This walk is rated 1A.**

This is a unique opportunity to see the Town of Woodway with its horse stables, chickens, and beautiful homes followed by a walk in Edmonds "Bowl" neighborhood and historic cemetery ending with views of Puget Sound and the Olympic Mountains.

**Starting Point:** Harbor Square Athletic Club  
160 W Dayton Street., Edmonds, WA 98020



**Driving Directions:**

I-5 (N & S) take exit #177 for SR104W toward Edmonds. Keep right at the fork, following signs for WA-104 W/Edmonds/Kingston Ferry. Left on Dayton Street. Left at first street (unmarked) into Harbor Square Complex. Free parking available in parking lot.

**Restrooms:** Edmonds City Park (both 6K and 10K), and QFC (10k only).

Please use either the Online Start Box(OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. DO NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.

Walk completion and credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system ([my.ava.org](http://my.ava.org)) to finish/complete your online registration after doing the walk. The OSB system does not deduct any walking fee from a walker's Event Bank until they have submitted walk completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that walker is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to walker's Event Bank when he/she submits the walk completion info as a paying for credit walker. Note, however, the \$2 "coupon" for the downloaded PDF expires in 60 days.

**Walking Instructions:**

1. Leaving Athletic Club turn **TURN LEFT** thru parking lot to white poles bordering red path bordered.
2. **TURN LEFT** on path, following it to front of Hotel driveway entrance.
3. **TURN RIGHT** toward Hwy 104.
4. **TURN RIGHT** again at Hwy 104 (unmarked), passing Edmonds Marsh on your right.
5. **TURN LEFT** at pedestrian crosswalk on Hwy 104.
6. Follow short path down through a chain link gate into park.
7. **TURN LEFT** on 1<sup>st</sup> road in park.
8. **TURN RIGHT**, through barrier. Stay on asphalt path passing Shelter 2. RR on left.
9. Follow path veering to right to second RR, then **TURN LEFT** up steps to exit park.
10. **TURN RIGHT** onto 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. S. After passing under overpass, 3rd Ave S changes street name to Woodway Park Rd.
11. **TURN LEFT** onto Algonquin Road. (Cross at crosswalk which is a few feet pass street.)
12. At stop sign, cross N. Deer Drive, to continue onto 226th St. SW for several blocks.
13. Cross Hwy 104 (also called Edmonds Way) at light, using crosswalk
14. **TURN LEFT** to cross 15th St. SW at light using crosswalk.
15. Continue on Hwy 104 (Edmonds Way).
16. At split in road, veer to the right onto Paradise Lane.
17. Follow Paradise Lane until you reach a "Y" in the road.
18. Veer to the left onto dead end street with steel barriers.
19. At the right of the barriers, there is an opening that leads to a paved path.
20. **TURN RIGHT** on this paved path.
21. HWY 104 (Edmonds Way) and a cyclone fence will be on your left.
22. Follow the path up a short hill to 5th Ave. South.
23. **TURN RIGHT** onto 5th Ave. South for 1K. (also named Rosalynn Sumners Blvd who was an 1984 Winter Olympic figure skating silver medalist and considers Edmonds her hometown.)
24. **TURN LEFT** on Dayton Street. to Hwy 104. Note Edmonds Wastewater Treatment plant on left with fountains.
25. Cross Hwy 104 and enter straight ahead on path to Harbor Square sign, veering to the right to walk through parking lot.
26. **TURN LEFT** at street, taking a slight right to return to Harbor Square Athletic Club to finish.

