

## **SODUS POINT NY Seasonal Walk 5 KM/10KM**

**EVENT ID:** Y2111

**WALK Dates:** April 1<sup>st</sup> through December 31<sup>st</sup>

**START POINT:** The start point is the parking lot of the Sodus Bay Lighthouse Museum 7606 North Ontario Street, Sodus Point, New York 14555. GPS coordinates of the start point (43.162527 -76.591160). **NOTE the start point on the map is the old one, use point #1 as the start point. Directions match new start point.**

**TRAIL DESCRIPTION:** The 5K course is on sidewalks, city streets without sidewalks with some small hills. The 10K has one large (200 foot) hill and is on city streets without sidewalks for half its length. There is not much traffic in the town on the streets you have to walk on. Please use caution if walking in April. November, and December if it has snowed.

**TRAIL RATING:** 2B

**AWARDS AND FEES:** This event is available for on line registration only. ([www.my.ava.org](http://www.my.ava.org)). A minimal charge is incurred for the directions. There is an A award. Contact the POC directly for information on how to obtain the award.

### **DRIVING INSTRUCTIONS:**

From the East and West: New York State Thruway (Interstate 90) to exit 42 (Geneva-Lyons). Then take NY Route 14 north through Lyons and Alton. Route 14 goes into the village of Sodus Point, and makes a right on Bay Street. Left on North Ontario Street. Museum is about 3 blocks ahead on the Lake. Free parking is next to the museum. Alternates routes from Rochester NY. Take NY Route 104 to NY Route 14 then left into the village of Alton and follow the route above to the start point.

**PETS:** Leashed pets are allowed on all walks, and you must clean up after them.

**AMENITIES:** Restrooms are at the start point if open see the lighthouse web site. The route takes you through a small upstate NY village on the south shore of Lake Ontario. There are a number of restaurants and other businesses you pass where there are restrooms and food. Restrooms at the Sodus Point Beach in season and Willow Park. The town is the site of the Sodus Point Lighthouse Museum. It is an 1871 light house built on the site of an earlier 1824 light house. Hours of the museum vary please use the web site at [www.soduspointlighthouse.org](http://www.soduspointlighthouse.org) for details. There was a War of 1812 battle in the town.

**REMEMBER:** You must log back into OLSB to finish online registration procedures after completing the Event.

## **SODUS POINT NY 10K WALK INSTRUCTIONS**

1. From the Lighthouse Parking area face Lake Ontario and turn left onto the street parallel to the lake. This is Lake Street (no sign)
2. Turn LEFT at North Fitzhugh St
3. At the 4 way stop carefully CROSS Lake Road then turn left cross Route 14. This should put you on the right side of Lake Street at the Church.
4. Left onto to Route 14 (You will be walking along the left or water side of the road once you get to the first bend. There is not a lot of sidewalk here but there is enough room along the shoulder. This is route 14)
5. Continue walking along Route 14. You will see a marina, an old stone factory, a small park, and a few businesses on both sides of the road. The old factory building was actually the Genesee Brewery malt warehouse where they stored malt for beer.
6. Look for the coal trestle historic sign on your left.
7. Continue on Route 14 and soon you cross a little bridge. Take the first LEFT after the bridge into South Shore Road.
8. Take the first RIGHT onto Central Avenue. It rises up a hill.
9. FOLLOW Central Ave past Bayview Drive, past Overlook Drive to the top of the hill.
10. At the top of the Hill Central goes right and an unnamed street goes LEFT. Take a LEFT on the unnamed street.
11. Take a RIGHT at Overlook Drive.
12. Take a LEFT into Bayview Drive. ("T" intersection) There are Tennis courts on the left. The Golf Course will be on your right. There are restrooms available at the Golf Course restaurant if open.
13. FOLLOW Bayview Drive back to Central Ave.
14. Take a RIGHT on Central Ave and go back down the hill to South Shore Rd
15. At the "T" intersection take a LEFT on South Shore Road, back to RT 14.
16. At Route 14 take a RIGHT stay along the left side of the road facing traffic and retracing your steps into the village.
17. At the 4 way stop take a Right onto BAY Street, (Lake Road turns into Bay St here). As you pass the fire hall look to the east side of the building. There are murals for Native Americans.
18. Just past the post office on Bay Street there is a historic sign to the Battle of Sodus Point. (War of 1812)
19. Keep following Bay St. It turns into Greig St just after the visitor's center and Willow park (on your Right)
20. FOLLOW Greig St all the way to the end where it loops. You will be walking past several restaurants where you can take a rest and get a bite to eat if you want.
21. RETURN along Greig Street to Bay Street Extension.
22. Right on Bay Street Extension.
23. Take a Right onto Wickham Blvd (again no side walk) walk past 8<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 2<sup>nd</sup> Street to

the parking lot at the beach. Turn around and retrace your steps back to where you turned at Bay Street Extension.

