Springfield, Oregon
5/6/10 Km, rated 1A**

Walk Start Location: 710 Main Street Springfield, OR GPS Coords: 44.04639, -123.01642

Driving Directions: I-5: exit 191, Right on Glenwood at stop sign; Right on OR126 at traffic light, follow signs to downtown Springfield & go through 2 traffic circles to use Willamette River bridge. East on South A St. (OR126), Left on 7th, cafe at NE corner.

Park : Please park on A street one block North. DO NOT park in parking lot.

Restrooms: Restrooms available at start & finish from 7 – 2 M-F and 8 – 2 Sat/Sun. Restrooms are also available along route.

WALK COMPLETION AND CREDIT: Be sure to log back into the OSB system to finish/complete your online registration after doing the event. The OSB system does not deduct any event fee from a participant’s Event Bank until they have submitted event completion info including the date the event was walked, the distance walked, and the selection of applicable special programs that person is participating in. Nevertheless, a fee of \$2 for a downloaded PDF is deducted from the user’s Event Bank when the PDF is downloaded. Later, any PDF fees are credited back to a user’s Event Bank when he/she submits the event completion info as a paying for credit participant. Note, however, the \$2 coupon for the downloaded PDF will expire in 60 days.

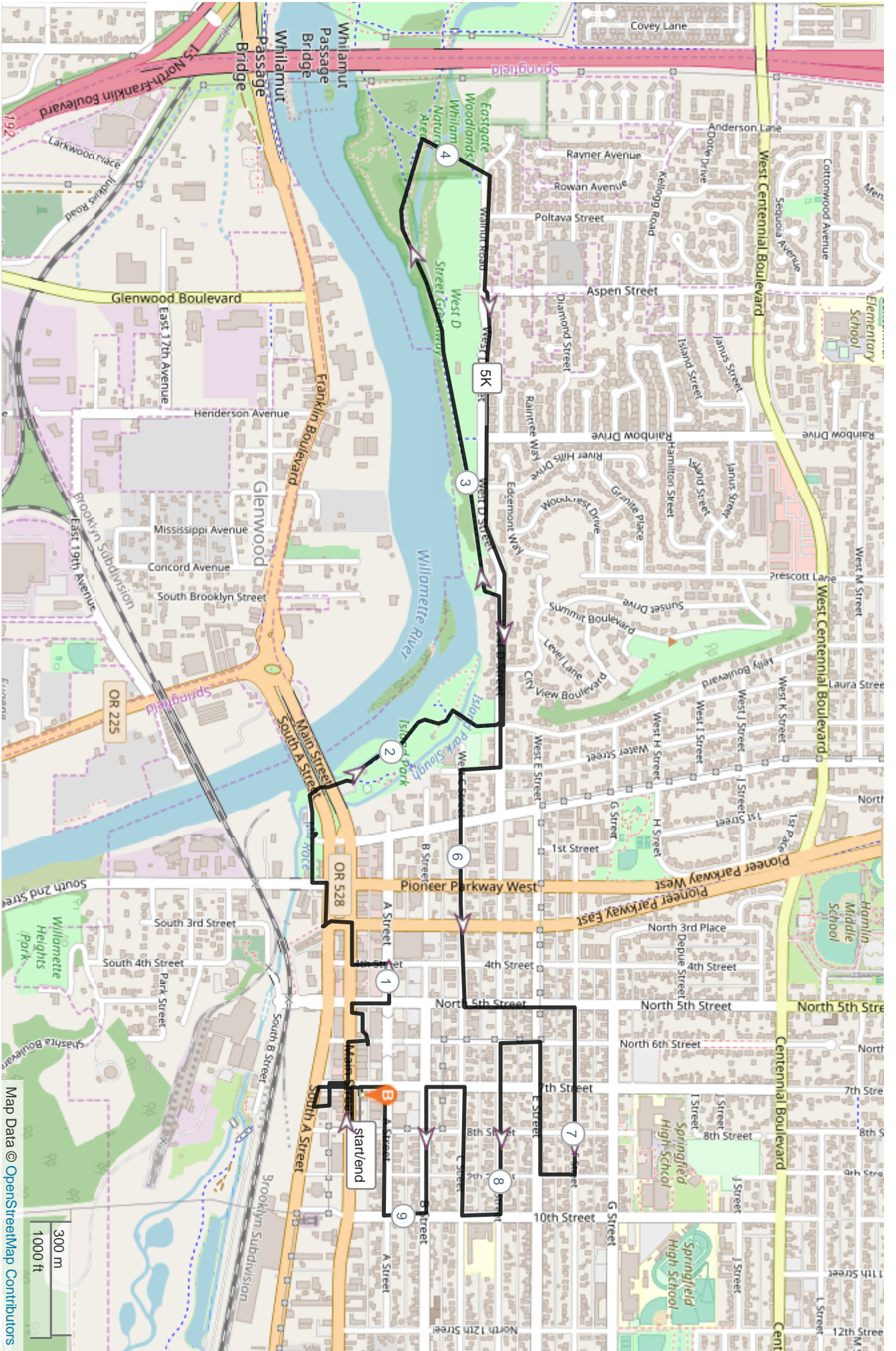

1. Leaving Pump Café, **GO** to 7th & **LEFT** to Main;
2. **LEFT** on Main to 8th to check mural at 740 Main on east wall;
3. **CROSS & RIGHT** on Main, passing mural “Raices Within” on side of Memos’s Mexican Restaurant, unnamed 727 Main mural & then look up to see mural at Banner Bank;
4. **LEFT** on 7th passing another Banner Bank mural. Go to Wynant’s Family Health Foods;
5. **GO** counterclockwise around Wynant’s building to see the murals at south end & in the back. **(In the distance you can see the former Booth-Kelly lumber mill which employed generations of workers from 1901 to 1958);**
6. **LOOK** behind to your right to see Homer Simpson mural on the next building. Bayne Gardner’s Simpson murals are popping up everywhere especially in alleys;
7. **RETURN** to 7th via the alley and turn **RIGHT**;
8. **LEFT** on Main and passing the new “Labor Builds Community” mural and Academy of Arts & Academics High School;
9. **LEFT** on 6th to see “Express Yourself” mural on left but then **return** to Main;
10. **CROSS** Main to stay on 6th, passing “The Moderns” (19th century artists/authors) to the alley for “The Draft Horse Logging” on the Right;
11. **CAREFULLY CROSS** 6th to the other side and **GO LEFT** (*note: cute UpStream drain mural is on the top step of the terrace steps leading to main stairway*);
12. **RIGHT** into the parking lot to see the large “Oregon Trail” mural depicting the segments of the Trail. Then **LEFT** to Main & go **RIGHT**;
