

SUNCADIA SEASONAL WALK EVENT

In Kittitas County - Y1599 - Central Washington Sun Striders
5K Rated 1A 10K Rated 2B
The 5K has one small trail section of gravel (300') and two steps.

Driving directions to the walk start

From Snoqualmie Pass:

Drive east on I-90. Take Exit 80 (Roslyn/Suncadia. At the stop sign, turn LEFT on Bullfrog Road (unsigned) and CROSS over I-90. Continue 2 miles on Bullfrog Road. At the first small roundabout, take the second exit (LEFT) into Suncadia on Suncadia Trail Road (unsigned but there is a large Suncadia Resort sign). In 1.2 miles, you will come to a large forested roundabout. Take the second exit off the roundabout and stay on Suncadia Trail Road toward the Lodge. In 2.2 miles on Suncadia Trail Road (just past the pond and shops on your right), turn RIGHT on the access road for the Lodge and park in the parking lot on your left. Walk to the Lodge entrance. Inside are restrooms.

From Ellensburg:

Drive west on I-90. Take Exit 80. At the stop sign, turn RIGHT on Bullfrog Road (unsigned). Continue 2 miles on Bullfrog Road. At the first small roundabout, take the second exit (LEFT) into Suncadia on Suncadia Trail Road (unsigned but there is a large Suncadia Resort sign). In 1.2 miles, you will come to a large forested roundabout. Take the second exit off the roundabout and stay on Suncadia Trail Road toward the Lodge. In 2.2 miles on Suncadia Trail Road (just past the pond and shops on your right), turn RIGHT on the access road for the Lodge and park in the parking lot on your left. Walk to the lodge entrance. Inside are restrooms.

Suncadia Lodge parking lot coordinates: 47.12' 28.71" N 121.01' 07.97" W

Restrooms:

In the Lodge and at Batista and Dawson Parks.

Words-to-the-Wise and Other Info:

During cold mornings in the early spring or late fall, there may be icy patches especially where temps are below freezing at night and where the sun hasn't shone on or melted ice on walk surfaces. In April, there may still be snow patches on the trail. During hot summer days, carry water.

Be sure to log back into the OSB system (my.ava.org) to finish/complete your online registration after doing the walk. The OSB system does not deduct any walking fee from a walker's Event Bank until they have submitted walk completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that walker is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded pdf is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the pdf is downloaded. Later, any pdf fees are credited back to a walker's Event Bank when he/she submits the walk completion info as a paying for credit walker.) The \$2 "coupon" for the downloaded pdf expires in 60 days.

Thanks for participating in our Suncadia walk. There are walks nearby in Cle Elum, South Cle Elum and Roslyn. There are also two walks in Ellensburg.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY, CALL 911**

(Do Not Take or Turn On Any Asphalt "Golf Cart Only" Paths)

1. Exiting the Lodge, turn **LEFT** along the front of the Lodge.
2. Turn **LEFT** along the side of the Lodge on the asphalt path.
3. At the next corner of the Lodge, you'll see a gravel path to a viewpoint deck. **VEER RIGHT** onto the gravel path to the wooden viewpoint deck overlooking the river.
4. Turn **AROUND** and **RETURN** to the paved path. Turn **SHARP RIGHT** on the asphalt path along the back of the Lodge (river below).
5. As you come around the far end of the Lodge, follow the path/driveway **STRAIGHT** ahead to the parking lot.
6. Go **STRAIGHT** through the parking lot to the asphalt path that parallels Suncadia Trail Rd (no sign).
7. Turn **LEFT** on the asphalt path (Suncadia Tr. Rd on your right). You will pass a small area of shops and then a large pond on your left.
8. At the far end of the pond, you will go over a pedestrian bridge.
9. Just after the bridge, stay **RIGHT** at the next two paved trail junctions.
10. **CROSS** Big Hill Drive and continue **STRAIGHT** on the main asphalt path that parallels Suncadia Trail Rd (on your right).
11. **CROSS** Swiftwater Drive.
12. At the trail junction just past Swiftwater Dr, continue **STRAIGHT** on the main asphalt path.

13. At the large, forested, single lane rotary (it may be difficult to see all of it), **ANGLE LEFT** at the rotary and continue (**clockwise**) on the asphalt path that will go around most of the rotary. You will **CROSS** Rope Rider Dr. and then Suncadia Trail Road (unmarked here).

