

Black Hoof Park, Lenexa KS – YRE 2026 - 5 & 10 K - Pace Setters Volkssport Club

In case of emergency : Dial 911. Restrooms are available at the start point

Start/Finish point: Black Hoof Park, 9053 Monticello Rd, Lenexa KS. **From the north:** Go south on KS-7 to exit to W 83rd St. Turn left on W St to Monticello Rd, just past Freedom Fields ball fields. Continue straight thru 3 traffic circles and turn left at Black Hoof Park – Lake Lenexa (2nd entrance to park) to the Stone Wall Shelter. **From the south:** Go north on KS-7 to the exit for Prairie Star Parkway and turn right to Monticello Rd. Turn left on Monticello Dr going straight thru 1 traffic circle and turn right at the 1st entrance to Black Hoof Park Lake Lenexa to the Stone Wall Shelter. **GPS coordinates** 38.964468, -94.843390.

Special Programs: Walking the USA A-Z – ("L"), Mayflower – 400th Anniversary (for Chief Black Hoof). Walk qualifies for Johnson County in the KS County booklet.

1. From shelter turn right on trail with lake on your right and restrooms on the left
2. Follow trail with the lake on your right to the 1st left
3. Turn left on the path with the large shelter on your right continuing on the asphalt path with the playground on your left & the parking lot on the right. The path will bear right and head towards the lake.
4. Go over a bridge and turn right at the junction. Stay on the asphalt trail passing the restroom on your on the left.
5. At the T intersection turn left back onto the main trail towards the dam.
6. 10K – skip to #9
7. 5K – Go to the middle of the dam
8. Turn around & take the trail back to the start/finish. (do not go back up to the large shelter)
9. Just before you reach the dam turn left and take the switchbacks to the bottom of the hill and cross the bridge
10. Continue straight on asphalt path, crossing a bridge with a small lake on the right
11. At the intersection by a bench bear left up the hill to the wooden street sign Red Bud Lane.
12. Turn around and retrace your steps across 2 bridges, up the switchbacks to the top of the dam.
13. Cross the dam to the end of the pavement & continue straight ahead on the dirt trail .
14. Continue on the trail through the woods on the right side of the lake
15. At the sign #32457LN veer right on concrete and continue on trail through the woods. DO NOT GO TO THE LEFT UP THE MAINTENANCE RD continue on the trail until you reach the sidewalk at Monticello Rd
16. Turn right and follow the sidewalk across the bridge
17. Turn right at the first sidewalk after the bridge
18. Take a sharp right at the next intersection with the Lake on your left and road on your right going under Monticello Rd
19. Continue on the trail with the creek on your right
20. Cross 3 bridges and under the Prairie Star Pkwy underpass
21. Continue straight over pedestrian bridge (Do not take the left sidewalk up to the street)
22. Veer left on asphalt trail at intersection immediately after the bridge (Do not take sidewalk to the right into parking lot)

23. Continue to far end of the small lake to a bench.
24. Turn around and retrace your steps under 2 underpasses back to the lake.
25. Turn right onto the boardwalk through the wetlands
26. At end of boardwalk turn right on sidewalk back to the finish.

Thank you for walking with the Pace Setters. Don't forget to return to the Online Start Box to check-in as complete and get your AVA/IVV stamped Insert Card for this event.

Note that there is a physical start box located at Mill Creek Activity Center, 6518 Vista Drive, Shawnee, KS 66218. If you have initiated registration in the OSB for this event, please continue with the OSB process. **DO NOT DOUBLE REGISTER** with both the OSB and the physical start box. Complete the event by logging back into the OSB as stated in these Event Directions.
