Trail Description:

The Residential event (Y1619) has four different trail options that can be walked for this event credit. This is to allow variety while maintaining the integrity of the trails that the original pioneers developed. Please take time to enjoy the seasonal displays within Brookside Gardens.

1. Residential trail 11KM (dedicated to Paul Redmer explorer of this trail): This trail is on a mixture of paved and natural surfaces. The trail starts within Brookside gardens and then follows Glenallen Avenue by the stables to Kemp Mill Road. The trail then proceeds on a natural surface path on the Northwest Branch Trail for about 1.75 KM where you will leave this trail up a short hill exiting onto a residential area. You will walk on the side on lightly traveled roads through a neighborhood of contrasting homes, returning the Kemp Mill Road. From Kemp Mill Road, you walk through another neighborhood to a school. The trail then takes asphalt paths with some hills back to Wheaton Regional Park. The trail then passes Pine Lake and re-enters Brookside Gardens. Once within the gardens the trail route will take you past the memorial to the 2002 sniper victims and through the conservatories.
2. Optional 11KM Residential Trail: This trail is on paved surfaces and suitable for inclement weather. This trail follows the original trail to Kemp Mill Road. Then you will follow Kemp Mill Road and then make a large loop through the same neighborhood as the original trail before returning to Kemp Mill Road. You will then walk through another neighborhood returning to Kemp Mill Road and then take Arcola Avenue to an entrance to Wheaton Regional Park Ice Rink. After proceeding by ball fields and ice rinks you pass Pine Lake and re-enter Brookside Gardens.
3. Residential 5KM trail: This trail is on paved surfaces and suitable for inclement weather. This trail exits Brookside Gardens by the entrance to the Visitor Center. You will cross Glenallen Ave and walk around the neighborhood between Glenallen Ave and Randolph Road. You will re-enter Brookside Gardens and walk through the gardens for about 1 KM before finishing at the Visitor Center.
4. Option #2 5KM / 10KM Stay in the Gardens: This trail stays entirely within Brookside Gardens making 6 loops around and through the gardens and should be suitable for muddy conditions or inclement weather. The route makes 3 full loops and 3 figure eights going in both directions to break any monotony. This trail takes you through the Japanese Tea House garden and other areas of the gardens not on the traditional routes.

Special Programs:

Par for the Course is on the Optional 11KM Trail. A-MAZE-ing Labyrinths is on both 11KM trails plus the Stay in the Gardens (Option 2) trail. The labyrinth is near the Japanese Tea House.

Start Point:

Brookside Gardens Visitor Center 1800 Glenallan Ave. Wheaton, MD 20902 (301) 962-1400

Hours are 9 AM-5 PM daily closed New Years, MLK Day, Presidents Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving and day after Thanksgiving, and Christmas. Pets are not allowed in Brookside Gardens. The gardens are open every day.

Amenities:

Restrooms and water are located in the Start Point and also in the Conservatory within Brookside Gardens.

Driving Directions:

Washington DC Capital Beltway (I-495) exit 31A follow Georgia/Rt 97 N to Wheaton about 3.1 miles. At Randolph Road turn RIGHT. At 2nd traffic light, turn RIGHT onto Glenallan Ave. to Brookside Gardens on right. Park in 1st lot for Visitor Center and if full return to Glenallan Ave. turn right, park in 2nd lot off Glenallan by Conservatory or in lot near Nature Center.

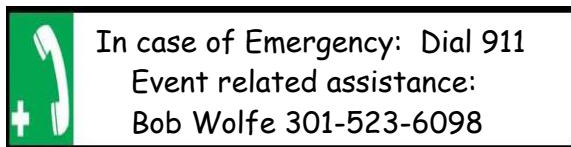
Walk Registration:

Registration takes place online using that AVA Online Start Box, on my.ava.org. Follow the instructions provided to create a user account and sign the AVA waiver (one time). Instructions for payment are also included. Download the directions and print as needed. The POC does not provide event directions or accept alternate payment methods.

Note: This event also has a physical start box. Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete this event. Do not mix and match. For example, if you register using the OSB do not complete your event by using the PSB (nor sign the PSB log sheet). The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distance and any special program using the OSB. See below.

Walk Completion and Walk Credit:

Once you have physically completed the walk, please log in to your Online Start Box account, click on the “My Start Box” tab, then the “Finish Table” tab, and click on “Go to Finish Table” button for the event you have completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance of your walk as well as select applicable AVA Special Programs to generate stamped “virtual” insert cards that you may choose to print out.