14. **ANGLE LEFT** toward Battista Park (sign for the park) on the asphalt path following Pinegrass Loop road on your right.

15. **CROSS** Spragger Way. (*Restrooms at Battista Park*).

16. **CROSS** Larkspur Loop and continue on the path **CROSSING** Larkspur Loop a second time.

17. When the asphalt path ends at Pinegrass Loop Road (no sign), turn **LEFT** and walk on the left side of the road.

18. At the road gate, **ANGLE LEFT** and enter a paved path which parallels the road on your right. Follow it to the Lodge parking lot.

19. **ANGLE LEFT** through the parking lot back to the entrance of the Lodge.

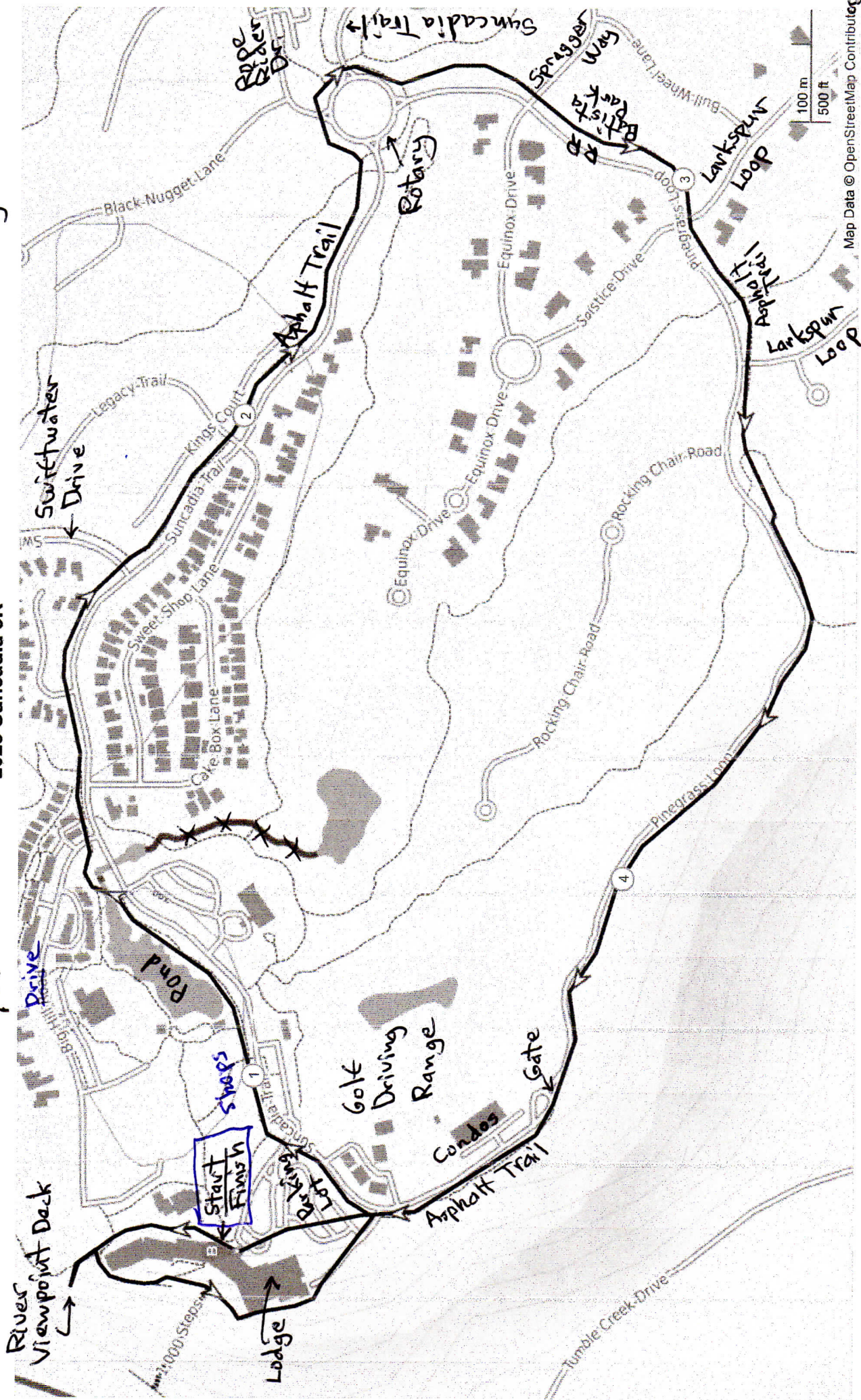

CENTRAL WASHINGTON SUN STRIDERS - RATED 2B
IN CASE OF EMERGENCY, CALL 911**

(Do Not Take or Turn On Any Asphalt "Golf Cart Only" Paths)

