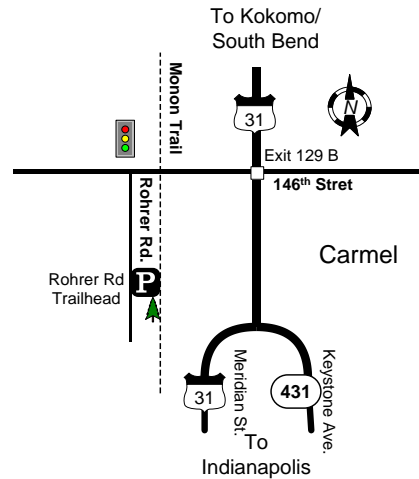


Qualifies for Ice Cream Parlors, Little Free Libraries, Rockin' Around the Clock special event programs.

The start point is the Rohrer Road - Monon Greenway Trailhead, 14178 Rohrer Road · Carmel, IN. There is free parking at the trailhead parking lot which is open from dawn to dusk.

From Indianapolis take US 31 (Meridian St) or SR 431 (Keystone Ave) north and exit at 146th Street, going west. Proceed west on 146th Street to Rohrer Road (traffic signal). Left on Rohrer Road to the Monon parking lot. Left into parking lot (rest rooms and drinking fountain available)

Note: There is a traditional start box nearby at Dunkin', 1305 S Rangeline Road, Carmel, IN 46032. If you have initiated registration in OSB for this event, please stay with the OSB process. Do not double register at the Dunkin's start box. Complete the event by logging back into OSB as stated in walk instructions

10K Walk Instructions

Welcome to Carmel, Indiana, and our beautiful year-round event. There are rest rooms available at the start point and at restaurants along the trail

1. Leave parking lot and go to the entrance to the Monon Greenway and turn right (south).
2. Continue walking south on the Monon Greenway crossing two streets until you come to Main Street (Policeman Statue).
3. Turn left and walk on the north side of Main Street. You will be in the heart of the Arts and Design District.
4. At the stoplight at Rangeline Road, push the walk button and cross the street.
5. Continue straight on Main Street until you get to the second stoplight (you will see Carmel High School straight ahead and the Carmel Clay Library to your right).
6. Press the walk button and turn right and cross Main Street and then turn right again and walk back on the other side of the street.
7. Again, carefully cross Rangeline Road at the stoplight and when you come to the Monon Greenway Trail turn left. You will walk through the newly created Midtown Area.
8. Continue straight going through a tunnel after which you will see the Palladium on the right. The Farmer's Market is held in this area during the warmer months and it is also the site of Carmel's Chriskindlmarket, which runs in November and December.
9. Continue walking down the Monon and after crossing Gradle Drive, you will see a red bridge on your left.
10. Turn left and walk onto the Bridge, after which you will see a parking lot for the Carmel City Hall on your left and a park with a pond on your right.
11. Walk straight on the sidewalk keeping the pond on your right and the parking lot on your left.
12. You will come to the entrance of the Japanese Garden, where there is a large sign.
13. **CHECKPOINT:** What is the Month and Year shown on the lower right of the sign?
14. Continue walking and you will cross a short street with parking on both sides. You will come to Rangeline Road (a busy street).
15. Turn left and continue walking on the sidewalk on the west side of Rangeline.
16. When you come to a roundabout at City Center Drive, very carefully cross at the pedestrian crossing on the left.
14. After crossing City Center Drive, turn left and walk a short distance and then follow the trail on the right downhill to the Monon Trail.
15. Turn right on the Monon Trail and continue walking past several intersections until you come to 136th Street (also known as Smokey Row).
16. Turn right and walk on the trail on south side of 136th Street.
17. Carefully cross Rangeline at the Pedestrian crossing to right. Continue walking on 136th Street and you will go over a bridge.
18. A short distance after crossing the bridge, you will come to a Piano Keys crossing.
19. Turn left and carefully cross 136th Street and go straight onto the Greyhound Trail. A parking lot will be on your right and will pass the Carmel High School Football Stadium on the right.
20. Follow the Greyhound Trail as it curves to the left. After crossing a bridge, you will get to a trail roundabout junction. Take the second exit going straight (west) on the Hagan-Burke Trail.
21. Carefully cross Rangeline Road at the pedestrian crossing.
22. Continue walking straight on the Hagan-Burke Trail until it intersects with the Monon Trail.

22. Turn right and follow the Monon Greenway Trail until you are back to the entrance the Rohrer Road parking lot on the left.

23. Turn left and you are back at the start point.

You have completed the 10K walk!

