

**Instructions for
Fort Steilacoom Walk, Y-1996
Steilacoom, WA
6 Km & 10 Km, rated 1B**

Walk Start Location: Chevron Station at 3025 Steilacoom Blvd SW, Steilacoom, WA 98388.
GPS Coordinates: 47.17708, -122.757534.

Driving Directions: From I-5: Exit 129 (So. 72nd St.). Southbound--Get in right lane on off-ramp following So. 74th St. Westbound. Turn right onto So. 74th St. and follow it for 2.1. miles. After crossing Lakewood Dr. W., So. 74th St. becomes Custer Rd. W. Follow Custer Rd. W. for 1.3 miles merging into right lane. Stay in right lane as it turns right onto 88th St. W. After the first traffic signal, 88th merges into Steilacoom Blvd. SW. Follow Steilacoom Blvd. for 2 miles to Sentinel/Far West Dr. SW. Chevron Station is on the right. Park in a stall away from the station entrance if possible. Northbound--Get in left lane at end of off-ramp and turn left onto So. 72nd St. After crossing over I-5, So. 72nd St. becomes So. 74th St. Follow directions above to start point.

Parking: Use parking spots away from the station or on side street.

Restrooms: available in Chevron Station and at step #22 of directions—Jack in the Box.

Walk Completion and Credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that a person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a "paying for credit" participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

"Please use either the Online Start box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB or signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB."

"These maps and directions may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited."

6 and 10 km Directions

- 1 - Depart Chevron Station and head toward the intersection at the traffic light.
- 2 - **CROSS** Steilacoom Blvd.
- 3 - **TURN LEFT** to cross Far West/Sentinel Dr SW
- 4 - Walk on the wide asphalt trail starting at the two wood posts (parallel to Steilacoom Blvd)
- 5 - Continue **STRAIGHT past** the jog in the trail where a trail passes through a tunnel under the road.
- 6 - **RIGHT** at paved Angle Ln SW, (unmarked/historical marker on left), continue straight between the barns.
- 7 - **TURN RIGHT** at stop sign at 4-way intersection, onto Waughop Lake Rd SW
- 8 - Go around steel gate in the road (Discovery Trail Sign) and continue straight
- 9 - **ANGLE RIGHT** at the next trail intersection by the large round stone planter in center of the trail.
- 10-Continue counter-clockwise around Waughop Lake. **DO NOT** take any side trails. **Note the signs showing the history of the lake.**
- 11 - **TURN RIGHT** at large round stone planter back onto Waughop Lake Rd SW, passing parking lot.
- 12 - Proceed around the steel gate across the road again and back to the four-way intersection.

6KM WALKERS GO TO STEP #40

10KM WALKERS CONTINUE WITH STEP #13

- 13 - **TURN RIGHT (RESTROOMS ON LEFT)** and continue straight, going around the steel gate.
- 14 - Continue straight, keeping the dog park to your left.
- 15 - **TURN LEFT** just before another steel gate onto a dirt/gravel trail that goes around the end of dog park.
- 16 - Continue to follow this trail, keeping dog park on your left. **DO NOT TAKE ANY SIDE TRAILS.**
- 17 - Continue on this trail until it ends at asphalt trail near the park entrance (Dresden Lane SW)
- 18 - **TURN RIGHT** on this road to park entrance,
- 19 - **TURN LEFT** onto 87th Ave SW
- 20 - **RIGHT** at light onto Steilacoom Blvd (walk on right side of street).
- 21 - **LEFT** at Hipkins Rd SW (by Jack in The Box) crossing Steilacoom Blvd. **RESTROOMS**
- 22 - Hipkins Rd SW becomes 83rd Ave SW.
- 23 - **LEFT** onto Garnet Ln SW.
- 24 - **LEFT** onto Onyx Dr SW.

- 25 - When reaching the School Crossing sign, cross Onyx and walk on right side of road.
- 26 - Onyx angles left and becomes 87th Ave SW.
- 27 - **RIGHT** on unmarked road with gate
At sign “Child Study and Treatment Center”
- 28 - TURN LEFT** at next road on LEFT.
- 29 - Walk through/around gate. Continue straight ahead, entering Western State Hospital grounds
- 30 - **LEFT** at first building (8805 or 54 on end) walking in front of building.
- 31 - **LEFT** at Stop Sign for one block, then **RIGHT** onto street with **Speed Limit 15** sign.
- 32 - This street curves **RIGHT** by a red fire hydrant and becomes Cottage Row.
- 33 - **RIGHT** onto Fort Street, passing remaining buildings of Fort Steilacoom.
- 34 - Fort Street **URNS LEFT** and ends at a “T” intersection.
- 35 - Cross this street and **TURN LEFT** walking in front of buildings.
- 36 - Follow sidewalk around right side of a Roundabout.
- 37 - **LEFT** at traffic light (Circle Dr. S.W./crosswalk) crossing Steilacoom Blvd
- 38 - Immediate **RIGHT** onto paved walkway parallel to Steilacoom Blvd.
- 39 - Continue on paved walkway to finish at Chevron Station (Steilacoom Blvd and Sentinel Dr S.W.)

