Driving Directions to Boulder Dam Hotel, 1305 Arizona St, Boulder City, NV 89005

- A. From Las Vegas: Take US 93/95/I-11 South to Exit 15B, Boulder City Parkway. At second light continue straight on Bus. US 93/Nevada Way. Go to C.
- B. From Arizona: Cross O'Callaghan-Tillman Memorial Bridge and take I-11, Exit 2, Boulder City Pkwy. Left at light on Bus. US 93/Nevada Way.
- C. Go thru town and turn right on Arizona St. The Hotel and parking is a half block on your right. Use hotel side entrance for restroom access.

Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB or signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online (including stamps) by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.

Before you begin or after your walk visit the Boulder City Hoover Dam Museum in hotel. Go up 3 steps by front desk and turn left. Follow hallway past Art Gallery to Museum entrance. FREE! Open 7am-7pm.

1. Exit Hotel at side door by restrooms, turn **LEFT** to cross street to Goat Feathers Emporium.
2. Turn **LEFT** and follow the right sidewalk as it curves around, passing parking lot on left and shops on right to Arizona Street.

3. Turn **RIGHT** on Arizona Street and continue to street corner at Police Station.
4. Turn **LEFT** to CAREFULLY CROSS Arizona Street passing City Hall on your right.

The City Hall was the first official school in Boulder City, established in 1932. Just past City Hall, restrooms and water are available on right, near the gazebo bandstand

5. At Colorado Street, (no sign) carefully cross and walk straight on the semi-circular walkway to statue.

Bicentennial Park is often the site of car rallies, art festivals and concerts.

☺ *Walk with America's Veterans – Navy Seal Shane Eric Patton Statue (1st qualifier – Only one qualifier for each paid walk per day. Each qualifier can only be used once in same book.)*

6. Follow the walkway around to left and return to Colorado Street.
7. CAREFULLY CROSS Colorado Street and turn **RIGHT** (Post Office on your left) to Nevada Way.
8. Turn **RIGHT** to cross Colorado Street then turn **LEFT** to cross Nevada Way. You are now walking on the right side of Colorado Street.

Houses date from the 1930s, when Boulder City was built to support Hoover Dam construction. They are original, but have been well-maintained and remodeled.

9. At Railroad Ave., (*sculptures across the street*) turn **RIGHT** and then **RIGHT** again on Denver Street.

We'll be back to see the sculptures later.

10. Continue along Denver, to Nevada Way.
11. Turn **LEFT** and continue on Nevada Way to enjoy the panoramic views of Lake Mead
See the info placard halfway down the street.
12. Continue on Nevada Way to the end of the sidewalk. Turn **RIGHT**, CAREFULLY CROSS Nevada Way and walk uphill on the left side of the Avenue I.
13. At Park Place, CAREFULLY CROSS and follow Park Place uphill.

14. Take the first right onto Park Street., continue uphill on right side walk past homes.

The city park is now on your left and Bureau of Reclamation Administration Building on your right. This building houses the Government offices for Boulder Dam. Boulder City is laid out so that all streets radiate from this building.

15. After passing the steps leading to entrance of Administration Building, **VEER RIGHT** on path to enter the “garden”
16. At circular junction go **LEFT** toward Nevada Way.
17. **CAREFULLY CROSS** Nevada Way and turn **LEFT**.
18. **CROSS** Colorado Street, to walk down the right side of Nevada Way.

This is the original main street, with many unique stores and shops. The Original Coffee Cup Café is a local and international favorite.

19. Cross Ash and turn **RIGHT**. Restrooms available on corner up steps.
20. Continue to and **CROSS** Railroad Avenue.
21. Circle **LEFT** through Teddy Fenton Memorial Park Reflections Center with multiple sculptures to parking lot.
22. Turn **LEFT** and up the steps.
23. Facing the building, bear right on driveway to Railroad Street (no sign)
24. **CAREFULLY CROSS** Railroad Street and turn **RIGHT**
25. Turn **LEFT** at Birch Street
26. **CONTINUE** to Nevada Way (*Frank Crowe Park on right and Sun Dial Park on left with large mural.*)
27. Turn **RIGHT**, walk to and cross Date St/5th St.

