Kingston YRE #1927
6K (1A) and 10K (2B) EVENT**

10K walk is rated 2B due to hills and exposed roots on trails.

Leave your car in Edmonds and enjoy a relaxing ferry ride to Kingston, where the walk begins at Port of Kingston Kiwanis Park. Enjoy the marina, community center/library, neighborhood parks, all in this quaint town. Plenty of places for eats and special coffees.

Starting Point: Port of Kingston Kiwanis Park (one block up from ferry terminal on the right side.) 25882 Washington Blvd. NE, Kingston, WA



Driving Directions:

1. For walk-on passengers from Edmonds-Kingston Ferry, Port of Kingston Kiwanis Park(PoKKP) is located to the right of the toll booth.
2. If you are driving via Ferry, there is a free 2hr parking in the Marina parking lot on your left. Park, and walk across Hwy 104 to PoKKP.
3. Driving from the Olympic Peninsula, head towards Kingston on Hwy. 104. There is a free 2hr parking in the Marina parking lot on your right. Park, and walk across Hwy 104 to PoKKP.

Restrooms: Ferry terminal and Library.

Walk completion and credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system (my.ava.org) to finish/complete your online registration after doing the walk. The OSB system does not deduct any walking fee from a walker's Event Bank until they have submitted walk completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that walker is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to walker's Event Bank when he/she submits the walk completion info as a paying for credit walker. Note, however, the \$2 "coupon" for the downloaded PDF expires in 60 days.

RR at Kingston Ferry Dock

1. With the Kiwanis Park Gazebo behind you, walk straight ahead to Washington Blvd NE, and **TURN LEFT**.
2. Cross State Hwy 104 and **TURN RIGHT**.
3. Continue walking up hill, crossing NE West Kingston Road. (unmarked)
4. At next street, **TURN LEFT** onto NE Maine St (Kola Kole Park will be on your right.)
5. **TURN RIGHT** onto Banister NE St.
6. **TURN LEFT** using crosswalk, onto NE Oregon St.
7. Pass through 4 yellow post. immediately **TURNING LEFT**.
8. **TURN RIGHT** down hill on sidewalk.
9. **CURVE LEFT**, keeping Village Green Community Center on your right (RR)
10. Continue downhill on sidewalk to street below.
11. **TURN RIGHT** onto NE West Kingston Rd (unmarked). Children's play area on your left.
12. Using crosswalk, **TURN RIGHT** on Barber Cutoff NE Road.
13. **TURN RIGHT** onto Tuckerman NE Ave. into Kingston Hill neighborhood.
14. Walk on left side of street on sidewalk.
15. Stay on sidewalk as it curves left and then down hill.
16. **TURN RIGHT** onto NE Carpenter Lane
17. **TURN RIGHT** onto Barber Cutoff, using crosswalk.
18. In a short distance, **TURN LEFT** onto Carpenter Lake Nature Reserve trail.
19. **TURN RIGHT** at first crosswalk, continuing on sidewalk with cable barrier.
20. Cross at crosswalk, then **TURN RIGHT** at next crosswalk walk toward gravel parking lot.
21. Continue along the gravel lot, looking to your left at paved parking lot for sign "Trail Access".
22. **Cross Street** at the corner of paved parking lot to walking diagonally toward another "Trail Access" sign.
23. Pass thru gate onto trail, passing Portable buildings for Richard Gordon Elementary School.
24. Pass thru another gate to Carpenter Lake Trail.
25. Follow trail to the end at the Boardwalk viewing platform.
26. Return on same route to sidewalk with Cable Barrier.
27. At the end of sidewalk with cable barrier, use crosswalk and then **TURN LEFT** down hill.
28. Return to Barber Cutoff NE Rd, **TURN RIGHT**.
29. **TURN LEFT** onto NE Kingston Rd.
30. Street name changes to NE West Kingston Rd.
31. Using crosswalk, **TURN RIGHT** onto Central NE Ave.

32. Continue downhill on sidewalk with parking lot on your right.
33. At the end of the sidewalk, **TURN RIGHT** crossing parking lot.
34. Join the sidewalk, **TURNING LEFT**, keeping the water and black iron fence your right.
35. **TURN LEFT** at boat ramp, then immediately **TURN RIGHT**. (RR)
36. Continue on sidewalk as it curves, keeping water on your right.
37. **OPTION 1: TURN RIGHT** on ramp to Ferry Terminal.
38. **OPTION 2:** Continue on sidewalk around park, walking upstairs to Washington

Blvd, **TURNING RIGHT**, returning to Kiwanis Park Gazebo.

Port of Kingston Kiwanis Park

RR is located at Ferry Terminal and at the Library.