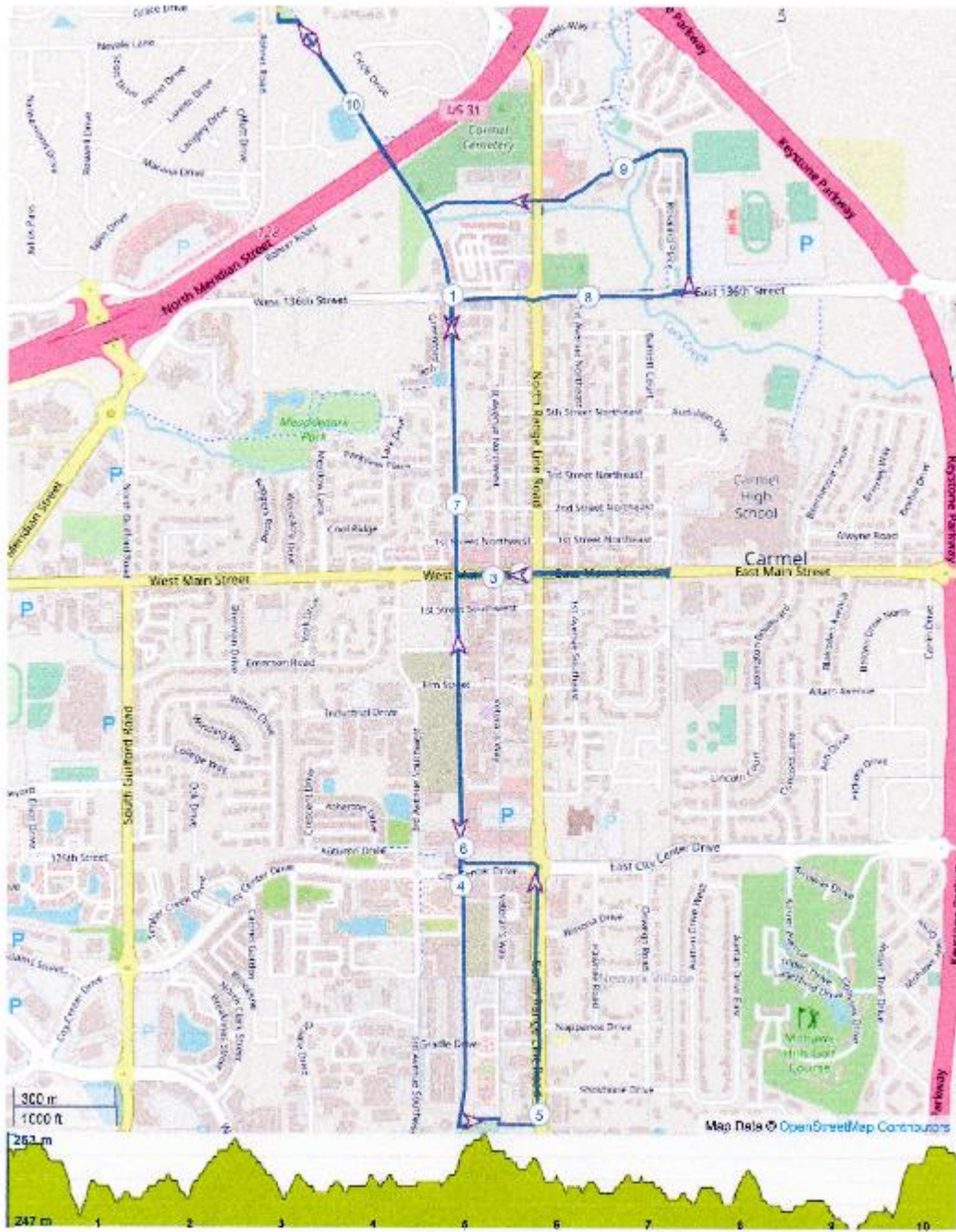

WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT

Be sure to log back into the OSB system to “finish/complete” your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant’s Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date of the event, the distance, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user’s Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user’s Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

5 K Walk Instructions

Welcome to Carmel, Indiana, and our beautiful year-round event. There are rest rooms available at the start point and at restaurants along the trail.

1. Leave parking lot and go to the entrance to the Monon Greenway and turn right (south).
2. Continue walking south on the Monon Greenway crossing two streets until you come to Main Street (Policeman Statue).
3. Turn left and walk on the north side of Main Street. You will be in the heart of the Arts and Design District.
4. At the stoplight at Rangeline Road, push the walk button and cross street.
5. Turn left and walk north on the east side of Rangeline Road.
6. At the Roundabout at 136th Street bear right, going east on 136th Street.
7. Continue walking on 136th Street, crossing a bridge until you come to a "Piano Keys" crossing.
8. Turn left and carefully cross 136th Street and go straight onto the Greyhound Trail. A parking lot will be on your right.
9. After passing the Carmel High School Football Stadium, the trail will go left and you will cross a bridge and then come to a roundabout junction with the Hagan-Burke Trail.

10. Take the second exit going straight (west) on the Hagan-Burke Trail.

11. Carefully cross Rangeline Road at the pedestrian crossing.

12. Continue walking straight on the Hagen-Burke Trail until it intersects with the Monon Greenway Trail.

12. Turn right on the Monon Greenway Trail and continue straight until you are back to the entrance to the Rohrer Road Parking Lot.

13. Turn left and you are back at the start point.
