

LAGUNA BEACH – ORANGE COUNTY

Canadian Volkssport Association: Murals – Outside Whole Foods Market; Community Services Building – Laguna Beach Community Services; Church: Presbyterian Church.

Start: Pavilions Market, 600 N. Coast Hwy (Boat Canyon), Laguna Beach, CA 92651.

Directions to Start: Take I-5 or I-405 to Hwy 133 S (becomes Broadway in Laguna Beach), dead-ends at Pacific Coast Hwy 1. Turn right, go approximately 1 mile to Boat Canyon, turn right to shopping plaza.

1. With the front door of the market behind you, turn Left to the Pacific Coast Hwy (PCH). Left on North PCH
2. To Aster St./Cliff and PCH. (5 corners) across from the Laguna Art Museum.
3. Cross over Aster and walk a few steps.
4. Cross Right over Cliff. *Statue of a dog at the drinking fountain on your right. (A donation by dog lovers).*
5. Left in the traffic triangle into the park and continue along Cliff Drive.
6. Turn Left along Cliff Drive as it curves downhill and to the Right to Broadway at its dead end.
7. Right to first stop/go and Left crossing over Broadway. Right along Broadway to the PCH.
8. Left on PCH for one block to Ocean.
9. Crossover Ocean. Then Left on Ocean for two long blocks to Forest Ave./3rd.
10. Right on Forest keeping Right as the road turns, three blocks to the PCH.
11. Left crossing over Forest along the PCH for two streets to Legion St. *****5k** cross the PCH, then turn Right and skip to #21, Option #1 Beach walk: Right along the beach to Laguna Ave. Left to the Main Beach, Right on the famous Boardwalk **OR** skip to #21, Option #2, below.
12. *****10k:** cross Legion and Left along it for two streets to Glenneyre.
13. Right on Glenneyre to Calliope, about a mile.
14. Right on Calliope to the PCH. Left on the PCH. Cross Bluebird Canyon.

15. Right crossing over the PCH and turn Left along the PCH to Moss St., two blocks past Diamond Street.
16. Right on Moss St. to the first driveway on your left.
17. On the next streets, stay Left and walk against the traffic. Keep going on Moss St. to the first street, Ocean Way.
18. Right on Ocean Way. If you have the time, look down at the beautiful beaches at the dead end of the upcoming streets coming from the PCH.
19. Left ½ block at Pearl St. and continue. Stay left. Look out for cars.
20. Right at Agate St. to the PCH. Left at the PCH to Bluebird Canyon

21. Walk option #1 or #2

#1 Bluebird Canyon blacktop ramp using a tan railing on your Left that leads down to the beach. Right along the beach for one mile to the Main Beach and continue on the boardwalk. *Walk along the water's edge where the water has just receded for a firmer walk. The trick is to keep from getting your feet wet. If it is high tide you may want to take your shoes off and wade through it or you may come back up to the PCH by using the many public bronze*

stairways from the beach to the cliffs above them, then Left to the PCH to Laguna Ave., Left to Main Beach, Right on the famous boardwalk. #2 Keep walking on the PCH back to Laguna Ave., then Left to the Main Beach. Right on the popular boardwalk.

22. Options #1 & #2 continue here. *Restrooms and water located at both ends of the boardwalk.* Climb up the flight of stairs and look back at the Main Beach for a picture perfect view.
23. At the top, keep going past the popular Las Brisas Restaurant until you meet the street sidewalk. On your Left is a view point from the gazebo where marriages are performed. Keep going Right along the cliff and bronze rail with the ocean and beach view on your Left. *There are restrooms and water in Heisler Park.* At the end of Heisler Park, the bronze rail and trail will intersect Cliff Dr.
24. Right on Cliff Dr. to Myrtle St. Left on Myrtle St. one block.
25. Crossover the PCH, then Left along it.
26. Right at the shopping center and back to your car. Copyright 2019 PARD