**24.** Keep Straight on Wickham St to the Tee intersection at North Ontario Street.

**25.** Right on North Ontario Street back to the start point.

**26.** You have completed the Sodus Point 10K.

**27.** Remember to log back on to the OLSB to get your walk credit.

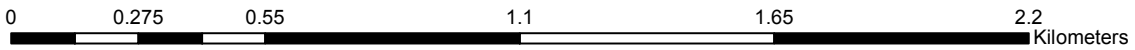

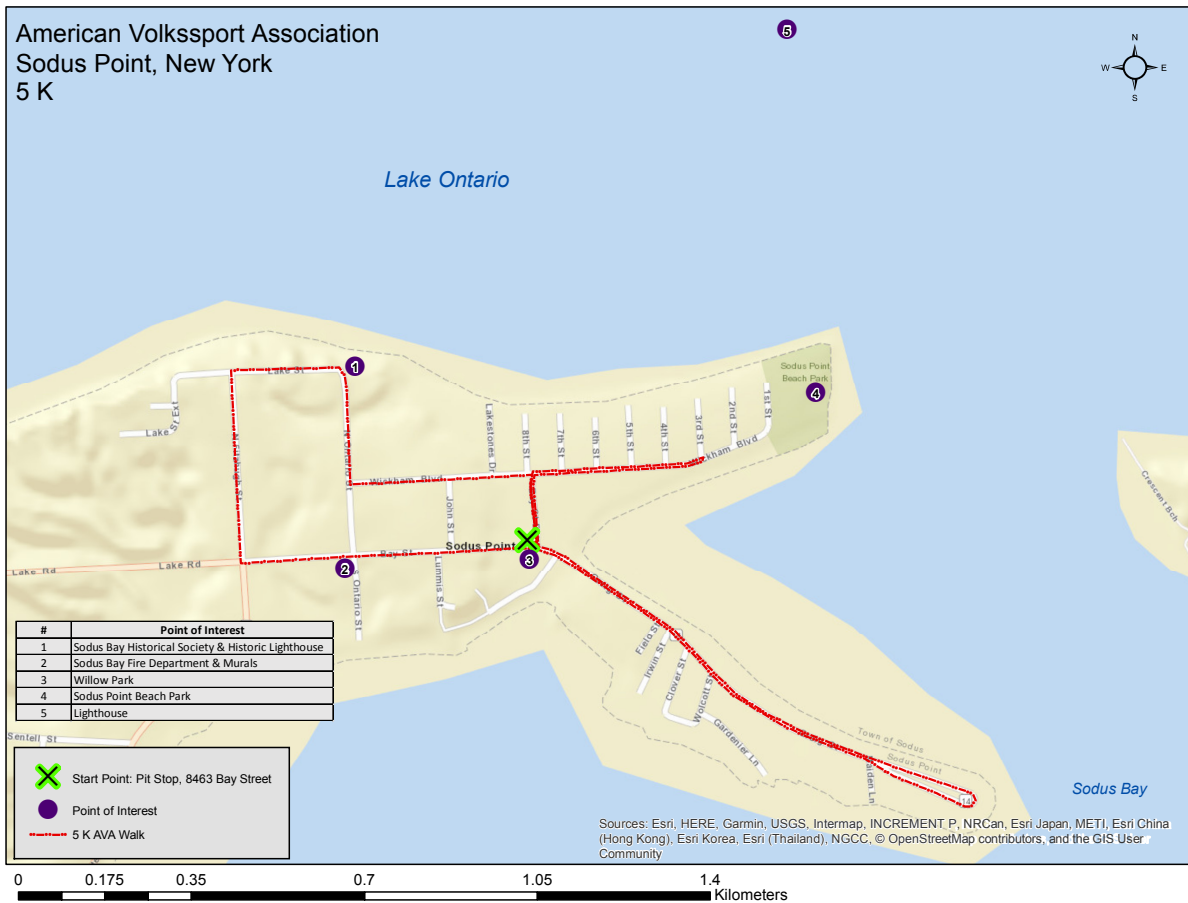

## **SODUS POINT NY 5K WALK INSTRUCTIONS**

1. From the Lighthouse Parking area face Lake Ontario and turn left onto the Street parallel to the lake. This is Lake Street (no sign)
2. LEFT at North Fitzhugh St. At the 4 Way Stop cross Lake Road then turn LEFT and cross Bay Street (Bay Street is on the left, Lake Road to the right) You should be on the Right side of Bay Street.
3. Follow Bay Street past the Fire House. As you pass the fire house, look to the east side of the building. There are murals for the Native Americans.
4. FOLLOW Bay Street past the post office. There will be a historic sign for the Battle of Sodus Point. (War of 1812)
5. Keep following Bay St. You will pass Willow Park and the visitors center on the right.
6. Bay ST becomes Greig Street past Willow Park. You will be walking past several restaurants where you will be able to take a rest and get a bite to eat if you would like.
7. Go all the way to the end of Greig ST, walk around the loop/circle.
8. Return along Greig Street to Willow Park.
9. Just before Willow Park turn right onto Bay Street Extension. There is a sign pointing toward the beach.
10. Right onto Wickham Blvd.
11. Follow Wickham Blvd past 8<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> Street to the beach parking lot.
12. Walk through the beach parking lot. There is a pier on the corner of the lot. If it's not too windy you can walk out onto the pier. There is a lighthouse at the end, walk to the lighthouse. If you do this part credit yourself with 6KM. If you turn around at the entrance to the beach parking lot credit yourself with 5KM
13. Turn around and return to Wickham BLVD
14. Walk past 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, Lakeshore Dr, and John Street, to the Tee intersection at North Ontario Street.
15. Left on Right on North Ontario Street back to the Start point.
16. You have completed the Sodus Point 5K or 6K.
17. Remember to sign back into the OLSB to record your walk.
