

Instructions for
Blue Lake, Y-2249
5 & 10 Km, rated 1A

Walk Start Location: For **10km walkers:** intersection of NE Fairview Lake Way and NE 211th Ave, Fairview, OR. For **5km walkers:** intersection of NE Fairview Lake Way and NE Alton St, Fairview, OR for 5km walkers.

GPS Coords: 45.54678, -122.44477 (**10km**), 45.54889, -122.43429 (**5km**)

Driving Directions: From I-84 east or west bound, take Exit 14 from the freeway. From eastbound, turn left on NE Fairview Pkwy/207th to NE Sandy Blvd, turn right to 223rd Ave. Turn left on 223rd Ave to NE Fairview Lake Way. For **10km walkers** left on NE Fairview Lake Way to Pelfrey Park on right and park on street. For **5km walkers** left on NE Fairview Lake Way one block to Alton St on right and park on street. From I-84 westbound turn right on NE Fairview Pkwy/207th to NE Sandy Blvd and follow directions above for 5 or 10km start point.

Park: On neighborhood streets.

Restrooms available in Blue Lake Regional Park.

Walk Completion and Credit: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant's Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. (Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user's Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user's Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.)

"Please use either the Online Start Box (OSB) or Physical Start Box (PSB) to register and complete the event. Do NOT mix and match, for example, by registering using the OSB then completing your event using the PSB nor signing the PSB log sheet. The sponsoring club only receives credit for an OSB participation when an OSB registration has been completed online by entering your participation date, distances, and any special programs using the OSB."

"These maps and directions may only be used in conjunction with a signed American Volkssport Association athletic waiver. All other uses are prohibited."

2022 BLUE LAKE – FAIRVIEW LAKE
YR 10K RATED 1-A

No dogs are allowed in Blue Lake Park and there is an alternate route.

1. At Pelfrey Park go to the corner of 211th Ave. and Fairview Lake Way.
2. **Left** on 211th Ave to Shore Dr.
3. **Right** on Shore Dr. to 214th Dr
4. **Right** on 214th Dr. to Fairview Lake Way.
5. **Left** on Fairview Lake Way to 217th Ave.
6. **Left** on 217th Ave. to Lakeshore Park (1K)
Circle the entire park clockwise coming back to 217th Ave.
7. **Left** on 217th Ave. to Fairview Lake Way.
8. **Left** on Fairview Lake Way to 218th Ave.
9. **Left** on 218th Ave. to Alton Street.
10. **Right** on Alton St. to Fairview Lake Way.
11. **Left** on Fairview Lake Way to 223rd Ave.
12. **Left** on 223rd Ave. to Failing St.
13. **Left** on Failing St. to 220th Ave.
14. **Left** on 220th Ave. to Lachenview Ln.
15. **Right** on Lachenview Ln. to 216th Ave.
16. **Right** on 216th Ave to Interlachen Ln.. (3K)
17. **Right** on Interlachen Ln. to Blue Lake Rd.
18. **Left** on Blue Lake Road to entrance to Lake House. (Little Free Library – at house #21510).
19. **Left** on entrance road, stay on right of parking area and exit on small road on opposite side of parking to paved road. (*If there is a function in the Lake House, go to the main entrance road and enter park then (instruction 20) go straight ahead to restrooms.*)
20. **Left** on road to restrooms.
21. **Left** at the restrooms going past the boat rental building to sidewalk on far side of building.
22. **Left** on sidewalk going to lake (4K)
23. **Right** at lake on concrete sidewalk next to lake until I ends at swimming area.
24. **Right** at swimming area going up slope past the dressing rooms (on left), **cross road** and **continue straight** going past several group picnic areas. Continue as the road (entrance) bears to your right past the office until reaching the entrance fee booths.
25. Go past the entrance fee booths on the pavement farthest to the right to next intersection. **Right** a short ways to the small road you entered the park on.
26. **Left** on the small road going past the Lake House to Blue Lake Rd.
27. **Right** on Blue Lake Rd to Interlachen Ln. (this is a long stretch).
28. **Cross and right** on Interlachen Ln. (6K) to Fairview Lake Way.
29. **Left** on Fairview Lake Way to Blue Heron Shores Drive. (8.1K)
30. **Left** on Blue Heron Shores Dr. to 202nd Av.
31. **Right** on 202nd Av. to 203rd Ave.
32. **Left** on 203rd Ave. to Fairview Lake Way.
33. **Left** on Fairview Lake Way to 204th Ave.
34. **Left** on 204th Ave. to Lakeside Drive
35. **Right** on Lakeside Dr. to just past house at 20689 then head left to concrete barriers passing house 20705 and then passing between the 2 sets of barriers (9.1K) and continue on paved road until reaching Fairview Lake Way.
36. **Left** on Fairview Lake Way past large home to trail on left at lower level. Take the trail which goes to Pelfrey Park. At the playground go right to Fairview Lake Way and your car.

