DRIVING DIRECTIONS: Woodard Trailhead at 6518 Shincke Rd NE, Olympia, WA.

From Southbound I-5, take Exit 109 turning **RIGHT** onto Martin Way. Turn **RIGHT** onto Sleater-Kinney Rd NE. In 4.5 miles turn **RIGHT** onto Shincke Rd NE. Trailhead on **RIGHT** in about 1 mile.

From Northbound I-5, take Exit 108 onto Sleater-Kinney Rd North. In 5.3 miles turn **RIGHT** onto Shincke Rd NE. Trailhead on **RIGHT** in about 1 mile.

GPS Coords: 47.123710,-122.850553

Parking: Trailhead.

Restrooms: available at various points along the trail and in the communities of Tenino, Rainier and Yelm.

Bike Completion and Credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

Capitol Volkssport Club Southeast Lacey YRE Bike Event # 1931

1. Start out on the C-W trail at the far end of the parking lot at Mile Post 0. The trail crosses multiple road intersections. Please be careful crossing all roads along this trail as cars may not stop.
2. After MP 10 ½ pass under the main Burlington Northern Railroad line.
3. After MP 21 the C-W trail ends at a T and the Yelm-Tenino trail leads either to Rainier and Yelm or to Tenino. The sign clearly indicates the directions and distances.
4. Heading to Yelm, pass thru Rainier staying on the trail and cross under the train trestle and pass MP 4. Turnaround at upon reaching the gravel road at the end of the bike trail. Retrace back to the Rainier/Lacey/Tenino intersection. RIGHT toward Lacey and the start point or straight ahead on the path to the Tenino.
5. In Tenino, the trail ends at the Depot Museum. Turnaround and retrace back to the Rainier/Lacey/Tenino intersection. LEFT toward Lacey and retrace the path to the start point.

With mile post markings, it is easy to determine the distance traveled. For example, 9 miles divided by 0.6 equals 15 km.