WHEATON'S BROOKSIDE GARDEN TRAIL/RESIDENTIAL – 11 KM (YR 1619)

This trail is dedicated to the memory of Paul Redmer, POC and explorer of this trail.

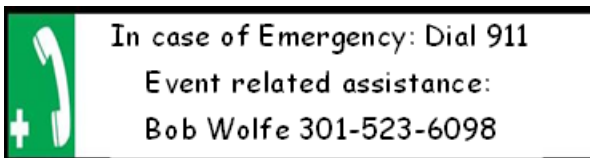
1. EXIT Visitor's Center towards parking lot and **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk following the sidewalk along and away from the parking lot. At "Y" **TURN RIGHT**. Pass the first pond on your left continuing between two ponds to a "T" – **TURN RIGHT** (keeping second pond on your right.)
2. As you approach the Conservatories, the path comes to a "T" at an asphalt path – **TURN HARD RIGHT** (uphill) on asphalt trail. (Do not continue towards the Conservatories.)
3. At top of hill, **BEAR LEFT** at "Y" on asphalt trail (down hill).
4. **BEAR LEFT** at next "T" (fencing should be on your right).
5. Prior to the parking lot, **BEAR RIGHT** onto the boardwalk (towards the Nature Center) and exit through the gate.
6. Cross footbridge. **TURN LEFT** and cross parking area (Nature Center on right). At the end of the lot, enter the boardwalk by the pond and **TURN RIGHT**. Take the first **RIGHT** to exit the boardwalk to the asphalt driveway. **TURN LEFT** on driveway and follow to road (Glenallan Ave).
7. **CROSS** Glenallan Ave and **TURN RIGHT**. Walk on the shoulder of the road carefully watching out for oncoming traffic.
8. Continue past the Stables to Stop Sign for Kemp Mill Road. **Cross** Kemp Mill Road and **TURN RIGHT** onto the sidewalk.
9. **TURN LEFT** at first trail to left (2.1 Km) onto Northwest Branch Trail. Stay on main natural surface gravel trail with stream on your left. Ignore side trails. After roughly 1.25 kilometers you will pass an overhanging rock cropping on your right. After almost ½ Km further, look for a tree with two red paint markings and then **TURN RIGHT** just prior to a second tree with double paint markings on the natural trail (uphill towards a brick house). [NOTE: If you come to another rock outcropping on your right with a culvert on your left, you've gone about 0.1 Km too far.] As you continue uphill, you will pass a cluster of bamboo on your right. Exit onto road.
10. Continue up Stonington Road. **BEAR RIGHT** at "Y" intersection. At Yield sign – **CROSS** and continue **RIGHT** on Stonington Road.
11. **TURN LEFT** at Kemp Mill Road (5.1 Km). Continue to the traffic light at Hermleigh Road. **TURN RIGHT** and cross Kemp Mill Road at the crosswalk. **TURN LEFT** and continue on the right side of Kemp Mill Road.
12. **TURN RIGHT** on Clintwood Place. At "T", **TURN LEFT** on Clintwood Drive. Continue past Annmore Dr. to a "T" at Monticello Ave (no sign).
13. At "T", **CROSS** Monticello Avenue and **TURN RIGHT**. Proceed to the school and after the last driveway to the right of school **TURN LEFT** going around the end of the fence. Follow the woodchip path to an asphalt path. **TURN RIGHT** on the asphalt path.
14. After about ¾ Km – **BEAR RIGHT** at 'T'. Continue to roadway (7.1 Km). **CROSS** road, **ANGLE LEFT**, and immediately **BEAR RIGHT** onto asphalt path into the woods. Continue for about 1 Km to an intersecting asphalt path.
15. **TURN RIGHT**. Continue past small red brick building. **TURN RIGHT** on next hardtop trail on right and go between the split rail fences. At intersecting hardtop path **TURN RIGHT**.