2022 BLUE LAKE – FAIRVIEW LAKE
YR 5K RATED 1-A

“These directions may be used only upon registration at a currently sanctioned IVV/AVA event.”

No dogs are allowed in Blue Lake Park. There is an alternate 6K route.

Driving Directions to Walk Start: From Fred Meyer facing away from doors – drive RIGHT to 223rd Ave., RIGHT on 223rd Ave. 1.3 miles to Fairview Lake Way. LEFT on Fairview Lake Way, 1 block to Alton St. and park on street.

Note, this walk meets the following challenges: **AVA: Walk in the USA A-Z. Walk Oregon Challenges: Zeroes.**

1. From parking on Fairview Lake Walk, walk back 1 block the way you came to 223rd Ave.
2. Left on 223rd Ave. to Failing Street
3. Left on Failing St. to 220th Ave.
4. Right on 220th Ave. and continue as it bears left and changes to Skidmore St. to 218th Ave.
5. Right on 218th Ave. to Blue Lake Road (1K)
6. Left on Blue Lake Road to entrance to Lake House. (**Little Free Library- at House #21510, Parks**)
7. Left on entrance road, stay on right of parking area and exit on small road on opposite side of parking to paved road. (*if there is a function in the Lake House go to the main entrance road and enter park*)
8. Left on road to restrooms.
9. Go past the restrooms and turn left at the first asphalt path and head to the lake.
10. Stay on the path keeping boat rentals on your left (2K at lake).

11. Right at lake on concrete sidewalk next to lake until it ends at swimming area.
12. Right at swimming area going up slope past the dressing rooms (on left), cross road and continue straight going past several group picnic areas. Continue as the road (entrance) bears to your right past the office until reaching the entrance fee booths.
13. Go past the entrance fee booths (3.2 K) on the pavement farthest to the right to next intersection. Right a short ways to the small road you entered the park on.
14. Left on the small road going past the Lake House to Blue Lake Road.
15. Right on Blue Lake Rd to Interlachen Ln.
16. Right on Interlachen Ln. to 216th Ave. (4K)
17. Left on 216th Ave. to Lachenview Ln.
18. Left on Lachenview Ln. to 220th Ave.
19. Left on 220th Ave. 1 block to Failing St.
20. Right on Failing St. to 223rd Ave.
21. Right on 223rd Ave. to Fairview Lake Way
22. Right on Fairview Lake Way to your car.

