibb Graves Hall.

24. At the "Y" intersection take the RIGHT onto brick walkway. CROSS Bloch St. and proceed up Hanson Way at the end of Tutwiler Hall located to your right. *a women's residence hall, was named for the first president Julia Strudwick Tutwiler, the founder of Alabama Girl's Industrial School (University of Montevallo)*

25. When Hanson curves left, STAY STRAIGHT on the brick path

26. Continue STRAIGHT. Pass the school cafeteria (building with purple awning) and take the 2nd brick path to the LEFT.

27. BEAR RIGHT keeping "The Tower" on your left. *THE TOWER - it served as the sole source of water storage on campus until 1962. The large round attachment to the side of the building on your right, across from the tower, has a slide inside of it. This is a fire escape which is no longer in use.*

28. WALK to the sculpture of Two Hands and Highland St. RIGHT on Highland St. Walk to Main Hall (on your right) proceed

to front steps. **It is the geographic center of State of Alabama**

29. RETURN to Highland St. and go RIGHT

30. After crossing Vine St., take the curved sidewalk on your right, in front of large white building - Reynolds Hall. On the left of Highland St. is Maxine Couch Davis Hall. Dept of Music and Recital

31. At end of curved sidewalk, turn RIGHT and continue on Highland St. and pass through the small gateway.

32. CROSS Middle St. (no sign)

33. LEFT on Middle St.

34. LEFT on Main St

CONTINUE on Main St to N. Boundary St.

FOR Walkers who changed their minds and just want to do 5 K, TURN Left at N. Boundary St. Left on Valley St Return to Start Point located at 845 Valley Street..

35. RIGHT and CROSS Main St and PROCEED on N. Boundary St. It's by McDonalds.

36. CROSS Island St.--Go under ORR Park archway and turn immediate LEFT onto walkway.

37. RIGHT on Park Drive (street just after tennis courts and by the library)

38. CONTINUE up and down the hill. Turn LEFT at end of wooden rail fence (just past the ditch) onto walkway.

39. Follow walkway as it bears right along stream to bridge. Turn LEFT over bridge. *ORR PARK.*

40. Go STRAIGHT, At "T" STOP turn around and view Indian and Wizard carving.

41. Return to bridge

42. RIGHT on the walkway just before the bridge. Continue on walkway keeping restrooms and playground area to your right.

43. Follow walkway around field and up and down hill.

44. At intersection, turn LEFT, keeping gazebo on your right. At "T" intersection, turn LEFT and cross to middle of bridge.

45. Turn around and return to walkway. Bear LEFT. (Gazebo on your right)

46. Follow walkway along stream to bridge.

47. LEFT to cross bridge and CROSS Park Drive—continue on walkway, with hill on your left and fenced ball fields on your right.

48. CONTINUE straight on walkway, passing restrooms, and playground on your left. At "T" intersection turn LEFT and go between Orr Park archway sign to exit Park.

49. LEFT on Island St. Go STRAIGHT to **Stop Sign** and LEFT on Middle St.(no sign)by dalmatian fire hydrant.

50. LEFT on East Boundary St.

51. CROSS Vine St, turn RIGHT and proceed on Vine.

52. RIGHT on Morgan St. Walk to **Stop Sign** and Turn RIGHT on Middle St. (no sign)

53. CROSS E Boundary St, turn LEFT, Carefully CROSS Middle St and proceed on E Boundary St.

54. RIGHT on Shelby St.

55. RIGHT on Main St. CROSS Main St at Middle St intersection by brick church

56. LEFT on Main St. RIGHT on Moreland Drive Pass City Hall on your left

57. RIGHT on Valley St pass start point

58. CROSS N Boundary St.

59. RIGHT on Bloch St

60. RIGHT on Main St

61. RIGHT on N. Boundary St.

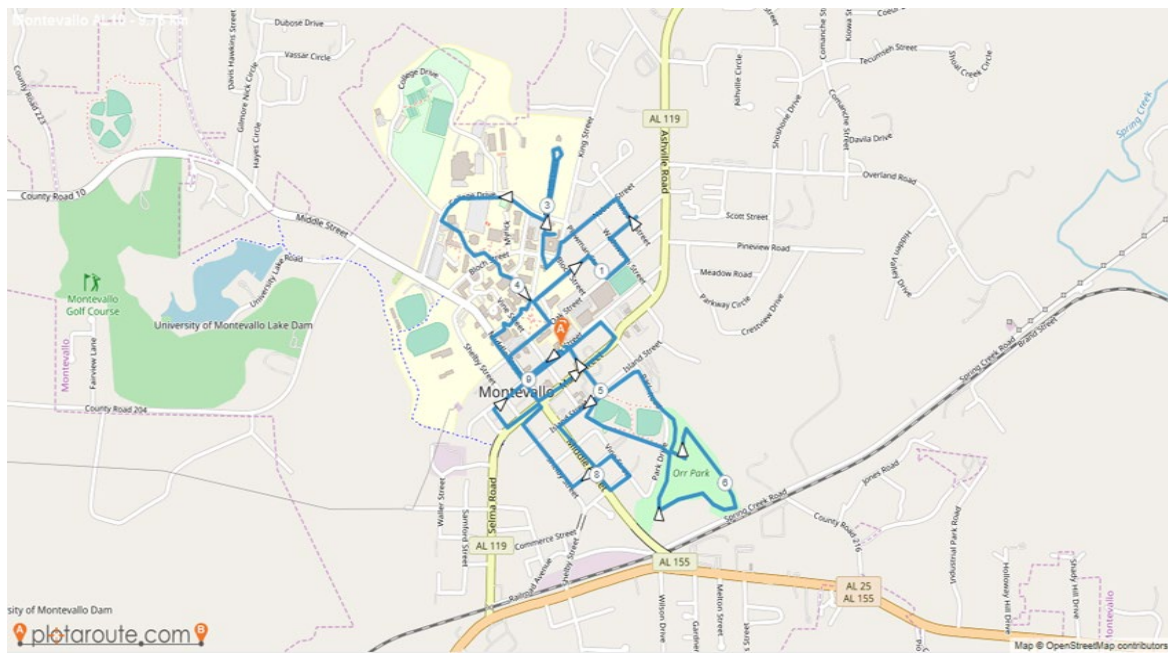
62.. LEFT on Valley Street Return to the Start/Finish Point. You completed 10K!!!