16. Continue on path as it changes from asphalt to gravel. You will cross railroad tracks (twice) and will pass Pine Lake on your right.
17. At "T" asphalt path **TURN LEFT**. At "Y" **BEAR RIGHT** and proceed back into Brookside Gardens.
18. Inside garden, **BEAR RIGHT** at first "Y" on asphalt trail. After passing Japanese Tea House on your left, **TURN LEFT** on 1st paved pathway lined with stones. (Take time to pause at the Reflection Terrace honoring the 2002 sniper victims.) Continue on stone pathway, passing asphalt trail, and straight through the Fragrance Garden to circular walkway.
19. **TURN LEFT** on circular walkway to rose trellis. **TURN LEFT** at rose trellis.
20. Passing under trellis, **BEAR LEFT** at concrete sidewalk. Sidewalk will curve around until it reaches an asphalt path.
21. **TURN RIGHT**, then **RIGHT** again on the sidewalk, and go through the conservatories (restrooms, water, and seasonal exhibits inside).
22. Exiting through other end of building, **TURN RIGHT** going up steps through formal gardens to the gazebo visible ahead. (Note: If the rear exit is blocked, leave by the door you entered and **TURN RIGHT** going around the building to the rear. Then continue straight to the gazebo.)
23. At gazebo, continue up steps, on the right toward benches, to wood chip trail.
24. At "T" **TURN LEFT** on wood chip trail to asphalt trail.
25. **TURN LEFT** on asphalt trail. At "Y" **VEER RIGHT** and follow to the START/FINISH on your right.

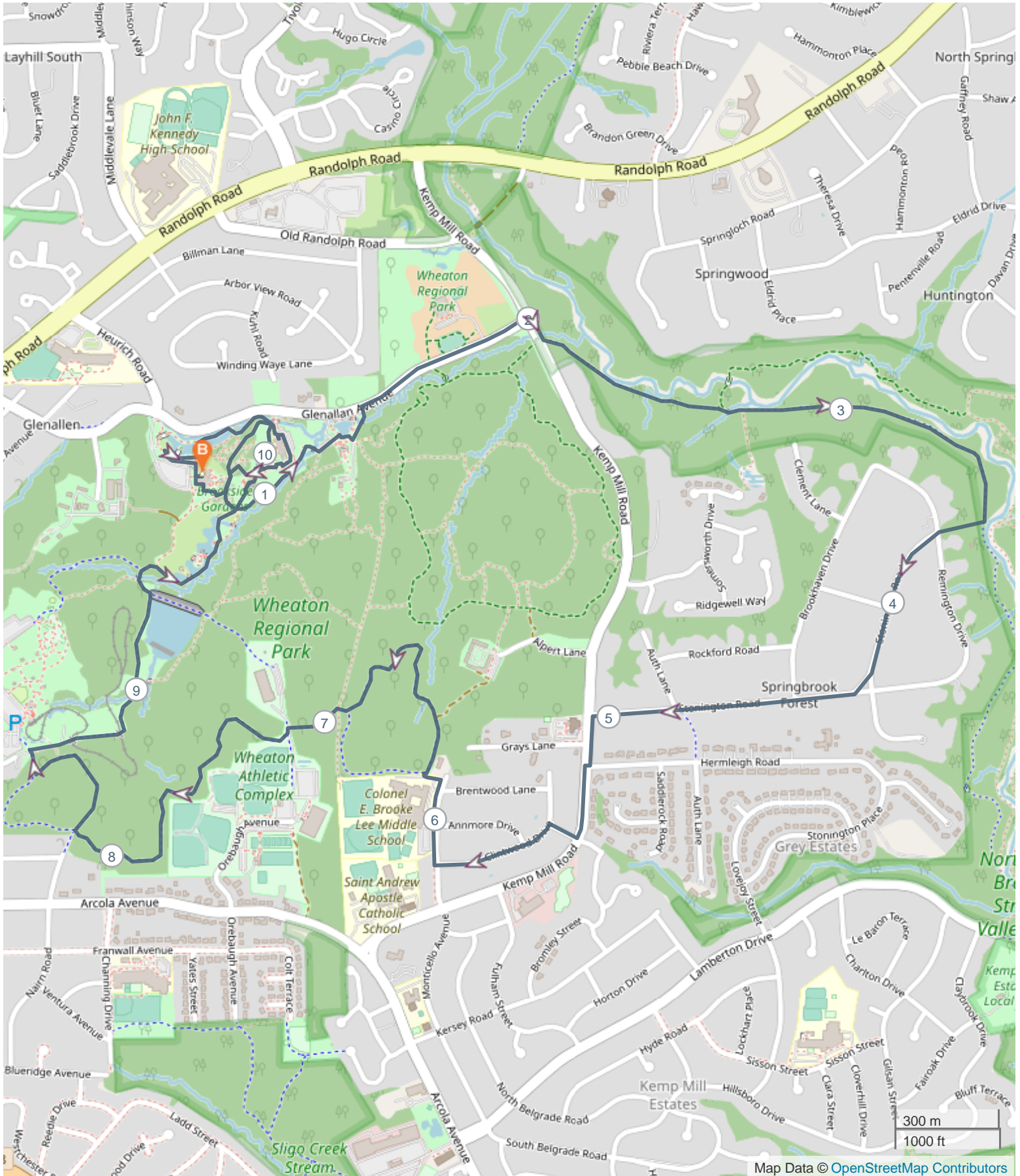

FREESTATE HAPPY WANDERERS

WHEATON'S BROOKSIDE GARDEN TRAIL/RESIDENTIAL – 11 KM (YR 1619) (2nd Half of 22Km)

This trail is almost entirely on paved surfaces and should be suitable for inclement weather.

