

Seven Sacred Pools of Ohe'O, Y-2000
Hana (Maui), HI
11 Km, rated 2B

Walk Start Location: Hana/Kipahulu District Ranger Station

GPS Coords: 20.66167, -156.04491

Driving Directions: From Kahului Airport drive east on SR 36/SR360 (Hana Highway). Continue on SR 360 past Hana (milepost 35) to start location (milepost 42) at Kuloa Loop/Piipiwai Trailhead at the Ranger Station visitor center on LEFT. The "Road to Hana" and beyond is a winding, at times one lane beautiful drive with many waterfalls and viewpoints, which will take nearly 2 hours to complete. Give yourself all day to complete the roundtrip drive and walk.

Park: Kipahulu Visitors Center lot.

Restrooms: Visitors Center.

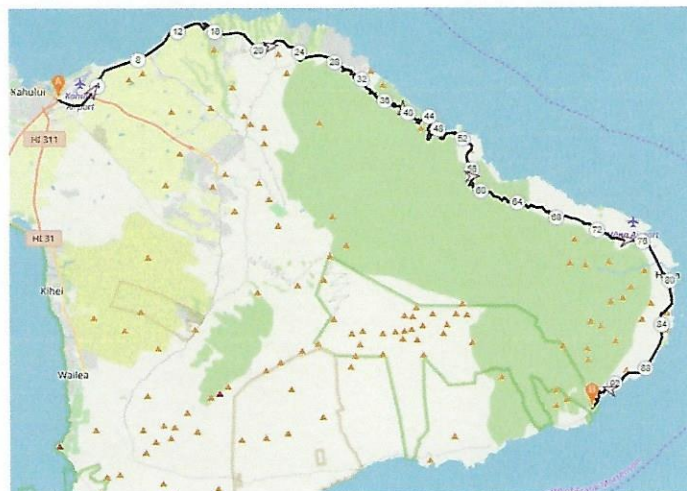
Walk Completion and Credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

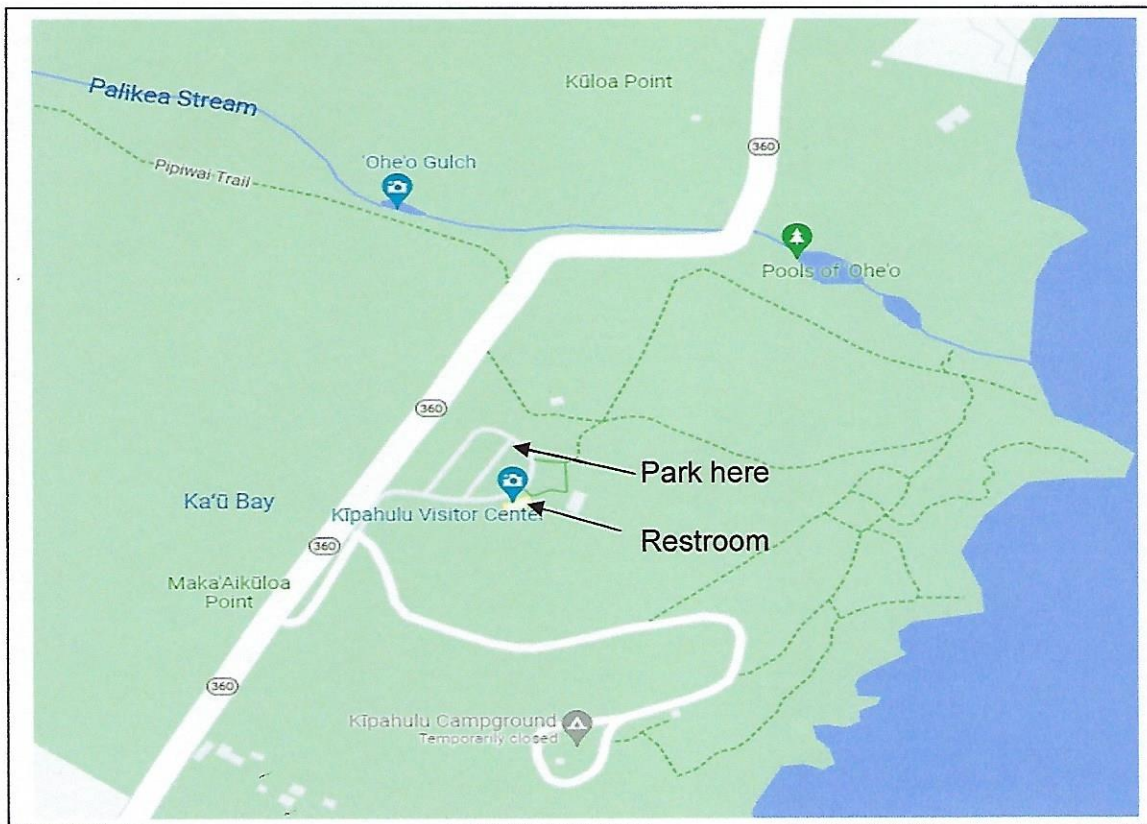
Event Recommendations: The "Road to Hana" and beyond is a winding, at times one lane, beautiful drive with many waterfalls and viewpoints. Give yourself all day to enjoy and accomplish this walk and the roundtrip drive. If time permits, a short trip to Hana for lunch/supper and returning on the "Road to Hana" is an adventure one should not miss.

The route takes in the "Kuloa Loop Trail" and Pipiwai Trail".

1. **LEFT** from the Ranger Station on the .6-mile (1km) loop trail through ancient Hawaiian archeological site of rock walls and house foundations, past bluffs overlooking the ocean, and the lower Pools of Ohe'o.
2. **CONTINUE ACROSS** H/SR31 following trail up above the "Seven Sacred Pools" to the 400 ft high Waimoku Falls overlook and **TURNAROUND POINT**.

*(**You will walk past several overlooks of the stream past a large spreading Banyan tree, through impressive bamboo forest to the base of one of Maui's most spectacular waterfalls with a 400 ft drop.)*

3. **RETURN** to highway.
4. **RIGHT** carefully walking along road/shoulder when possible of a very narrow road 1.1 mile (1.5km) to the Palapala ho'omau Church (burial place of Charles Lindberg) and **RETURN** to car (6.9mi/11.3km)



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