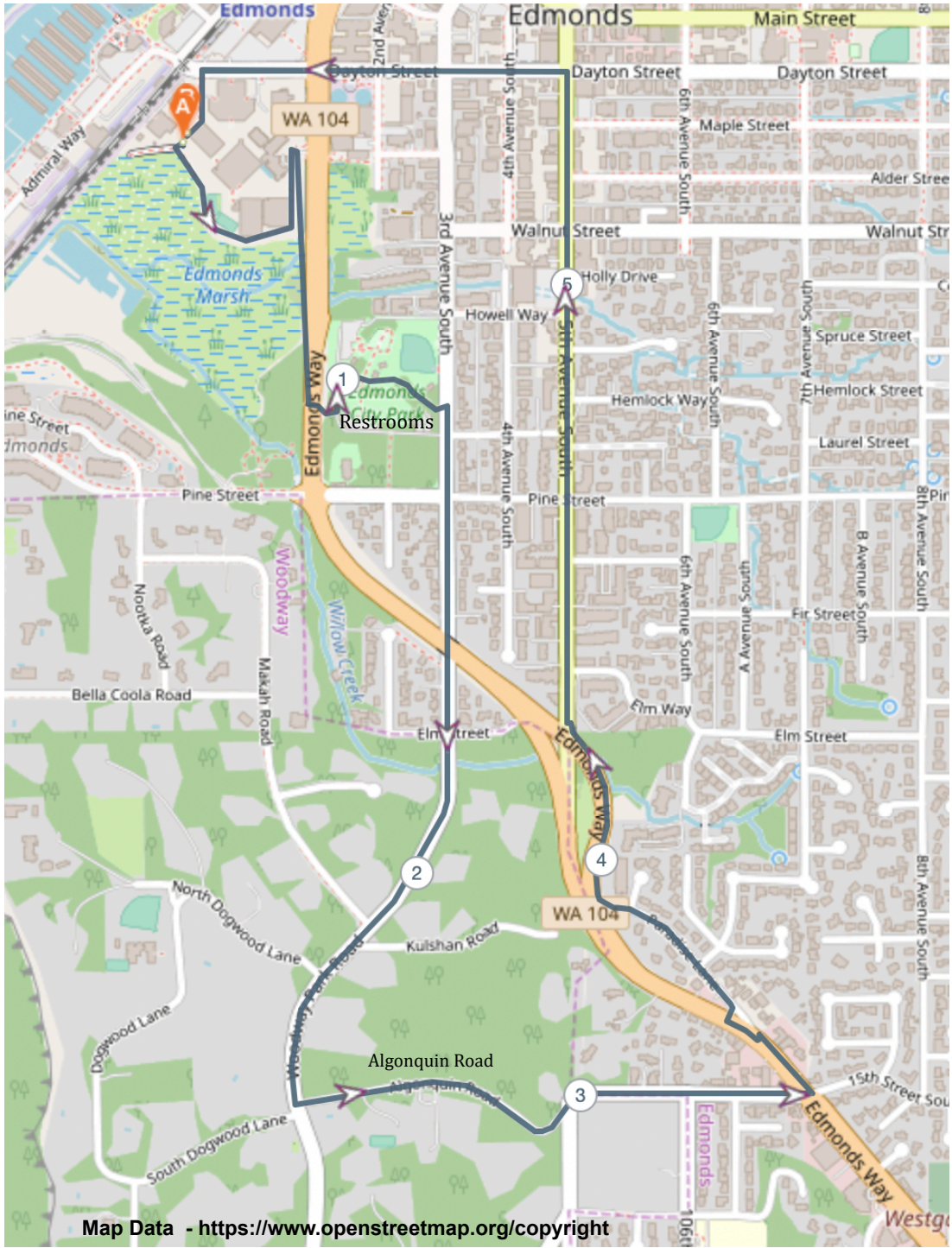

**Walking Instructions:**

1. Leaving Athletic Club turn **TURN LEFT** thru parking lot to white poles bordering red path bordered.
2. **TURN LEFT** on path, following it to front of Hotel driveway entrance.
3. **TURN RIGHT** toward Hwy 104.
4. **TURN RIGHT** again at Hwy 104 (unmarked), passing Edmonds Marsh on your right.
5. **TURN LEFT** at pedestrian crosswalk on Hwy 104.
6. Follow short path down through a chain link gate into park.
7. **TURN LEFT** on 1<sup>st</sup> road in park.
8. **TURN RIGHT**, through barrier. Stay on asphalt path passing Shelter 2. RR on left.
9. Follow path veering to right to second RR, then **TURN LEFT** up steps to exit park.
10. **TURN RIGHT** onto 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. S. After passing under overpass, 3rd Ave S changes street name to Woodway Park Rd
11. **TURN RIGHT** onto North Dogwood Lane (unmarked), walking through 2 stone columns to enter housing complex.
12. Continue on N Dogwood Lane, keeping to the left at the fork in the road, until you come to Woodway Park Road.
13. Cross Woodway Park Road at crosswalk.
14. **TURN LEFT** for a short distance to Algonquin Rd, **TURN RIGHT**.
15. At stop sign, **TURN RIGHT** onto North Deer Drive.
16. Before you get to the 3 way intersection, carefully cross North Deer Drive at 228th St. SW,
17. Enter a short wood chip path, changing to road that leads to 106th Ave W. **TURN RIGHT**.
18. Cross Robin Hood Dr, and **TURN LEFT**.
19. Pass Robbers Roost Rd. In a half block, look for a white mailbox (#23515) across the street. This is your clue to cross Robin Hood Dr.
20. The house at 23515 has a driveway. Do not enter this private road. **TURN LEFT** up hill on wood chip/dirt path.
21. Stay left on path up hill, then pass through chain link gate at the top.
22. Stay on this walkway with running track on your left and baseball field on your right, walking toward school bldg. Pass through gate.
23. **TURN LEFT** on sidewalk. Continue downhill on road (102<sup>nd</sup> Place West-unmarked) to stop sign at bottom of hill (Edmonds Way-unmarked)
24. **TURN RIGHT** to stoplight intersection of Edmonds Way and 100<sup>th</sup> Ave West.
25. **TURN LEFT** onto 100<sup>th</sup> Ave W. (RR at QFC).
26. Continue on 100<sup>th</sup> Ave W to wrought iron gate with brick pillars on your left.
27. **TURN LEFT** into the historic Edmonds Memorial Cemetery.
28. **TURN RIGHT** at first road
29. Exit cemetery, **TURNING LEFT** onto 15<sup>th</sup> Street SW (unmarked).
30. **TURN RIGHT** at 8<sup>th</sup> Ave S.
31. Walk one block on 8<sup>th</sup> Ave S, then cross street to walk on left shoulder.
32. Continue on 8<sup>th</sup> Ave S to dead end street, passing through metal barrier, down steps to cross street.
33. Walk up stairs to the pedestrian path, and continue to Dayton Street.
34. **TURN LEFT** on Dayton Street. to Hwy 104. Note back of Edmonds Library, and then Edmonds Wastewater Treatment plant on left with fountains.
35. Cross Hwy 104 and enter straight ahead on path to Harbor Square sign, veering to the right to walk through parking lot.
36. **TURN LEFT** at street, taking a slight right to return to Harbor Square Athletic Club to finish.