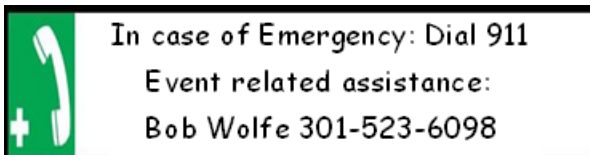
1. EXIT Visitor's Center towards parking lot and **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk following the sidewalk along and away from the parking lot. At "Y" **TURN RIGHT**. Pass the first pond on your left continuing between two ponds to a "T" – **TURN RIGHT** (keeping second pond on your right.)
2. As you approach the Conservatories, the path comes to a "T" at an asphalt path – **TURN HARD RIGHT** (uphill) on asphalt trail. (Do not continue towards the Conservatories.)
3. At top of hill, **BEAR LEFT** at "Y" on asphalt trail (down hill).
4. **BEAR LEFT** at next "T" (fencing should be on your right).
5. Prior to the parking lot, **BEAR RIGHT** onto the boardwalk (towards the Nature Center) and exit through the gate. (1.2 Km)
6. Cross footbridge. **TURN LEFT** and cross parking area (Nature Center on right). At the end of the lot, enter the boardwalk by the pond and **TURN RIGHT**. Take the first **RIGHT** to exit the boardwalk to the asphalt driveway. **TURN LEFT** on driveway and follow to road (Glenallan Ave).
7. **CROSS** Glenallan Ave and **TURN RIGHT**. Walk on the shoulder of the road carefully watching out for oncoming traffic.
8. Continue to Stop Sign for Kemp Mill Road. Cross Kemp Mill Road and **TURN RIGHT**. Continue on sidewalk along Kemp Mill Road for about 1 Km to Stonington Road (Springbrook Forest sign).
9. **TURN LEFT** on Stonington Road, walking on the left side of the road. Pass Auth Lane, Brookhaven Drive and two Stonington Roads on your left. The street name changes to Remington Drive at this point. **CONTINUE STRAIGHT** and the road will bend to the left. Just past 12211 Remington Dr. you'll see a street on the left and cluster of bamboo on your right.
10. **CONTINUE STRAIGHT** on Remington Drive. Remington Dr. will turn left and change name to Brookhaven Drive. Continue on Brookhaven Dr. to Stop Sign at Stonington Road. **CROSS** and **TURN RIGHT** on Stonington Road.
11. **TURN LEFT** at Kemp Mill Road (5.6 Km). Continue to the traffic light at Hermleigh Road. **TURN RIGHT** and cross Kemp Mill Road at the crosswalk. **TURN LEFT** and continue on the right side of Kemp Mill Road.
12. **TURN RIGHT** on Clintwood Place. At "T", **TURN LEFT** on Clintwood Drive. Continue past Annmore Dr. to a "T" at Monticello Ave.
13. At "T", **CROSS** Monticello Avenue and **TURN LEFT**. Proceed to Kemp Mill Road and **TURN RIGHT**. Continue to Traffic Light at Arcola Avenue. **TURN RIGHT** and continue along Arcola Av. to entrance to Wheaton Regional Park Indoor Ice Arena (7 Km).
14. Follow on the left side of the roadway passing two baseball fields on your left and the indoor tennis court on your right towards the Wheaton Ice Arena. **TURN LEFT** at the Ice Arena and continue straight past a baseball field on your left to the old ice rink and dog park. Continue through the upper parking lot to the dog park.
15. Enter the paved path, keeping the dog park on your right. You will pass Pine Lake on your left.
16. At "Y" **BEAR RIGHT** and proceed back into Brookside Gardens.