1. Leaving the Kiwanis Park, with your back to the gazebo and ferry parking lot, **TURN RIGHT** on the sidewalk along Washington Blvd.(street is unmarked)
2. Walk on Washington Blvd, using crosswalk at light, and continue up hill, passing through yellow posts.
3. Continue straight to the paved trail.
4. **TURN LEFT** at NE 3rd Ave.
5. Cross next street (Ohio Ave, unmarked), and **TURN RIGHT**.
6. Street splits. Keep **LEFT** on Ohio Ave, walking up hill.
7. Look for a green, cyclone fence on your left and with sign for Public Utilities Trail, and stairs.
8. **TURN LEFT** down stairs to trail.
9. **TURN RIGHT** at end of stairs.
10. **Keep right** at next intersection.
11. Cross over creek. Continue walking with the creek on your right. This is the main trail.
12. There will be side trails along the way, just keep going straight, veering to the right.
13. You should see a cement wall coming up on your right. As you reach the corner of the cement wall, take the main trail to the **LEFT**.
14. In a short distance, you will see a split in the trail. Take the trail UP hill & continue for about 1K.
15. Trail ends at unpaved road which is NE 272nd (unmarked). **TURN LEFT**, staying on NE 272nd.
16. **TURN LEFT** at Lindvog Road (no sign).
17. **CROSS** Lindvog Road to walk on the right side, until sidewalk ends. Cross back over Lindvog Road and continue ahead.
18. Cross Hwy 104 with the crosswalk.
19. **TURN RIGHT** on NE West Kingston Rd.
20. **CROSS** Barber Cutoff Rd NE and **TURN RIGHT**.
21. Look for a sign Carpenter Lake Nature Preserve. **TURN LEFT** on trail.
22. **TURN RIGHT** at first Crosswalk, use sidewalk with cable barrier on sidewalk.

23. Cross at crosswalk, **TURN RIGHT** at crosswalk walk toward gravel parking lot.
24. Continue along the gravel lot, looking to your left at paved parking lot for sign Trail Access.
25. **Cross Street** at the corner of paved parking lot to walking diagonally toward a Trail Access sign.
26. Pass thru gate to trail, pass Portable buildings for Richard Gordon Elementary School.
27. Pass thru another gate to Carpenter Lake Trail.
28. Follow trail to the end at the Boardwalk viewing platform.
29. Return on same route to sidewalk with Cable Barrier.
30. At the end of sidewalk with cable barrier, use crosswalk and then **TURN RIGHT** up hill.
31. **TURN LEFT** through a metal barrier. Notice the small yellow sign for Kitsap County Trail.
32. **TURN LEFT** at paved road junction. Continue to High School Football field. Porta Pottie seasonally available.
33. At "T" intersection with STOP SIGN, cross at crosswalk and **TURN LEFT** onto Siyaya Ave. NE.
34. At the end of the driveway, **TURN LEFT** onto NE West Kingston Rd (no sign).
35. Cross a bridge and continue on the road as it curves left.
36. **TURN RIGHT** on S Kingston Rd NE. (signage also points to Indianola) in the crosswalk. Continue to Arness Roadside Park on your left. (RR). (FYI- authentic Train Caboose is parked on train tracks, on your left)
37. Walk around this small park, and return to road.
38. **TURN RIGHT** on S. Kingston Rd NE.
39. Use crosswalk, and **TURN RIGHT** onto NE West Kingston Rd.
40. Continue on this road as it curves right.
41. Cross Dulay Rd NE and **TURN LEFT uphill**. Stay on the sidewalk on the right side of the road.
42. Kitsap Regional Library is at the top of the road (#26159 Dulay Road). **TURN RIGHT** to continue on sidewalk ramp to the exit.
43. **PASS** through 4 yellow posts. You are now on NE Oregon St (no sign) FYI- notice a miniature castle on your right.)
44. At the end of NE Oregon St ("T"), cross street and **TURN LEFT** onto Bannister (unmarked).

At the intersection of Bannister and Hwy. 104,
TURN RIGHT Hwy 104.

45. **TURN LEFT** onto Ohio Ave N.E.

46. Cross Central Ave NE.

47. Carefully cross parking lot to pedestrian walkway and black iron fence straight ahead.

48. **TURN LEFT**, walking on pedestrian walkway with water on your right, and parking lot on your left, passing restrooms, stage, marina.

49. **OPTION 1:** TURN RIGHT on ramp to Ferry Terminal.

50. **OPTION 2:** Continue on walkway around

park, walking upstairs to Washington Blvd. Cross and return to Kiwanis Park Gazebo. 51. We hope you enjoyed your walk!