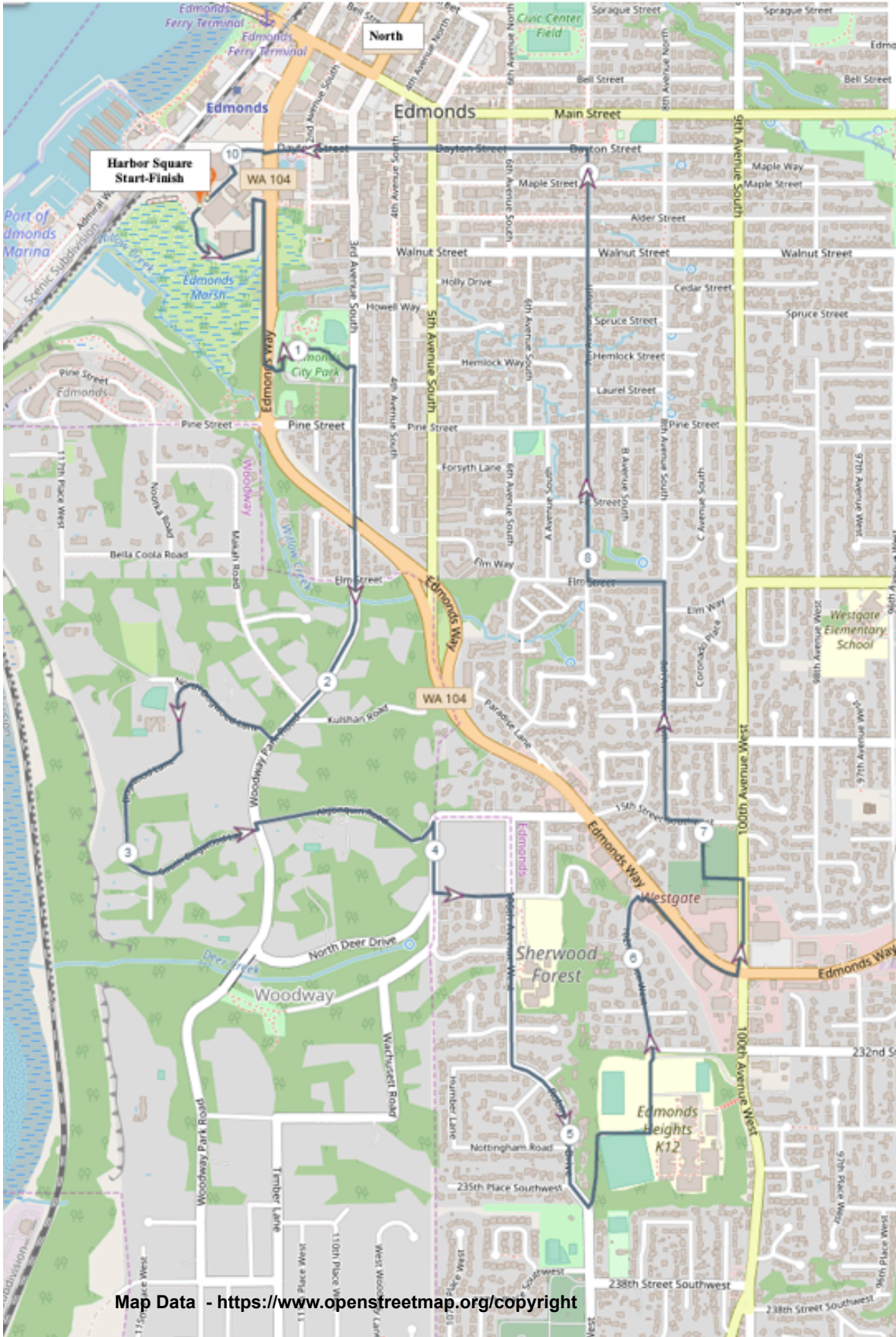
