City of Everett walks Y1919
5K (1A) and two 10K's for a possible 20K loop (1A)**

These walks highlight the City of Everett's neighborhoods, college, arboretum, and waterfront. The 5K includes a walk through Everett College Campus and the Evergreen Arboretum. The 20K loops has two very different 10K's: Directions for the Historical Homes and Buildings includes interesting facts about the homes, places, and building you will walk by. Directions for the waterfront include seeing the marina close up, view from the Grand Ave Park, and various restaurants you can enjoy a meal.

Starting Point: by the restrooms/parking lot at American Legion Memorial Park, 145 Alverson Blvd, Everett, WA 98201

Driving Directions:

1. Driving 5N: Exit 195 for Marine View Drive. Turn left onto E. Marine View Drive. Turn left onto Alverson Blvd. Turn left onto 2nd St into American Legion Memorial Park. Turn left in the parking lot, parking close to Restrooms.
2. Driving 5S: Take exit 198 to merge onto State Rte 529 S/WA-529 S. Take the WA-529 S/Marine View Dr. exit toward Port of Everett/Naval Station. Keep right and merge onto WA-529 S/E Marine View Dr. Turn left onto Alverson Blvd. Turn left onto 2nd St. Turn left in the parking lot, parking close to Restrooms.

Restrooms: American Legion Memorial Park, Waterfront, Student Bldg at Everett College Campus.

Walk completion and credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system (my.ava.org) to finish/complete your online registration after doing the walk. The OSB system does not deduct any walking fee from a walker's Event Bank until they have submitted walk completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that walker is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to walker's Event Bank when he/she submits the walk completion info as a paying for credit walker. Note, however, the \$2 "coupon" for the downloaded PDF expires in 60 days.

Restrooms at Legion Park

1. Start the walk with your back to the restrooms, crossing parking lot to exit at 2nd St. **TURN RIGHT** on 2nd St.
2. **TURN LEFT** on Alverson Blvd.
3. Alverson Blvd will curve Right.
4. Follow Alverson Blvd then **TURN LEFT** onto Rucker Ave.
5. **TURN LEFT** on 10th St.
6. Follow 10th St pass Whittier School.
7. **TURN LEFT** onto Trojan Way.
8. At the corner with Tower St **TURN LEFT** on sidewalk entrance to Everett College campus.
9. Continue straight on sidewalk into campus.
10. Pass the Jackson Center bldg on your right.
11. At the corner of Jackson Center **TURN RIGHT** onto sidewalk.
12. Pass the Parks Student Union.
13. Sidewalk will curve **LEFT**.
14. Stay **LEFT** at sidewalk junction.
15. **TURN RIGHT** at the next sidewalk junction, continue to campus exit.
16. Cross parking lot toward Wetmore Ave.
17. **TURN RIGHT** on Wetmore Ave.
18. **TURN RIGHT** on Alverson Blvd.
19. **TURN RIGHT** on 2nd St.

20 **TURN RIGHT** at the parking lot for Evergreen Arboretum. Trail next to parking lot.

21. Follow trail into Evergreen Arboretum.
22. Stay **RIGHT** on the trail in the Arboretum.
23. Follow the trail to the far end of the Arboretum.
24. Return by the Gazebo and the Water Feature. Continue to exit the Arboretum.
25. Return to American Legion Park and finish.

Everett Historical Homes & Buildings Y1919 Rated 1A 10K

Bayside Area, American Legion Park 145 Alverson Blvd, Everett, WA

Restroom at American Legion Park and Library.

Enjoy this walk, full of addresses of historic homes on this special 10K

1. With Restroom behind you, **TURN LEFT** crossing parking lot to exit at 2nd St.
2. **TURN RIGHT** onto 2nd St.
3. **TURN LEFT** onto Alverson Blvd.
4. **TURN LEFT** onto Grand Ave
5. Follow Grand Ave and stay on the Left side.

1703 Grand (1910) Butler-Jackson House is in the Northwest Neighborhood . 1967 Senator Henry M "Scoop" Jackson & family moved into the home (\$65,000 purchase price). Senator Jackson ran for president twice.

2012 Grand (1901) William Chase Cottage. Simple worker class house

2031 Grand (1908) W.J. Clough House. Swiss chalet character in a Craftsman Style home.

2132 Grand (1900) Gable-front vernacular house that was once hidden by a neighborhood grocery store.

2228 Grand - Mills Flats. The Mills family developed many cottages & bungalows on 2 blks of Grand. This unusual 2 story house is suggestive of 19th century Greek Revival style. Note bridge to sidewalk.

6. **TURN LEFT** on 23rd.
7. **TURN RIGHT** on Rucker to Everett Ave

2301 Rucker (on left) (1899) Andrew J. Andre Northwest Colonial Revival style, historically restored by Dave & Diane Loop.

2302 Rucker - John T. McChesney House. Mr. McChesney was in charge of J.J. Hills Everett Improvement Company.

2320 Rucker (1905) Governor Roland H. Hartley Mansion. Has a ballroom on the 3rd floor & a turnstile in the garage to turn the car around to drive out.

2421 Rucker (1905) Schumacher Ecklund House. Classic American Foursquare. Arthur & his wife Theresa lived in the house from 1918 to 1977.

2632 Rucker (1923) Madrona Apts. Advertised in the Herald as having every modern device known in apartment houses'. Tudor - apartment - style.

8. **TURN LEFT** on Everett Ave.
9. **TURN RIGHT** on Hoyt.

