



## Fredericksburg Walking Club

**CULPEPER — Historic District Streetscapes 5K & 10K Walk | Y2061 | Rated 2A**  
**Start Point: Culpeper Visitor Center, 109 S Commerce St. Culpeper, VA 22701**  
**Restrooms: Visitors Center and at the entrance to Yowell Meadow Park**

An AVA Sanctioned Year Round Event (YRE) (Credit Only)

This walk comprises 5 km and 10 km trails. The uniqueness of this walk results from the emphasis Culpeper places on preserving historic buildings and landmarks from each era of its history. There are many interesting streetscapes. Walk the historic streets of Culpeper including Davis Street and Yowell Meadow Park. The routes are mostly on sidewalks and paved pathways, though there are sections along unpaved nature trails. Route is rated 2A.

The walk start / finish point is the Culpeper Visitor Center in historic Train Depot (see Driving Directions below for details). Bring your own water.

### **Walk Registration:**

This walk has a Physical Start Box (PSB) inside the Visitor Center. If you register at the location, ask the center personnel for the walk box. Registration can also take place using the AVA Online Start Box (OSB), which is located on the website [my.ava.org](http://my.ava.org). Follow the instructions provided to create a user account and sign the AVA waiver (one time). Instructions for payment are also included. Download the directions (print if desired). The Point of Contact (POC) does not provide event directions or accept payments.

### **Driving Directions:**

**Culpeper Visitor Center** is located at 109 S Commerce St. Culpeper, VA 22701. They are currently open Monday through Sunday from 10-5, please call ahead to ensure they are open (540) 727-0611.

**From VA-3 West:** Take S. East St. to Commerce St. Slight RIGHT onto Orange Rd. Turn RIGHT onto S. East St. Turn RIGHT onto E. Culpeper St. Continue onto Commerce St. Destination on your RIGHT.

**Parking is Free at the Culpeper Visitor Center.** The Triangle Parking Lot, near Culpeper Depot, is available for all day parking.

**Restrooms:** are located at the Visitor Center and at the entrance to Yowell Meadow Park.

### **Special Programs:**

Par for the Course, Step to the Beat, Walking with America's Veterans (monument circle, Vietnam Memorial at Courthouse), Walking the USA A-Z, Washington-Rochambeau National Historic Trail (Monument Circle-Minute Men), Walk With the Wild Things, and Find the LOVE.

### **Walk Completion and Walk Credit:**

**Please use either the OSB or the PSB to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match. For example, do not register using the OSB and then complete your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB.** Once you have completed the walk, either follow the instructions in the PSB and sign the log, stamp your books, and mail in your payment **OR** log in to your AVA OSB Account. If you are using the OSB, click on the "My Start Box" tab, click the "Finish Table" tab, and then click "Go to Finish Table" button for the event that you completed. Use the displayed entry form to submit the date and distance for your walk, as well as selecting the applicable AVA Special Programs. This will generate the stamped virtual insert cards that you may choose to print out.

**These walk directions and maps may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited.**

**CULPEPER — Historic Streetscapes | 5K & 10K Walk | Y2061 | Rated 2A**

**START POINT: Culpeper Visitors Center, 109 S Commerce St., Culpeper,**

**VA Restrooms: Visitors Center & entrance to Yowell Meadow Park**

1. **EXIT** Visitors Center, (**Find the LOVE** sign) walk up E. Davis St. crossing East St., Main St., and N. West St. (**Walk With the Wild Things-See atop REAR of Frost Cafe, 101 E. Davis-Griffin**)
2. **RIGHT** on N. West St.
3. **LEFT** on W. Cameron St.
4. **RIGHT** on N. Blue Ridge Ave. **CROSS** and **ENTER** Yowell Meadow Park (**Par for the Course — Yowell Meadow Park**).
5. **LEFT** on paved walking path.
6. Walk around the pond to metal railed bridge.
7. **CROSS** the bridge.
8. **LEFT** at end of bridge on to unpaved Nature Tr.
9. **FOLLOW** Nature Trail along Mountain Run, walk up steep hill.
10. Top of hill, facing a walking map, **LEFT** along paved trail.
11. Take second exit on **RIGHT** into Lakeview Subdivision.
12. Subdivision sign on **RIGHT**, Playground on **LEFT**.
13. **RIGHT** on Fairwood Dr.
14. Follow Fairwood Dr., passing Fox Den Rd.
15. **CROSS** Prosperity Rd., Fairwood Dr. becomes Woodcrest Loop.
16. **LEFT** on Monument Lane.
17. **PASS** (3) houses on right and turn **RIGHT** on cement path ending in set of stairs.
18. **TAKE** and go **UP** stairs.
19. Enter Park, turn **LEFT**, follow path, Subdivision on left. Near *parking, see monument area to left (Washington Rochambeau Trail & Walking with America's Veterans)*.
20. **VIEW** Monuments, follow path to iron bridge with steps.
21. **CROSS** bridge and **EXIT** the Park.
22. **RIGHT** on N. Blue Ridge Ave.  
**\*\*5K walk\*\*** continue to #35  
**\*\*10K walk\*\*** continue to #23
23. **CONTINUE ON** N. Blue Ridge Ave., passing Scanlon, Asher, Park, and Spring Streets (follow red line on map).
24. **RIGHT** on Oaklawn Blvd. Follow the loop back to **RIGHT** on Oaklawn Blvd.
25. **LEFT** on N. Blue Bridge, walk to W. Spring St.
26. **LEFT** on W. Spring St., proceed past old utilities bldgs. to iron walking bridge.
27. **CROSS** iron walking bridge and turn.
28. **LEFT**, proceed around unpaved walking trail.
29. Come out at sign, **CROSS** path to unpaved Memorial Garden path.
30. Proceed through 9/11 Memorial, **CONTINUE ON** loop to **SECOND** path back to paved Park Trail.
31. **RIGHT** on paved Park Trail.
32. **ENTER** paved Memorial Circle, view monuments.
33. **RESUME** Park Trail, bear slight **LEFT** past large pavilion (**Step to the Beat — pavilion**).
34. Proceed around loop to Skate Park and Parking Lot.
35. **RETURN** to Park entrance.
36. **CROSS**, turn **RIGHT** on N. Blue Ridge Ave.
37. **LEFT** on W. Cameron St.
38. **RIGHT** on N. Main St. (**Step to the Beat — music store on your left**)
39. **LEFT** on E. Davis St.
40. **RETURN** to Visitor Center.

Notes: Map lines inside of Yowell Meadow Park is approximate and not to scale.

5k way out from the start point (into the Subdivision) is solid blue, and the way back (to the finish point) is dotted red to help differentiate the lines.

## 10k Map

Notes: Map lines inside of Yowell Meadow Park and on the trails are approximate and not to scale.

10k to the park and nature trails (from start point and into Lakeview Subdivision) is purple solid lines, on second trip back into the nature trails and the park (from in the subdivision) is dark blue dashed/dotted lines, and the third trip into park (to go to the Skate Park and back to the finish point) are dotted red.