Montevallo 5 KM 845 Valley St

- 1, Facing the Global Community Outreach/Veterans Affair Building GO LEFT onto Valley St.
2. RIGHT on Vine St-next stop sign
3. RIGHT on Oak St.
4. At 3 way stop, CROSS N. Boundary St. to Center for the Arts.
5. Turn LEFT and CROSS Oak St.
4. Go thru gate onto red brick sidewalk to pass Palmer Hall.
5. Just before sculpture of two hands (Centennial Plaza), go RIGHT onto Highland St.
6. LEFT onto **THIRD brick walkway** which crosses lawn. Located beside brick walk is the University of Montevallo National Historic District Marker and directly across is the fountain in front of Carmichael Library.
7. At **intersection**, take FIRST walkway to your RIGHT, King House located on your left.
8. Go thru **smaller brick gateway**, then LEFT on Bloch St thru larger gate RIGHT on King-Harman St, passing Harman Hall on your right.
9. TURN RIGHT on the sidewalk at the end of Harman Hall. Before the end of the sidewalk, go LEFT across the grass to view the King Family Cemetery inside the stone wall.
10. Leave the cemetery, retrace steps and return to King-Harman St and go RIGHT.
11. CROSS College Dr. to the brick walkway, which is right of the brick driveway, and follow it to the President of Montevallo's home the FLOWERHILL HOUSE
12. When the sidewalk ends at brick driveway, take driveway in a counter-clockwise direction pass the front of house.
13. Return to the brick walkway and return to College Dr.
14. CROSS College Drive and Turn RIGHT.
15. LEFT onto Farmer St.
16. RIGHT on Bloch St.
17. Pass the first Hanson Way sign, LEFT on Hanson Way (**at second sign**). When Hanson Way curves left, STAY STRAIGHT on brick path.
18. Continue straight. Pass the school cafeteria (building with purple awning) and take the SECOND brick path to the LEFT.
19. Bear RIGHT keeping the "TOWER" on your left
20. Walk to the sculpture of Two Hands by Highland St.
21. RIGHT on Highland St. MAIN HALL --walk to front steps entrance, step on the star which represents the geographic center of the State of Alabama then RETURN to Highland St and go RIGHT
Note: Maxine Couch Davis Hall-Music and Recital Dept.-located left of exit gate.
22. Go thru gate, CROSS Middle St. (no sign) and LEFT on Middle St.
23. CROSS Main St. and LEFT on Main St.
24. RIGHT on N. Boundary St. The street after McDonalds.
25. CROSS Island St. and go under Orr Park sign and go straight on walking path with library and cabin type building on left and ball field on right.
26. CROSS Park Drive and continue on walking path and bear RIGHT creek will be on your left.
27. Follow path as it bears right along the creek to the bridge.
28. LEFT over the bridge. You are in ORR PARK- which has a stream, waterfall, and a quiet restful atmosphere. It is the home of "Tingle Woods."
29. Go STRAIGHT, viewing Indian carving on left and looking further left to see Wizard carving.
30. RIGHT at "T" intersection and continue on walk way.
31. Continue on walk way, keeping gazebo on your right.
32. At the next intersection, turn LEFT and cross to the middle of the bridge.
33. Turn around and return to walk way.
34. Bear LEFT with gazebo on your right.
35. Follow path along the stream to the bridge.
36. Turn LEFT to cross bridge, CROSS Park Street continue on walk way-with hill on your left and fenced ball fields on your right.
37. Continue on walkway, pass restrooms and playground on your left and ball park on your right

38. LEFT on walk way by blue fire hydrant to Island St.
39. Bear LEFT on Island St
40. RIGHT on Middle St. (no sign) by Dalmatian fire hydrant
41. CROSS Main St
42. LEFT on Main St
43. RIGHT on Moreland Drive. Pass City Hall on your left continue straight to Valley St
44. RIGHT on Valley St. and return to START/FINISH POINT at 845 Valley St.