CONTINUATION OF 6KM

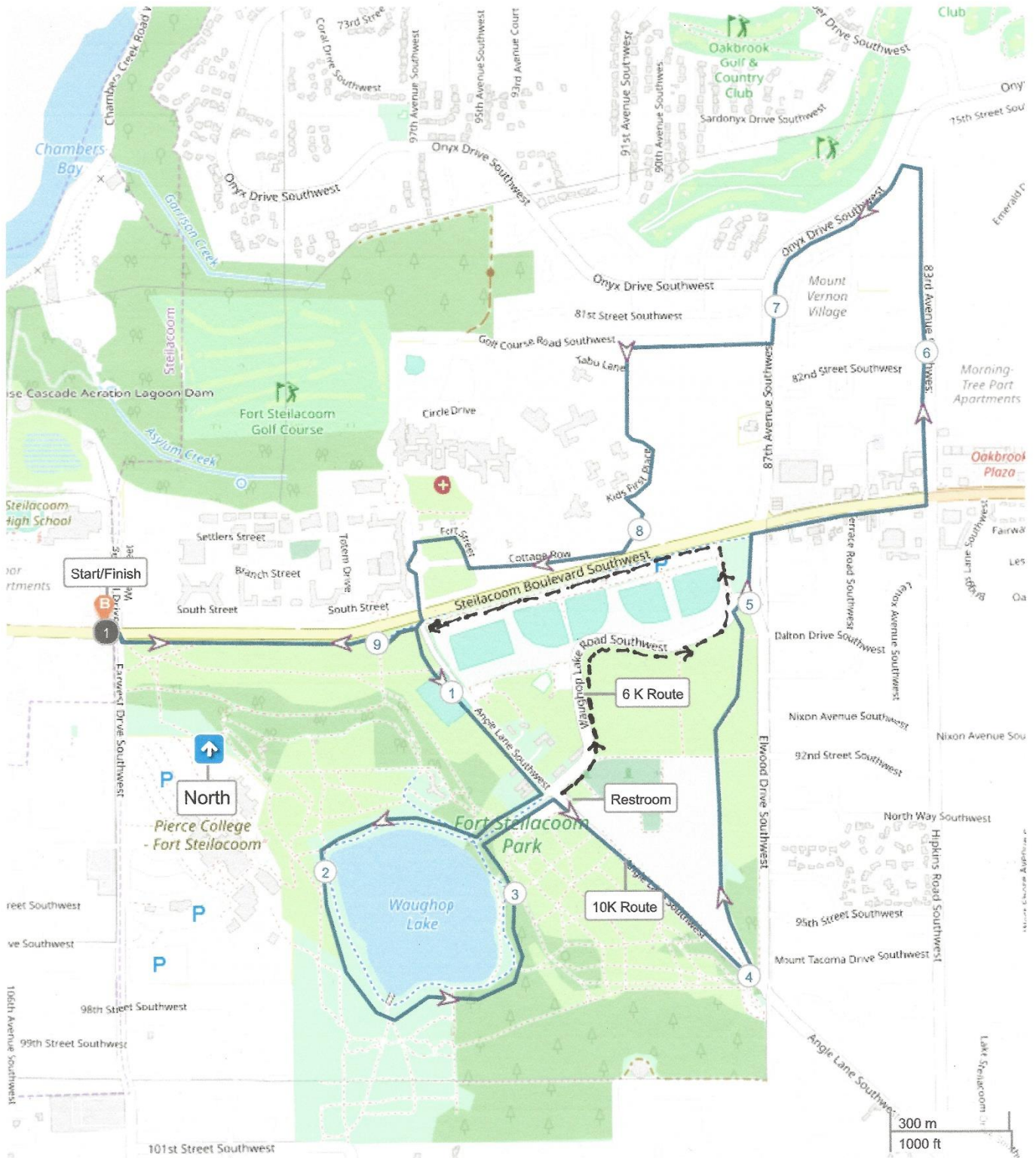
- 40 - Continue straight ahead following Waughop Lake Rd SW passing an entrance, and continue on path toward Steilacoom Blvd.
- 41 - **SHARP LEFT** onto trail paralleling Steilacoom Blvd.
- 42** – Continue on trail to the end.
- 43 – **CROSS** Steilacoom Blvd and Sentinel Drive to **START/FINISH** at Chevron Station.

These directions may be used only by individuals duly registered for this AVA/IVV Sanctioned Event

THINGS TO SEE:

Fort Steilacoom Park used to be a farm where crops and animals were raised to feed Western State Hospital patients
10K will pass remaining buildings of Fort Steilacoom on Western State Hospital grounds. A US Army Fort from 1649 to 1868.