13. **RIGHT** on 5th, passing the Simpsons mural on the Right;
14. As you pass the alley, look to your right to see “Two Cities” mural and “Smart Reading” mural. There’s a mural at 5th/A;
15. **CONTINUE** to see Centennial Fountain & Balancing Act sculpture in front of City Hall/Library. **There are murals in the Library plus an exhibit about the rapids boats once made in Springfield. This boat design is in the city seal and reproduced elsewhere; restrooms here;**
16. **RETURN** to **CROSS** 5th to **GO STRAIGHT** on A. **1K**
There are UpStream storm drain entrances in this area created annually by chosen artists. You will be passing the Public House. a former church which has several restaurants/restrooms;
17. **LEFT** on 4th to see the Ken Kesity mural across the street;
18. **RIGHT** on Main; before crossing Pioneer Parkway East, look to your right to see the Patriot Eagle mural;
19. Check out mural on the other side of Pioneer Pkwy East before going **LEFT** to cross Main St;
20. Before crossing South A St, look up to your Left for the large “Welcome to Springfield” mural;
21. **ENTER** the Springfield Transit Center to see “The Sun” mosaic on the wall to the right;
22. **RETURN** to South A and turn **LEFT**;
23. **CROSS** 2nd (Pioneer Pkwy West) & then **LEFT** to go to parking lot entrance on the Right at the old train station;
24. **RIGHT** into the train station parking lot & go through the arbor to see the sign about the Mill Race;
25. **RIGHT** at stop sign on Mill St (looks like a driveway) to look at the White Horse statue across the street;
26. **TURN AROUND** to go Right on Mill St and carefully walk down hill on the Right;
Note: If this entrance to Island Park is closed, return to 2nd/Pioneer Pkwy West & turn Left. Continue on Pioneer Pkwy W to C St & turn LEFT. Enter Park & Go RIGHT. Continue at #30;
27. **RIGHT** to go under overpass where there is a mural and the entrance to Island Park;
28. **KEEP** to the Left in the Park with Willamette River on your Left. Restrooms in the park; **2K**
29. **RIGHT** to cross bridge & then **LEFT** to D St;
30. **LEFT** on D Street and go about 1/2K;
31. **LEFT** to enter West D Street Greenway;
32. **FOLLOW** Greenway with Willamette River on your Left. **(3K) You might want to walk on the dirt path on left to avoid inconsiderate cyclists.**
33. At the Y go **LEFT** passing Aspen St exit and go to Eastgate Woodlands kiosk in parking lot. To the Left of the kiosk in front of the Canoe Canal is Pre’s trail & monument (Steve Prefontaine);
34. **GO** on Pre’s woodchip path through the woods to the bridge on Right using the sidewalk on Left to enter the bridge; **4K**
35. **RIGHT** on Walnut St & go 1½ K. Walnut will become D Street. **5K at Rainbow**
36. **RIGHT** on Water St;