17. Inside garden, **BEAR RIGHT** at first “Y” on asphalt trail. After passing Japanese Tea House on your left, **TURN LEFT** on 1st paved pathway lined with stones. (Take time to pause at the Reflection Terrace honoring the 2002 sniper victims.) Continue on stone pathway, passing asphalt trail, and straight through the Fragrance Garden to circular walkway.
18. **TURN LEFT** on circular walkway to rose trellis. **TURN LEFT** at rose trellis.
19. Passing under trellis, **BEAR LEFT** at concrete sidewalk. Sidewalk will curve around until it reaches an asphalt path.
20. **TURN RIGHT**, then **RIGHT** again on the sidewalk, and go through the conservatories (restrooms, water, and seasonal exhibits inside).
21. Exiting through other end of building, **TURN RIGHT** going up steps through formal gardens to the gazebo visible ahead. (Note: If the rear exit is blocked, leave by the door you entered and **TURN RIGHT** going around the building to the rear. Then continue straight to the gazebo.)
22. At gazebo, continue up steps, on the right toward benches, to wood chip trail.
23. At “T” **TURN LEFT** on wood chip trail to asphalt trail.
24. **TURN LEFT** on asphalt trail. At “Y” **VEER RIGHT** and follow to the START/FINISH on your right.

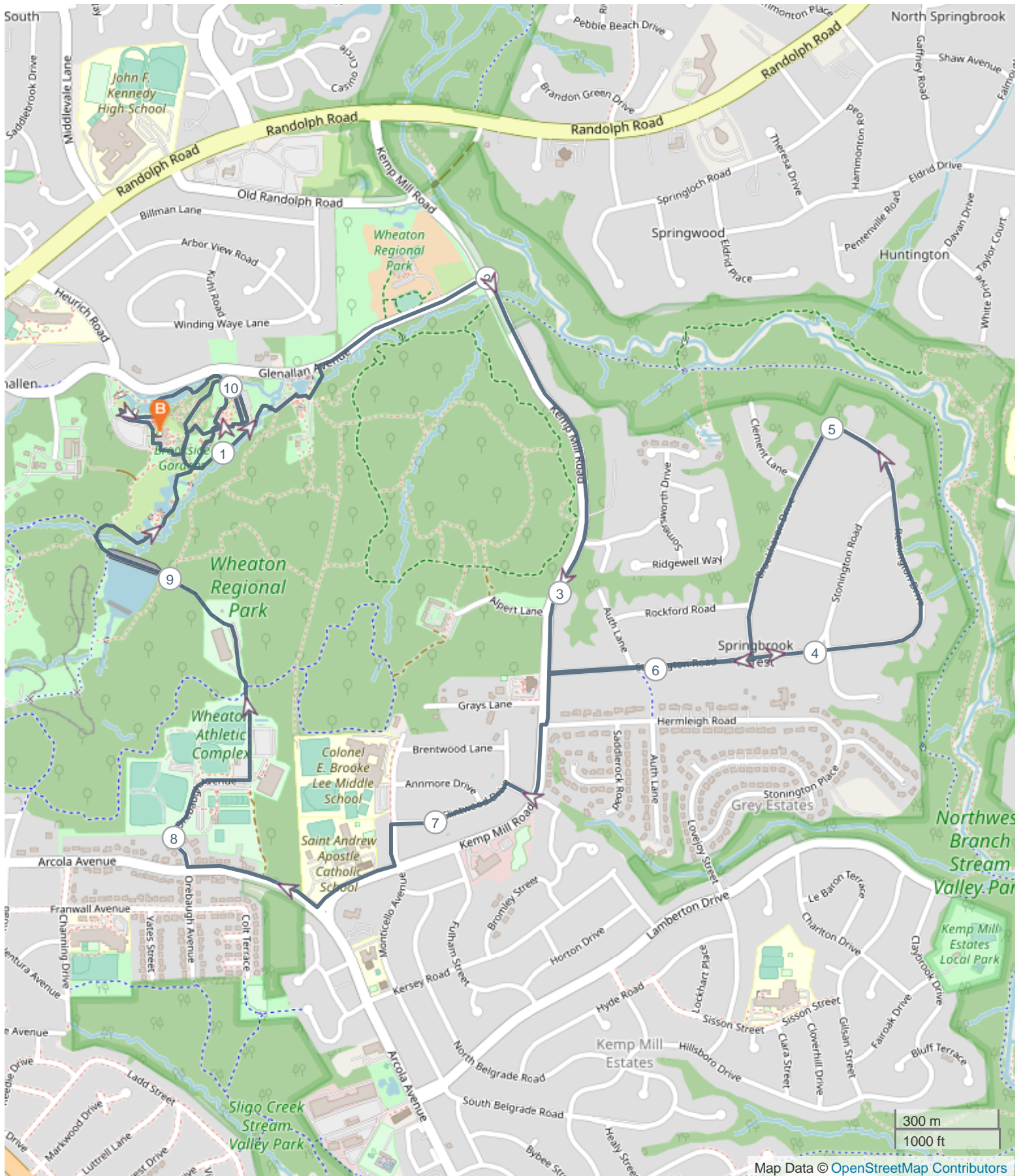

FHW Brookside Gardens Residential 11Km 2nd Route



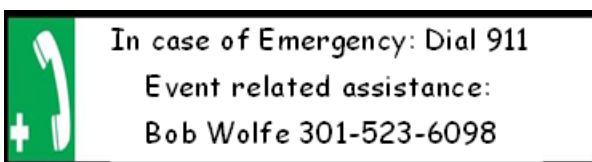
**FREESTATE HAPPY WANDERERS
WHEATON'S BROOKSIDE GARDEN TRAIL/RESIDENTIAL - 5 KM (YR 1619)**

1. EXIT Visitor's Center towards parking lot and **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk following the sidewalk along and then away from the parking lot. At "Y" **TURN LEFT** and continue on path over boardwalk to gate.
2. Exit Brookside Gardens through gate to Glenallan Ave. Cross Glenallan Ave and then continue uphill on Heurich Rd.