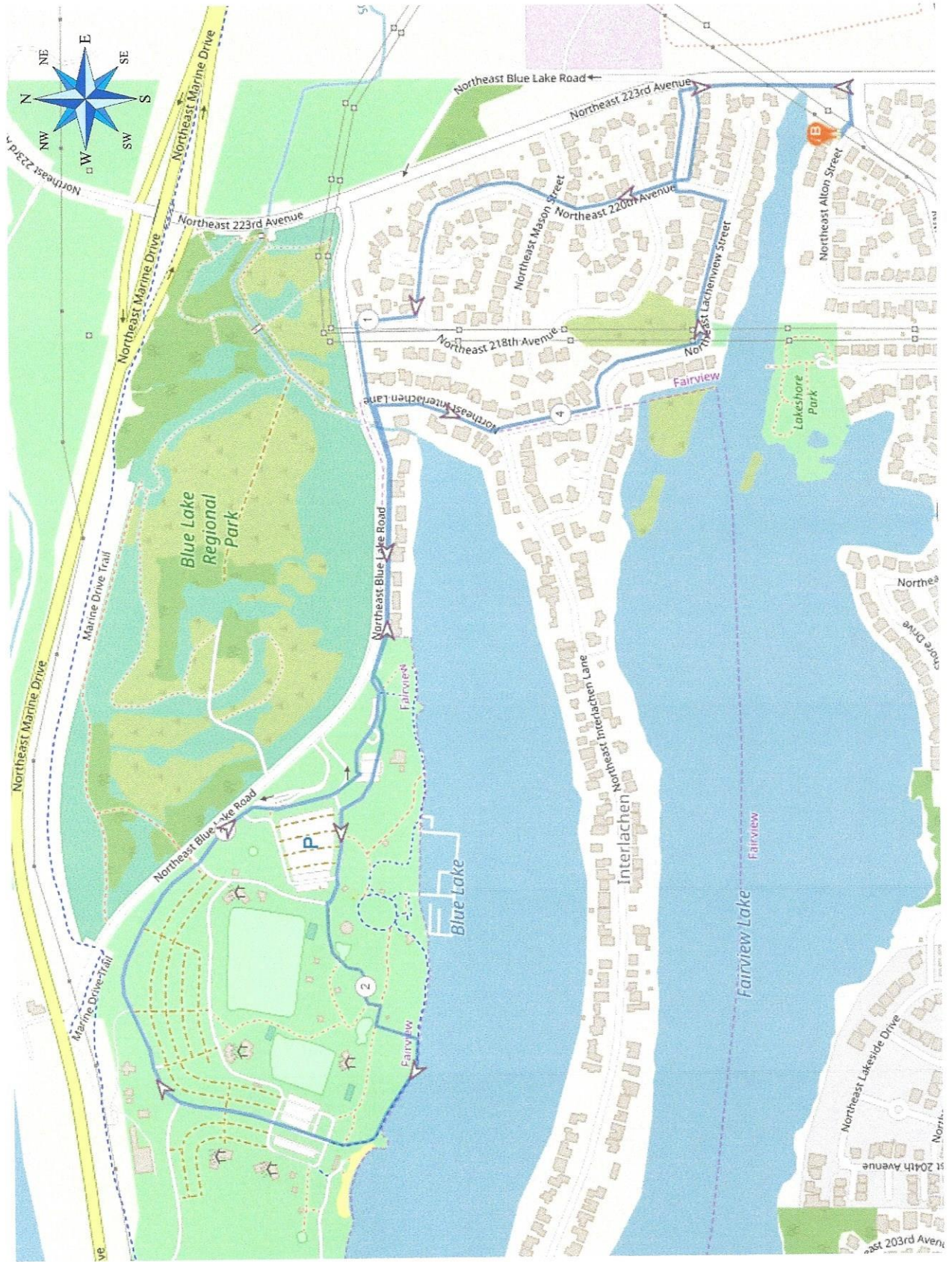

YR 6K RATED 1-A

“These directions may be used only upon registration at a currently sanctioned IVV/AVA event.”

Driving Directions to Walk Start: From Fred Meyer facing away from doors – drive RIGHT to 223rd Ave., RIGHT on 223rd Ave. 1.3 miles to Fairview Lake Way, LEFT on Fairview Lake Way, 1 block to Alton St. and park on street.

Note, this walk meets the following challenges:
AVA: Walk in the USA A-Z. Walk Oregon Challenges: Roses, Unique, Railroad, Zeroes.

1. From parking on Alton Street turn left on Fairview Lake Way to 223rd.
2. Left on 223rd Ave. to Failing Street
3. Left on Failing St. to 220th Ave.
4. Right on 220th Ave. and continue as it bears left and changes to Skidmore St. to 218th Ave.
5. Right on 218th Ave. to Blue Lake Road (1K)
6. Left on Blue Lake Road to Interlachen Lane.
7. Left on Interlachen Lane to Fairview Lake Way. This a long stretch (2K at 20912 Interlachen).
8. Left on Fairview Lake Way to Blue Heron Shores Drive (3K @ 4052 Fairview Lake Way).
9. Left on Heron Shores Drive which becomes 202nd Ave.
10. Curve right on 202nd Ave. to 203rd Ave.
11. Left on 203rd Ave. to Fairview Lake Way.

12. Left on Fairview Lake Way to 204th Ave.
13. Left on 204th Ave and follow as it curves right to become Lakeside Drive.
14. Continue on Lakeside Drive to the corner just past the house @20689. (4K @ 20537 Lakeside Drive).
15. Left at the corner to the concrete barriers passing house 20705 and passing between the two sets of concrete barriers and follow the paved road to Fairview Lake Way.
16. Left on Fairview Lake Way to Alton St. and your car. This is a long stretch. (5K at 215th Ct.).

Total distance 5590 meters.