37. **LEFT** on C St. Carefully **CROSS** Mill St (**6K**), Pioneer Pkwy West & Pioneer Pkwy East;
You are now in the Washburne Historic District of 34 blocks (2nd-10th Sts; B-H Sts) with houses built from 1890s to 1940s in Bungalow/Mill Cottage/Traditional Box or Homestead styles. Some were built by the original owners.
38. **CROSS & LEFT** on 5th St; **521 5th (built 1920) was originally a residence, then a store for many years;**
39. **RIGHT** on F Street. You will be zig-zagging in this historic area as the east/west streets have more attractive houses/gardens. **636 F (ca 1900) was a fire station. 846 F (1914) was a former hospital; 7K**
40. **RIGHT** on 9 Street;
41. **RIGHT** on E Street;
42. **LEFT** on 6th Street;
43. **LEFT** on D Street; **8K**
44. **RIGHT** on 10th Street;
45. **RIGHT** on C Street;
46. **LEFT** on 7th Street;
47. **LEFT** on B Street;
48. **RIGHT** on 10th Street; **9K**
49. **CROSS & RIGHT** on A Street;
50. **LEFT** on 7th Street to end at Pump Café. **9.5K**

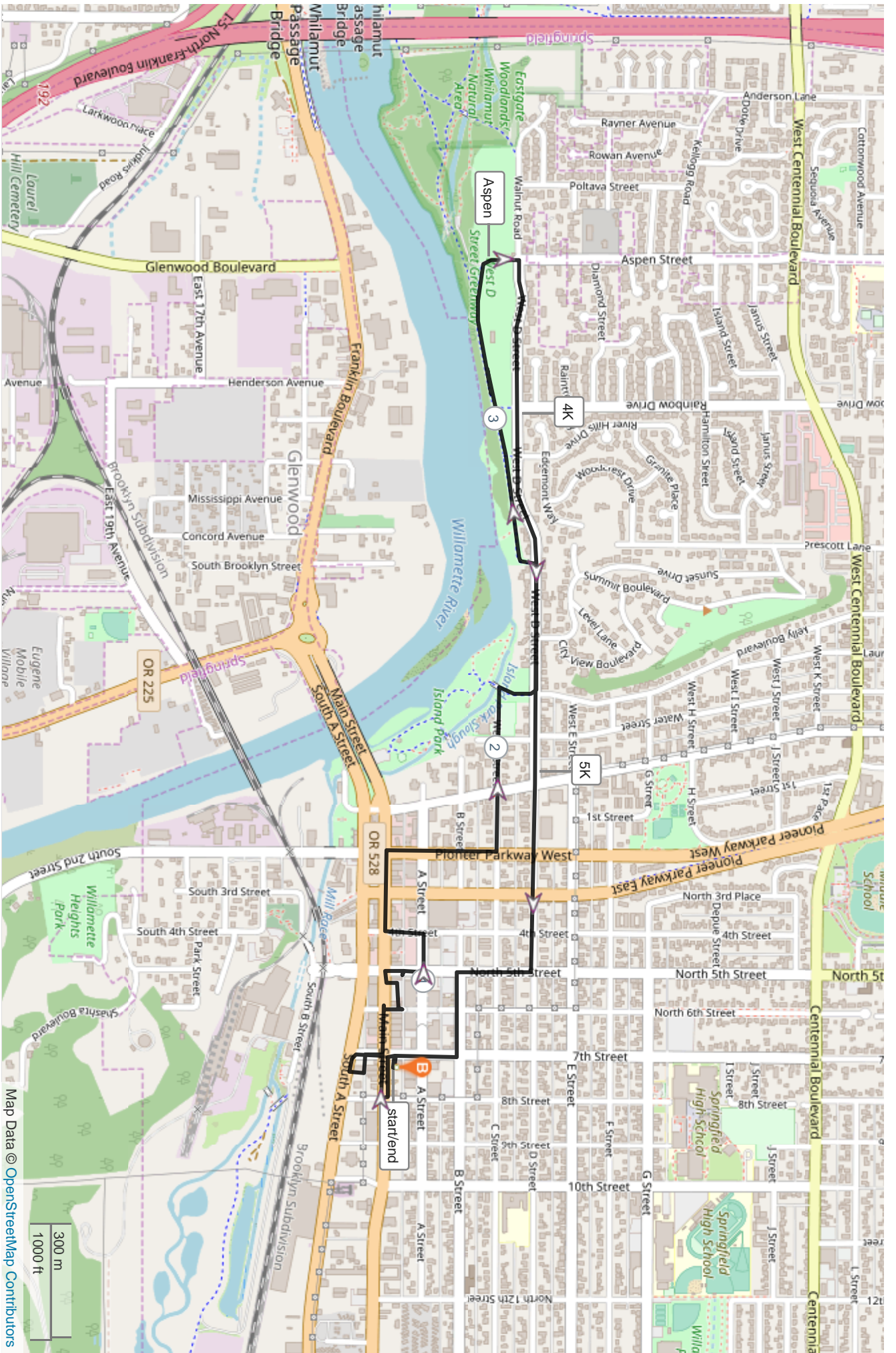

12. **RIGHT** into the parking lot to see the large "Oregon Trail" mural depicting the segments of the Trail. Then **LEFT** to Main & go **RIGHT** on Main;
13. **RIGHT** on 5th, passing Simpsons mural on on the Right;
14. As you pass the alley, look to your Right to see "Two Cities" and "Smart Reading" murals. There's a mural at 5th/A;