2702 Hoyt (1934) The Everett Public Library. (RESTROOM)

10. **TURN LEFT** on Hewitt to Lombard
At Colby: (1901) Everett Historic Theater

At Wetmore: Free Speech Corner - Traditional spot for local evangelists & soapbox orators. Focal point for controversy that led to the Everett Massacre.

1721 Hewitt (1925) Central Bldg. Cost: \$150,000

1801 Hewitt - Commerce Block. Occupied by Everett Women's Suffrage Club the year Washington women gained the right to vote .

1805 Hewitt (1902) Fire & rebuilt (1909)

1901 Hewitt (1902) Early commercial bldg.

1915 Hewitt - Mitchell Hotel. This was the main city hotel when the original Monte Cristo Hotel was turned into a hospital.

11. **TURN LEFT** on Lombard to California

2812 Lombard (1930) Labor Temple built during the depression. Fraternal orders/ labor organizations .

12. **TURN LEFT** on California.

Corner of Oakes (1920) Challacombe Funeral Home Corner of Oakes - Fire Station #2 built in the 1920's

Corner of Rockefeller (1921) YMCA Georgian style

13. **TURN RIGHT** on Colby.

2722 Colby (1925) Med-Dental Bldg. Art Deco & Renaissance style.

2714 Colby - Treasure House, was the oldest business on Everett & Colby. Built in the 20's as an auto shop.

1611 Everett Ave (1921) Knights of Columbus

2416 Colby Established 1880 - Everett High School - example of 'Beau Arts Academy' classicism is rich in detail.

14. **TURN LEFT** on 23rd.

2301 Hoyt (1920) Trinity Episcopal Church

15. **TURN RIGHT** on Rucker.

2230 Rucker (1901) John T McChesney House

2208 Rucker (1910) Blackman House \$6,000 to build

2201 Rucker(1905) Spanish Colonial style

2129 Rucker (1895) Clark Mansion

2112 Rucker (1905) Howard S. Wright Construction magnate built this house & his company built Seattle World's Fair buildings including the Space Needle.

2108 Rucker (1907) Hilzinger House This family moved here in 1903 from North Dakota

2031 Rucker (1932) Marlborough Apts. Art deco/modern.

16. Follow Rucker Ave to 10th St **TURN RIGHT.**

17. 10th St to Wetmore Ave, cross Wetmore Ave **TURN LEFT.**

18. Passing the Everett College campus, buildings opened in 1958.

19. **TURN RIGHT** on Alverson Blvd.

20. **TURN RIGHT** on 2nd St return to finish at Legion Park.

American Legion Park

145 Alverson Blvd

Everett, WA 98

Restroom (RR) at Legion Park and Waterfront Park

1. With Restroom at your back, **TURN LEFT** cross parking lot to exit park on 2nd St.
2. **TURN RIGHT** on 2nd St.
3. Cross Alverson Blvd **TURN RIGHT**.
4. Cross W Marine View Dr in crosswalk, **TURN LEFT**.
5. Follow W Marine View Dr, passing Port Gardner Bay.
6. Cross 10th St, **TURN RIGHT** to boat launch parking.
7. Restroom next to boat launch. Continue to water.
8. Trail will **TURN LEFT** continue along waters edge, trail will **TURN LEFT**.
9. At corner with Craftsman Way trail will **TURN RIGHT**.
10. At Fisherman's Tribute statue **TURN LEFT**.
11. Pass statue, **TURN RIGHT**.
12. At the corner with Millwright Lp N **TURN LEFT**, pass Scuttlebutt Brew Pub on your left.
13. Follow sidewalk as it curves **LEFT** onto 13th St.
14. **TURN RIGHT** at first intersection, cross street toward Hotel Indigo.
15. Walk along Hotel Indigo toward Pacific Rim Plaza.
16. Continue **STRAIGHT AHEAD** to walk sidewalk along Marina.
17. Sidewalk will **TURN LEFT** continue along Marina.
18. **TURN RIGHT** toward Grand Ave Park Bridge.
19. Ascend the stairs or use the elevator. Cross the bridge to Grand Ave Park.
20. **TURN RIGHT** in Grand Ave Park.
21. Walk thru the Grand Ave Overlook Park to the far end.
22. At the end of park **TURN LEFT** on 19th.
23. **TURN LEFT** on Rucker.
24. **TURN RIGHT** on 10th St.
25. **TURN LEFT** on Trojan.
26. **TURN LEFT** at corner with Tower St (Golf Course beyond fence).
27. Follow sidewalk **STRAIGHT AHEAD** into Everett College campus.
28. Continue **STRAIGHT AHEAD** on campus sidewalk toward Jackson Conference Center building to your right.
29. Pass Jackson Center, then **TURN RIGHT** on sidewalk.
30. Pass Parks Student Union (RR), sidewalk curves left.
31. At Totem Pole **STAY LEFT** at sidewalk junction.
32. **TURN RIGHT** at next sidewalk junction.
33. Continue to edge of campus, pass the Clock Tower.
34. Cross parking lot to Wetmore Ave, **TURN RIGHT**.
35. **TURN RIGHT** on Alverson Blvd.
36. **TURN RIGHT** on 2nd St enter Legion Park.
37. **TURN RIGHT** on trail next to Evergreen Arboretum parking.
38. Enter Arboretum on right side, at trail junction take right hand gravel trail.
39. Continue across bridge, continue straight ahead to Silver Boxed sculpture in corner of Arboretum.
40. Return on the right side of Gazebo, continue past Water Sculpture.
41. Exit Arboretum return to the parking lot in Legion Park.