3. **TURN RIGHT** on Billman La. Continue on Billman La passing Garden Gate Rd to stop sign at Winding Waye La.
4. **TURN RIGHT** on Winding Waye La. Continue on Winding Waye passing Arbor View Rd, Kuhl Rd (sign on other side of street), Winding Waye Ct to "T" and stop sign at Kuhl Rd.
5. **TURN LEFT** on Kuhl Rd, crossing Winding Waye La, to Arbor View Rd. **TURN LEFT** on Arbor View Rd to Garden Gate Rd (across from 1700 Arbor View). **TURN RIGHT** to cross Arbor View and continue up Garden Gate Rd to Billman La. (3 Km) **TURN LEFT** on Billman La to Heurich Rd.
6. **TURN LEFT** on Heurich Rd and continue downhill to 4-way stop sign by entrance to Brookside Gardens. Cross Glenallan Ave and enter through gate into Brookside Gardens.
7. Continue on boardwalk and then concrete path in the direction of the visitor center. Ignore path on your right to the parking lot, and pass a pond on your left. Continue between two ponds to "T" and **TURN RIGHT**. Pass second pond on your right and continue to an intersecting paved path.
8. **CROSS** the paved path and continue straight on sidewalk. At circular area opposite Conservatories **TURN RIGHT** up 3 steps to the Rose Garden. **TURN RIGHT** and then **TURN LEFT** through the Rose Garden to the trellis. **TURN LEFT** under the trellis and continue past the hedges on your left. At end **TURN RIGHT**.
9. **TURN LEFT** on first path to Fragrance Garden. Continue through the Fragrance Garden and cross an intersecting paved path to the Reflection Terrace honoring the 2002 sniper victims. Turn around and retrace your steps to the paved path.
10. **TURN LEFT** and go uphill to a "Y". **TURN LEFT** at the "Y" and then **TURN RIGHT** on first sidewalk to the Visitor's Center and finish.