15. **CONTINUE** to see Centennial Fountain & Balancing Act sculpture in front of City Hall/ Library. *There are murals in the Library plus an exhibit about the rapids boats once made in Springfield. This boat design is in the city seal and reproduced elsewhere. Restrooms here;*
16. **RETURN** to cross 5th and **GO STRAIGHT** on A. *(1K) There are UpStream storm drain entrances in this area created annually by chosen artists;*
17. **LEFT** on 4th to see Ken Kesey mural across the street;
18. **RIGHT** on Main, **CROSS** Pioneer Parkway East (more murals) & then **CROSS & RIGHT** on Pioneer Parkway West;
19. **LEFT** on C and **CROSS** Mill; **2K**
20. **GO** straight into the Willamalane Adult Activity Center parking lot to its border with Island Park; turn **RIGHT** to go up the stairway to the Park & turn **RIGHT**;
21. **LEFT** on D and go about 1/2K;
22. **LEFT** to enter West D Street Greenway;
23. Follow Greenway with Willamette River on your left. **You might want to walk on the dirt path on Left to avoid inconsiderate cyclists.**
- 3K**
24. At the Y, go **RIGHT** to exit at Aspen Street passing playground on your Left;
25. **CROSS & RIGHT** on D and go 1.8K to 5th St, carefully crossing Mill/Pioneer Pkwy West & East; **4K at Rainbow; 5K at Mill**
26. **RIGHT** on 5th. You will be in the Washburne Historic District;
27. **LEFT** on B;
28. **CROSS & RIGHT** on 7th to return to Pump Café. **6K**