1. Exiting the Lodge, turn **LEFT**, following the paved path along the front of the Lodge.
2. Turn **LEFT** along the side of the Lodge on the asphalt path.
3. At the next corner of the Lodge, you'll see a gravel path to a viewpoint deck. **VEER RIGHT** onto the gravel path to the wooden viewpoint deck overlooking the river.
4. Turn **AROUND** and **RETURN** to the paved path. Turn **RIGHT** on the asphalt path along the back of the Lodge.
5. As you come around the end of the Lodge, follow the driveway to the parking lot.
6. Go **LEFT** through the parking lot and sidewalk to the front of the Lodge again. (You will have circled the Lodge).
7. For the second time, go **STRAIGHT** across the front and side of the Lodge on the asphalt path to the gravel path and a dirt path by the river view deck.
8. **ANGLE RIGHT** on a dirt path to a Trailhead sign with map and a blue stake with ELC on it.
9. Go **LEFT** downhill on the dirt trail. You will pass a scenic overlook sign and picnic table on your left.
10. **ANGLE LEFT** at a "Y". The way trail to the right has 2 boulders on it. Stay on main trail.
11. Turn **LEFT** at a "T" junction.
12. Turn **RIGHT** at a way trail junction with 2 trail signs. Stay on main trail.
13. At bottom of the hill, carefully **CROSS** the creek. Use crossing log if creek is running.
14. At the "T", turn **RIGHT** onto Eisenberg Trail (wood post and map #4). Creek bed will now be on your right.
15. **CROSS** short wooden bridge. Go **STRAIGHT** at trail junction that is just after the bridge.
16. **ANGLE LEFT** at a big, open, unmarked trail intersection with a picnic table.
17. At the next "T" (wood post and map #3), turn **LEFT** on trail.
18. **CROSS** paved Swiftwater Drive (unsigned) and continue **STRAIGHT** on a short gravel trail.
19. At the "T", turn **RIGHT** onto the paved asphalt trail (wood post and map #2).
20. At dirt trail junction that goes to Roslyn, continue **STRAIGHT** on the asphalt trail.
21. Turn **LEFT** at the next asphalt "T" junction. A paved road will be on your right.
22. Turn **LEFT** at the next paved asphalt trail junction. Sign points to Dawson Pk/restrooms.
23. Go **STRAIGHT** at next paved trail junction from the right. Stay on main asphalt trail.
24. **CROSS** a single track gravel road that goes to the water tower.
25. Just after the gravel road, you will pass a bench and the Duck Town Arch site plaque.
26. **CROSS** the paved #9 Mine Road (unsigned).
27. **CROSS** Coal Mine Way (unsigned) in the crosswalk into Dawson Park.
28. **ANGLE RIGHT** at the triangular trail junction.
29. **ANGLE RIGHT** at the next triangular trail junction. With the parking lot on your right and the big open grass field on your left, circle counterclockwise around the field to the restrooms at the base of the forested hill.
30. At the restrooms, turn **SHARP RIGHT** on the asphalt trail that goes up the hill.
31. Go **STRAIGHT** at the junction at top of hill.
32. Immediately turn **RIGHT** at next intersection onto Ridge Loop Trail (unsigned). "Caution Flying Discs" sign on your right
33. Pass the golf club house and Swiftwater Cellars across the road on your right and then a parking lot on your left. Continue down hill on the asphalt path to the roundabout/rotary.
34. At the "T", turn **LEFT** on the asphalt path and **CROSS** Suncadia Trail Rd.
35. **ANGLE LEFT** toward Batista Park (sign for the park) following Pinegrass Loop road on your right.
36. **CROSS** Spragger Way (*Restrooms at Batista Park*).
37. **CROSS** Larkspur Loop Rd and continue on the asphalt path **CROSSING** Larkspur Loop Rd a second time.
38. When the paved path ends at Pinegrass Loop Rd (no sign), turn **LEFT** and walk on left side of the road.
39. At next asphalt trail junction to your left, continue **STRAIGHT** ahead on the road.
40. At the road gate, **ANGLE LEFT** and enter a paved asphalt path which parallels the road on your right. Follow it to the Lodge parking lot.
41. **ANGLE LEFT** through the parking lot back to the entrance of the Lodge.