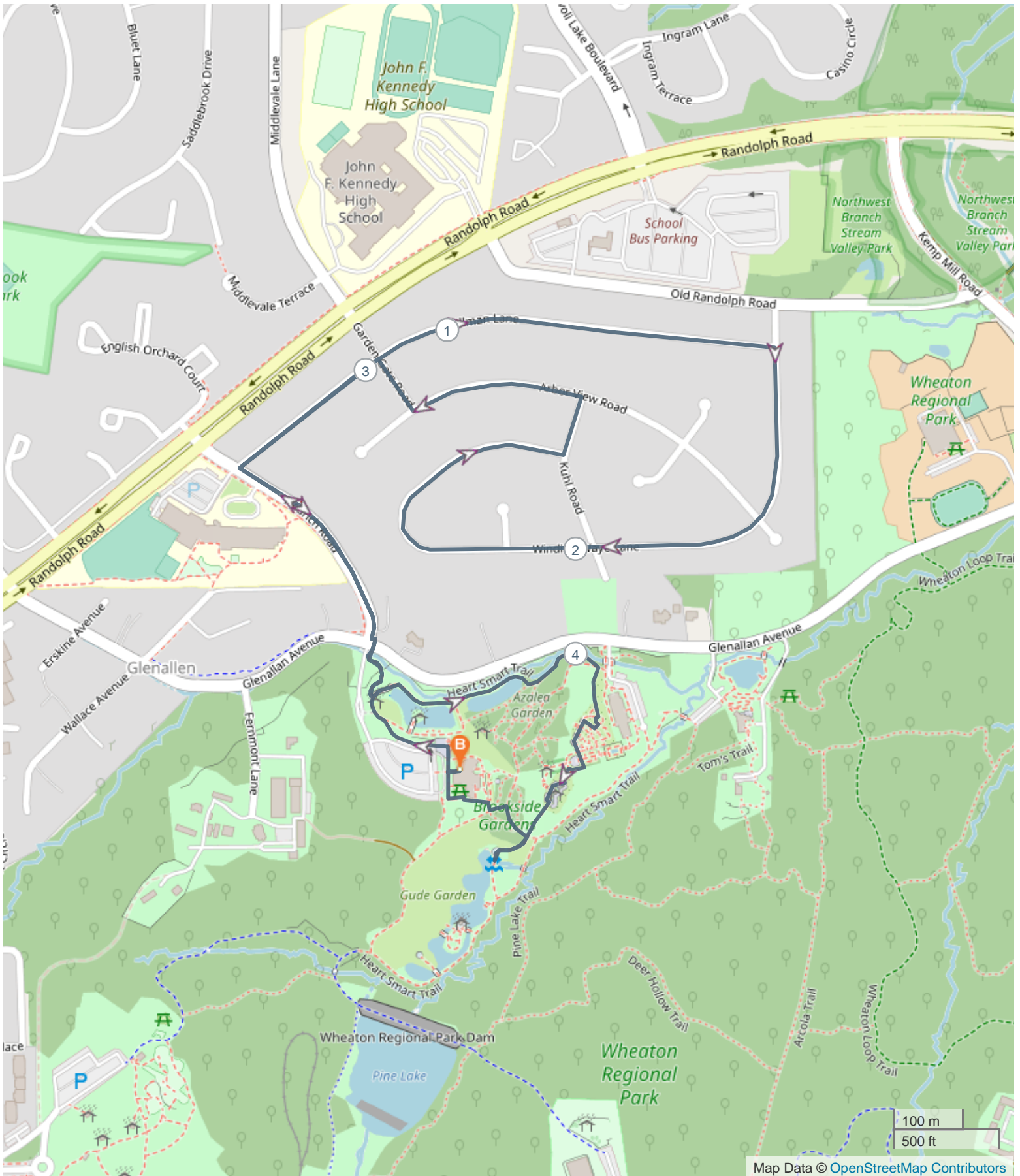

FREESTATE HAPPY WANDERERS

WHEATON BROOKSIDE GARDEN TRAIL (Woods YR 0144/Residential YR 1619) – 5 KM / 10 KM

This trail stays entirely in Brookside Gardens making multiple (6) loops (one complete loop is 1 mile), but is mostly on paved paths and should be suitable for inclement weather.

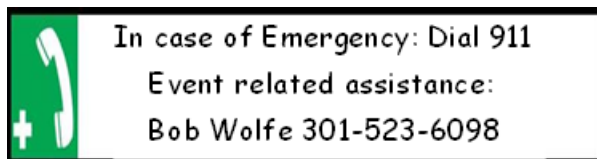
1. EXIT Visitor's Center towards parking lot and **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk following the sidewalk along and away from the parking lot. At "Y" **TURN RIGHT**. Pass the first pond on your left continuing between two ponds to a "T" – **TURN RIGHT** (keeping second pond on your right.)
2. As you approach the Conservatories, the path comes to a "T" at an asphalt path – **TURN HARD RIGHT** (uphill) on asphalt trail. (Do not continue towards the Conservatories.)
3. At top of hill, **BEAR LEFT** at "Y" on asphalt trail (down hill), passing the Viburnum Garden on your right.
4. **BEAR RIGHT** at next "T". Continue Clockwise around the gardens ignoring four paths to the left (to exit, to service area, parking lot and to visitor's center). Just past the turn to the visitor's center **BEAR LEFT** at the "Y". (1.25 Km)
5. Continue on the paved path down the hill (same as in step 2) toward the Conservatories. At the bottom of the hill **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk in front of Conservatories (water and restrooms).
6. Follow the sidewalk keeping the Conservatories on your right. At the end of the circular parking lot **TURN LEFT** and **THEN RIGHT** onto the paved path. Fencing will be on your left.
7. At the next "Y" **TURN RIGHT** uphill passing the Viburnum Garden on your left. At the top of the hill **TURN LEFT** at the "Y".
8. Continue counterclockwise around grassy area ignoring four paths to the right (to visitor's center, parking lot, to service area and to exit). At wood chip path on your left, **TURN LEFT** to the Japanese Tea House. (Not suitable for strollers or wheelchairs.) (2.5 Km)
9. Follow the stone path around the island garden and exit where you entered. **TURN LEFT** at the paved perimeter path. **TURN LEFT** on next paved pathway (Not suitable for strollers or wheelchairs). (Take time to pause at the Reflection Terrace honoring the 2002 sniper victims.) Continue, passing asphalt trail, and straight through the Fragrance Garden to circular walkway.
10. **TURN LEFT** on circular walkway to rose trellis. **TURN LEFT** at rose trellis. Passing under trellis, **BEAR LEFT** at concrete sidewalk. Sidewalk will curve around until it reaches an asphalt path.
11. **TURN LEFT** (uphill) on asphalt trail (same as step 2). At top of hill, **BEAR LEFT** at "Y" on asphalt trail (down hill), passing the Viburnum Garden on your right. **BEAR RIGHT** at next "T". Continue Clockwise around the gardens ignoring four paths to the left.
12. Just past the turn to the visitor's center **BEAR RIGHT** at the "Y". Continue on the paved path down the hill to the "T". At the bottom of the hill **TURN LEFT** on paved path to the Conservatories (water and restrooms). Continue through parking lot with Conservatories on you left. In front of Conservatories, enter the sidewalk and continue to the asphalt path. **TURN LEFT** and then immediately take first path to the **RIGHT**.
13. Pass the first pond and follow to a "Y" – **TURN LEFT** on path (keeping second pond on your right). At the end of the second pond, **TURN RIGHT** and visit the Gazebo. Exit the Gazebo and continue on sidewalk to parking lot and **LEFT** to Visitor Center. **(5 KM finish)**