Southwest Diner is across the street – another great restaurant.

**** **5KM WALKERS** ****

- Turn **LEFT** and **CROSS** Nevada Way in the crosswalk.
- Continue **STRAIGHT** on 5th St.
- Go to Step 43 to rejoin 10K route.

28. **10K WALKERS:** Continue on Nevada Way to the traffic light.

You will pass Fox Smokehouse BBQ on right. YUM!

29. Using walk signal **CAREFULLY CROSS** Boulder City Parkway.

Construction on corner is for the new Nevada State Railroad Museum Visitor Center opening late 2026.

30. **CONTINUE** on the right sidewalk to Yucca St.

31. Turn **RIGHT** on Yucca and walk uphill.

32. Just before the tracks, turn **RIGHT** to Nevada State Railroad Museum – daily 9:00am to 3:30pm. Restrooms on left. *Train rides are available most weekends.*

33. Retrace your steps to Yucca Street, turn **LEFT** and walk downhill to Boulder City Parkway.

34. Turn **RIGHT** and walk to the 2nd crosswalk.

Chilly Jilly’s has food and soft serve delights. And The Patio is open for brunch 8am-1:30pm Fri-Sun and dinner 5pm-9pm Fri-Sat.

Just past the crosswalk are metal sculptures in the median, reminiscent of the days when Hoover Dam was under construction.

35. **CROSS** Boulder City Parkway with walk signal, turn **LEFT**

36. Just past Mom’s Hotdogs 10:30-3:30 7days, turn **RIGHT** across parking lot to the American Legion Post 31.

☺ **Walk with America’s Veterans – American Legion Post 31** (2nd qualifier)

37. **RETURN** to sidewalk and turn **RIGHT**. Elks Lodge is at 1217 Boulder City Pkwy.

☺ **Walk with America’s Veterans – Elks Lodge Armed Forces sidewalk display** (3rd qualifier)

38. Turn **RIGHT** on Juniper Way.

☺ **Walk with America’s Veterans – Freedom Tree Plaque** (4th qualifier) embedded in ground after second tree by RV park.

39. Turn **LEFT** on Elm St.
40. **CROSS** Buchanan using crosswalk signal and continue on Elm St. as it curves left to Nevada Way
41. Turn **RIGHT** on Nevada Way to 5th St.
Southwest Diner across the street.
42. Turn **RIGHT** on 5th St.
43. Continue past 1525 5th Street. *House number 1525 was a first-place winner in the national Christmas Light Fight competition in 2017.*
44. Turn **LEFT** on Avenue B to Wyoming Street.
45. Turn **LEFT** on Wyoming Street to Nevada Way.
46. Turn **RIGHT** on Nevada Way.

47. Turn **RIGHT** on Arizona Street to Hotel.

We hope you enjoyed historic Boulder City. Boulder Dam Brewing Co across the street has great atmosphere and even better burgers. Or try the Cornish Pasty restaurant also across the street.

Be sure to log back into the OSB system (my.ava.org) to finish/complete your online registration after doing the walk. The OSB system does not deduct any walking fee from a walker's Event Bank until they have submitted walk completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that walker is participating in. (NOTE: The \$2 fee for event PDF Download is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the pdf is downloaded. This prepaid fee is applied against the credit fee(s) at the OSB "Finish Table" when you submit the walk completion info. However, the \$2 "coupon" for the downloaded PDF expires 60 days from download.)



Built in 1933 to accommodate visitors to the construction of Hoover Dam (then called Boulder Dam), the historic Boulder Dam Hotel preserves the classic style of the era. This tidy, boutique-style hotel is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and houses the Boulder City Hoover Dam Museum. The free museum tells story of the construction of Hoover Dam with an emphasis on the men and women who braved the desolation of the Southern Nevada desert to build it. bchdmuseum.org

The BC Art Guild Gallery is also located in the hotel near museum with over 1,000 sq.ft. of exhibits from the best local and regional artists.