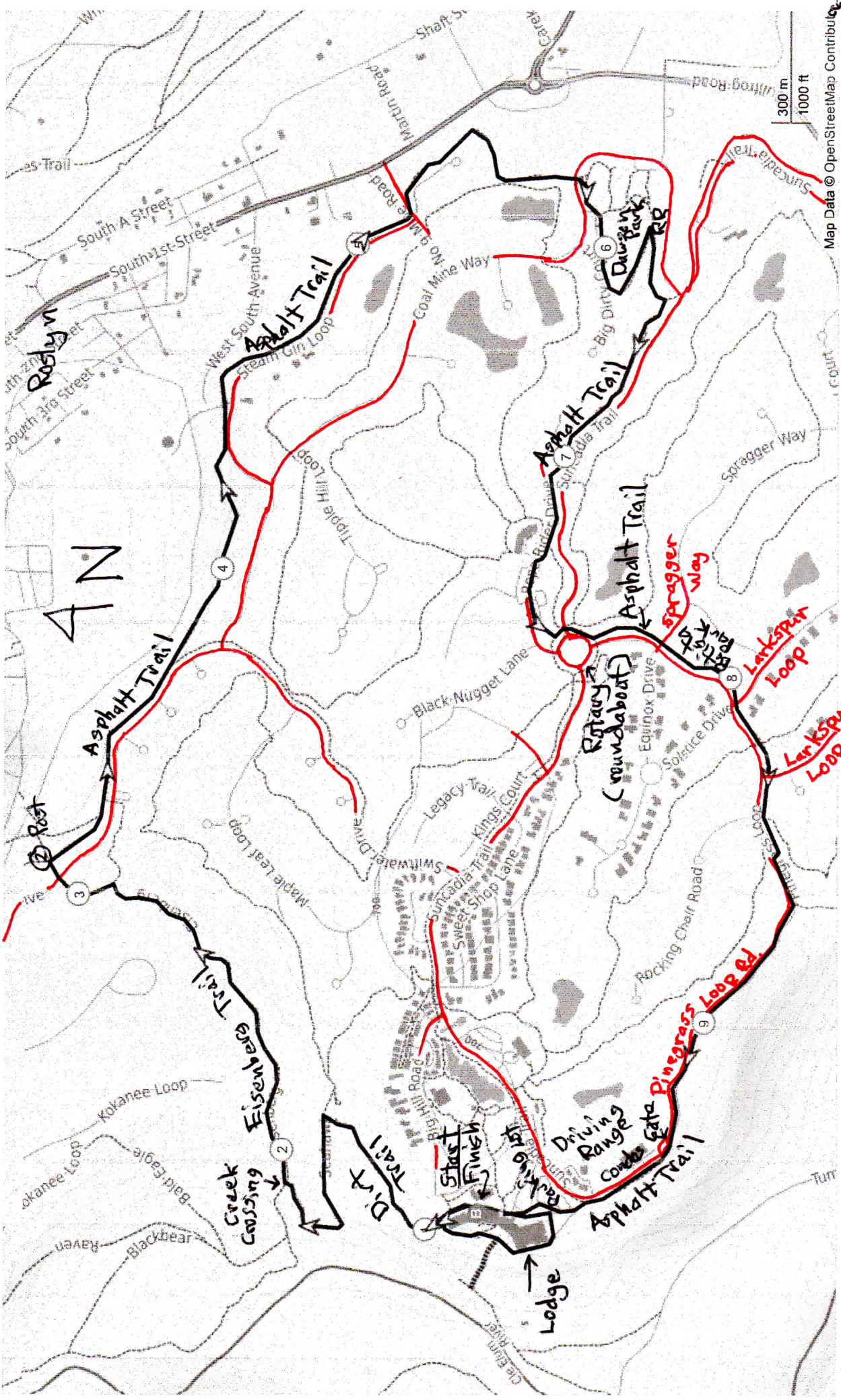