14. **10K walkers** Continue past Visitor Center and **TURN LEFT** on last sidewalk, passing the Visitor Center on your left. **VEER RIGHT** on sidewalk to asphalt path. **BEAR RIGHT** at the “T”. Continue counterclockwise around grassy area ignoring all paths to the right. Continue on the perimeter path until you reach the Conservatories. Follow the sidewalk past the front of the Conservatories to a paved path. (6 Km)
15. **TURN LEFT** (uphill) on asphalt trail (same as step 2). At top of hill, **BEAR LEFT** at “Y” on asphalt trail (down hill), again passing the Viburnum Garden on your right. **BEAR RIGHT** at “T”. Continue Clockwise around the gardens ignoring four paths to the left (to exit, to service area, parking lot and to visitor’s center).
16. Just past the turn to the visitor’s center **BEAR LEFT** at the “Y”. Continue on the paved path down the hill (same as in step 2) toward the Conservatories. At the bottom of the hill **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk in front of Conservatories (water and restrooms).
17. Follow the sidewalk keeping the Conservatories on your right. At the end of the parking lot **TURN AWAY** from the conservatories and take paved path at the end of the circular parking area.
18. At the next “Y” **TURN RIGHT** uphill passing the Viburnum Garden on your left. At the top of the hill **TURN LEFT** at the “Y”. Continue counterclockwise around grassy area ignoring four paths to the right. Continue on the perimeter path. After passing Japanese Tea House on your left, **TURN LEFT** on the paved pathway (same as step 9, not suitable for strollers or wheelchairs). Cross asphalt trail, continue straight on stone slab path through Fragrance Garden to circular walkway.
19. **TURN LEFT** on circular walkway to rose trellis. **TURN LEFT** at rose trellis and rose garden.
20. Passing under trellis, **BEAR LEFT** at concrete sidewalk. Sidewalk will curve around until it reaches an asphalt path. (8.5 Km) **TURN RIGHT**, then **RIGHT** again on the sidewalk, and this time **ENTER** the Conservatories (restrooms, water, and seasonal exhibits inside).
21. Exiting through other end of building, **TURN RIGHT** going up steps through formal gardens to the gazebo visible ahead. (Note: If the rear exit is blocked, leave by the door you entered and **TURN RIGHT** going around the building to the rear. Then continue straight towards the gazebo.)
22. Walk through the first garden with a pool. Then **TURN RIGHT** between hedges to the Rose Garden. **TURN RIGHT** following perimeter of Rose Garden to brick path just beyond 4 benches. **TURN RIGHT** on brick path to end by back of the Conservatories. **TURN LEFT** and continue straight on sidewalk until it ends at a paved path.
23. **VEER LEFT** crossing asphalt path onto path to ponds (do not go uphill). Pass the first pond and follow to a “Y” – **TURN LEFT** on path (keeping second pond on your right). At “Y” **TURN LEFT** to parking lot and **LEFT** to Finish at Visitor’s Center.
